### GAMEDAY QUICK FACTS

- **TELEVISION:** The game will be streamed nationally by Big12Now/ESPN+. Lowell Galindo (pxp) and Lance Blanks (analyst) will call the action.
- **RADIO:** The Longhorn IMG Radio Network broadcasts every UT game on the statewide network. Craig Way (pxp) and Eddie Oran (analyst) will call the action. Check TexasSports.com for a listing of affiliates carrying the game.
- **SERIES:** K-State leads, 22-20. Last meeting: Texas 80-77 (Feb. 9, 2021; Manhattan).

### NOTABLES

- **RECENT SUCCESS AGAINST K-STATE:** Texas has won four straight and five of the last six meetings against the Wildcats entering Tuesday's game. UT swept the regular-season series in each of the last two years.
- **DEFENSE WINS:** The Longhorns lead the **NATION** in scoring defense (51.9 ppg) through games of Jan. 2. Texas is 11-0 this year when holding its opponent below 60 points.
- **SOLID AT THE STRIPE:** Texas leads the Big 12 in free throw percentage (77.8). UT went 15-of-16 from the line in Saturday's win against WVU. The last time Texas hit at least 75-percent from the stripe over a full season was 1977-78 (76.0).
- **CARR IN HIGH GEAR:** Senior Marcus Carr posted a season-high 20 points (7-11 FG, 4-5 FT) in Saturday's win against West Virginia. He topped the 20-point mark for the first time at Texas and 23rd time in his collegiate career.

Head Coach: Chris Beard, 11-2 at Texas (1st year); 263-105 overall (12th year)

## KANSAS STATE SERIES INFO

- Tuesday's contest marks the 43rd meeting between Texas and Kansas State.
- The Wildcats hold a 22-20 lead in the all-time series which dates back to an 87-60 K-State win in Manhattan on Dec. 8, 1971.
- **UT has won four straight and five of the last six meetings in the series entering Tuesday's contest.**
- Texas swept the regular-season series last year. The Longhorns posted an 82-67 victory in Austin (Jan. 16, 2021) and followed with an 80-77 win in Manhattan (Feb. 9, 2021).

## IN THE POLLS

- The Longhorns are **No. 14** in the current AP poll (Jan. 3) and **No. 16** in the latest Ferris Mowers coaches poll (Jan. 3).
- Texas was tabbed No. 5 in the preseason AP poll, marking UT's highest preseason AP poll ranking since the 2009-10 season (No. 3).
- It also marked the first time in program history that the Longhorns have been ranked in The AP preseason poll under a first-year head coach.

## WEST VIRGINIA RECAP

- Texas has now won six of the last eight meetings against the Mountaineers and improved to 14-10 in the all-time series.
- The Longhorns improved to 17-9 in Big 12 Conference openers. Texas improved to 20-6 in Big 12 home openers.
- The Longhorns hit 15-of-16 from the free throw line (.938), including a 12-of-13 mark (.923) in the second half.
- UT forced 20 turnovers by West Virginia. This marked a team season high by the Mountaineers (previous: 16 vs. Kent State).
- WVU entered the game allowing just 59.8 ppg and had held six straight opponents to 59 points or less.
- Texas converted 50-percent from the floor (15-30), including a 6-of-11 mark (.545) from three-point range, in the opening 20 minutes while building a 39-20 lead.
- The Longhorns held WVU to 20 points on 32.0-percent FG shooting (8-25) in the first half. UT allowed just four assists while forcing 12 turnovers and registered a 10-0 advantage in points off turnovers during the opening 20 minutes.
- **Christian Bishop** tied his season high with seven rebounds in 19 minutes. Six of his seven boards came off the offensive glass.
- **Marcus Carr** topped the 20-point mark (game-high 20 points) for the first time at Texas (13 games) and 23rd time in his collegiate career (105 games). He set season highs in points, rebounds (four), field goals made (7-11) and free throws made (4-5). Carr reached double figures in scoring for the seventh time this year and 71st time in his career. He recorded a team-best plus-minus total of plus-19 in 34 minutes.
- **Dylan Disu** set a season high and tied his career high with three assists in just eight minutes played.
- **Andrew Jones** reached double figures in scoring (14 points) for the seventh time this year (13 games) and 72nd time in his career (115 games). He tied his season high in three-pointers made (3-6) and set a season high in free throws made (5-5).
- **Courtney Ramey** reached double figures in scoring (15 points) for the fourth time this year (13 games) and 61st time in his career (107 games). He set season highs in points and minutes (36) and tied season highs in field goals made (6-15) and assists (three).

## YEAR ONE OF THE CHRIS BEARD ERA

- **Chris Beard** was introduced as the 25th head basketball coach at The University of Texas on April 2, 2021.
- Beard is a 1995 graduate of The University of Texas with a degree in Kinesiology. During his undergraduate time, he worked as a student assistant under head coach Tom Penders.
- **In his 12 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Beard has a 263-105 (.715) record** and advanced to four NCAA Tournaments.
- Beard inherited a program at Texas Tech that was coming off five losing seasons in the six years prior to his arrival, and he guided the Red Raiders to a 112-55 (.671) record, including a 9-3 mark in NCAA Tournament games.
- Texas Tech advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in program history in 2018 and returned the following year with a trip to the 2019 National Championship Game.
- The 2019 Associated Press National Coach of the Year, Beard is a two-time Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year (2018 and 2019).
- In addition to his five years at Texas Tech, Beard has also led five other programs, serving as head coach at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock (2015-16), Angelo State University (2013-15), McMurry University (2012-13), Seminole State College (2000-01) and Fort Scott Community College (1999-2000).

## HOW THE ROSTER CAME TO BE ...

- When Chris Beard was introduced as the head coach of the Longhorns on April 2, his roster was essentially blank.
- **Night of April 2: Brock Cunningham** (who was on a road trip at the time of the hire) talked with Beard on the phone and committed to returning.
- **April 13: Jase Febres** and **Andrew Jones** decide to return and Beard/staff began group workouts with those three players.
- **April 16: Devin Askew** signs paperwork to transfer to Texas.
- **April 17: Timmy Allen** and **Christian Bishop** both sign paperwork to transfer to Texas.
- **April 27: Dylan Disu** signs paperwork to transfer to Texas.
- **April 28: Courtney Ramey** announces his return for his senior season.
- **June 1: Avery Benson** and **Gavin Perryman** arrive in Austin and begin summer workouts later that week.
- **June 19: Tre Mitchell** signs paperwork to transfer to Texas.
- **July 19: Marcus Carr** signs paperwork to transfer to Texas.

## DID YOU SAY 'EXPERIENCED' ???

- The average age of UT's 14-man roster is 21.7 years old.
- **SEVEN Longhorns were at least 22 years old at the start of the 2021-22 season.**
- The 12 players who brought previous collegiate experience to the 2021-22 roster have combined career totals of **1,039** games played (**677** starts), **10,435** points, **4,073** rebounds and **2,161** assists.
- **EIGHT** of UT's 12 players who have previous collegiate experience averaged double figures in scoring last year: Timmy Allen (17.2), Christian Bishop (11.0), Marcus Carr (19.4), Dylan Disu (15.0), Andrew Jones (14.6), Tre Mitchell (18.8), Courtney Ramey (12.2) and Tristen Licon (20.4).
- **FIVE** players have earned their degrees: Avery Benson (Texas Tech), Marcus Carr (Minnesota), Jase Febres (Texas), Andrew Jones (Texas) and Tristen Licon (Sul Ross State).

## EXCITEMENT IN THE FAN BASE

- Texas has set a single-season record for **most season tickets distributed**, as the total is nearly at the 9,200 mark. The Longhorns topped the previous mark of 8,882 set in 2004-05.
- The attendance of 14,683 (tickets distributed) for the season-opening doubleheader on Nov. 9 marked the fourth-largest home-opening crowd in the 45-year history of the Frank Erwin Center. It also marked the largest home-opening crowd since UT drew 15,291 fans on Nov. 17, 2001 against Arizona.
- In the first nine games at the Erwin Center this season, the Longhorns have averaged 11,656 fans per game.

## PRESEASON INDIVIDUAL HONOR ROLL

- **Marcus Carr** was selected as the Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year and tabbed to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team (chosen by coaches).
- **Andrew Jones** and **Tre Mitchell** each were named Preseason Honorable Mention All-Big 12.
- **Marcus Carr** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Bob Cousy Award (nation's top point guard). He is also one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the NABC Division I Player of the Year and one of 50 preseason watch list candidates for both the Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy.
- **Andrew Jones** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Jerry West Award (nation's top shooting guard) and one of 50 preseason watch list candidates for the Naismith Trophy.
- **Timmy Allen** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Julius Erving Award (nation's top small forward).
- **Tre Mitchell** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Karl Malone Award (nation's top power forward).

## DEFENSE FIRST

- Texas has limited its first 13 opponents to an average of 51.9 ppg. **UT leads the NATION in scoring defense through games of Jan. 2.**
- UT has held seven of its first 13 opponents below 50 points.
- **Texas is 11-0 this season when holding its opponent below 60 points.**
- UT has held its opponent to 20 points or below in a half a total of **nine** times (out of 26 total halves) this year.
- The Longhorns have held their opponents to a 31.2-percent mark from three-point range (73-234).
- Texas has allowed just 111 assists while forcing 238 turnovers in its first 13 games.
- **The Longhorns lead the Big 12 and rank THIRD nationally in turnover margin (+7.5).**
- Texas ranks 14th nationally in turnovers forced per game (18.3).
- UT is averaging 9.5 steals per game. The Longhorns have reached double digits in steals in eight of their first 13 contests.

## A LOOK INSIDE THE OFFENSIVE NUMBERS

- In the most recent KenPom rankings (through games of Jan. 2), Texas is No. **30** in the nation in offensive efficiency (110.4).
- The Longhorns are hitting at a **47.0-percent** clip from the floor. **The last time Texas converted at least 47-percent from the field in a season was in 1994-95 (48.0).**
- UT leads the Big 12 and ranks 19th nationally in free throw percentage (77.8, 165-212). **The last time Texas converted at least 75-percent from the line was in 1977-78 (76.0).**
- Texas has averaged just **10.8** turnovers per game through its first 12 contests. This leads the Big 12 Conference and ranks 30th nationally in fewest turnovers per game.
- The Longhorns have recorded an impressive 1.39 team assist-to-turnover ratio this season (194 assists against 140 turnovers). This ranks third in the Big 12 and 36th nationally.

## DEPTH & BALANCE

- **SEVEN** Texas players currently average between 7.2 ppg and 11.6 ppg.
- **SEVEN** different players have led the team in scoring in its first 13 contests.
- **TEN** players have reached double figures in scoring in a game this season.
- **TEN** players average at least 11.5 minutes per contest.

## TIMMY IS TOUGH

Senior F **Timmy Allen** has played in 98 career games (95 starts) during his four years at Utah and Texas. He has registered career totals of 1,474 points, 617 rebounds and 295 assists. Allen has reached double figures in scoring 80 times and topped the 20-point mark 22 times in his career. He has recorded 12 career double-doubles.

- Through the first 13 contests, Allen leads the team in scoring (11.6 ppg) and rebounding (6.4 rpg) and ranks second in assists (34), steals (16) and minutes (27.1 mpg).
- He has converted 52.3-percent (56-107) from the floor this year.
- A team-high 36 of his team-best 83 rebounds have come on the offensive glass.
- Allen had a season-high seven assists to go along with seven rebounds, four points, one block and one steal in 23 minutes vs. Incarnate Word (Dec. 28).
- He recorded 10 points (4-4 FT), seven boards, four assists, two blocks and two steals in 31 minutes vs. Alabama State (Dec. 22).
- Allen tallied 11 points (5-11 FG), five boards, three steals and one block in 37 minutes vs. Stanford (Dec. 19).
- He posted his first double-double as a Longhorn with 17 points (8-15 FG) and a game-high 12 boards in 33 minutes at No. 23/25 Seton Hall (Dec. 9).
- Allen recorded 13 points (6-7 FG) and three boards in 18 minutes against UTRGV (Dec. 3).
- He registered 12 points (8-10 FT), six assists and four rebounds in 33 minutes against Sam Houston (Nov. 29).
- Allen posted 15 points (5-9 FG, 1-1 threes, 4-6 FT), a game-high eight boards, three assists and three steals in 28 minutes vs. California Baptist (Nov. 24).
- He recorded a game-high 17 points (6-10 FG, 1-1 threes, 4-6 FT) in 23 minutes against San Jose State (Nov. 20).
- Allen had 10 points, eight rebounds (six offensive), three assists and two steals in 23 minutes vs. Northern Colorado (Nov. 17).
- He posted a team-high 18 points (7-12 FG, 2-4 threes), six boards and four assists in 32 minutes at No. 1/1 Gonzaga (Nov. 13).
- Allen earned All-Pac-12 First-Team honors as a junior last year, leading the team in scoring (17.2 ppg) and rebounds (6.4 rpg) while ranking second in assists (3.9 apg) in 35.2 mpg.
- He was the only Pac-12 player to rank in the top 10 in the league in scoring (fifth), rebounds (seventh), assists (fifth) and steals (10th).

## MITCHELL IS MOTIVATED

Junior F **Tre Mitchell** has played in 57 career games (54 starts) during his three seasons at UMass and Texas. He has registered career totals of 929 points, 381 rebounds and 63 blocks. Mitchell has reached double figures in scoring 48 times, topped the 20-point mark 16 times and recorded five 30-point efforts in his career. He has recorded nine career double-doubles.

- Through the first 13 games, he leads the team in blocks (11) and ranks second in scoring (10.5 ppg) and rebounding (5.1 rpg) in 21.4 mpg.
- Mitchell has converted 52.5-percent (53-101) from the floor and 75-percent (21-28) from the free throw line.
- He tallied 14 points (6-8 FG, 2-3 threes), six boards, three steals and two blocks in 20 minutes vs. Incarnate Word (Dec. 28).
- Mitchell posted a game-high 14 points (4-7 FG, 2-3 threes, 4-6 FT), five boards and one block in 22 minutes vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 14).

- He recorded his first double-double as a Longhorn with 19 points (9-17 FG) and 11 rebounds to go along with two blocks and two steals in 35 minutes at No. 23/25 Seton Hall (Dec. 9).
- Mitchell tallied 13 points (6-10 FG, 1-2 threes), five rebounds and tied his collegiate high with five assists against no turnovers in 23 minutes against UTRGV (Dec. 3).
- He recorded 14 points (6-8 FG), eight boards and two steals in 22 minutes against San Jose State (Nov. 20).
- Mitchell posted a game-high 16 points (7-11 FG, 1-2 threes), seven rebounds (four offensive) and one block in 21 minutes versus Northern Colorado (Nov. 17).
- He tallied 10 points (3-6 FG, 4-4 FT), five boards, two blocks and two steals in 20 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- Mitchell earned a spot on the Atlantic 10 All-Conference First Team last season, averaging a team-best 18.8 ppg and 7.2 rpg in 32.3 mpg.

## RAMEY'S RETURN FOR YEAR FOUR

Senior G **Courtney Ramey** (pronounced: RAY-me) has played in 107 career games (85 starts). He has reached double figures in scoring 61 times in his career, including six 20-point efforts. Ramey has hit 37.3-percent from three-point range (161-432) during his career, including a 39.6-percent mark (91-230) in Big 12 play.

- Through the first 13 games, Ramey ranks third on the team in minutes (25.3 mpg) and fifth in scoring (8.8 ppg) while hitting 47.8-percent from the floor (44-92), including a 40-percent mark (16-40) from three-point range.
- He tallied a season-high 15 points (6-15 FG, 3-8 threes), four rebounds and three assists in 36 minutes against West Virginia (Jan. 1).
- Ramey posted 14 points (6-10 FG, 2-4 threes), four boards and three assists against Sam Houston (Nov. 29).
- He recorded 12 points (5-8 FG), five boards and two steals in 33 minutes vs. California Baptist (Nov. 24).
- Ramey tallied a team-high 14 points (5-7 FG, 4-5 threes) in 19 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).

## RAMEY'S REACHES 1,000-POINT MILESTONE

- With his turnaround jumper at the 17:24 mark of the second half in the home win against California Baptist (Nov. 24), **Courtney Ramey became the 40th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point mark.**
- Ramey has scored **1,069** points in 107 career games (10.0 ppg).

## AJ1

**Andrew Jones** is in his sixth season with the UT program in 2021-22. He was diagnosed with leukemia in January 2018 but underwent successful treatment at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston. Jones re-joined the team for the 2018-19 season and played in two games, as he continued his treatments throughout the year. **He completed his final treatment in September 2019.** Jones was granted a medical redshirt for both the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons and is classified as a redshirt senior (still has one year of eligibility remaining due to COVID). Here's a timeline of Andrew's battle and inspirational recovery:

- May 2017: Went through NBA Pre-Draft Combine following his freshman season but decided to withdraw his name from the draft pool and return to UT for his sophomore season.
- Dec. 5, 2017: Suffered a fracture in his right wrist during the final minutes at VCU and missed the next four games.
- Dec. 29, 2017 and Jan. 1, 2018: Returns to the court but only plays limited minutes (nine vs. Kansas, 11 at Iowa State).
- Jan. 9, 2018 (night): Shaka Smart informs the Texas team that Jones had been diagnosed with leukemia.
- Jan. 10, 2018: Andrew's family (through UT) publicly announces Jones' diagnosis.
- Jan. 19, 2018: Moved to The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston.
- Feb. 24, 2018: Released from MD Anderson Cancer Center and began receiving treatments on an outpatient basis.
- June 7, 2018: Jones is approved to enroll in web-based coursework for first session of summer school at UT. Allowed to move into a dorm room and uses the room during the times he is on campus.
- Aug. 24, 2018: Finishes round of treatment at MD Anderson Cancer Center and heads to Austin to move back into the dorm.
- Aug. 29, 2018: Began fall classes at UT and allowed to participate in basketball-related activities.
- Nov. 6, 2018: Entered the Eastern Illinois game at the 11:40 mark of the second half. Saw nine minutes of playing time and recorded one point (1-2 FT), one rebound, one assist and one steal in his first game action since Jan. 1, 2018 at Iowa State.
- Nov. 16, 2018: Plays two minutes and scores two points (2-2 FT) and grabs one rebound vs. The Citadel.
- Dec. 11, 2018: Returned to MD Anderson to begin next round of pre-scheduled treatment.
- Jan. 10, 2019: Re-joined the team at practice but did not see game action for the remainder of the year.
- Spring/Summer 2019: Continues several additional cycles of treatment while remaining a full-time UT student and practicing with the basketball team.
- September 2019: Completes final round of treatment while on the UT campus and participating in preseason team and individual basketball workouts.

## ANDREW ON THE COURT

Senior G **Andrew Jones** has played in 115 career games (76 starts). He has reached double figures in scoring 72 times and topped the 20-point mark 11 times.

- Through the first 13 games, he leads the team in steals (21) and ranks third in scoring (9.6 ppg) and assists (26) and fourth in minutes (25.2).
- Jones sports a 1.73 assist-to-turnover ratio (26-15) and has converted 85.2-percent from the free throw line (23-27).

- He posted 14 points (3-6 threes, 5-5 FT) and three rebounds in 26 minutes against West Virginia (Jan. 1).
- Jones recorded 12 points, four rebounds and three assists in 31 minutes vs. Alabama State (Dec. 22).
- He tallied a team-high 13 points, four boards and two steals in 29 minutes vs. Stanford (Dec. 19).
- Jones posted 14 points (6-9 FG), four boards, three steals and two blocks in 31 minutes vs. Sam Houston (Nov. 29).
- He tallied 15 points (5-10 FG, 2-of-4 threes, 3-3 FT) and five assists against one turnover in 27 minutes against California Baptist (Nov. 24).
- Jones recorded 13 points (5-6 FG, 1-2 threes, 2-2 FT), three steals and two assists in 23 minutes vs. San Jose State (Nov. 20).
- He posted 11 points (4-7 FG, 3-6 threes) and a career-high five steals in 24 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- Jones is a two-time All-Big 12 Conference selection, earning second-team honors last year and Honorable Mention accolades in his sophomore season.
- He led the team in scoring (14.6 ppg) and ranked third in assists (2.3 apg) and minutes (31.5 mpg) and fourth in rebounding (4.5 rpg) last year. He finished fifth in the Big 12 in scoring in league games (16.6 ppg).

## DRIVING A NEW CARR

Senior G **Marcus Carr** has played in 105 career games (98 starts) during his time at Minnesota, Pittsburgh and Texas. He owns four-year collegiate totals of 1,484 points, 519 assists and 393 rebounds. Carr has reached double figures in scoring 71 times and topped the 20-point mark 23 times in his career.

- Through the first 13 games, Carr leads the team in assists (3.2 apg) and minutes (27.8 mpg) and ranks fourth in scoring (9.5 ppg). He has registered a 1.75 assist-to-turnover ratio (42-24).
- He posted a season-high and game-high 20 points (7-11 FG, 4-5 FT), four rebounds, two assists and two steals in 34 minutes vs. West Virginia (Jan. 1). He had team-best plus-minus total of plus-19.
- Carr recorded 13 points (3-5 threes) in 32 minutes against Alabama State (Dec. 22).
- He tallied 10 points and three assists against one turnover in 36 minutes at No. 23/25 Seton Hall (Dec. 9).
- Carr registered 11 points, four assists without a turnover and two steals in 23 minutes against UTRGV (Dec. 3).
- He posted a game-high 19 points (6-12 FG, 4-7 threes) and four assists in 35 minutes vs. Sam Houston (Nov. 29).
- Carr tallied 11 points, three assists and two steals in 32 minutes at No. 1/1 Gonzaga (Nov. 13).

- He recorded 10 points (4-7 FG) and seven assists in 26 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- Carr earned All-Big Ten First Team (AP) recognition last year at Minnesota, where he ranked first in the Big Ten in minutes (35.8 mpg), third in scoring (19.4 ppg) and assists (4.9 apg) and sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1).

### CHRISTIAN'S CAUSE

Senior F **Christian Bishop** has played in 103 career games (65 starts) during his four seasons at Creighton and Texas. He has recorded career totals of 817 points, 476 rebounds and 87 blocked shots. Bishop has converted **63.8-percent** (329-516) from the field over his **career**. He has reached double figures in scoring 42 times and double digits in rebounds seven times in his career.

- Through the first 13 games, he ranks fourth on the team in rebounding (4.3 rpg) and blocks (five) and seventh in scoring (7.2 ppg) in 14.8 mpg.
- Bishop has converted 57.9-percent (33-57) from the field and 83.3-percent (25-30) from the free throw line this year.
- He grabbed seven boards (six offensive) and added six points in 19 minutes vs. West Virginia (Jan. 1).
- Bishop posted seven rebounds (four offensive) in 17 minutes against Alabama State (Dec. 22).
- He recorded a game-high 17 points (4-7 FG, 9-9 FT), three boards, two steals and one block in 14 minutes against UTRGV (Dec. 3). He set his collegiate best in free throws made.
- Bishop tallied 12 points (4-6 FG, 4-4 FT) and five boards in 16 minutes vs. California Baptist (Nov. 24).
- He recorded 10 points (3-3 FG, 4-6 FT) and two blocks in 17 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- In his junior season in 2020-21, Bishop averaged 11.0 points and a team-best 6.4 rebounds in 23.5 minutes per game. He converted 68.1-percent from the floor (141-207), ranking second on the Creighton single-season chart.
- Bishop led the BIG EAST in field goal percentage last year and his 68.1-percent mark was tops nationally in Division I among the 770 players who attempted at least 200 field goals.

### DISU'S DOMAIN

Junior F **Dylan Disu** has played in 54 career games (48 starts) during his three seasons at Vanderbilt and Texas. He has registered career totals of 534 points, 363 rebounds and 61 blocked shots. In his career, Disu has reached double figures in scoring 28 times and double digits in rebounds 15 times. He has recorded 12 career double-doubles.

- After missing the final eight games to conclude last season at Vanderbilt and the first eight contests this year at Texas due to a left knee injury (bone fracture), Disu made his debut as a Longhorn against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 14).
- Through his first five games, he ranks second on the team in blocks (10), third in rebounding (5.0 rpg) and sixth in scoring (8.2 ppg) in 14.9 mpg.
- Disu has a blocked shot in four of his first five contests.
- He has reached double figures in scoring in three of the five games and converted 54.8-percent from the floor (17-31) and is a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line.
- Disu posted his first double-double as a Longhorn with 14 points (5-9 FG, 4-4 FT) and 11 boards while tying his career high with five blocks in 20 minutes against Incarnate Word (Dec. 28).

- He recorded a team-high 14 points (6-10 FG, 2-2 FT), four boards and three blocks in 18 minutes vs. Alabama State (Dec. 22).
- Disu registered 11 points (5-7 FG, 1-2 threes), four boards, one block and one steal in 16 minutes vs. Stanford (Dec. 19).
- The 2021 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year for Men's Basketball, he led the SEC in rebounding (9.2 rpg) in his sophomore season in 2020-21. He also led the team in blocked shots (21) and field goal percentage (.492) and ranked second on the team in scoring (15.0 ppg) and minutes (31.6 mpg).
- Disu was born in Austin and grew up in Pflugerville where he played at Hendrickson High School.

### FEBRES RETURNS FOR SUPER SENIOR SEASON

Senior G **Jase Febres** (pronounced: JAYCE FEB-rus) has played in 116 career games (67 starts). He has reached double figures in scoring 32 times in his career, including four 20-point efforts. Febres has registered 771 points and converted 36.1-percent from three-point range (204-565) during his career.

- Through his first 12 games, he ranks eighth on the team in scoring (4.6 ppg) in 16.1 mpg.
- Febres tallied 10 points (3-6 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-2 FT) and four rebounds in 27 minutes at No. 1/1 Gonzaga (Nov. 13).
- He posted eight points (2-3 threes) in 15 minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- Febres graduated in May 2021 with a degree in Corporate Communication and is continuing his studies in personal branding.
- He missed the first 12 contests of the 2020-21 season while completing his rehabilitation from microfracture surgery on his left knee (suffered the injury on Feb. 8, 2020).

### CUNNINGHAM BACK FOR YEAR FOUR

Junior F **Brock Cunningham** is in his fourth season in the UT program. Cunningham has played in 54 career games (one start) and reached double figures in scoring once and double digits in rebounds three times. A two-time Academic All-Big 12 Second Team selection, he elected to redshirt the 2018-19 season.

- Through the first 13 contests, Cunningham ranks seventh on the team in rebounding (2.2 rpg) while averaging 3.2 ppg in 11.5 mpg.
- Eleven of his 28 rebounds have come off the offensive glass.
- Cunningham has converted 13-of-22 field goals (.591), including 5-of-9 threes (.556), and 11-of-12 free throws (.917) this year.
- He tallied six points (3-5 FG), three boards and one assist in 13 minutes vs. Incarnate Word (Dec. 28).
- Cunningham set career highs in scoring with 10 points (2-2 FG, 1-1 three) and free throws made (5-5) while adding two steals in 14 minutes against San Jose State (Nov. 20).

### FRESH START FOR ASKEW

Sophomore G **Devin Askew** has played in 38 career games (23 starts) during his first two years at Kentucky and Texas. The consensus No. 1 point guard in the class of 2021, he reclassified to be a part of the class of 2020.

- Through the first 13 games, he is tied for fourth on the team in steals (14) and tied for fifth in assists (20) in 15.1 mpg. He has a 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio (20 assists, eight turnovers).
- Askew earned his first start at Texas against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 14) and had a game-high three steals in 18 minutes.

- He posted nine points (4-6 FG), two rebounds and a steal in 15 minutes at No. 1/1 Gonzaga (Nov. 13).
- As a freshman at Kentucky last year, Askew ranked second on the team in assists (73, 2.9 apg) and averaged 6.5 points and 2.6 rebounds in 28.9 minutes per contest.

### BENSON FOLLOWS BEARD ... AGAIN

Senior G **Avery Benson** has played in 82 career games during his time at both Texas Tech and Texas. He has registered career totals of 92 points and 76 rebounds while converting 41.7-percent (15-36) from three-point range. Benson, who elected to redshirt the 2017-18 season, helped Texas Tech post a total of 94 wins during his four years in Lubbock.

- Benson graduated in August 2021 from Texas Tech with a degree in Management and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communications.
- While at Southwest Christian Academy (Springdale, Ark.), he was offered a scholarship by Coach Beard while Beard was at Little Rock.
- When Beard left Little Rock to take the job at Texas Tech, Benson elected to join the Red Raider program as a walk-on and earn his way into receiving a scholarship.

### LICON'S LEAP OF FAITH

Senior G **Tristen Licon** has played in 110 career games (65 starts) over the last five seasons at Sul Ross State (NCAA Division III school in Alpine, Texas) and Texas. Licon has career totals of 1,599 points, 553 rebounds and 256 assists.

- He had five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 three) in six minutes against UTRGV (Dec. 3).
- Licon tallied four points (2-3 FG), one rebound and one assist in eight minutes vs. San Jose State (Nov. 20).
- He posted six points (2-2 threes), two rebounds and one steal in six minutes against Houston Baptist (Nov. 9).
- Licon joined the Texas program as a walk-on in the summer for his super senior season. He originally enrolled at Texas with the intention of joining Coach Beard's coaching staff as a graduate assistant. Licon worked Coach Beard's camp at Texas Tech in the summer of 2019.
- He ranks second in Sul Ross State program history in career scoring (1,579 points) and career rebounds (548).
- Licon earned his bachelor's degree in May 2020 from Sul Ross State in Kinesiology and Human Performance.
- He earned his master's degree in August 2021 from Sul Ross State in Education and is currently pursuing a master's degree in Sport Management at Texas.
- During the 2020-21 season at Sul Ross State, Licon led the team in scoring (20.4 ppg), rebounding (8.3 rpg) and steals (45) while converting 39.5-percent from three-point range (34-86).

### IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Tuesday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,033 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,161 of 1,169 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

### EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF

UT's three assistant coaches, Managing Director and Special Assistant to the Head Coach have a combined **97** years of coaching experience and have coached in **37** NCAA Tournaments and developed **42** NBA Draft picks. **This five-man group has made a total of 13 NCAA Sweet 16, nine Elite Eight and two Final Four appearances.** The group also has extensive experience in the state of Texas as well as the Big 12 Conference, including two staffers who have a combined 21 years of service working for Texas Basketball.

- Associate Head Coach **Rodney Terry** was a former head coach at UTEP and Fresno State for the previous 10 seasons. He brings 26 years of collegiate coaching experience to the Texas staff, including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11. He has made 12 appearances in the NCAA Tournament and produced 14 NBA Draft selections. The Longhorns had 13 players chosen in the NBA Draft in the nine seasons with Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.
- Assistant Coach **Jerrance Howard** was an assistant coach at Kansas for the last eight years. He brings 17 years of collegiate coaching experience to the UT staff and has made nine NCAA Tournament appearances and developed 12 NBA Draft picks.
- Assistant Coach **Ulric Maligi** (YUR-ick MAL-uh-ghee) was an assistant coach under Chris Beard at Texas Tech for the previous two seasons. He brings 14 years of collegiate coaching experience to the UT staff and has made four NCAA Tournament appearances and developed five NBA Draft picks.
- Managing Director **Chris Ogden** is a former UT player and assistant coach who spent the last three years as head coach at UTA. He brings 18 years of collegiate coaching experience to the UT staff and has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances and developed eight NBA Draft picks.
- Special Assistant to the Head Coach **Bob Donewald Jr.** is an experienced coach at the professional, international and collegiate levels who worked under Chris Beard at Texas Tech the past two seasons. He brings 22 years of coaching experience to the UT staff and has made one NCAA Tournament appearance and developed three NBA Draft picks.

### HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 14 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2021-22 regular season on Oct. 19.

- Texas ranks **THIRD** nationally in most players on 2021-22 NBA opening-night rosters, trailing only Kentucky (27) and Duke (22).
- In addition to the 14 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Atlanta Hawks and Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Brooklyn Nets.

## NEW ARENA NEARING COMPLETION

The University of Texas and a group led by the Oak View Group (OVG) is completing a world-class arena on campus that will be the home to Texas Men's and Women's Basketball games, graduations, concerts and other events.

- **The arena will open in April 2022.**
- The innovative 35-year agreement between UT and ArenaCo - which includes OVG, Live Nation, C3 Presents and Matthew McConaughey - will provide a public benefit for UT and the City of Austin. The \$338 million venue will be constructed on land fully owned by UT without using any university or public money.
- The 10,000-seat arena will provide an intimate, state-of-the-art men's and women's basketball fan experience and feature student seating surrounding the court. The new arena is designed to expand to 15,000 seats to provide a world-class venue for touring concerts and shows.
- UT's new basketball arena and events center will be named **Moody Center** in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation.
- The grant to support Texas Athletics is the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history and brings to more than \$200 million the donations to UT Austin from the Galveston-based foundation. Previously, the foundation contributed \$50 million to support the Moody College of Communication and \$20 million to reimagine and transform the exterior spaces at the Blanton Museum of Art. Overall, the foundation has contributed more than \$260 million to institutions in the University of Texas System.

His mom, Elise Allen, passed away after a seven-year battle with breast cancer on Dec. 3, 2016 at the age of 49 (during Timmy's junior year of high school). His godfather, Ray Arvizu, has served as a father figure to Timmy for the last decade.
- **Devin Askew's** dad, Brian Askew, played soccer at Fresno State and went on to play professionally for the San Francisco Seals (USISL).
- **Avery Benson's** dad, Andy Benson, played basketball at John Brown University (Siloam Springs, Ark.). His grandfather, Randy Benson, was a high school basketball coach.
- **Christian Bishop** was born in Sacile, Italy. His father, Jerry Bishop, played basketball at Abilene Christian. His older brother, Grant, played basketball at Missouri Baptist. He wears jersey No. 32 to honor Jerry and Grant, who both wore the number.
- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play for a great basketball coach while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Marcus Carr's** brother, Duane Notice, played on South Carolina's 2017 NCAA Final Four team and has gone on to play professionally internationally and with Raptors 905 (Toronto affiliate in the NBA G-League).
- **Brock Cunningham's** dad, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville).
- **Jase Febres' father**, Orlando Febres, passed away in September 2015 at the age of 51 after a bout with cancer. Orlando played college basketball at New Mexico State (1982-86) and went on to play professionally in Puerto Rico and for the Puerto Rican national team.
- **Andrew Jones' sister**, Alexis Jones, played basketball at Baylor (2014-17) and was selected as the No. 12 overall pick of the 2017 WNBA Draft by the Minnesota Lynx. Andrew is in the process of launching the "AJ1 Foundation" which aims to inspire and mentor the future generation who do not have access to benefits or resources.
- **Tristen Licon** grew up as a Longhorn fan, as his uncle attended UT as a student. His father, Al Licon, is the head boys track coach and assistant football coach at Parkland HS in El Paso. Al was a long jumper at New Mexico State. Tristen worked Coach Beard's camp at Texas Tech in the summer of 2019.
- **Tre Mitchell** was born in Bamberg, Germany. His family moved from Germany to Pittsburgh when Tre was one year old.
- **Courtney Ramey** wears jersey No. 3 in honor of three people who were close to him that passed away (his mother, his grandmother, and his close friend while in high school).
- **Gavin Perryman's father**, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant. His late grandfather, Dennis Perryman, was a longtime AD at Garden City Community College (Garden City, Kan.).
