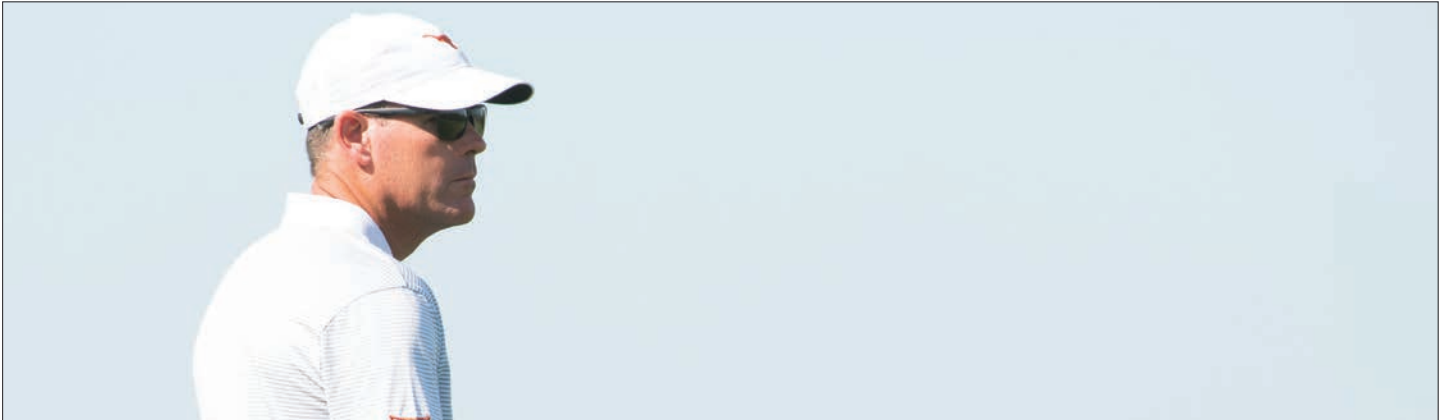

### TRADITION

#### 47TH SEASON

• The Texas women's golf team begins its 47th season of varsity competition on Sept. 27 when it opens play at the Schooner Fall Classic in Norman, Okla. The 1973-74 campaign marked the first season of Texas women's golf.

#### THE MURPHY EFFECT

- Texas head coach **Ryan Murphy** is in his seventh season at the helm of the Texas women's golf program.
- Under the direction of Murphy, Texas golfers have recorded 14 of the best 15 18-hole scores in program history, and each of the top-10 54-hole totals in school annals.
- Each of the top 15 18-hole team scores in school history have come during Murphy's tenure. Additionally, each of the top-16 54-hole team scores in program history have been charted by Murphy's teams.

#### US AMATEUR CHAMPIONS

• When Texas' then-senior **Sophia Schubert** in August 2017 claimed the 2017 U.S. Women's Amateur, she became one of five golfers in school history to capture the event. Longhorns to capture the U.S. Women's Amateur are listed below:

#### NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

- Three golfers in University of Texas history have won individual national titles, including two NCAA Championships.
- Charlotta Sorenstam became the Longhorns' first NCAA individual champion when she won the 1993 event, while Heather Bowie claimed the 1997 NCAA individual crown. Prior to NCAA sponsorship of women's golf, Debbie Petrizzi was the 1978 AIAW individual champion.
- In total, the Longhorns have posted 20 top-10 individual finishes at the NCAA Championship.

#### CONFERENCE CHAMPIONS

- The Longhorns have won 16 conference championships in program history, including five in the Big 12 Conference era.
- Texas claimed 10 Southwest Conference Championships: 1984, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1995 and 1996.
- UT has won Big 12 Conference Championships in 1997, 2004, 2011, 2017, 2018 and 2019. The Longhorns are the three-time defending Big 12 Champions.

#### HALL OF HONOR

- The Athletics Hall of Honor at The University of Texas began in 2000 to recognize individuals for exceptional contributions to The University of Texas, Texas women's athletics and the community at large.
- Since that time, nine Texas women's golfers have been inducted into the Athletics Hall of Honor, with Nancy [Hager] Hale as the most recent inductee in 2019. The full list of inductees is below:

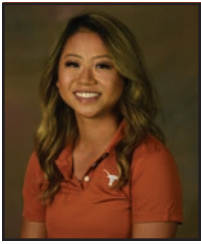

- Competed in 10 tournaments and 30 rounds for the Longhorns as a sophomore in 2018-19 with a stroke average of 72.30, which ranks fourth on Texas' all-time single-season stroke average list.
- Tied for 10th at the NCAA Championship, recording a four-over-par 223 [75-74-74].
- Turned in the best 54-hole total of her collegiate career at the NCAA Norman Regional, tying for third individually with a five-under-par 211 [71-68-72].
- Tied for second at the highly competitive Northrop Grumman Intercollegiate, totaling a one-over-par 214 [69-74-71].
- Competing as an individual at the Betsy Rawls Invitational, recorded the first top-five finish of her collegiate career with a two-under-par 214 [68-79-67].

- Led Texas at the Schooner Fall Classic, tying for third place. Fired a two-under-par three-round total of 208 [70-66-72]. The 208 set a new career-best 54-hole total.
- Placed third at the prestigious ANNIKA Intercollegiate with a seven-under-par 209 [70-68-71]. Each of her three rounds came at par or better.
- Selected to represent the United States team at the Arnold Palmer Cup for the third consecutive season.

### SOPHOMORE [2018-19]

- A 2019 WGCA First-Team All-American. Also named a Second-Team All-American by Golfweek.
- A 2019 All-Big 12 Conference selection and a Big 12 All-Tournament Team honoree.
- Competed in 11 tournaments and 33 rounds for the Longhorns as a sophomore in 2018-19.
- Ranked third on her team with a stroke average of 72.36, which was good for fifth on the school's all-time single-season stroke average list.
- Carded 18 rounds at par or better and four rounds in the 60s.
- Thirty-one of her 33 rounds counted towards the team score.
- Recorded seven top-10 finishes, including tying for 10th place at the NCAA Championship.
- Logged a pair of runner-up individual finishes in 2018-19, placing second at the Betsy Rawls Invitational and at the Big 12 Championship.
- Tied for eighth at the NCAA Norman Regional with a two-under-par 214 [71-70-73]. Led the Longhorns with 41 pars on the week and added six birdies.
- Tied for second at the Big 12 Conference Championship with a five-over-par 221 [76-74-71] to earn her second consecutive Big 12 All-Tournament Team selection.
- Placed second at the Betsy Rawls Invitational with a five-under-par 211 [71-70-70], carding 13 birdies and 35 pars on the weekend.
- Selected to participate in the inaugural Augusta National Women's Amateur,



tying for fifth overall.

- Selected to represent the United States team at the Arnold Palmer Cup for the second consecutive season.
- One of 26 amateurs who qualified to participate in the 74th U.S. Women's Open in Charleston, S.C.

**FRESHMAN (2017-18)**

- A 2018 WGCA Second-Team All-American.
- The first golfer in program history to be named Big 12 Conference Player of the Year and Big 12 Freshman of the Year in the same season.
- A 2018 All-Big 12 Conference selection and a Big 12 All-Tournament Team honoree.
- Competed in all 13 tournaments and 38 rounds as a freshman in 2017-18.
- Ranked second on her team with a stroke average of 72.05, which goes down as the second-best single-season stroke average in program history.
- Claimed two individual victories as a freshman - the Northrop Grumman Intercollegiate and the Dr. Donnis Thompson Invitational.
- Her third-round 64 at the Schooner Fall Classic tied for the Texas' 18-hole school record with teammate Emilee Hoffman.
- Recorded a team-leading 20 rounds at par or better.
- Thirty-six of her 38 rounds counted towards the team score.
- Strung together a highly impressive streak of 45 consecutive bogey-free holes. Included the final 40 holes of the Silverado Showdown and the first five holes of the Big 12 Championship. Turned in five bogey-free rounds her rookie season.
- Tied for fourth at the 2018 Big 12 Conference Championship with a three-over-par two-round total of 219 [74-74-71].
- Was named to the 2018 Arnold Palmer Cup team.

- Entered college ranked fifth in the Golfweek/Sagarin Girls Junior Rankings.

- Captured the 2015 Texas Women's Stroke Play Championship, finishing first among 48 participants.
- Won the 2014 AJGA Ping Invitational at Karsten Creek Golf Club, finishing first among 24 golfers with rounds of 71 and 68.

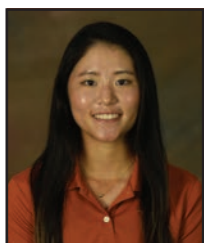

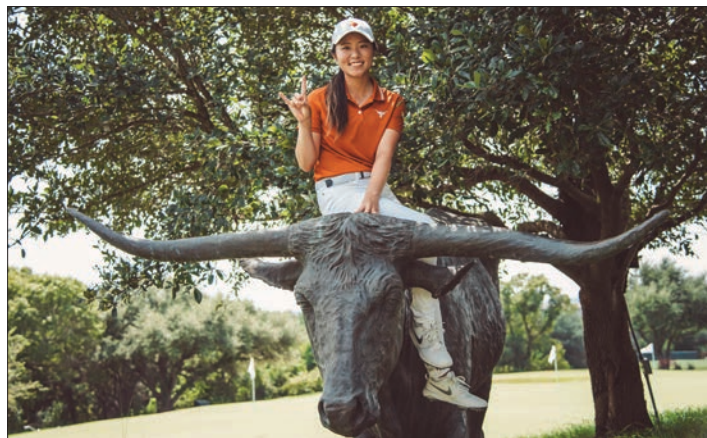

**RYAN MURPHY**  
HEAD COACH

In six impressive seasons at the helm of the University of Texas women's golf program, **Ryan Murphy** has returned the Longhorns to among the nation's elite, culminating with three consecutive Big 12 Conference Championships for the first time in program and a top-five finish at the 2019 NCAA Championship.

Murphy, who as an assistant coach helped the Texas men's golf team to the 2012 NCAA Championship, was named the fourth head women's golf coach in program history on May 29, 2014. Murphy's efforts have resulted in bringing some of the nation's top prep golfers to the Forty Acres and putting the Longhorns on a steady ascent to the top of the collegiate golf world. He has been named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year three consecutive seasons.

Under the direction of Murphy, Texas golfers have recorded 14 of the best 15 18-hole scores in program history, and each of the top-10 54-hole totals in school annals. Each of the top 15 18-hole team scores in school history have come during Murphy's tenure. Additionally, each of the top-16 54-hole team scores in program history have been charted by Murphy's teams.

In a 2019-20 season shortened by COVID-19, Murphy's Longhorns were ranked No. 1 nationally the majority of the year and finished ranked No. 2 by Golfweek. Texas won three of the seven tournaments in which it participated during the season and recorded three of the top-five 54-hole scores in school history en route to winning those events. Junior Kaitlyn Papp was an All-American for the third consecutive season and freshman Sophie Guo also garnered All-America honors.

In 2018-19, Murphy led the Longhorns to an historic season that culminated in the program's first appearance in match play at the NCAA Championship and the Longhorns' first top-five national finish since 2003. Texas was the stroke-play medalist at the 2019 NCAA Championship, giving the Longhorns their sixth victory of the season, which tied the school record first set in 1987-88. Golfstat tabbed the Longhorns No. 1 nationally in their final rankings of the season. Three Texas golfers earned Women's Golf Coaches Association First-Team All-America honors and the Longhorns placed four in the top-10 at the NCAA Championship. Both were program firsts. Freshman Hailee Cooper, the 2019 Big 12 Freshman of the Year, finished fourth individually at the NCAA Championship, becoming just the fourth player in program history to earn a top-five finish at the NCAA Championship and first since 1997. Junior Emilee Hoffman, sophomore Agathe Laisne and Papp all tied for 10th at the NCAA Championship. The Longhorns also won the NCAA Norman Regional, marking the program's first-ever NCAA Regional win.

In 2019, Texas won its third consecutive Big 12 Conference Championship. The Longhorns set two league records along the way, winning the conference title by 37 strokes and also by placing its golfers in each of the top-four spots individually. Laisne captured the Big 12 Conference individual championship, becoming the program's third Big 12 champion and first since 2011. Laisne was named the 2019 Big 12 Player of the Year. In addition, all five golfers in the championship lineup earned All-Big 12 Conference honors for the first time in Big 12 history.

In 2017-18, Murphy led the Longhorns to their second consecutive Big 12 Conference Championship, a second-place finish at the NCAA Austin Regional and a tie for 12th place at the NCAA Championship, which then marked the program's best finish at the NCAA Championship since 2004. His team won

three tournaments and also earned three individual tournament medalist honors. In 13 tournaments in 2017-18, Texas recorded nine top-five team finishes and UT golfers posted 19 rounds in the 60s.



Murphy's mentorship of Papp resulted in her becoming the first golfer in program history to be named both the Big 12 Player of the Year and the Big 12 Freshman of the Year. She was one of three First-Team All-Big 12 Conference selections for the Longhorns in 2017-18, joining senior Sophia Schubert and Hoffman. It marked the first time since 2003 that Texas had placed three people on the All-Big 12 Team in a single season.

Schubert in 2017-18 became the program's first WGCA First-Team All-American since 1997 and Papp was named a WGCA Second-Team All-American. Schubert broke her own single-season school-record stroke average at 71.76.

In his third season of 2016-17, Murphy directed Texas to its first Big 12 Championship since the 2011 season. The Longhorns finished 13th at the NCAA Championship which, at the time, marked the best finish for Texas since a tie for 13th in 2012. The team posted 11 top-four finishes during the season, including two team wins and two individual medalists.

Murphy mentored Schubert to Honorable Mention All-America honors from both Golfweek and the Women's Golf Coaches Association. Schubert, who also was an All-Big 12 Conference selection, concluded her junior campaign with a team-best 72.49 stroke average and finished as the Longhorns' low scorer on seven occasions, including five top-five team finishes and individual medalist honors at the Lady Buckeye Invitational.

Schubert, in August 2017, became the third Longhorn to claim the U.S. Women's Amateur Championship, joining Michiko Hattori [1985] and Kelli Kuehne [1995 and 1996]. Her victory earned her exemptions into four of the five major women's championships – The Evian Championship, the ANA Inspiration, the U.S. Open and the Women's British Open.

Also in 2016-17, Murphy mentored freshman Greta Isabella Voelker to Big 12 Freshman of the Year accolades. She became the third golfer in program history to earn that distinction, joining Randi Meadows [1999] and Kelley Louth [2005]. Voelker posted seven top-15 finishes her rookie season, including four top-10 showings. She was the individual runner-up at the Las Vegas Collegiate, where she tied the school record for lowest 18-hole score at 65.

Fellow rookie Hoffman was the runner-up at the 2017 Big 12 Championships and earned a spot on the 2017 Big 12 All-Tournament Team. Hoffman, who was one of three collegiate golfers nationally to be selected to represent the United States at the World University Games, also tied the school record for lowest 18-hole score [65] at the Lady Paladin Invitational, winning individual medalist honors in that event with the fifth-lowest 54-hole score [210] in program history.

Murphy's 2015-16 team earned a runner-up finish at the Big 12 Championships. The Longhorns earned seven top-five finishes in 12 events and individuals posted 12 top-10 individual finishes, led by Schubert's five. At least four golfers finished in the top-10 at least once during the season. Texas returned to the NCAA Championship for the first time in two years, finishing 23rd.

In Murphy's first season, he led the Longhorns to a vastly improved season, where they earned 10 top-10 team finishes, including three in the top five and a bid to the 2015 NCAA San Antonio Regional. During the 2014-15 season, Murphy coached senior Bertine Strauss into becoming one of the country's best. Strauss earned six top-10 individual finishes, including four in the top five and the first win of her career at the Ping/ASU Invitational in April. She went on to Big 12 Player of the Year honors, qualified for the NCAA Championship and gained full LPGA membership in December of 2015.

Murphy was named the head women's golf coach at Texas after six seasons as an assistant men's coach for the Longhorns. During that time, Murphy recruited and developed the talents of All-Americans Dylan Frittelli, Cody Gribble, Beau Hossler, Bobby Hudson, Jordan Spieth, Brandon Stone and Julio Vegas. From 2008-14, the Longhorns recorded 19 team titles, including their first NCAA Championship title since 1972, and 12 medalist honors. Murphy was named the 2013 Jan Strickland Assistant Coach of the Year, recognizing his efforts as the top NCAA Division I, II, III, NAIA or NJCAA assistant coach who, among other things, has helped their student-athletes both excel on the course and in the classroom.

Prior to arriving on the Forty Acres, Murphy was the men's head golf coach at NCAA Division II power St. Edward's [Texas] University. He led the Hilltoppers to national prominence as he guided St. Edward's to a tie for first at the 2008 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championships before falling in a three-team playoff for the national title. The Hilltoppers qualified for the NCAA Championships by posting a 31-stroke victory in the eight-team NCAA Men's South Central Regional Championship at the Grey Rock Golf Club in Austin.

Murphy was a four-year letterwinner for New Mexico from 1994-97 under current Texas men's head coach John Fields. He twice earned Academic All-America honors for his performance in the classroom. Murphy had a career stroke average of 75.04 and played in the NCAA Championships each of his four seasons. He was a member of UNM's Western Athletic Conference championship team in 1996 and helped lead the Lobos to a sixth-place tie in the 1996 NCAA Championships, their best finish since 1979. Murphy's best career

finish as an individual was a tie for sixth in the 1995 WAC Championships. His low round was 68 in both the 1995 and 1996 Taylor Made Intercollegiate, and his low tournament was 213 [-3] in the 1994 John Burns Intercollegiate.

Murphy began his coaching career as an assistant men's coach [2001-05] at his alma mater where he helped the Lobos to a fifth-place showing at the 2005 NCAA Championships and three consecutive Mountain West Conference titles.

Murphy earned a bachelor's degree in criminology in 1997 and a master's degree in sport administration in 2001 from New Mexico. He married the former Terry Furuta in June 2010, and the couple has two sons – Aiden and Jackson.

**KATE GOLDEN**  
ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

One of the most accomplished golfers in University of Texas history and an 18-year LPGA veteran, **Kate Golden** enters her 11th season on the women's golf coaching staff at her alma mater, currently serving as associate head coach.

Golden has helped return the Longhorns to among the nation's elite programs. Together with head coach Ryan Murphy over the past six seasons, Golden has helped the Longhorns win three consecutive Big 12 Conference Championships and advance to the NCAA Championships for four consecutive years. In 2018-19, Texas posted its best NCAA Championship finish [T-5] since 2003.

Since the start of the 2014-15 season, she has helped Texas golfers have recorded 14 of the best 15 18-hole scores in program history, and each of the top-10 54-hole totals in school annals. Each of the top 15 18-hole team scores and each of the top-16 54-hole team scores in program history have been accomplished during that time.

Golden returned to the Forty Acres in advance of the 2010-11 season as a volunteer assistant coach. In total, she has worked with teams that have advanced to six NCAA Championships and have won four Big 12 Conference Championships. She has helped mentor several All-America selections in Bertine Strauss [2015], Sophia Schubert [2017 and 2018], Kaitlyn Papp [2018, 2019, 2020], Hailee Cooper [2019], Agathe Laisne [2019] and Sophie Guo [2020].

Golden joined the Texas staff after serving as the interim women's golf head coach at Florida State during the spring 2010 season. Under her tutelage, the Seminoles finished in 10th place at the 2010 NCAA Championship to earn their best national finish since winning the 1981 AIAW Championship. Additionally, Golden guided FSU to a No. 14 finish in the national rankings by GolfStat and a No. 22 showing in GolfWeek's season-ending standings after inheriting a team that was unranked in both polls.

Prior to her stint in Tallahassee, Golden was a volunteer assistant coach for the University of Houston men's golf team.

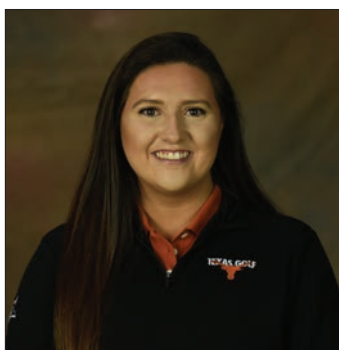
Competing in the LPGA from 1992-10, Golden's professional career included a victory at the 2001 State Farm Classic, appearances in more than 30 major championships and nearly \$1.5 million in career earnings. En route to the State Farm Classic title, Golden set a then-tournament record of 21 under par during the 72-hole event. She totaled eight top-five finishes and 14 top-10 showings.

A 1989 University of Texas graduate, Golden was a four-year member of the women's golf team under former Hall of Fame head coach Pat Weis. She earned second-team All-America honors in 1989 and was a three-time All-Southwest Conference first-team selection [1987-89]. Golden was named to the Southwest Conference All-Decade Team for the 1980s and won three collegiate events during her career.

The 1987 Southwest Conference individual champion, Golden is the daughter of Texas Ex Joe Bob Golden, the 1954 Southwest Conference men's golf individual champion. The Goldenes were the only father-daughter tandem in the history of the Southwest Conference to win individual conference titles in the same sport. Joe Bob Golden played at Texas for Harvey Penick from 1952-54 and served as his assistant while attending law school at UT.

A former member of the LPGA Board of Directors and the LPGA Player Committee, Golden is currently on the Board of Directors for the charitable organization Golfers Against Cancer.





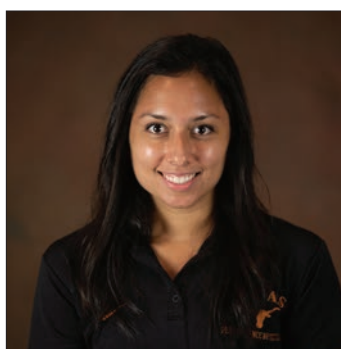

The Betsy Rawls Longhorn Invitational annually features many of the top women's golf teams in the country. Until 2010, players and coaches made their plans to come to Austin each spring to compete in one of the most prestigious regular-season tournaments in the country. It is now a fall tournament and, in 2020, the 47th edition of the tournament will take place Oct. 10-11 at the University of Texas Golf Club.

It was in March of 1974 that Texas head coach Pat Weis had the foresight to establish what has not only become a tradition at UT and Austin, but a tradition that dominates collegiate golf for one weekend. This annual event originally known as the Texas Invitational has evolved into one of the strongest collegiate invitational tournaments of the year.

In 1977, the Texas Invitational was renamed to honor Betsy Rawls, a 1950 Texas graduate and one of the most prolific golfers of her day. Rawls won more than 50 tour championships between 1951 and 1975, including four U.S. Opens, and was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 1977 and into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame.

The tournament champions' list reads like a "who's who" of women's golf. Nancy Lopez, Beth Daniel, Jody Rosenthal, Val Skinner, Michiko Hattori and Annika Sorenstam are just a few of the past winners who have made the Betsy Rawls tournament one of the marquee events in women's golf.

In 2019, Texas won its third consecutive Betsy Rawls Invitational.

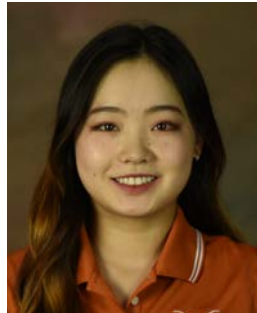

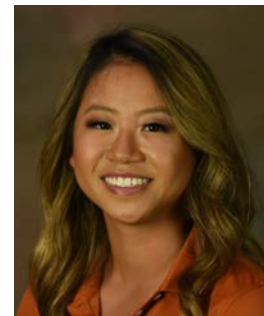
