LONGHORNS NOTES

THE MATCHUPS—Texas is set for its home opener against UTSA on Tuesday before welcoming the Lamar Cardinals on Wednesday. Last season, UTSA snapped a five-game losing streak to Texas with a 10-7 win at UFCU Disch-Falk Field. Against Lamar in 2019, the Longhorns won 7-2 in Austin.

A LOOK AT THE LONGHORNS—Texas Baseball has started the season with a series sweep for the first time since 2009. The 2009 team won its first 11 games and ended the year as the national runner-up with a 50-16-1 record. The Longhorns entered the season with several fresh faces, including 13 true freshmen and three junior college transfers. Those 16 new faces pair up with 17 returning letterwinners. On offense, the Longhorns return their leading hitter from last season in bryce Elder and a number of young pitchers that contributed in 2019.

NEXT UP—The Longhorns continue their six-game homestand at UFCU Disch-Falk Field by hosting Boise State for a three-game weekend series, Feb. 21-23. Texas will close the homestand against Sam Houston State next Tuesday, Feb. 25.

TULO—Longhorns' Head Coach David Pierce made a splash during the offseason, with the hiring of 13-year Major League Baseball shortstop and five-time All-Star Troy Tulowitzki as an assistant coach. Tulowitzki, who was also a two-time All-American at Long Beach State, will coach the infielders and work with the hitters, alongside Philip Miller. With the hire of Tulowitzki, assistant coach Sean Allen assumes the role of pitching coach, a role he last held as an assistant at Florida International University from 2008-11. Texas also added Longhorn Legend and two-time MLB All-Star Huston Street to the staff as a student assistant.

THE FRESHMEN—Six Longhorn freshmen made their debuts in the season-opening series at Rice, including three who played in all three games. Brenden Dixon, Trey Faltine and Douglas Hodo III have started every game and each recorded a home run for their first career hit. Andre Duplantier II and Pete Hansen each pitched in relief and did not allow a run. In addition to the freshmen, two junior college transfers made their debut – infielder Murphy Stehly and RHP Dawson Merwan

PRESEASON PICKS—Junior right-handed pitcher Bryce Elder and sophomore outfielder Eric Kennedy were named to the 2020 Preseason All-Big 12 team. Elder was one of three unanimous selections to the team and Kennedy was one of only three sophomores selected. A second-team selection to the 2019 All-Big 12 team, Elder finished the year with a 2.93 ERA in 83 innings pitched. He led the Longhorns with 86 strikeouts and nine quality starts. The Longhorns' leading hitter as a freshman in 2019, Kennedy batted .310 with eight doubles, three triples and two home runs. During his debut season on the Forty Acres, he scored 41 runs and had 28 RBI to go with nine stolen bases.

PRESEASON RANKINGS—The Longhorns landed on a trio of preseason polls, checking in at No. 22 in the Collegiate Baseball poll, No. 24 in the Perfect Game poll and No. 30 in the NCBWA poll. In the Big 12 preseason coaches' poll, Texas was selected to finish fifth behind preseason favorite Texas Tech (62), Oklahoma State (52), TCU (45) and Oklahoma (40).

DRAFTED—Texas saw three players selected in the 2019 Major League Baseball Draft: RHP Blair Henley (Astros, 7th round, No. 226), INF David Hamilton (Brewers, 8th round, No. 253) and INF Ryan Reynolds (Cubs, 14th round, No. 432).

LONGHORNS NOTES

THE SCHEDULE—The 2020 schedule features 32 home games at UFCU Disch-Falk Field, including a marquee non-conference series with Cal State Fullerton, March 6-8. In addition to 32 home games, Longhorn fans from around the state of Texas will have an opportunity to see the team play. Texas will play seven total games in Houston, with a season-opening series at Rice before returning two weeks later for the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic at Minute Maid Park. In Big 12 Conference play, the Longhorns will host Oklahoma State, Baylor, TCU and Kansas and travel to Oklahoma, Texas Tech, Kansas State and West Virginia.

HONORING A LEGEND—Longhorn Legend Huston Street will have his jersey number retired during the 2020 season. A three-time All-American and the 2002 College World Series Most Outstanding Player, Street becomes the seventh former Texas Baseball star to have his jersey retired. One of the greatest closers in college baseball history, Street holds the Texas record with 41 career saves and ranks 13th in NCAA Division I history in career saves. His 1.31 career ERA ranks second all-time at Texas and his .172 opponents' batting average is the third-best in Longhorn history In his three-year career at Texas, Street made 105 appearances and pitched 178.1 innings. He struck out 177 batters and posted an 18-3 record to go along with his 41 saves.

PACKING THE HOUSE—Last season Texas set and re-set attendance records at UFCU Disch-Falk Field. Longhorn fans showed up in droves to see Texas host Texas A&M on April 2, 2019, establishing a new regular season record crowd of 7,952. The April 2 crowd topped the previous regular season record of 7,879, set earlier in the season against Texas Tech (3/16/19). The total attendances for the three-game series against LSU (22,434) and Texas Tech (22,729) were also program records. Texas ranked sixth in the country, and first in the Big 12, in total attendance (175,768) and average attendance (5,493) last season. The Longhorns have led the Big 12 in attendance for 14-consecutive seasons.

PRO PARKS—Including the early season trip to Minute Maid Park in Houston, Texas will play in a total of three professional ballparks during the regular season. The Longhorns take on UT Arlington at Dr Pepper Ballpark, home of the Double-A Frisco Roughriders, on March 18. Texas then plays at Whataburger Field, home of the Double-A Corpus Christi Hooks, against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on April 13. Also for the 21st time, the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship will be played in Oklahoma City. The Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark, home of the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, plays host to the event.

HEAR 'EM—In partnership with Learfield IMG College, Texas games will be broadcast on the Austin Radio Network, primarily on 104.9 The Horn and AM 1260. Craig Way handles primary play-by-play duties alongside Roger Wallace and Quan Cosby.

WATCH 'EM—All but one Texas home game will be broadcast on Longhorn Network this season. The team of Lowell Galindo, Keith Moreland, and Greg Swindell will return to the booth to call the action.

HEAD COACH **AVID PIERCE 22**

4th season at Texas | 9th season as head coach

HIGH SCHOOL St. Pius X High School JUNIOR COLLEGE Wharton County Junior College ALMA MATER University of Houston, 1988

A Texas native who has spent most of his 30-year career coaching in the state. David Pierce was named head baseball coach at The University of Texas on June 29, 2016. Pierce, just the fifth Longhorn head coach since 1911 (with the exception

of the war years of 1943-45 when Blair Cherry was at the helm), is the 13th head coach in 122 years of Texas baseball.

Entering his fourth season as the Longhorns' head coach, Pierce has an overall record of 108-74 at Texas and a 305-183 mark in eight seasons as a Division I head coach.

In just his second season at the helm, Pierce was named Baseball America's National Coach of the Year after guiding the Longhorns to a 42-23 record and back to the College World Series for the first time since 2014. With a 17-7 mark in league play, Pierce, who was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year, led his team to the Big 12 Conference title—the first conference title for Texas since 2011—and hosted both an NCAA Regional and an NCAA Super Regional. In the Austin Regional, the Longhorns went 3-0 with wins over Texas Southern, Texas A&M, and Indiana. In the Super Regional, Texas dropped game one to Tennessee Tech before taking games two and three to send Pierce to Omaha for the first time as head coach. The Longhorns finished ranked in the top eight in every major poll to close out the season and finished first in the nation in double plays (73) and ninth in triples (22). Under Pierce and his staff's tutelage, second baseman Kody Clemens completed one of the best offensive seasons in Texas history. A third-round draft pick by the Detroit Tigers, Clemens was named a unanimous first team All-American at second base, becoming the first to earn that honor under Pierce. Clemens, the ABCA National Player of the Year and a finalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award, blasted 24 home runs on the year, good for second in the country and second-most in a single season in Texas Baseball history. Clemens also ranked nationally in total bases (second, 180), slugging percentage (fifth, .726), and RBI (12th, 72).

In his first season leading the Longhorns, Pierce led Texas to a 39-24 record, a 14-win improvement from the 2016 campaign. Texas came within one win of taking the Big 12 Conference tournament title before earning a No. 2 seed in the Long Beach Regional. Texas won its first two games of the regional before its season came to a close at the hands of LBSU. As a team, the Longhorns finished in the top 10 nationally in several statistical categories including double plays turned (fourth, 65), fielding percentage (fourth, .982), earned run average (ninth, 3.15), and hits allowed per nine innings (ninth, 7.60). Right-handed pitcher Morgan Cooper, a third team All-America selection, was taken in the second round of the MLB Draft, the first of 11 Longhorns to be selected in 2017, the most for any school. In Pierce's two seasons, a total of 16 Longhorns have been chosen in the draft.

The 56-year-old Pierce came to Texas from Tulane, where he spent the previous two seasons as head coach following a three-year stint at Sam Houston State in the same role. Pierce's teams have qualified for the NCAA tournament in seven years with him at the helm, and including his time as an assistant, Pierce was a part of programs that advanced to the postseason in 18 consecutive years, played in eight Super Regionals and reached five College World Series, winning a title in 2003 with Rice. In the summer of 2016, he was also named an assistant coach with the U.S. Collegiate National Team. Joining the Tulane Green Wave in 2015, the Houston native guided the school into its first season in the American Athletic Conference. His team posted a school-record nine shutouts, which ranked fourth in the nation, en route to a 35-25 record and the program's first regional appearance since 2008.

Pierce's second season at Tulane brought even more success as he led the 2016 Green Wave to a 41-21 record, a regular season AAC championship and a second-consecutive regional appearance. The 41 wins were the most for the program since 2006. The team led the nation with 13 shutouts and ranked in the top 25 in both ERA (23rd/3.24) and WHIP (25th/1.24), while belting out 66 home runs, which was tied for 13th nationally. Tulane produced two third-round picks in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft in catcher Jake Rogers and shortstop Stephen Alemais with Rogers becoming Tulane's highest draft pick since 2008. Seven players earned All-AAC honors, including four first-team selections, while starting pitcher Ross Massey was named freshman All-America after leading the conference and tying for 18th in the nation in victories (10).

In three seasons as head coach at Sam Houston State, Pierce compiled a record of 121-63 .658). During his tenure, the Bearkats made three straight NCAA Regional appearances for just the second time in program history. Sam Houston State was crowned Southland Conference champions in each of his three seasons (the program's only previous league title came in 1989), and Pierce was named the conference coach of the year in both 2012 and 2013. The recognition in back-to-back years made him the first Southland Conference coach to earn consecutive honors since UTSA's Sherman Corbett (2007-08).

In his first season as head coach in 2012, the Bearkats were ranked in each of the major Division I polls for the first time in program history. He was honored as an American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Regional Coach of the Year that season. In 2014, his final season in Huntsville, Pierce guided SHSU to a 43-19 record, the second-highest single-season win total for the Bearkats since they joined Division I in 1987. The team ranked in the top 25 in the nation and second in the conference in both ERA (17th/2.73) and hits (25th/610). It also led the conference in scoring (5.7 rpg), home runs (31) and slugging percentage (.390)

A native of Houston, Pierce was born on October 13, 1962. He and his wife, Susan, have two children – a daughter, Chelsea, who graduated from The University of Texas in 2012 and is married to husband Bryan Caffey, and a son, Shea, who played for his father at both Sam Houston (2012-15) and Tulane (2016).
