## GAMEDAY STORYLINES

• **SETTING THE STAGE:** Texas returns to the friendly confines of the Frank Erwin Center looking to bounce back against TCU on Wednesday, Jan. 20, at 7 p.m. CT. The Longhorns are currently 9-3 on the year, and 3-2 in Big 12 play, following a loss at Texas Tech this past Sunday.

• **SERIES HISTORY:** The Longhorns hold a 45-4 advantage over the Horned Frogs in the all-time series, and have won 14 of the schools' 18 meetings since TCU joined the Big 12 Conference. UT is also 21-1 against its in-state foe when the two teams face off on the Forty Acres.

• **TURNING THEM OVER:** Texas' pressure defense has made an impression on the national and Big 12 stats rankings this year. UT forced a season-high 35 turnovers in a win over SMU on Nov. 25, and created 34 turnovers in its Big 12 opener at Kansas State on Dec. 21. As a result, the Longhorns rank 11th nationally in turnovers forced per game (22.2) and ninth in turnover margin (+7.4). Both of those are also the best marks by a Big 12 program this season.

• **CREATING OFFENSE FROM DEFENSE:** Texas is utilizing its defense to create offense this season, as the Longhorns has scored at least 20 points off turnovers in eight of 12 games this season. The Longhorns posted a season-high 39 points off turnovers in the season opener versus SMU, and hit the 30-point mark in three-straight outings against Drake (33 points), at Kansas State (38 points) and against Lamar (32 points).

• **CHASING CHARLI:** Preseason National Player of the Year candidate Charli Collier has put up All-America numbers this season, averaging 21.4 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. Collier currently ranks fourth in Division I in double-doubles (8), fourth in free throws made (80), sixth in free throws attempted (98), 12th in rebounds (128), 12th in offensive rebounds per game (4.5), 14th in total points (257), 20th in points per game (21.4), 23rd in rebounds per game (10.7) and 25th in field goals made (86).

## ON THE COURT

### AS A JUNIOR [2020-21]

- Averaging 21.4 ppg and 10.7 rpg in 12 starts. Has eight double-doubles on the year and seven 20-plus point efforts.
- Named to the preseason watch lists for the Naismith Trophy, the Wooden Award, the Wade Trophy and the Lisa Leslie Award.
- Scored a career-high 44 points [and grabbed 16 boards] against North Texas. That was just the sixth overall 40-point game and the fourth-most points in a game in program history. Her 40+ point effort was the first for a Texas player since Danielle Viglione established the program record with 48 points back on Jan. 29, 1994, against Houston.
- Scored 28 points against Kansas and 27 points against Kansas State, her two best outputs against a Big 12 opponent during her career.

### AS A SOPHOMORE [2019-20]

- Started all 30 games at center for the Longhorns. Averaged 29.8 minutes per game, which ranked second on the team.
- Scored in double figures on 23 occasions and brought down double-figure rebounds 17 times.
- Brought down 15 or more rebounds seven times during the year.
- Tied for the team lead in scoring [13.1 points per game] and led the Longhorns in rebounding [10.5 rebounds per game].
- One of only six players in the Big 12 Conference [all games combined] to average a double-double on the season.
- Ranked 16th nationally in double-doubles with 16 on the year. Became the first Texas player to record double-digit double-doubles in a single season since Imani McGee-Stafford did so in 2015-16.
- Ranked 20th nationally in rebounds per game [10.5] and 23rd in total rebounds [314].
- Second on her team in free-throw percentage [.771, 74-of-96] and third both in field-goal percentage [.432, 146-of-338] and three-point field-goal percentage [.379, 22-of-58].
- Led the Longhorns in blocked shots with 39 [1.3 blocks per game].

### AS A FRESHMAN [2018-19]

- Played in 31 games with one start, averaging 14.4 minutes per game her freshman season.
- Averaged 5.9 points per game, 4.3 rebounds per game and 0.6 blocks per game.
- Led the Longhorns with 20 blocks on the season.
- Scored in double figures on eight occasions during the year.

# TEXAS BASKETBALL GAME NOTES | GAME NOTES

## WHAT'S COMING UP

- Senior guard Kyra Lambert is closing in on 700 career points (692), needing just eight more to reach the plateau.
- Junior forward/center Charli Collier is creeping closer to joining the 1,000-point club. The Mont Belvieu, Texas, native currently sits at 834 career points, needing 166 more to become the 47th Longhorns player to achieve the plateau.

## QUICK DRIBBLES

- Texas ranks 11th in turnovers forced (22.2) and ninth in turnover margin (+7.4) per game this season. Both of those are also the best mark among Big 12 programs in 2021.
- Freshman forward DeYona Gaston is among the league leaders in blocks, rating third in the Big 12 (37th nationally) with 21 blocked shots this season.
- Charli Collier's 28-point effort vs. Kansas marked the most points the junior forward/center has ever scored against a Big 12 Conference opponent. Her previous high was 27 points at Kansas State back in December.
- Texas has already reached the 100-point mark in two games this season (North Texas, Drake). The Longhorns had managed a total of just three 100-point games over their previous six seasons (2014-15 to 2019-20).
- Charli Collier currently ranks fourth in Division I in double-doubles (8), fourth in free throws made (80), sixth in free throws attempted (98), 12th in rebounds (128), 12th in offensive rebounds per game (4.5), 14th in total points (257), 20th in points per game (21.4), 23rd in rebounds per game (10.7) and 25th in field goals made (86).
- Junior guard/forward Audrey Warren has scored in double figures in seven of the eight Texas games she's played in this season. Her four-game streak of reaching double figures to start the campaign was the longest such streak of her career as the Fort Worth, Texas, product entered 2020-21 with only six career double-figure scoring efforts.
- Collier's 44-point effort against North Texas is still the highest point total by any Division I player in a game so far this season. Toledo's Sophia Wiard had 42 points in an 82-79 victory over Northern Illinois.
- With 44 points and 16 rebounds in the 106-69 win over North Texas, Charli Collier became the first Big 12 player since at least 1999-00 to score 44+ points and grab 15+ rebounds in a single game.
- Collier was honored for the second time in her career as the Big 12 Conference Player of the Week (Nov. 30) for her combined performance against SMU and North Texas.

## SERIES HISTORY

- Texas and TCU will meet for the 50th time in series history on Wednesday night, with the Longhorns holding a 45-4 advantage over the Horned Frogs all-time.
- Texas has won 14 of its 18 matchups against TCU since the Horned Frogs joined the Big 12 Conference.
- The Longhorns are 21-1 all-time against TCU when the schools compete in Austin.

## QUARTER SUPERLATIVES

- Texas' offense has been prolific thus far this season, posting three of the top 10 all-time quarter scoring totals in school history. Texas' 38 points in the third quarter against North Texas (Nov. 29) were the most in a single quarter in program history, while the 33 tallies in the first against Drake (Dec. 18) tied for the second most all-time. The Longhorns have now scored at least 20 points in 21-of-36 total quarters this season.

- Getting out to an early lead has been key to the Longhorns' success thus far during the 2020-21 campaign. Eight times this season, Texas has been leading or tied (seven leads, one tie) after the first quarter. The Longhorns are 8-1 in those outings, and 1-2 when trailing after the opening frame.
- In its most recent win, Texas held a 23-20 lead after the first quarter of a win over Kansas on Jan. 14. The Horns snagged the lead in the opening quarter behind a hot shooting effort, going 10-of-16 (62.5%) from the floor and 3-of-4 (75%) from behind the arc.

## 20-POINT TANDEM

- Junior forward/center Charli Collier and sophomore guard Celeste Taylor became the first Texas duo to each tally 20-point outings in the same game when they scored 28 and 23 points, respectively, vs. Kansas on Jan. 14.
- Collier did so on 11-of-21 shooting from the floor, and 5-of-6 from the free throw line. She also snagged 14 rebounds to tally her seventh double-double of the season.
- Taylor went 9-of-20 from the field, and drained 4-of-6 from the behind the arc, to post her second-best scoring total of the 2020-21 season. Her nine field goals and four 3-pointers both tied her previous career-high marks.

## DEYONA'S DYNAMITE

- Freshman forward DeYona Gaston picked a great time to register her first career double-double, scoring 18 points and dishing 10 rebounds in 27 minutes against Lamar [Dec. 29] on a day that Texas only had eight players available because of various maladies. Gaston currently leads the team with 14 blocks (third in the Big 12) and just missed a double-double back in her collegiate debut against SMU [Nov. 25] by putting up 10 points, nine boards and a team-leading five blocks during a 90-51 victory.

## ALLEN-TAYLOR TAKING ADVANTAGE

- Texas junior guard Joanne Allen-Taylor is well on her way to a breakout 2020-21 campaign. The Houston, Texas, native currently leads the squad in minutes played (33.7) while averaging 12.7 ppg, 3.8 rpg and 2.7 apg. She entered this season averaging just 2.8 ppg, 1.4 rpg and 0.9 apg in 12.7 mpg. Allen-Taylor registered her first career double-double against Drake [Dec. 18] with a career-high 23 points and 10 boards. Check out her impressive improvement below:

## WONDERFUL WARREN

• Texas junior guard/forward Audrey Warren is also having a breakthrough season. She posted a career effort in the 84-57 win over LA Tech, setting career-highs in field goals made (eight), assists (six), steals (tied with three) and minutes (35), while just missing her career mark (21 points against Tennessee, Dec. 9, 2018) with 19 points. Warren entered this year with just six career double-figure efforts, but has already managed to score at least 12 points in seven of her eight games played in 2020-21. ## REBOUNTING RELEVANCE

- Rebounding has always been a key to the success of the Texas program.
- Texas has won the battle of the boards in nine of its 12 games this season, while crossing the 40-or-more rebound plateau in six of those instances (SMU, North Texas, Idaho, Iowa State, Kansas, Texas Tech). UT managed a season-best 52 boards against Idaho.
- Texas has now tied or won the rebounding battle in 149 of its last 179 games overall.
- Junior forward/center Charli Collier ranks 12th nationally in rebounds (128) and 12th in offensive rebounds per game (4.5).

## COLLIER'S CAREER GAME

- Texas junior forward/center Charli Collier had a game for the ages against North Texas on Nov. 29 as the Mont Belvieu, Texas, product scored a career-high 44 points and grabbed 16 rebounds in a 106-69 win. Take a look at some of the notes to come out of her historic performance below:
- Collier's effort marked the sixth 40-point game in Texas history while her 44 points were the fourth-most in a single game in program history.
- Collier's 40-point game was the first for a Texas player since Danielle Viglione established the program record with 48 back on Jan. 29, 1994, against Houston.
- Collier's 14 made free throws tied for the fourth-most in a single game in program history.
- Collier posted back-to-back 20-or-more point games for the first time in her career.
- Collier registered her 18th career double-double by the half (22 points and 11 boards in the first half) and finished with 44 points and 16 rebounds.
- Collier's 16 rebounds marked the eighth time in her career that she recorded at least 15 boards in a game.
- Collier's 14 field goals and 14 free throws were both career-highs.
- Collier registered her seventh career game of 20-or-more points.
- Collier started the game 7-for-7 from the free throw line meaning she made her first 16 FT's to open the season.

## EBO EMERGES

- Texas junior forward/center Lauren Ebo made her first game for the Longhorns count during the 101-80 win over Drake [Dec. 18] by scoring 14 points (6-for-9), grabbing seven boards, dishing an assist and blocking a shot. Ebo was granted immediate eligibility by the NCAA Division I Council on Wed., Dec., 16, through the passing of the blanket waiver on transfers.

## AN ALMOST HISTORIC THREE-POINT NIGHT

- Texas got the three-ball rolling during its 73-48 win over Idaho by hitting 12 triples to tie for the third-most in a single game in program history. Karisma Ortiz, Joanne Allen-Taylor and Kyra Lambert all equaled their career-high by draining three three-pointers each to lead the squad.

## SEASON-OPENING DOMINANCE

- Texas' season-opening, 90-51 win over SMU was truly eye-opening as the 39-point margin of victory marked the largest for the Longhorns in a season opener in 33 years since beating Northern Arizona back on Nov. 27, 1987, 93-34. It was also the largest home-opening win since topping Houston Baptist in 2016 by a score of 98-46.

## CHARLI CAROM

- Texas welcomed back one of the top players (and especially rebounders) in the nation in junior forward/center Charli Collier. The Mont Belvieu, Texas, native was one of just six players in the Big 12 to average a double-double over the entire 2019-20 season, becoming the first UT player to do so since Imani McGee-Stafford in 2015-16. She also ranked 16th in the NCAA in double-doubles (16), rated 20th nationally in rebounds-per-game (10.5) and 23rd in total rebounds (314).

## COLLIER ON WATCH LISTS

- Standout junior forward/center Charli Collier cleaned up on preseason accolades, having been named to "Watch Lists" for the Wade Trophy, the Naismith Trophy, the Lisa Leslie Award and the Wooden Award. The Mont Belvieu, Texas, native averaged 13.1 ppg and 10.5 rpg during the 2019-20 campaign on the way to becoming a Top 10 finalist for the Lisa Leslie Award.
- She was named to the John R. Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 watch list in early January, adding to her impressive resume of award recognitions as a junior.

## NEW LOOK LONGHORNS

- The Longhorns squad looks a lot different this season under new head coach Vic Schaefer. UT welcomed back just four letterwinners from the 2019-20 squad, Charli Collier, Joanne Allen-Taylor, Celeste Taylor and Audrey Warren, while adding eight newcomers, including Duke transfer Kyra Lambert and Penn State transfers Lauren Ebo and Karisma Ortiz.

## KEPT THE STREAK ALIVE

- Texas first-year head coach Vic Schaefer extended a program-long streak as all five UT head coaches have now won in their debut on the Forty Acres after the season-opening, 90-51 victory over SMU. See below for the instances:

## LAMBERT UP FOR THE LIEBERMAN

- Texas senior guard transfer Kyra Lambert is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the 2021 Nancy Lieberman Award. A three-time team captain at Duke, she started the final 21 games of the 2019-20 season and averaged 5.8 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.2 steals per game. Lambert made her return to the court last year after missing the previous two seasons due to ACL injuries.

## BIG 12 PRESEASON COACHES POLL

- In the annual preseason Big 12 coaches vote, the Longhorns were picked to finish second in the league during the 2020-21 season. Baylor claimed the top spot in the poll, earning nine first-place votes and 81 points in polling for the upcoming 2020-21 season. The Longhorns received one first-place vote and 73 points in the poll. Rounding out slots three thru 10 in the poll in descending order were: Iowa State (69), Kansas State (50), West Virginia (45), Texas Tech (36), Oklahoma (33), Oklahoma State (26), TCU (23) and Kansas (14).

# TEXAS BASKETBALL GAME NOTES | GAME NOTES

## **AMONG THE BIG 12'S BEST**

• A pair of returning players were named to the 2020-21 Preseason All-Big 12 Teams. Junior forward/center Charli Collier was a unanimous selection to the 10-person Preseason All-Big 12 Team, while sophomore guard Celeste Taylor was one of 10 players to claim a spot on the Preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention team. The Longhorns posted a 19-11 mark (11-7, third in Big 12) last year prior to the season being canceled on March 12 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **A BRIGHT FUTURE**

• Recently, Texas signed the No. 4 ranked recruiting class (espnW HoopGurlz team rankings) by inking a trio of top 20 nationally-ranked high school players to national letters of intent (Rori Harmon, Kyndall Hunter, Aaliyah Moore) before later adding a pair of No. 1 junior college prospects in the nation according to two different national ranking services (Kobe King-Haweia & Femme Sikuzani). Check out a little more about those five players below:

### **Kobe King Haweia - Point Cook, Australia - G/F**

• King-Haweia, a guard/forward originally from Point Cook, Australia who currently plays at Casper College (Casper, Wyo.) under head coach Dwight Gunnare, is ranked as the No. 1 junior college prospect in the nation in Dan Olson's Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the World Exposure Report. As a freshman during the 2019-20 season at Gillette College (Gillette, Wyo.) under head coach Liz Lewis, King-Haweia earned NJCAA Division I first-team All-America honors and was the only freshman to earn a spot on the first team.

• King-Haweia averaged a team-best 20.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and 5.4 assists in a team-high 29.5 minutes per contest while starting all 33 games and leading Gillette to a 28-5 overall record. She earned NJCAA Region IX Division I-North Most Valuable Player and All-Tournament honors last year, as she led the division in scoring and assists and ranked second in rebounding.

• King-Haweia set a school single-season record with 675 points (surpassing the previous mark of 558 by Kenosha Wright in 2012-13). She also set school records for most field goals in a season (284), most field goals in a game (16) and most steals in a game (10). King-Haweia recorded the first triple-double in Gillette program history with her 12-point, 13-rebound, 10-steal effort against Bismarck State.

### **Rori Harmon - Houston, Texas - PG**

• A point guard from Cypress Creek High School (Houston, Texas) who plays under coach Jennifer Alexander, is ranked as the No. 6 overall prospect in the nation by All Star Girls Report and No. 10 by espnW HoopGurlz. In her junior season at Cypress Creek, Harmon averaged 15.6 points, 5.6 rebounds, 5.2 assists and 4.7 steals per game while helping Cypress Creek to a 41-1 record and a runner-up finish in the Class 6A state tournament. She claimed District 17-6A Most Valuable Player honors last year and is a three-time Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABCO) all-state selection. In her first three seasons at Cypress Creek, Harmon has registered career totals of 2,059 points, 565 rebounds, 552 assists and 528 steals in 113 games.

### **Kyndall Hunter - Houston, Texas - G**

• An explosive, scoring two-guard who plays alongside Harmon in the starting backcourt at Cypress Creek High School (Houston, Texas), is ranked as the No. 18 prospect in the nation by All Star Girls Report and No. 19 by Blue Star Basketball. Hunter averaged 20 points, 2.8 steals per game and 2.3 assists per game as a junior as Cypress Creek went 41-1 and advanced to the Class 6A state championship game. The All-Greater Houston Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Houston Chronicle in 2019-20, she recorded four 30-point performances last year and posted a game-high 24 points in the state title contest against Duncanville. In her first three seasons at Cypress Creek, Hunter has registered career totals of 2,217 points, 351 steals, 338 assists and 286 rebounds in 115 games.

### **Aaliyah Moore - Moore, Okla. - F**

• A forward from Moore High School (Moore, Okla.) who plays under coach Brent Hodges, is ranked as the No. 3 prospect in the nation by Blue Star Basketball and No. 6 by espnW HoopGurlz. In her junior year at Moore, she was named Gatorade's Oklahoma Girls Basketball Player of the Year after averaging 21.9 points, 10.9 rebounds, 2.9 steals and 2.1 blocks per game while converting 58-percent from the floor. Moore led her team to a 20-5 record and the Class 6A state tournament, the program's first state appearance in 22 years, prior to the cancellation of the tourney due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In her first three seasons at Moore High School, she has registered career totals of 1,274 points, 698 rebounds, 102 assists and 91 blocks in 73 games. During the summer of 2019, Moore helped Team USA win the gold medal at the FIBA Americas U16 Championship in Chile.

### **Femme Sikuzani - Goma, Democratic Republic of the Congo - C**

• A center originally from Goma, Democratic Republic of the Congo who currently plays at South Georgia Technical College (Americus, Ga.) is ranked as the No. 1 junior college prospect in the nation by All Star Girls Report and No. 7 in Dan Olson's Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.

• As a freshman in 2019-20, Sikuzani averaged 10.6 points, 10.8 rebounds, 1.4 blocks and 1.1 steals in just 16.7 minutes per contest. She led the Georgia Collegiate Athletic Association (GCAA) in total rebounds (345), blocks (46), field-goal percentage (55.0), offensive rebounds (156) and defensive rebounds (189) and earned a spot on the NJCAA Women's Basketball Coaches Association All-Star team.

• Sikuzani played in all 32 games (29 starts) and helped lead the Lady Jets to a record-setting 30-2 overall mark, the GCAA regular-season championship with a 17-0 league record, and the NJCAA Region XVII Tournament title. South Georgia Technical College advanced to the NJCAA National Tournament in Lubbock, Texas, but the tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
