• **BIG 12 HOME OPENER:** UT owns a 20-6 mark in Big 12 HOME openers entering Tuesday's contest.

• **RECENT SUCCESS AGAINST K-STATE:** Texas has won five of the last six and six of the last eight meetings against the Wildcats entering Tuesday's game.

• **SOLID AT THE STRIPE:** The Longhorns converted **15-of-16 (.938)** from the free throw line, including a perfect 9-of-9 mark in the second half, during Saturday's victory in Norman. **Sir'Jabari Rice** went 7-of-7 from the line in the final 2:07 of the contest.

• **CARR ON A ROLL:** Graduate G **Marcus Carr** has averaged 23.2 ppg while converting 53.6-percent from the floor (37-69), including a 61.8-percent (21-34) mark from three-point range, and 84.0-percent (21-25) from the free throw line in 32.9 mpg and posted an 18-to-8 assist-to-turnover ratio over the last **five** contests. The two-time Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week is just **26** points shy of reaching the 2,000-career point mark.

Acting Head Coach: Rodney Terry, 5-0 at Texas; 168-156 overall (11th year)

SOLID START

- Texas is off to a 12-1 start (1-0 Big 12 Conference) and has posted a pair of impressive wins against AP Top 10 opponents (93-74 over No. 2 Gonzaga on Nov. 16 and 72-67 against No. 7 Creighton on Dec. 1).
- **This marks UT's first 12-1 start to the year since the 2009-10 season**, when it opened the year with 17-straight wins.
- Texas was the **ONLY** Big 12 team to earn a **road** win on the opening day of league play on Saturday.
- The Longhorns' lone loss this year came in an 85-78 overtime setback to No. 17/17 Illinois (Dec. 6) in a neutral-site contest at the Jimmy V Classic in Madison Square Garden.
- This marks the first time Texas has beaten a pair of AP Top 10 opponents at home in one year since the 2015-16 season when UT claimed a trio of home wins against AP Top 10 opponents (No. 3 North Carolina, No. 10 West Virginia and No. 3 Oklahoma).
- Nine of the 12 victories have been by at least **10** points, and the Longhorns have posted a **+20.0** scoring margin this year (82.7-62.7).

TEXAS IN BIG 12 HOME OPENERS

- **Texas owns a 20-6 all-time record in Big 12 Conference HOME openers** entering Tuesday's contest.

KANSAS STATE SERIES INFO

- Tuesday's game marks the 45th meeting between Texas and K-State.
- The Wildcats hold a 23-21 lead in the all-time series which dates back to an 87-60 K-State win in Manhattan on Dec. 8, 1971.
- **UT has won five of the last six and six of the last eight meetings in the series entering Tuesday's contest.**
- The Longhorns and Wildcats split last year's regular-season series. Texas claimed a 70-57 win in Manhattan (Jan. 4), and K-State earned a 66-65 victory in Austin (Jan. 18).

IN THE POLLS

- The Longhorns are ranked No. **6** in the latest AP poll (Jan. 2) and No. **6** in the latest USA TODAY Sports coaches' poll (Jan. 2).
- Texas climbed to as high as No. 2 in both polls earlier this year (Nov. 28 and Dec. 5). This marked the highest ranking in The AP poll for the Longhorns since UT was ranked No. 1 in consecutive polls on Jan. 11 and Jan. 18, 2010.

OKLAHOMA RECAP

- This marked UT's first true road contest of the season.
- The Longhorns improved to 18-9 in Big 12 Conference openers with the victory.
- Texas has won four-in-a-row, five of the last six and 24 of the last 36 meetings in the series against Oklahoma.
- The Longhorns have posted wins in each of their last four trips to Norman.
- Texas converted 15-of-16 (.938) free throws on the afternoon, including a perfect 9-of-9 mark in the second half.
- UT registered a 27-5 advantage in bench scoring.
- The Longhorns claimed a plus-11 (22-11) rebound margin in the second half, including an 11-4 advantage on the offensive glass. For the game, Texas posted a 33-31 rebound margin.

- **Timmy Allen** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the seventh time this season (13 games) and 100th time in his career (132 games). He added seven rebounds (four offensive), two assists without a turnover and two steals in 32 minutes.
- **Marcus Carr** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the 11th time this year (13 games) and 96th time in his career (139 games). He tied his collegiate career high in steals (4).
- **Brock Cunningham** posted a team-best plus-minus total of plus-10 in 18 minutes played.
- **Dylan Disu** reached double figures in scoring (10 points) for the fourth time this season (12 games) and 33rd time in his career (87 games). He reached double digits in points for the first time since Nov. 21 vs. Northern Arizona. Disu had three blocked shots, marking the fifth time this year that he has multiple blocked shots in a game.
- **Tyrese Hunter** set a season high in assists (8) without committing a turnover. He registered a team-best plus-minus total of plus-30 in 30 minutes.
- **Sir'Jabari Rice** reached double figures in scoring (11 points) for the seventh time this year (13 games) and 65th time in his career (124 games). He scored all of his 11 points in the final 5:49 of the contest and hit 7-of-7 free throws in the last 2:07. Rice set season highs in rebounds (7) and free throws made (7-of-7).

STATEMENT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS (DEC. 12)

- "The University takes matters of interpersonal violence involving members of its community seriously. Given the information available, The University has suspended Chris Beard from his position as head coach of Men's Basketball and will withhold his pay until further notice. Associate Head Coach Rodney Terry will serve as acting head coach for tonight's game against Rice."

ACTING HEAD COACH RODNEY TERRY

- **Rodney Terry** was named Acting Head Coach at The University of Texas a few hours prior to the Dec. 12 (Monday) home game against Rice.
- **He has posted a 5-0 mark as acting head coach** and now sports an overall career record of **168-156**.
- Terry, who has 27 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Acting Head Coach.

- Terry was a former head coach at UTEP and Fresno State for a combined 10 seasons, where he compiled an overall record of 163-156 (.511).
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. During those nine years, the Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. The two-person class of Cory Joseph and Tristan Thompson was the No. 8 recruiting class in the nation by ESPN. UT's three-person freshman class in 2009 was ranked No. 3 nationally by Rivals and No. 4 by ESPNU. The seven-man freshman class in 2006 was tabbed as the No. 3 class in the country by Rivals and Scout. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.
- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

BLESS THE MOOD

- The Longhorns have moved into Moody Center, the new home of Texas Basketball, for the 2022-23 season.
- Texas is **8-0** in games played at Moody Center and has posted a **+24.3** scoring margin (86.4-62.1) in those contests.
- **Texas has had a sellout crowd in EACH of its first eight contests in Moody Center this year** and is averaging **10,917** fans per game in Moody (capacity: 10,763).
- The \$375 million world-class arena is located on campus and will play host to UT Men's and Women's Basketball games, graduations, concerts and other events.
- The arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is the first of its kind in the industry with an unrivaled partnership between Oak View Group (OVG), Live Nation/C3 Presents, The University of Texas and the MOC (Minister of Culture) Matthew McConaughey.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, Texas Basketball and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section, **The Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court in the lower bowl.
- In late September, the team and the MOC (Minister of Culture) hosted 500-plus UT students in a standing-room only event at the Scoot Inn in East Austin.
- A few weeks later, the program welcomed nearly 800 students to an open practice at Moody Center to connect them with the current players on the team and show students exactly where their seats would be for basketball games.

BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL AND HONORS

- A trio of Texas players were named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Awards teams.
- **Timmy Allen** and **Marcus Carr** were both tabbed to the Preseason All-Big 12 team, while **Tyrese Hunter** was named Preseason Honorable Mention All-Big 12.
- The Longhorns were picked to finish third in the league's preseason coaches' poll. Baylor claimed the top spot and received five first-place votes and 77 points. Kansas tallied four first-place votes and 73 points, while Texas received the final first-place vote and 64 points.

PRESEASON POSITIONAL AWARDS HONOR ROLL

- **Tyrese Hunter** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Bob Cousy Award (nation's top point guard).
- **Timmy Allen** is one of 20 preseason watch list candidates for the Julius Erving Award (nation's top small forward).
- **Timmy Allen** and **Tyrese Hunter** are two of 50 preseason watch list candidates for the John R. Wooden Award presented by Wendy's. Texas is one of 10 schools to have multiple players selected to the Wooden Award preseason watch list.

HISTORY-MAKING WIN vs. No. 2/2 GONZAGA

- Texas **tied** a program record for defeating the highest-ranked AP opponent in school history with its 93-74 win over No. 2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).
- This marked the **fourth** time in school history that the Longhorns have topped the No. 2 team in The AP poll.
- Texas previously defeated No. 2 Louisville (74-70) on Nov. 30, 1986 in the seventh-place game at the Great Alaska Shootout (Anchorage, Alaska). The Longhorns beat No. 2 UCLA (63-61) on Dec. 2, 2007 at Pauley Pavilion. UT also topped No. 2 Oklahoma (73-68) on Feb. 21, 2009 in Austin.

DEFENSE WINS

- Texas has limited its opponents to an average of **62.7** ppg on **40.5**-percent FG shooting (292-721), including a **30.9**-percent mark from three-point range (81-262), this season.
- The Longhorns have allowed 137 assists while forcing 231 turnovers (17.8 tpg) this year. UT has forced at least **15** turnovers in 12 of its first 13 contests.
- **Texas has recorded a 283-114 advantage in points off turnovers this season.**
- Texas held Houston Christian to 31 points in the home win (Nov. 10). The 31 points is tied for the second-fewest points allowed by the Longhorns in program history.

- The Longhorns held HCU to 21.7-percent FG shooting (13-60) in the contest. This marked the **fourth**-lowest FG percentage allowed by Texas since the 1960-61 season and lowest since Texas State converted 21.6-percent (11-51) on Dec. 13, 2014.
- UT held Creighton (Dec. 1) to 67 points on 40.9-percent (27-66) FG shooting, including a 14.8-percent mark (4-27) from three-point range. Creighton entered the game averaging 83.9 points per contest while converting 51.2-percent FG, including a 38.2-percent mark from three-point range.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- The Longhorns are averaging **82.7** ppg and have converted **49.5**-percent (408-824) from the floor this season. This marks the first time Texas has averaged **more** than 80 ppg since the 2009-10 season (**81.2** ppg).
- **Texas topped the century mark** for the first time since the 2017-18 season opener with its 100-72 home victory against Louisiana (Dec. 21). It marked the first 100-point effort for the Longhorns since UT claimed a 105-59 home win over Northwestern State on Nov. 10, 2017.
- UT has hit at least 50-percent from the floor in **eight** of its first **13** contests this year.
- The Longhorns converted a season-best 58.1-percent (36-62) from the floor, including a season-high 54.5-percent (12-22) from three-point range, and a season-best 94.1-percent (16-17) from the free throw line against Louisiana (Dec. 21).
- Texas hit 56.9-percent (37-65) from the floor, including 40.9-percent (9-22) from three-point range, against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- UT converted 56.1-percent (37-66) from the field, including 44.4-percent (12-27) from three-point range, against Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27).
- **The Longhorns have posted a 218-67 advantage in fast-break points this year.**

SHARING THE ROCK

- Texas has averaged **18.3** assists per game and sports an impressive 1.6 **TEAM** assist-to-turnover ratio (238 assists, 151 turnovers) this season.
- UT has recorded at least **20** assists in five of its last seven contests entering Tuesday's game. **During its last eight contests, Texas has tallied 161 assists against 86 turnovers.**
- The Longhorns registered a season-high 30 assists (on 37 made field goals) against just nine turnovers versus UAPB (Dec. 10).
- UT posted 22 assists (on 28 made field goals) against eight turnovers versus Stanford (Dec. 18).
- Texas had 23 assists on 36 made field goals against Louisiana (Dec. 21). Five different Longhorns posted at least three assists.
- The Longhorns registered 28 assists (on 37 made field goals) against 10 turnovers versus Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27).

GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2022-23 Texas roster includes **SIX** players who are either graduate students, super seniors or seniors: Timmy Allen (super senior), Christian Bishop (super senior), Marcus Carr (graduate student), Brock Cunningham (graduate student) and Sir'Jabari Rice (graduate student).
- **FOUR** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Marcus Carr** (1,974 points), **Timmy Allen** (1,864 points), **Sir'Jabari Rice** (1,230 points) and **Christian Bishop** (1,049 points).
- The **SEVEN** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **755** games played (**533** starts).

A LIGHTER, QUICKER CARR

Graduate G **Marcus Carr** has played in 139 career games (132 starts) during his time at Minnesota, Pittsburgh and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of 1,974 points, 647 assists and 466 rebounds. Carr has reached double figures in scoring **96** times, topped the 20-point mark **27** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **six** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career.

- Through the first 13 games, he leads the team in scoring (17.5 ppg), steals (26) and minutes (30.0 mpg) and ranks second in assists (53).
- Carr has posted an impressive 3.12 assist-to-turnover ratio (53-17) and has converted 46.3-percent (75-162) from the field, including a 45.5-percent (35-77) mark from three-point range.
- He recorded 13 points (2-3 threes, 3-3 FT) and tied his career high with four steals in 36 minutes at Oklahoma (Dec. 31). He hit a pair of free throws with 3.3 seconds left to seal the win.
- Carr registered 17 points (5-9 FG, 3-3 threes, 4-4 FT) and four assists in 24 minutes against Louisiana (Dec. 21).
- He earned **Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week** honors (Dec. 19) for his efforts in the wins against Rice (Dec. 12) and Stanford (Dec. 18). Carr averaged 22.5 ppg, 4.0 apg and 3.0 rpg in 37.3 mpg while converting 15-of-29 FG (.517), including 6-of-13 (.462) threes, and 9-of-12 FT (.750) in the two contests.
- Carr had a team-high 17 points (6-13 FG, 3-4 FT), five assists against one turnover and three boards in 33 minutes against Stanford (Dec. 18). He had 15 of his 17 points in the second half (5-7 FG, 2-4 threes, 3-4 FT) and five assists without a turnover.
- He recorded 28 points (9-16 FG, 4-7 threes, 6-8 FT), three assists and three rebounds in a season-high 42 minutes against Rice (Dec. 12). In the overtime session, he posted a team-high eight points (2-2 FG, 4-4 FT) and one assist without a turnover.
- Carr tallied 19 points (7-20 FG, 2-5 threes, 3-3 FT), five boards and five assists without a turnover in 34 minutes against No. 7/7 Creighton (Dec. 1).
- He posted 18 points (6-11 FG, 4-8 threes, 2-2 FT), three boards and two steals in 25 minutes against UTRGV (Nov. 26).

- Carr recorded 17 points (7-13 FG, 3-6 threes), four assists without a turnover and three steals in 23 minutes against Northern Ariona (Nov. 21).
- He posted 16 points (4-9 threes) and added seven assists against one turnover and four rebounds in 36 minutes against No. 2/2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).
- Carr tallied 11 points (5-9 FG) and tied his career high with four steals in 22 minutes against Houston Christian (Nov. 10).
- He posted 12 points (8-10 FT) and a team-high five assists in 30 minutes against UTEP (Nov. 7).
- Carr dropped nearly 20 pounds during the offseason to improve his quickness and conditioning.

CARR'S RECORD-SETTING NIGHT

In the home win against Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27), **Marcus Carr** registered 41 points while hitting 13-of-19 FG, including 10-of-15 threes, and 5-of-6 FT. He also added four assists against one turnover, two steals and one rebound while posting a plus-minus total of plus-29 in 30 minutes played.

- Carr tied the school record for most 3-point FG made in a single game (10-15), equaling the mark of 10 set by Al Coleman vs. K-State on Jan. 12, 1997.
- This marked the first 40-point performance by a Texas player since Reggie Freeman scored 43 in a home win against Fresno State on Dec. 14, 1996.

- He tied the school record for most points scored in a half (33) in the first half. Jim Krivacs had 33 in the second half vs. Northern Montana on Nov. 27, 1978.
- Carr set the school record for most points scored in a FIRST half. The previous mark was 29 by B.J. Tyler in the first half at Baylor on Jan. 19, 1994.
- Carr set the school record for most 3-pointers made in a HALF with 8 in the first half. The old mark was 6, which was done seven time previously.
- Carr registered 33 points (11-15 FG, 8-11 threes, 3-4 FT) in 18 minutes of action during the first half.
- The 41 points tied for the eighth-highest single-game scoring total in UT history (record is 49, twice).
- The 41 points also tied for the fourth-highest single-game scoring total in a HOME game in UT history.

- Thru the first 13 games, he is second on the team in steals (13) and tied for third in rebounding (3.8 rpg) while averaging 4.5 ppg in 17.5 mpg.
- Cunningham has posted a **12-to-4** assist-to-turnover ratio and has converted 51.3-percent from the floor (20-39), including a 40.9-percent mark (9-22) from three-point range, and 9-of-11 (.818) free throws this year.
- Twenty-one (21) of his 49 rebounds have come off the offensive glass.
- Cunningham recorded a season-best 10 rebounds (five offensive), six points (2-4 FG, 2-2 FT) and two steals in a season-high 27 minutes against Rice (Dec. 12).
- He tallied a career-high 13 points (career-high 5-6 FG, career-best 3-3 threes) and three rebounds (all offensive) in 15 minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).

He was the MVP for Team Air in the Jordan Brand Classic in Chicago (April 15) and a member of the USA Nike Hoop Summit Team in the 23rd Nike Hoop Summit (April 8). Mitchell averaged 12.3 ppg, 10 rpg and 1.5 bpg as a senior while leading Montverde Academy (Fla.) to the GEICO Nationals title. He posted 17 points, 12 rebounds and three steals in the title game win.

- He has started each of the first 13 games and ranks second on the team in rebounding (5.0 rpg), tied for third in steals (11) and fifth in scoring (8.0 ppg) in 21.4 mpg.

- Anamekwe has seen action in eight of the first 13 games and is averaging 2.3 ppg and 0.9 rpg in 6.9 mpg. He has converted 8-of-13 (.615) field goals, including 2-of-3 from three-point range.
- He had five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 threes) and two rebounds in nine minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- Anamekwe tallied a season-high three boards in eight minutes against UTRGV (Nov. 26).
- He posted five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 threes) in 10 minutes against NAU (Nov. 21).
- Anamekwe grabbed two boards in a season-best 13 minutes against Houston Christian (Nov. 10).

PAIR OF MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

Freshmen **Dillon Mitchell** and **Arterio Morris** were two of the 24 players selected to compete in the 45th annual McDonald's All-American Game last March in Chicago.

- Mitchell and Morris became the 21st and 22nd players in UT history to play in the McDonald's All-American Game.
- This marked just the fifth time in program history that the Longhorns have had at least two signees named to the roster in the same year (2004, 2006, 2010, 2016 and 2022).

HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 10 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2022-23 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **SIXTH** nationally in most players on 2022-23 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 10 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Atlanta Hawks and Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Brooklyn Nets.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Tuesday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,067 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,195 of 1,203 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

HORNS INK PAIR OF TOP-15 NATIONAL RECRUITS

Ron Holland and **A.J. Johnson** both signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. Holland and Johnson will join the Longhorns for the 2023-24 season.

- **Ron Holland** (6-8, 200), a forward from Duncanville, Texas who has played at Duncanville HS under coach David Peavy for the previous three seasons, is ranked as the top prospect in the state of Texas and a top-10 national recruit. Holland is ranked as the No. 10 prospect nationally by ESPN and 247 Sports Composite.
- During his junior season in 2021-22, Holland averaged 15.9 ppg, 7.9 rpg, 2.9 apg and 2.0 spg in 23.9 mpg while leading Duncanville to a 35-1 overall record and the Class 6A state championship. He was tabbed as MaxPreps' National Junior of the Year last season. Holland helped Duncanville to the Class 6A state title in his sophomore year, and Duncanville was also a heavy favorite to win the state title in his freshman year before the state tourney was canceled due to COVID-19.
- **A.J. Johnson** (6-5, 165), a guard from Fresno, Calif., who currently plays at Southern California Academy for coach Julius Von Hanzlik, is ranked as the No. 7 prospect nationally by On3, No. 9 by Rivals, No. 14 by 247 Sports and No. 15 in the 247 Sports Composite.
- Johnson played his junior year in 2021-22 at Taft HS (Woodland Hills, Calif.). He averaged 16.7 ppg, 4.7 apg, 2.6 rpg and 2.5 spg as a junior while leading Taft to a 17-7 mark.

LOOK BACK AT OPENING NIGHT IN THE MOOD

- Texas opened **Moody Center** for basketball in style with a 72-57 victory against UTEP on Nov. 7.
- The 1,200-seat Corral (official UT men's basketball student section) was full one hour prior to tipoff, and several hundred additional students filled a SRO (standing room only) section in the upper balcony.
- The season opener was an official sellout with an attendance of 11,313.
- **Timmy Allen** notched the first points for the Longhorns in Moody Center history with an old-fashioned three-point play at the 17:58 mark.

He was head coach of the Chinese National Team for three years (2010-12), leading the team at the 2010 World Championships, the 2010 and 2011 Asian Games and the 2012 London Olympics. Donewald was head coach for the Xinjiang Flying Tigers in the CBA for one year (2011) and the Shanghai Sharks for two years (2009-11). He served as head coach of Dnipro Dnepropetrovsk in Ukraine for one season (2008-09) and Objetivo Sao Carlos in Brazil for two years (2005-07). Donewald was head coach and general manager of the Leicester Riders in the British Basketball League (BBL) for two seasons (1996-98), head coach of the Derby Storm for one year (1998-99) and head coach of the Greater London Leopards for two seasons (1999-2001).
- Special Assistant to the Head Coach (now serving as an Assistant Coach) **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- Managing Director **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) for three seasons (2018-21).

His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family. He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother (Brian Jr.) with raising him after the loss of his parents. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Gavin Perryman's** father, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant. His late grandfather, Dennis Perryman, was a longtime AD at Garden City Community College (Garden City, Kan.).
- **Sir'Jabari Rice** did not start playing basketball until his sophomore year of high school. He played football (wide receiver and quarterback) through his freshman year in high school. Jabari is the second-oldest of five children in his family. He earned his bachelor's degree in Individualized Studies from New Mexico State University in May 2022 and is pursuing postgraduate coursework at Texas.
