## **LONGHORNS NOTES**

THE MATCHUPS—Second-seeded Texas arrives in Omaha as the highest remaining seed in the NCAA Tournament and is slotted in the bracket with No. 3 Tennessee, No. 7 Mississippi State and Virginia. The Longhorns will open College World Series play on Sunday at 6 p.m. CT against Mississippi State, then face either Tennessee or Virginia on Tuesday. Mississippi State advanced to the College World Series with a three-game defeat of Notre Dame in the Starkville Super Regional after sweeping their way through the Starkville Regional. Tennessee is riding a five-game winning streak after sweeping the Knoxville Regional and Super Regional, while Virginia defeated Dallas Baptist in three games at the Columbia Super Regional after winning the Columbia Regional in five games. The other side of the College World Series bracket includes No. 4 Vanderbilt, No. 5 Arizona, No. 9 Stanford and NC State.

A LOOK AT THE LONGHORNS—Texas swept through the NCAA Austin Super Regional against South Florida, winning in a ninth-inning walk-off, 4-3, on Saturday, then with a dominant 12-4 victory on Sunday. The Longhorns have won all five NCAA Tournament games, sweeping through the Regional and Super Regional rounds for the second time in program history. In the Regional round, the Longhorns outscored Southern, Arizona State and Fairfield by a combined score of 33-5. The 33 runs were the second-most scored by the Longhorns since the current four-team regional format began in 1999 and the most since scoring 58 runs over five games in the 2005 Austin Regional. The Texas pitching staff has compiled a 2.89 ERA, which ranks No. 1 nationally and leads the Big 12 by over a run. The starting pitching trio of Pete Hansen (1.84), Ty Madden (2.41), and Tristan Stevens (2.97) all rank in the top six in ERA in the Big 12, while Stevens' 11 wins lead the conference and are the civil more in the NCA. the conference and are the sixth-most in the NCAA.

ALL-BIG 12 HONORS—Ty Madden led a total of 13 Long-horns named to All-Big 12 teams this season. Right-handed pitcher Tristan Stevens, second baseman Mitchell Daly and designated hitter Ivan Melendez join Madden on the first team. Third baseman Cam Williams and outfielder Mike Antico both landed on the second team. Seven other Longhorns picked up Honorable Mention recognition: Silas Ardoin, Trey Faltine, Pete Hansen, Douglas Hodo III, Aaron Nixon, Tanner Witt, Zach Zubia. First-year Longhorns Daly, Nixon and Witt all landed on the Big 12 All-Freshman team. The 13 total players recognized leads the Big 12 and are the most for Texas since 2005.

BIG 12 PITCHER OF THE YEAR-Ty Madden was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year leading into the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. Madden has compiled a 2.41 ERA and a 7-4 record in 16 starts this season. He has struck out 119 batters in 100.2 innings pitched and has the best opponents' batting average in the league at .189. Madden is the Longhorns' first Big 12 Pitcher of the Year since Taylor Jungmann in 2011 and the seventh Longhorn overall.

**BIG 12 COACH OF THE YEAR**—For the second time in his five seasons at Texas, head coach David Pierce led the Longhorns to the Big 12 regular season title and was named the league's coach of the year. The award is his fourth overall as a head coach after receiving the honor twice in the Southland Conference while leading Sam Houston.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS-It's an old adage that has played out well in Texas' journey to a record 37th College World Series appearance. The Longhorns 2.89 ERA leads the NCAA by a quarter of a run and the Big 12 Conference by more than a run. Texas' .980 fielding percentage also leads the Big 12 and is the 13th-best percentage in the nation. The squad has committed a conference-low 47 errors while also turning 49 double plays, tied for the most in the Big 12.

MOUND PRESENCE—The Texas pitching staff has been among the most dominant groups in the nation. Three Texas starters rank in the top-six in the Big 12 Conference in earned run average, with Pete Hansen leading the conference with a 1.84 ERA. Ty Madden sits in second with a 2.41 ERA, while Tristan Stevens' 2.97 ERA ranks sixth. As a staff, the Longhorns have the best ERA in the nation at 2.89, a mark that leads the conference by more than a run.

MR. CONSISTENT—With a ninth-inning RBI-single against South Florida on Sunday in the NCAA Austin Super Regional, Zach Zubia extended his streak of reaching base safely to 38 games. During the streak, Zubia has hit .324 with seven doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 35 RBI and 30 runs scored while walking 32 times for a .451 on-base percentage. Zubia has 13 multi-hit games and eight multi-walk games during the run, including five three-hit games, one three-walk and one four-walk game. On the season, the redshirt junior's 45 walks are fourth in the Big 12 Conference and rank 29th in the NCAA

## **LONGHORNS** NOTES

FLASHING THE LEATHER—Trey Faltine has been a human highlight reel this season, making the difficult look routine. The Longhorns shortstop leads the Big 12 with 184 assists and ranks second with 33 double plays while sporting a .971 fielding percentage in 273 chances.

DALY GETTING IT DONE—Mitchell Daly has had a breakout season at the plate, reaching base safely in 50 of the 54 games he has started this season with 16 multi-hit games, including three three-hit games and a four-hit game. Daly's .321 batting average is tied for 15th in the Big 12 Conference. The freshman is currently tied for the team lead in batting average, is second in hits (62) and tied for third in doubles (15), while sitting fifth in on-base percentage (.417), slugging percentage (.430) and OPS (.847) and seventh in total bases (83).

ANTICO CREATING CHAOS—Mike Antico is second in the nation and leads the Big 12 Conference with 39 stolen bases, the most for a Longhorn since 2002 (Tim Moss, 40). His 39 steals are tied for seventh by a Longhorn in a single season and 10 shy of the program record. Antico has also walked 60 times this season, the second-highest total in the nation and the most in a season for a Longhorn since Wylie Campbell had 64 in 1994. The redshirt senior stole four bases against Fairfield in the NCAA Austin Regional Championship, the first Longhorn to swipe four bags in a game since 2016 (Joe Baker vs. Stanford, Feb. 26). In Texas' five postseason games, Antico has walked nine times, stolen 10 bases and has now reached base safely in 25 consecutive games.

INFIELD HIT MACHINE—Throughout his career on the Forty Acres, Eric Kennedy has used his speed as a means to get on base. This season is no different, with 26 infield singles, including 15 bunt hits. In his career, Kennedy has 50 infield hits (27 bunts). He's not the only speedy Longhorn, as Texas has 31 total bunt singles this season. Douglas Hodo II has seven bunt hits, Mike Antico has four, Mitchell Daly has three and Trey Faltine has two.

MAKING A BIG IMPRESSION—After a relatively quiet start to the season, Ivan Melendez caught fire in the month of April. For the month, Melendez hit .412 with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 27 RBI and 16 runs scored. In that span, he compiled a .529 on-base percentage and .912 slugging percentage for an OPS of 1.441. He raised his batting average from .263 to .344 during the 19 games. From April 3-11, he established a program-record six-game home run streak that culminated with a pair of bombs against Kansas State on April 11. For his efforts in April, he was named Big 12 Player of the Week, National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Hitter of the Week, and Big 12 Co-Newcomer of the Week.

COMMANDING THE ZONE—Tristan Stevens' command has been on point this season, yielding only 14 walks over his last 92.2 innings pitched. Prior to issuing a walk to open the sixth inning at Oklahoma State on April 24, Stevens had gone 113 batters (28 1/3 innings) without relinquishing a free pass. On the season, Stevens leads the Big 12 with 11 wins and 103 innings, while the 19 walks he has yielded this year are the sixth fewest among starting pitchers in the conference.

HAMMER KEEPS HAMMERING—Cam Williams has been crushing the ball all season and is currently second on the squad with 11 home runs, including a pair from each side of the plate against Oklahoma on March 27. His 20 doubles this season lead the Big 12 and rank 16th in the NCAA. The redshirt junior is second on the team in RBIs (47), slugging percentage (.596), OPS (1.020) and total bases (112), while sitting third in batting average (.303) and on-base percentage (.424).

PIERCE AT THE HELM—David Pierce will be making his second College World Series appearance as a head coach and sixth overall. Pierce led the Longhorns to the CWS in 2018 and was an assistant with Rice in four CWS (2003, 2006-08), including as part of the staff for the Owls' 2003 College World Series championship team.

## HEAD COACH VID PIERCE 22

5th season at Texas | 10th season as head coach

HIGH SCHOOL St. Pius X High School JUNIOR COLLEGE Wharton County Junior College ALMA MATER University of Houston, 1988

A Texas native who has spent most of his 30-year career coaching in the state. David Pierce was named head baseball coach at The University of Texas on June 29, 2016. Pierce, just the fifth Longhorn head coach since 1911 (with the exception

of the war years of 1943-45 when Blair Cherry was at the helm), is the 13th head coach in 122 years of Texas baseball.

Entering his fifth season as the Longhorns' head coach in 2021, Pierce has an overall record of 122-77 at Texas and a 319-186 mark in nine seasons as a Division I head coach.

In just his second season at the helm, Pierce was named Baseball America's National Coach of the Year after guiding the Longhorns to a 42-23 record and back to the College World Series for the first time since 2014. With a 17-7 mark in league play, Pierce, who was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year, led his team to the Big 12 Conference title—the first conference title for Texas since 2011—and hosted both an NCAA Regional and an NCAA Super Regional. In the Austin Regional, the Longhorns went 3-0 with wins over Texas Southern, Texas A&M, and Indiana. In the Super Regional, Texas dropped game one to Tennessee Tech before taking games two and three to send Pierce to Omaha for the first time as head coach. The Longhorns finished ranked in the top eight in every major poll to close out the season and finished first in the nation in double plays (73) and ninth in triples (22). Under Pierce and his staff's tutelage, second baseman Kody Clemens completed one of the best offensive seasons in Texas history. A third-round draft pick by the Detroit Tigers, Clemens was named a unanimous first team All-American at second base, becoming the first to earn that honor under Pierce. Clemens, the ABCA National Player of the Year and a finalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award, blasted 24 home runs on the year, good for second in the country and second-most in a single season in Texas Baseball history. Clemens also ranked nationally in total bases (second, 180), slugging percentage (fifth, .726), and RBI (12th, 72). In his first season leading the Longhorns, Pierce led Texas to a 39-24 record, a 14-win

improvement from the 2016 campaign. Texas came within one win of taking the Big 12 Conference tournament title before earning a No. 2 seed in the Long Beach Regional. Texas won its first two games of the regional before its season came to a close at the hands of LBSU. As a team, the Longhorns finished in the top 10 nationally in several statistical categories including double plays turned (fourth, 65), fielding percentage (fourth, .982), earned run average (ninth, 3.15), and hits allowed per nine innings (ninth, 7.60). Right-handed pitcher Morgan Cooper, a third team All-America selection, was taken in the second round of the MLB Draft, the first of 11 Longhorns to be selected in 2017, the most for any school. In Pierce's two seasons, a total of 16 Longhorns have been chosen in the draft.

The 56-year-old Pierce came to Texas from Tulane, where he spent the previous two seasons as head coach following a three-year stint at Sam Houston State in the same role. Pierce's teams have qualified for the NCAA tournament in seven years with him at the helm, and including his time as an assistant, Pierce was a part of programs that advanced to the postseason in 18 consecutive years, played in eight Super Regionals and reached five College World Series, winning a title in 2003 with Rice. In the summer of 2016, he was also named an assistant coach with the U.S. Collegiate National Team. Joining the Tulane Green Wave in 2015, the Houston native guided the school into its first season in the American Athletic Conference. His team posted a school-record nine shutouts, which ranked fourth in the nation, en route to a 35-25 record and the program's first regional appearance since 2008.

Pierce's second season at Tulane brought even more success as he led the 2016 Green Wave to a 41-21 record, a regular season AAC championship and a second-consecutive regional appearance. The 41 wins were the most for the program since 2006. The team led the nation with 13 shutouts and ranked in the top 25 in both ERA (23rd/3.24) and WHIP (25th/1.24), while belting out 66 home runs, which was tied for 13th nationally. Tulane produced two third-round picks in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft in catcher Jake Rogers and shortstop Stephen Alemais with Rogers becoming Tulane's highest draft pick since 2008. Seven players earned All-AAC honors, including four first-team selections, while starting pitcher Ross Massey was named freshman All-America after leading the conference and tying for 18th in the nation in victories (10).

In three seasons as head coach at Sam Houston State, Pierce compiled a record of 121-63 658). During his tenure, the Bearkats made three straight NCAA Regional appearances for just the second time in program history. Sam Houston State was crowned Southland Conference champions in each of his three seasons (the program's only previous league title came in 1989), and Pierce was named the conference coach of the year in both 2012 and 2013. The recognition in back-to-back years made him the first Southland Conference coach to earn consecutive honors since UTSA's Sherman Corbett (2007-08)

In his first season as head coach in 2012, the Bearkats were ranked in each of the major Division I polls for the first time in program history. He was honored as an American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Regional Coach of the Year that season. In 2014, his final season in Huntsville, Pierce guided SHSU to a 43-19 record, the second-highest single-season win total for the Bearkats since they joined Division I in 1987. The team ranked in the top 25 in the nation and second in the conference in both ERA (17th/2.73) and hits (25th/610). It also led the conference in scoring (5.7 rpg), home runs (31) and slugging percentage (.390)

A native of Houston, Pierce was born on October 13, 1962. He and his wife, Susan, have two children – a daughter, Chelsea, who graduated from The University of Texas in 2012 and is married to husband Bryan Caffey, and a son, Shea, who played for his father at both Sam Houston (2012-15) and Tulane (2016).
