NOTABLES

• **LAST TEST BEFORE LEAGUE PLAY:** Texas hosts its final non-conference contest of the 2023-24 season before starting Big 12 Conference play on Jan. 6 against Texas Tech.

• **DEFENSE SETS THE TONE:** The Longhorns held UNCG to a season-low 37 points on 29.8-percent (14-47) FG shooting, including a 3-of-19 (.158) mark from three-point range. The Spartans entered the game ranked No. 13 nationally in 3-pointers made per game (10.5) and No. 14 in 3-point FG percentage (.395).

• **HUNTER STUFFS THE STAT SHEET:** Junior G Tyrese Hunter tallied a season-high 23 points (8-12 FG, 3-4 threes, 4-4 FT), tied his season high with seven assists against just one turnover and added six rebounds and one block in 29 minutes during Friday's victory over UNCG.

UTA SERIES INFO

- Monday’s game marks the 14th meeting between Texas and UTA.
- Each of the previous 13 contests have been held in Austin.
- UT holds a **12-1** lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 116-66 Texas win on Nov. 28, 1989.
- The Longhorns won the first 11 meetings in the series, before UTA posted a 72-61 victory on Nov. 29, 2016.
- In the most recent matchup between the two schools (Dec. 28, 2018), Texas claimed a 76-56 win.

BLESS THE MOOD, YEAR TWO

- Texas is **24-1** all-time in games played in Moody Center.
- In the first year of Moody Center, the Longhorns registered a 16-1 mark. Texas went 6-0 against AP Top 25 opponents, including a 3-0 record against AP Top 10 foes last seasons with wins over No. 2 Gonzaga, No. 3 Kansas and No. 7 Creighton.
- The Longhorns have played in front of a sellout crowd in 18 of the 25 contests in Moody Center history.
- The \$375 million world-class arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is the first of its kind in the industry with an unrivaled partnership between Oak View Group (OVG), Live Nation/C3 Presents, The University of Texas and the MOC (Minister of Culture) Matthew McConaughey.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university’s history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court. The seating capacity for the Corral is 1,100.
- There is also an overflow standing-room only section (the Upper Corral) in the upper concourse that can fit approximately 550 students.

IN THE POLLS

- Texas is ranked No. **21** in the latest AP poll (Dec. 25) and No. **24** in the latest USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll (Dec. 25).
- The Longhorns have now been ranked in the top 25 of The AP poll for **34** consecutive weeks, dating back to the rankings on Jan. 31, 2022.
- Texas began the 2023-24 season ranked No. 18 in the preseason AP poll and No. 18 in the preseason USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.

UNC GREENSBORO RECAP

- UT led from start-to-finish for the fourth time this season (12 games) and the third time in the last four contests.
- UNCG entered the game ranked No. 13 nationally in three-pointers made per game (10.5) and No. 14 in three-point FG percentage (.395). Texas held the Spartans to 3-of-19 (.158) from three-point range.
- The Longhorns forced opponent team season lows in points (37), field goals made (14), field goals attempted (47), three-point field goal percentage (.158), free throws made (6) and free throw percentage (.353).
- UT held UNCG to a season-low 37 points (previous was 58 vs. UIC on Nov. 26) on 29.8-percent (14-47) field goal shooting. Texas allowed just six assists and forced 16 turnovers.
- Texas converted 10-of-23 (.435) from three-point range on the evening. This marked the fifth time this season (12 games) that the Longhorns have reached double digits in three-pointers made.
- UT registered a 20-6 advantage in points off turnovers.
- The Longhorns limited UNCG to 22 points on 34.6-percent (9-26) field goal shooting, including a 2-of-11 (.182) mark from three-point range, in the opening 20 minutes.
- UT posted a 36-15 scoring margin in the second half. The Longhorns held UNCG to 15 points on 23.8-percent (5-21) field goal shooting, including a 1-of-8 (.125) mark from three-point range, over the final 20 minutes.
- Max Abmas** reached double figures in scoring (10 points) for the 12th time this year (12 games) and 124th time in his career (135 games). Abmas has reached double figures in scoring in 34 consecutive contests.
- Dylan Disu** set his season high in three-point FG made (3-4).
- Tyrese Hunter** set his season high in scoring (23 points) and tied his season highs in assists (7), FG made (8-12), three-point FG made (3-4) and FT made (4-4). Hunter topped the 20-point mark for the first time this year (12 games) and seventh time in his career (85 games). He reached double

digits in scoring for the 10th time this year and 50th time in his career. Hunter committed just one turnover in 29 minutes. In 18 minutes of action in the first half, he recorded 16 points (6-9 FG, 2-2 threes, 2-2 FT), five assists without a turnover and four rebounds.

- **Dillon Mitchell** tied his career high in blocked shots (4). He registered a team-best plus-minus total of plus-34 in 25 minutes of action.
- **Devon Pryor** recorded his first collegiate points on a three-pointer with 1:19 remaining in the contest.
- **Kadin Shedrick** reached double figures in scoring (11 points) for the seventh time this year (11 games) and 29th time in his career (87 games).

TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of 37 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (39-40 overall record).
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 29 of the last 34 NCAA tourneys.
- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 21 of the last 24 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four three times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of eight times and the Sweet 16 a total of 14 times.

2022-23 IN QUICK REVIEW

- Texas completed the 2022-23 season with a **29-9** overall record (12-6 Big 12, second) and ranked No. 5 in the final AP poll and No. 7 in the final USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.
- The Longhorns advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight for the first time since 2008 and eighth time in program history (also their first trip to the NCAA's second weekend since 2008).
- UT captured its second Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship title in program history, earning a 76-56 win over No. 3 Kansas in the championship game in Kansas City.
- The 29 wins were the third-most in a single season in program history.
- Texas compiled a 10-7 record against AP Top 25 opponents, and the 10 wins were the most in the nation against AP-ranked foes. The 10 wins against AP-ranked opponents also set a school single-season record (previous: 8-5 in 2003-04).

- UT spent all 19 weeks of the AP poll in the top 12, including 17 consecutive weeks in the top 10. That marked the longest such stretch since Texas was in the top 10 for all 19 polls during the 2002-03 Final Four season.
- The Longhorns were one of three teams to rank in the top 15 in KenPom in both adjusted offensive and defensive efficiency. Texas (15 offense, 13 defense) was joined by UConn (3 offense, 7 defense) and Houston (11 offense, 5 defense).

OUR GUY, RT - YEAR TWO

- **Rodney Terry** was named the 26th head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on his 55th birthday - March 27, 2023. Terry was tabbed Acting Head Coach a few hours prior to the Dec. 12, 2022 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2022-23 season on Jan. 5.
- A former head coach at Fresno State and UTEP for a combined 10 years, he sports an overall head coaching record of **195-166** (.540) in **12** seasons.
- Terry was tabbed the 2023 Sporting News National Coach of the Year, becoming the first coach in program history to earn the prestigious honor. He also was named the Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Division I Coach of the Year by the National Sports Media Association (NSMA).
- Terry, who has 28 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. The Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003). Texas also claimed two Big 12 Conference regular-season titles (2006 and 2008).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.

- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

TERRY AT TEXAS

- Now in his second year as the head coach at Texas, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **32-10 (.762)** record.
- Terry is **8-8** against AP Top 25 opponents while at Texas.
- Texas is **9-1** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.

HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE ON THE STAFF

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **46** years of **Division I collegiate head coaching** experience.
- Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **11-plus** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18) in addition to his one previous year at Texas.
- Assistant Coach **Frank Haith** has **18** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) for seven seasons (2004-11), Missouri for three years (2011-14) and Tulsa for eight seasons (2014-22).
- Assistant Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- General Manager **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at UTA for three seasons (2018-21).

BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

- The Longhorns were picked to finish **third** in the league's preseason coaches' poll. Kansas claimed the top spot, receiving 12 first-place votes and 168 points. Houston tallied the remaining two first-place votes and 153 points. Texas was slotted in third with 143 points.
- Rounding out slots four through 14 in the poll in descending order were Baylor (137), TCU (113), Kansas State (106), Iowa State (95), Texas Tech (80), West Virginia (70), Oklahoma State (57), Cincinnati (55), Oklahoma (54), BYU (29) and UCF (14).

GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2023-24 Texas roster includes **five** players who have already earned their undergraduate degrees: Max Abmas, Brock Cunningham, Dylan Disu, Ithiel Horton and Kadin Shedrick.
- **Seven** individuals have played in at least **74** career games and **four** players have started at least **84** career contests.
- **Two** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Max Abmas** (2,767 points) and **Ithiel Horton** (1,278 points).
- The **12** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **871** games played (**556** starts).

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Texas has topped the **80-point** mark in six of its first 12 games and is averaging 79.2 ppg while hitting at a 49.2-percent (349-710) clip from the floor, including a 37.0-percent (88-238) mark from three-point range, this season.
- Five Longhorns are averaging in double figures in scoring (all over 11.3 ppg).
- Six Texas players have registered at least **17** points in a game, and four UT players have recorded at least **21** points in a contest this season.
- The Longhorns have reached double digits in three-point field goals made a total of **five** times in their first 12 games this year (5-0 record in those contests).
- Texas recorded a season-high 96 points while converting 54.2-percent (32-59) from the floor, including a 50-percent (10-20) mark from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) free throws in the 96-85 win over LSU (Dec. 16) in Houston.
- UT hit 55.7-percent (34-61) from the floor in the 86-63 victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- The Longhorns converted 60.4-percent (29-48) from the floor, including a 45.5-percent mark (10-22) from three-point range, in their 80-64 win over Rice (Nov. 15).

SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- The Longhorns have converted 73.5-percent (164-223) from the free throw line through their first 12 contests this season.
- During the win in Houston over LSU (Dec. 16), Texas hit 88.0-percent (22-25) from the free throw line. **The Longhorns went a perfect 12-of-12 from the stripe in the second half.** This marked the 11th time in program history (since the 1965-66 season) that Texas was perfect from the line in a half while attempting at least 10 free throws.
- UT converted a season-high 92.3-percent (12-13) from the free throw line in the home victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).

SAY HELLO TO MID-COURT MAX

Graduate G **Max Abmas** (pronounced: ACE-miss) has played and started **135** career games during his five years at Oral Roberts and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of **2,767** points, **446** assists, **445** rebounds and **148** steals. Abmas has reached double figures in scoring **124** times, topped the 20-point mark **71** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **18** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career. He has reached double digits in points in **34** consecutive games.

- In his first 12 contests at Texas, he leads the team in scoring (17.1 ppg) and minutes (33.5 mpg) and is second in assists (50). Abmas has hit 46.2-percent (73-158) from the floor, including a 38.8-percent (33-85) mark from three-point range, and 89.7-percent (26-29) from the free throw line. He also sports a **1.92-to-1** (50-26) assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Abmas registered a game-high 17 points (5-10 FG, 6-7 FT) and five assists in 37 minutes against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 22).
- He tallied a team-high 20 points (6-13 FG, 4-9 threes, 4-4 FT), seven assists and a season-high six rebounds in 35 minutes against LSU in Houston (Dec. 16).
- Abmas posted a game-high 16 points (7-12 FG) and a season-high seven assists against just one turnover in 30 minutes against Houston Christian (Dec. 9).
- He recorded a team-high 25 points (10-19 FG, 3-8 threes, 2-2 FT), three boards and two steals in 38 minutes at No. 8/7 Marquette (Dec. 6).
- Abmas tallied a season-high 26 points (9-18 FG, 5-12 threes, 3-3 FT) and six assists against just one turnover in 38 minutes against Texas State (Nov. 30).
- He registered a game-high 23 points (8-14 FG, 3-6 threes, 4-4 FT), three assists and four boards in 32 minutes vs. Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- Abmas posted 10 points and five assists against one turnover in 35 minutes against No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20).
- He recorded 14 points in 38 minutes against Louisville (Nov. 19). Abmas knocked down the game-winning jumper from the right elbow with 0.4 seconds left.
- Abmas tallied 13 points (5-9 FG, 3-6 threes), five boards and four assists in 27 minutes against Rice (Nov. 15).
- He had a team-high 19 points (6-12 FG, 4-8 threes, 3-3 FT) and five assists in 35 minutes against Delaware St. (Nov. 10).
- Abmas posted 12 points (5-10 FG, 2-4 threes), five rebounds, three assists and one steal in 30 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).
- Abmas earned his BS in Mathematics from Oral Roberts in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication.

DISU'S DOMAIN

Graduate F **Dylan Disu** has played in **114** career games (**84** starts) during his five seasons at Vanderbilt and Texas. He has registered career totals of **945** points, **589** rebounds and **122** blocked shots. In his career, Disu has reached double figures in scoring **48** times, including **four** 20-point performances, and double digits in rebounds **19** times. He has tallied **15** career double-doubles.

- In his first three games this year since returning from injury (missed the first nine contests due to left foot surgery), he has averaged 12.3 ppg, 3.3 rpg and 1.3 bpg in 20.9 mpg. He has converted 50-percent (12-24) from the floor, including 4-of-5 (.800) threes, and 9-of-9 free throws.
- Disu recorded nine points (season-best 3-of-4 threes) in 20 minutes against UNCG (Dec. 29).

- He tallied 11 points (5-9 FG, 1-1 threes), four boards and three blocks in 22 minutes against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 22).

Shedrick has converted **63.4**-percent (211-333) from the floor and **73.4**-percent (157-214) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **29** times, including **two** 20-point efforts, and double digits in rebounds **five** times in his career and registered **five** career double-doubles. A two-time All-ACC Academic Team selection (2022 and 2023), Shedrick has two years of eligibility remaining as he redshirted the 2019-20 season.

- In his first 12 games (three starts) at Texas, Onyema is third on the team in blocks (12), tied for sixth in rebounding (2.9 rpg) and eighth in scoring (4.8 ppg) in 12.9 mpg. He has converted 57.1-percent (24-42) from the floor this season.
- He tied his career high with three blocks to go along with seven boards (three offensive) and four points in 12 minutes against Wyoming (Nov. 26).

- Freshman G **Devon Pryor** (pronounced: duh-VONN) reclassified academically to join the Longhorns for the 2023-24 season. He played his junior year of high school at PSAT-XEA Academy in Houston and was tabbed No. 21 in the state of Texas, No. 45 among all small forwards and No. 209 nationally by 247 Sports in the final Class of 2023 rankings.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Monday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,104 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,232 of 1,240 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 11 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2023-24 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **FIFTH** nationally in most players on 2023-24 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 11 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets.

STAFF INKS IMPRESSIVE FALL SIGNING CLASS

A trio of top-45 national recruits signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period. **Tre Johnson**, **Cam Scott** and **Nic Codie** will join the Longhorns for the 2024-25 season. The three-man class is currently No. 4 nationally in the Class of 2024 team rankings by 247 Sports Composite.

- **Tre Johnson** (6-6, 190), a guard from Dallas, Texas, who plays at Link Academy (Branson, Mo.), is ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 4 by Rivals, No. 4 by 247 Sports and No. 4 by 247 Sports Composite. He played at Lake Highlands HS in Dallas during his freshman through junior seasons. As a junior in 2022-23, Johnson averaged 21.8 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while leading Lake Highlands to a 34-3 record and the UIL Class 6A state championship. The National Junior of the Year by MaxPreps and Mr. Basketball in the state of Texas last year, he converted 53-percent from the floor, including a 42-percent mark from three-point range, and 91-percent from the free throw line as a junior. Johnson surpassed the 2,000-career point mark during the quarterfinals of the state tourney last year and recorded a game-high 29 points in his team's 55-44 victory over Beaumont United HS in the Class 6A state title game. Lake Highlands won its first state championship in boys' basketball since 1968.
- **Cam Scott** (6-5, 185), a guard from Lexington, S.C., who plays at Lexington HS, is ranked as the No. 24 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 27 by 247 Sports Composite, No. 29 by On3, No. 30 by Rivals and No. 37 by 247 Sports. In his junior year in 2022-23, he averaged 19.2 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.4 steals per game while leading Lexington to a 20-7 record and a trip to the Class AAAAA state semifinals. Scott was named the South Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year following his junior season. He earned co-MVP honors in June at the Pangos All-American Camp in Las Vegas after averaging 24.6 points per game while hitting 57-percent from three-point range.
- **Nic Codie** (6-8, 200), a forward from Carrollton, Texas who plays at Newman Smith HS, is ranked as the No. 40 prospect in the nation by On3, No. 41 by Rivals, No. 45 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 46 by 247 Sports. The top-ranked player in the state of Texas in the Class of 2024, Codie averaged 16 points and nine rebounds per game as a junior in 2022-23 while leading Newman Smith to a 22-8 record and the District 9-5A championship.

- **Max Abmas** earned his BS in Mathematics from Oral Roberts in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication. His father, Troy, works in cybersecurity and his mother, Erika, is a respiratory therapist. Max is interested in the field of forensics in his post-basketball career.
- **Alex Anamekwe** enjoys writing and has the desire to become an author. Both of his parents (father, Nnamdi; and mother, Kelechi) are from Nigeria. Kelechi ran track in Nigeria during her youth.
- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play basketball while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Brock Cunningham's** father, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989. Brock graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising and he is on pace to earn his master's degree in Advertising in Spring 2024.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville). Dylan earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.
- **Ithiel Horton** is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 9. In Hebrew, the name "Ithiel" means "God is with me." His mother, Hattie, is an evangelist, and his father, Kevin, plays the organ in church. His uncle, Lenny Horton, played basketball at Georgia Tech. His uncle, Brian Horton, played basketball at Fairleigh Dickinson and Morgan State.
- **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family (eight brothers and three sisters). He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother, Brian Jr., with raising him after the loss of his parents. Annie passed away this spring. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Ze'Rik Onyema** has previously lived in Savannah, Ga.; Houston, Texas; Germany; El Paso, Texas; San Antonio, Texas; and Hawaii. His father, Kingsley, is a native of Owerri, Nigeria. Kingsley works in logistics for the U.S. Army and is based at the Pentagon. His mother, Mary, is an eighth-grade teacher. - **Kadin Shedrick** has a younger sister, Kari, who plays softball at Radford University (Radford, Va.). He played baseball as his primary sport until the age of 15. Kadin grew from 6-2 to 6-8 between his freshman and sophomore year of high school. His mother, Cindy, competed for the club Rowing team at the University of Cincinnati.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21) and one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022).

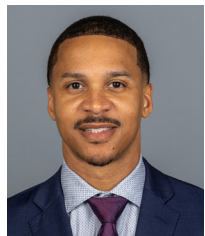
