### GAMEDAY QUICK FACTS

- **TELEVISION:** The game will be televised nationally by ESPN2. Mark Neely (pxp) and Chris Spatola (analyst) will call the action.
- **RADIO:** The Longhorn IMG Radio Network broadcasts every UT game on the statewide network. Craig Way (pxp) and Eddie Oran (analyst) will call the action. Check TexasSports.com for a listing of affiliates carrying the game.
- **SERIES:** K-State leads, 24-21. Last meeting: K-State 116-103 (Jan. 3, 2023; Austin).

### NOTABLES

- **SOLID START:** UT's 18-4 record marks its best 22-game start since the 2010-11 season (19-3). The 7-2 record in Big 12 play marks its best 9-game start in league action since the 2013-14 season (7-2). Texas is 7-4 in Quad 1 contests this year entering Saturday's game.
- **THE TERRY EFFECT:** Since moving into the role of Interim Head Coach, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to an 11-3 record entering Saturday's game. Texas is 5-0 under Terry in games decided by five points or less or in overtime in this stretch.
- **COOKING WITH RICE:** Graduate G **Sir'Jabari Rice** has averaged 21.0 points per game while hitting 13-of-23 (.565) field goals, including 7-of-14 (.500) from three-point range, and 9-of-12 (.750) free throws over the last two contests. He tied his season high with 21 points (for the second-straight game) while converting 5-of-7 field goals, including 4-of-5 threes, and 7-of-8 free throws and added six rebounds in 24 minutes during Monday's home win against No. 11/11 Baylor.

**Interim Head Coach:** Rodney Terry, 11-3 at Texas (1st year); 174-159 overall (11th year)

## SOLID START

- Texas is off to an 18-4 start (7-2 Big 12 Conference) and currently stands at No. 9 in the NCAA's NET ranking and No. 10 in KenPom.
- The 18-4 record marks UT's **best 22-game start** since the 2010-11 season (19-3).
- The 7-2 record in Big 12 play marks UT's best 9-game start in league action since the 2013-14 season (7-2).
- The Longhorns are 7-4 in **Quad 1** games this year.
- Texas is 4-3 against AP Top 25 opponents this season with wins over No. 2 Gonzaga (93-74), No. 7 Creighton (72-67), No. 17 TCU (79-75) and No. 11 Baylor (76-71).
- UT is 4-0 against AP Top 20 opponents at Moody Center this year.
- The Longhorns are 3-2 in true road games and 5-3 overall in contests played away from Austin (2-1 in neutral-site games).
- Since West Virginia joined the Big 12 prior to the 2012-13 season, this marks the **first** time that Texas has posted wins **AT** Oklahoma, Oklahoma State **AND** West Virginia in the same year.
- **Eleven** of the 18 victories have been by at least **10** points, and the Longhorns have posted a **+12.2** scoring margin this year (79.9-67.7).

## KANSAS STATE SERIES INFO

- Saturday's game marks the 46th meeting between Texas and K-State.
- The Wildcats hold a 24-21 lead in the all-time series which dates back to an 87-60 K-State win in Manhattan on Dec. 8, 1971.
- **UT has won five of the last seven and six of the last nine meetings in the series entering Saturday's contest.**
- The Wildcats claimed a 116-103 victory in Austin earlier this season (Jan. 3).

## BAYLOR RECAP

- The Longhorns snapped a six-game losing streak to Baylor with the victory. Prior to the win, the last time Texas defeated the Bears was an 84-72 victory in Austin on Feb. 6, 2019.
- UT claimed a 30-6 advantage in bench scoring.
- Texas recorded 14 assists against just nine turnovers on the evening.
- The Longhorns converted 53.8-percent (14-26) from the floor and hit 8-of-11 (.727) free throws in the opening 20 minutes while building a 38-36 halftime advantage.
- UT limited Baylor to 34.4-percent (11-32) field goal shooting, including a 2-of-11 (.182) mark from three-point range, in the second half.
- **Timmy Allen** reached double figures in scoring (18 points) for the 13th time this year (22 games) and 106th time in his career (141 games).
- **Marcus Carr** recorded a team-best plus-minus total of plus-13 in 29 minutes played.
- **Dylan Disu** set season highs in free throws made (3-4) and minutes played (29).
- **Tyrese Hunter** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the 12th time this year (22 games) and 32nd time in his career (57 games). He tied his season high in steals (3).

- **Sir'Jabari Rice** tied his season high in scoring (game-high 21 points) for the second-straight game. He also posted 21 points at No. 4/4 Tennessee (Jan. 28). Rice set his season high in three-point field goals made (4-5). He was one shy of his season high in both rebounds (6) and free throws made (7-8). His four 3-point field goals made were one shy of his collegiate best (5 at Dixie State on March 5, 2021).
- Rice topped the 20-point mark for the second-straight game, the second time this year (22 games) and 14th time in his career (133 games). He reached double figures in scoring for the 12th time this season and 70th time in his career. In 14 minutes of action in the second half, Rice posted 15 points while hitting 4-of-6 field goals, including 4-of-5 threes, and 3-of-4 free throws.

## IN THE POLLS

- The Longhorns are ranked No. **10** in the latest AP poll (Jan. 30) and No. **9** in the latest USA TODAY Sports coaches' poll (Jan. 30).
- Texas climbed to as high as No. 2 in both polls earlier this year (Nov. 28 and Dec. 5). This marked the highest ranking in The AP poll for the Longhorns since UT was ranked No. 1 in consecutive polls on Jan. 11 and Jan. 18, 2010.

## INTERIM HEAD COACH RODNEY TERRY

- **Rodney Terry** was named Acting Head Coach at The University of Texas a few hours prior to the Dec. 12 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the season on Jan. 5.
- **He has posted an 11-3 mark as Interim Head Coach** this season and now sports an overall career record of **174-159** (.523).
- Terry, who has 27 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- Terry was a former head coach at UTEP and Fresno State for a combined 10 seasons, where he compiled an overall record of 163-156 (.511).

- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. During those nine years, the Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. The two-person class of Cory Joseph and Tristan Thompson was the No. 8 recruiting class in the nation by ESPN. UT's three-person freshman class in 2009 was ranked No. 3 nationally by Rivals and No. 4 by ESPNU. The seven-man freshman class in 2006 was tabbed as the No. 3 class in the country by Rivals and Scout. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.
- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

#### STAFF FULL OF HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **45** years of head coaching experience at the collegiate, international and professional levels of basketball.
- Interim Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **10** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18).
- Assistant Coach **Bob Donewald Jr.** has **18** years of head coaching experience at the professional and international levels. He was head coach of the PBC Lokomotiv Kuban in Russia for one year (2018-19) and head coach for the Jilin Northeast Tigers in the Chinese Basketball Association for one season (2016-17). Donewald served as head coach of the Iowa Energy in the NBA D League for two years (2014-16). He was head coach of the Chinese National Team for three years (2010-12), leading the team at the 2010 World Championships, the 2010 and 2011 Asian Games and the 2012 London Olympics. Donewald was head coach for the Xinjiang Flying Tigers in the CBA for one year (2011) and the Shanghai Sharks for two years (2009-11). He served as head coach of Dnipro Dnepropetrovsk in Ukraine for one season (2008-09) and Objetivo Sao Carlos in Brazil for two years (2005-07). Donewald was head coach and general manager of the Leicester Riders in the British Basketball League (BBL) for two seasons (1996-98), head coach of the Derby Storm for one year

(1998-99) and head coach of the Greater London Leopards for two seasons (1999-2001).

- Special Assistant to the Head Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- Assistant Coach **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) for three seasons (2018-21).

#### GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2022-23 Texas roster includes **SIX** players who are either graduate students, super seniors or seniors: Timmy Allen (super senior), Christian Bishop (super senior), Marcus Carr (graduate student), Brock Cunningham (graduate student), Dylan Disu (senior) and Sir'Jabari Rice (graduate student).
- **FOUR** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Marcus Carr** (2,115 points), **Timmy Allen** (1,971 points), **Sir'Jabari Rice** (1,348 points) and **Christian Bishop** (1,110 points).
- The **SEVEN** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **818** games played (**569** starts).

#### EPIC COMEBACK vs. No. 17/17 TCU

- In UT's 79-75 home win against No. 17/17 TCU (Jan. 11), the Longhorns trailed by as much as **18** points (40-22) with 2:57 left in the first half and faced a 12-point deficit (61-49) with 9:36 remaining in the contest.
- This marked the largest comeback for Texas since the Longhorns overcame a 22-point deficit (67-45) with 7:54 remaining in a 92-86 OT home win against Oklahoma on Feb. 27, 2013.
- After trailing 42-29 at the break, the Longhorns posted a 50-33 scoring margin in the second half. UT converted 59.4-percent (19-32) from the floor and 83.3-percent (10-12) from the free throw line in the final 20 minutes.

#### HISTORY-MAKING WIN vs. No. 2/2 GONZAGA

- Texas **tied** a program record for defeating the highest-ranked AP opponent in school history with its 93-74 win over No. 2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).
- This marked the **fourth** time in school history that the Longhorns have topped the No. 2 team in The AP poll.
- Texas previously defeated No. 2 Louisville (74-70) on Nov. 30, 1986 in the seventh-place game at the Great Alaska Shootout (Anchorage, Alaska). The Longhorns beat No. 2 UCLA (63-61) on Dec. 2, 2007 at Pauley Pavilion. UT also topped No. 2 Oklahoma (73-68) on Feb. 21, 2009 in Austin.



## DEFENSE WINS

- The Longhorns have allowed 251 assists while forcing 352 turnovers (16.0 tpg) this year. UT has forced at least **15** turnovers in **16** of its first 22 contests.
- **Texas has recorded a 404-215 advantage in points off turnovers this season.**
- Texas held Houston Christian to 31 points in the home win (Nov. 10). The 31 points is tied for the second-fewest points allowed by the Longhorns in program history.
- The Longhorns held HCU to 21.7-percent FG shooting (13-60) in the contest. This marked the **fourth**-lowest FG percentage allowed by Texas since the 1960-61 season and lowest since Texas State converted 21.6-percent (11-51) on Dec. 13, 2014.
- UT held Creighton (Dec. 1) to 67 points on 40.9-percent (27-66) FG shooting, including a 14.8-percent mark (4-27) from three-point range. Creighton entered the game averaging 83.9 points per contest while converting 51.2-percent FG, including a 38.2-percent mark from three-point range.

## GETTING OFFENSIVE

- The Longhorns are averaging **79.9** ppg and have converted **48.1**-percent (644-1339) from the floor this season. The last time Texas averaged **more** than 80 ppg was the 2009-10 season (**81.2** ppg).
- **Texas topped the century mark** for the first time since the 2017-18 season opener with its 100-72 home victory against Louisiana (Dec. 21). It marked the first 100-point effort for the Longhorns since UT claimed a 105-59 home win over Northwestern State on Nov. 10, 2017.
- The Longhorns topped 100 points for the **second** time in a **four**-game stretch during the 116-103 loss to K-State (Jan. 3).
- UT has hit at least 50-percent from the floor in **10** of its first **22** contests this year.
- The Longhorns converted 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor, including a season-best **61.5-percent** (8-13) from three-point range, in the 89-75 home win against Oklahoma State (Jan. 24). The Cowboys entered the contest ranked fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense (37.3).
- **The Longhorns have posted a 292-135 advantage in fast-break points this year.**

## SHARING THE ROCK

- Texas has averaged **16.6** assists per game and sports an impressive 1.4 **TEAM** assist-to-turnover ratio (365 assists, 262 turnovers) this season.
- The Longhorns registered a season-high 30 assists (on 37 made field goals) against nine turnovers versus UAPB (Dec. 10).
- UT posted 22 assists (on 28 made field goals) against eight turnovers versus Stanford (Dec. 18).
- Texas had 23 assists on 36 made field goals against Louisiana (Dec. 21). Five different Longhorns posted at least three assists.
- The Longhorns registered 28 assists (on 37 made field goals) against 10 turnovers versus Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27).

## SUCCESS AT THE FREE THROW LINE

- Through its first 22 games, Texas has converted at a **74.6**-percent (312-418) clip from the free throw line.
- In the 13 games under Interim Head Coach Rodney Terry, the Longhorns have hit **78.9**-percent (220-279) as a team from the free throw line.
- **In Big 12 play**, Texas **leads** the conference in team free throw shooting percentage at **80.7**-percent (155-192).

## A LIGHTER, QUICKER CARR

Graduate G **Marcus Carr** has played in 148 career games (141 starts) during his time at Minnesota, Pittsburgh and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of **2,115** points, 683 assists and 501 rebounds. Carr has reached double figures in scoring **104** times, topped the 20-point mark **31** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **six** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career.

- Through the first 22 games, Carr leads the team in scoring (16.7 ppg), assists (89), steals (38) and minutes (32.0 mpg).
- He has posted an impressive 2.41 assist-to-turnover ratio (89-37) and has converted 45.3-percent (126-278) from the field, including a 40.2-percent (53-132) mark from three-point range, and 80.8-percent (63-78) from the free throw line.
- Carr tallied a game-high 21 points (7-11 FG, 2-2 threes, 5-7 FT), five assists, four rebounds and three steals in 36 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 24).
- He had a game-high 23 points (8-14 FG, 5-6 FT) and three steals in 37 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 21). Carr had 19 points (6-8 FG, 2-3 threes, 5-6 FT) in 19 minutes in the second half.
- Carr registered 11 points, four assists and three boards in 36 minutes at No. 12/12 Iowa State (Jan. 17).
- He posted a team-high 20 points, six rebounds and three assists against one turnover in 33 minutes against Texas Tech (Jan. 14).
- Carr recorded 11 points, five boards, seven assists against just one turnover and two steals in 35 minutes against No. 17/17 TCU (Jan. 11). His 3-pointer with 1:01 remaining gave the Longhorns the lead for good at 76-73.
- He posted a team-high 12 points (2-5 threes, 2-2 FT) and four assists in 38 minutes at Oklahoma State (Jan. 7).
- Carr tallied 27 points (10-17 FG, 4-10 threes, 3-3 FT), a season-high six rebounds and a team-high six assists in 36 minutes against K-State (Jan. 3).
- He claimed his **second Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week accolade** (Jan. 2) in a three-week span for his performances against Texas A&M-Commerce and Oklahoma. Carr averaged 27.0 ppg, 3.0 apg and 3.0 spg in 32.5 mpg while hitting 17-of-31 FG (.548), including 12-of-18 (.667) threes, and 8-of-9 FT and posting six assists against two turnovers.
- He recorded 13 points (2-3 threes, 3-3 FT) and tied his career high with four steals in 36 minutes at Oklahoma (Dec. 31). He hit a pair of free throws with 3.3 seconds left to seal the win.
- Carr registered 17 points (5-9 FG, 3-3 threes, 4-4 FT) and four assists in 24 minutes against Louisiana (Dec. 21).
- He earned **Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week honors** (Dec. 19) for his efforts in the wins against Rice (Dec. 12) and Stanford (Dec. 18). Carr averaged 22.5 ppg, 4.0 apg and 3.0 rpg in 37.3 mpg while converting 15-of-29 FG (.517), including 6-of-13 (.462) threes, and 9-of-12 FT (.750) in the two contests.

- Carr had a team-high 17 points (6-13 FG, 3-4 FT), five assists against one turnover and three boards in 33 minutes against Stanford (Dec. 18). He had 15 of his 17 points in the second half (5-7 FG, 2-4 threes, 3-4 FT) and five assists without a turnover.
- He recorded 28 points (9-16 FG, 4-7 threes, 6-8 FT), three assists and three rebounds in a season-high 42 minutes against Rice (Dec. 12). In the overtime session, he posted a team-high eight points (2-2 FG, 4-4 FT) and one assist without a turnover.

#### HORNS IN THE NBA

- Texas ranked in a tie for **SIXTH** nationally in most players on 2022-23 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 10 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Atlanta Hawks and Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Brooklyn Nets.



### IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,076 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,204 of 1,212 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

### HORNS INK PAIR OF TOP-15 NATIONAL RECRUITS

**Ron Holland** and **A.J. Johnson** both signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. Holland and Johnson will join the Longhorns for the 2023-24 season.

- **Ron Holland** (6-8, 200), a forward from Duncanville, Texas who has played at Duncanville HS under coach David Peavy for the previous three seasons, is ranked as the top prospect in the state of Texas and a top-10 national recruit. Holland is ranked as the No. 10 prospect nationally by ESPN and 247 Sports Composite.
- Holland is one of 24 players selected to compete in the 46th annual **McDonald's All-American Game** on March 28 in Houston. Holland will become the **23rd** player in UT program history to play in the McDonald's All-American Game.
- During his junior season in 2021-22, Holland averaged 15.9 ppg, 7.9 rpg, 2.9 apg and 2.0 spg in 23.9 mpg while leading Duncanville to a 35-1 overall record and the Class 6A state championship. He was tabbed as MaxPreps' National Junior of the Year last season.
- **A.J. Johnson** (6-5, 165), a guard from Fresno, Calif., who currently plays at Southern California Academy for coach Julius Von Hanzlik, is ranked as the No. 7 prospect nationally by On3, No. 9 by Rivals, No. 14 by 247 Sports and No. 15 in the 247 Sports Composite.
- Johnson played his junior year in 2021-22 at Taft HS (Woodland Hills, Calif.). He averaged 16.7 ppg, 4.7 apg, 2.6 rpg and 2.5 spg as a junior while leading Taft to a 17-7 mark.

### BLESS THE MOOD

- The Longhorns have moved into Moody Center, the new home of Texas Basketball.
- Texas is **12-1** in games played at Moody Center in the 2022-23 season.
- **UT has had a sellout crowd in EACH of its first 13 contests in Moody Center this year** and is averaging **10,942** fans per game in Moody (capacity: 10,763).
- The \$375 million world-class arena is located on campus and will play host to Texas Men's and Women's Basketball games, graduations, concerts and other events.
- The arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is the first of its kind in the industry with an unrivaled partnership between Oak View Group (OVG), Live Nation/C3 Presents, The University of Texas and the MOC (Minister of Culture) Matthew McConaughey.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

### THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, Texas Basketball and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section, **The Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court in the lower bowl.

### LOOK BACK AT OPENING NIGHT IN THE MOOD

- Texas opened **Moody Center** for basketball in style with a 72-57 victory against UTEP on Nov. 7.
- The 1,200-seat Corral (official UT men's basketball student section) was full one hour prior to tipoff, and several hundred additional students filled a SRO (standing room only) section in the upper balcony.
- The season opener was an official sellout with an attendance of 11,313.
- **Timmy Allen** notched the first points for the Longhorns in Moody Center history with an old-fashioned three-point play at the 17:58 mark.

## DID YOU KNOW ...



- **Timmy Allen** has four reasons for his why: his mother, his two brothers and himself. His mom, Elise Allen, passed away after a seven-year battle with breast cancer on Dec. 3, 2016 at the age of 49 (during Timmy's junior year of high school). Timmy has two older brothers, Nick and Teddy. Teddy played college basketball at West Virginia, Western Nebraska Community College, Nebraska and New Mexico State. His godfather, Ray Arvizu, has served as a father figure to Timmy for the last decade. Timmy is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Alex Anamekwe** enjoys writing and has the desire to become an author. Both of his parents (father, Nnamdi; and mother, Kelechi) are from Nigeria. Kelechi ran track in Nigeria during her youth.
- **Christian Bishop** was born in Sacile, Italy. His father, Jerry Bishop, played basketball at Abilene Christian. His older brother, Grant, played basketball at Missouri Baptist. He wears jersey No. 32 to honor Jerry and Grant, who both wore the number. Christian is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play for a great basketball coach while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Rowan Brumbaugh** lived in New York City, Northampton, Mass., Brooklyn and Washington, D.C. during his childhood. His father, Sam Brumbaugh, played rugby at Trinity University in Hartford, Conn. His uncle, Peter Brumbaugh, played football at Tulane and UCLA. His grandfather, Fred Brumbaugh, was a boxer at Princeton.
- **Marcus Carr's** brother, Duane Notice, played on South Carolina's 2017 NCAA Final Four team and has gone on to play professionally internationally and with Raptors 905 (Toronto affiliate in the NBA G-League). Marcus graduated in August 2021 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in Human Resource Development and is pursuing a second degree in Communication & Leadership.
- **Brock Cunningham's** dad, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989. Brock graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising. He still has two years of eligibility remaining and is pursuing a master's degree in Advertising.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville). Dylan is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family. He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother (Brian Jr.) with raising him after the loss of his parents. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Gavin Perryman's** father, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant. His late grandfather, Dennis Perryman, was a longtime AD at Garden City Community College (Garden City, Kan.).
- **Sir'Jabari Rice** did not start playing basketball until his sophomore year of high school. He played football (wide receiver and quarterback) through his freshman year in high school. Jabari is the second-oldest of five children in his family. He earned his bachelor's degree in Individualized Studies from New Mexico State University in May 2022 and is pursuing postgraduate coursework at Texas.
