LONGHORNS NOTES

THE MATCHUP—The Longhorns conclude their season-long 14-game homestand, welcoming Texas Tech for the first Big 12 series of the season at UFCU Disch-Falk Field. Texas Tech has already begun league play, winning a series against Oklahoma State last weekend in Lubbock. The Longhorns have dropped the last two series to the Red Raiders, last season in Lubbock and in 2021 in Austin. Texas last series win over Texas Tech came in 2019 at UFCU Disch-Falk Field.

A LOOK AT THE LONGHORNS—Texas is riding an 11-game winning streak, outscoring opponents 110-41 during the streak. Over the last 11 games, Texas is hitting .326 as a team with 25 doubles and 18 homers. During the first 11 games of the season, the Longhorns went just 4-7 and batted .235 as a team with only 10 homers. The Texas pitching staff, which has been the team's strength through the first 22 games, has a 3.18 ERA and is holding opposing hitters to a .225 batting average with 222 strikeouts this season.

EK-In five games last week Eric Kennedy batted .550 with five home runs, two doubles, 10 RBI and nine runs scored. He had a pair of two-homer games and hit a grand slam in Saturday's win over New Orleans. Kennedy currently has a six-game hitting streak and multiple-hits in four of his last five games. This season Kennedy leads Texas with nine doubles, seven homers and 21 RBI. In addition to his power display, he also leads the team with five bunt singles this season.

POW!-Peyton Powell has had a great month of March, starting all 14 games and picking up at least one hit in 13-of-14, with multiple hits in nine of them. For the season, Powell leads the Longhorns with a .419 batting average and has six doubles, three homers, 15 RBI and 17 runs scored. His versatility has also been beneficial, as he has played first base, third base and catcher this season.

OWN THE DISCH—A large part of the Longhorns success under head coach David Pierce has come down to dominating at home. Since 2017 Texas has produced a 163-42 (.795) record at UFCU Disch-Falk Field, including a 14-2 mark this season. Since the stadium opened in 1975, Texas has gone 1594-402-3 at home for a .798 winning percentage. The fan base has also done a great job of making the Disch a difficult place to play. With the exception of the 2021 season because of limited capacity due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Texas has led the Big 12 in attendance for 15-consecutive seasons.

HOME SWEET HOME—Texas holds a 14-2 record this season at the friendly confines of UFCU Disch-Falk Field. In the 16 home games, the Longhorns are hitting .307 and fielding .977, while the pitching staff has a 2.88 ERA. Texas hitters have also walked more times than they have struck out in home games, with 86 walks to 82 strikeouts. In the six games played away from UFCU Disch-Falk Field, Texas holds a 1-5 record and is batting .218 with a .959 fielding percentage. The Longhorns are also averaging 6,578 fans per game, the fifth-highest average attendance in the country.

THE HOMESTAND—Texas has taken full advantage of its longest homestand in more than 20 years, starting 11-0 heading with three games remaining. During the homestand, the Longohrns have outscored their opponents 110-41. The full homestand spans a three-week stretch from March 7 and concludes with the opening Big 12 series against Texas Tech this weekend. This is the longest Texas homestand in more than 20 years and the longest since the Longhorns hosted 13-straight games at UFCU Disch-Falk Field in 2011. The last time Texas had a longer homerstand was in 2001, when Texas played 21-straight home games from February 6 to March 13. This is the program's eighth homestand of at least 10 games since 2001.

LONGHORNS NOTES

INFIELD HIT MACHINE—Throughout his career on the Forty Acres, Eric Kennedy has used his speed as a means to get on base. With six infield singles (five bunt) this season, Kennedy now has 64 career infield singles (36 bunts). In 2021, Kennedy had a career-best 27 infield singles (16 bunts).

DOWNTOWN PORTER BROWN—Porter Brown has made an immediate impact after transferring from TCU. The redshirt junior is tied for second on the team with five home runs and tied for the team lead with 21 RBI, starting 20 of 22 games in left field and two as designated hitter. Brown also has one of the biggest hits of the season thus far, a goahead three-run homer in the eighth inning against Indiana on Feb. 24. In parts of four seasons at TCU, Brown batted .286 with 20 doubles, nine home runs, 63 RBI and 83 runs scored. He also stole 25 bases during his time at TCU, including eight in each of the last two seasons.

PRESEASON HONORS—Two Longhorn pitchers Lucas Gordon and Tanner Witt were named to the All-Big 12 Preseason team. Last season Gordon went 7-2 with a 3.05 ERA and 77 strikeouts in 85.2 innings after moving into the weekend rotation. Witt made two starts on the mound in the 2022 season before undergoing season ending surgery. He finished with a 2-0 record, a 1.64 ERA and 14 strikeouts in 11 innings pitched.

THE TRANSFERS—The Longhorns have seven transfers from Division I programs that hope to make an immediate impact, including outfielder Porter Brown (TCU), infielder Tanner Carlson (Long Beach State), catcher Garrett Guillemette (USC), RHP Cody Howard (Baylor) RHP Charlie Hurley (USC), LHP David Shaw (Rice) and RHP Heston Tole (Arkansas). Additionally RHP DJ Burke and LHP Chris Stuart transferred from San Jacinto College.

ROOKIES—Several freshmen will play big roles this season, including infielders Jalin Flores (San Antonio) and Jared Thomas (Waxahachie). Flores is likely to start at third base on Opening Day, while Thomas is expected to be the Longhorns starting first baseman. Additionally, infielders Jayden Duplantier and Cade O'Hara, catcher Rylan Galvan, outfielder Max Belyeu, and pitchers Kobe Minchey, Max Grubbs and Pierce George could all find significant playing time.

HEAR 'EM—In partnership with Learfield IMG College, Texas games will be broadcast on the Austin Radio Network, primarily on 104.9 The Horn and AM 1260. Craig Way handles primary play-by-play duties alongside Roger Wallace. This season fans will also hear analysis from Longhorn greats Keith Moreland, Ty Harrington and Nathan Thornhill throughout the season.

WATCH 'EM—Nearly all of Texas' home games will be broadcast on Longhorn Network this season. The team of Keith Moreland and Greg Swindell will return to the booth to call the action for all 36 home games.

THE SCHEDULE—The 2023 schedule features 36 home games at UFCU Disch-Falk Field after opening the season at the College Baseball Showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington. In Big 12 play, the Longhorns will host Texas Tech, Kansas State, Oklahoma and West Virginia and will travel to Oklahoma State, Baylor, TCU and Kansas. Texas also had a marquee midweek match up at home, welcoming LSU to UFCU Disch-Falk Field on Feb. 28. Texas will also travel to College Station for a midweek game against Texas A&M on March 28.

HEAD COACH VID PIERCE 22

7th season at Texas | 12th season as head coach

HIGH SCHOOL St. Pius X High School JUNIOR COLLEGE Wharton County Junior College ALMA MATER University of Houston, 1988

A Texas native who has spent most of his 30-year career coaching in the state, David Pierce was named head baseball coach at The University of Texas on June 29, 2016. Pierce, just the fifth Longhorn head coach since 1911 (with the exception of the war years of 1943-

45 when Blair Cherry was at the helm), is the 13th head coach in 123 years of Texas baseball. Entering his seventh season as the Longhorns' head coach in 2023, Pierce has an overall record 219-116 at Texas and a 416-225 mark in 11 seasons as a Division I head coach.

In 2022, the Longhorns returned to the College World Series for the second-consecutive season and third time in the last four completed seasons with a 47-22 overall. Texas smashed the program record with 128 home runs, surpassing the 2010 squad that hit 81. The best power hitting team in program history slugged .550 to smash the previous program record of .508 set in 1974. Leading the way offensively, Ivan Melendez became the first Texas player to win the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award and swept the national player of the year awards. Melendez hit a Longhorns record 32 home runs, surpassing Kyle Russell's Texas record 28 homers in 2007 and Kris Bryant's BBCOR era record of 31 homers in 2013. Melendez batted .387 and led the country with 94 RBI and an .863 slugging percentage. Along with Melendez's great season, Murphy Stehly had a breakout year batting .367 with 19 homers and 61 RBI and was named a second team All-American. Pete Hansen led the pitching staff and landed second team All-America honors with a 3.76 ERA, an 11-3 record and 120 strikeouts in 107.2 innings pitched. Melendez, Stehly and Hansen led a total of nine players named to the All-Big 12 teams and were joined by catcher Silas Ardoin on the first team. Infielders Trey Faltine and Skyler Messinger and starting pitcher Lucas Gordon landed on the second team. Outfielder Douglas Hodo III and designated hitter Austin Todd were named Honorable Mention. The Longhorns also produced the best defensive season in program history, fielding .985 for the first time ever and finishing with a program low 37 errors.

finishing with a program low 37 errors.

The 2021 season saw Texas return to the College World Series and come just one game shy of the CWS Finals. Pierce guided the Longhorns to the Big 12 Championship and their first 50-win season since 2010, while being named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year for the second time. He was also recognized as the ABCA Central Regional Coach of the Year, a distinction he had not received since the 2012 season. The Longhorns had 13 total players recognized on the All-Big 12 teams, including the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year Ty Madden. Madden was also named a First Team All-American and became the highest drafted Texas player since Taylor Jungmann in 2011. Including Madden, seven total Texas players were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft. The 2021 Longhorns led the nation with a 2 93 FBA, the best mark for the program since 2014. The pitching staff also totaled 556. nation with a 2.93 ERA, the best mark for the program since 2014. The pitching staff also totaled 556 strikeouts, the most for a Longhorn pitching staff since 2011. Offensively the Longhorns blasted 68 home runs, the most since a program record 81 in 2010. The team not only hit for power, finishing

with more stolen bases (92) than any Texas team in over 15 years.

In just his second season at the helm, Pierce was named Baseball America's National Coach of the Year after guiding the Longhorns to a 42-23 record and back to the College World Series for the first time since 2014. With a 17-7 mark in league play, Pierce, who was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year, led his team to the Big 12 Conference title—the first conference title for Texas since 2011—and hosted both an NCAA Regional and an NCAA Super Regional. In the Austin Regional, the Longhorns went 3-0 with wins over Texas Southern, Texas A&M, and Indiana. In the Super Regional, Texas dropped game one to Tennessee Tech before taking games two and three to send Pierce to Omaha for the first time as head coach. The Longhorns finished ranked in the top eight in every major poll to close out the season and finished first in the nation in double plays (73) and ninth in triples (22). Under Pierce and his staff's tutelage, second baseman Kody Clemens completed one of the best offensive seasons in Texas history. A third-round draft pick by the Detroit Tigers, Clemens was named a unanimous first team All-American at second base, becoming the first to earn that honor under Pierce. Clemens, the ABCA National Player of the Year and a finalist for both the Dick

honor under Pierce. Clemens, the ABCA National Player of the Year and a finalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and the USA Baseball Golden Spikes Award, blasted 24 home runs on the year, good for second in the country and second-most in a single season in Texas Baseball history. Clemens also ranked nationally in total bases (second, 180), slugging percentage (fifth, .726), and RBI (12th, 72). In his first season leading the Longhorns, Pierce led Texas to a 39-24 record, a 14-win improvement from the 2016 campaign. Texas came within one win of taking the Big 12 Conference tournament title before earning a No. 2 seed in the Long Beach Regional. Texas won its first two games of the regional before its season came to a close at the hands of LBSU. As a team, the Longhorns finished in the top 10 nationally in several statistical categories including double plays turned (fourth, 65), fielding percentage (fourth, 982), earned run average (ninth, 3.15), and hits allowed per nine innings (ninth, 7.60). Right-handed pitcher Morgan Cooper, a third team All-America selection, was taken in the second round of the MLB Draft, the first of 11 Longhorns to be selected in 2017, the most for any school. In Pierce's two seasons, a total of 16 Longhorns have been chosen in the draft. The 56-year-old Pierce came to Texas from Tulane, where he spent the previous two seasons as head coach following a three-year stint at Sam Houston State in the same role. Pierce's teams have qualified for the NCAA tournament in seven years with him at the helm, and including his time as an assistant, Pierce was a part of programs that advanced to the postseason in 18 consecutive years,

assistant, Pierce was a part of programs that advanced to the postseason in 18 consecutive years played in eight Super Regionals and reached five College World Series, winning a title in 2003 with Rice. In the summer of 2016, he was also named an assistant coach with the U.S. Collegiate National Team. Joining the Tulane Green Wave in 2015, the Houston native guided the school into its first season in the American Athletic Conference. His team posted a school-record nine shutouts, which ranked fourth in the nation, en route to a 35-25 record and the program's first regional appearance

Pierce's second season at Tulane brought even more success as he led the 2016 Green Wave to a 41-21 record, a regular season AAC championship and a second-consecutive regional appearance. The 41 wins were the most for the program since 2006. The team led the nation with 13 shutouts and ranked in the top 25 in both ERA (23rd/3.24) and WHIP (25th/1.24), while belting out 66 home runs, which was tied for 13th nationally. Tulane produced two third-round picks in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft in catcher Jake Rogers and shortstop Stephen Alemais with Rogers becoming Tulane's highest draft pick since 2008. In three seasons as head coach at Sam Houston State, Pierce compiled a record of 121-63 (.658). During his tenure, the Bearkats made three straight NCAA Regional appearances for just the second time in program history. Sam Houston State was crowned Southland Conference champions in each of his three seasons (the program's only previous league

title came in 1989), and Pierce was named the conference coach of the year in both 2012 and 2013. The recognition in back-to-back years made him the first Southland Conference coach to earn consecutive honors since UTSA's Sherman

In his first season as head coach in 2012, the Bearkats were ranked in each of the major Division I polls for the first time in program history. He was honored as an American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Regional Coach of the Year that season. In 2014, his final season in Huntsville, Pierce guided SHSU to a 43-19 record, the second-highest single-season win total for the Bearkats since they joined Division Lin 1987. The team replaced in the team of the team and country to the season win total for the Bearkats since they joined Division Lin 1987. joined Division I in 1987. The team ranked in the top 25 in the nation and second in the conference in both ERA (17th/2.73) and hits (25th/610). It also led the

conference in scoring (5.7 rpg), home runs (31) and slugging percentage (.390).

A native of Houston, Pierce was born on October 13, 1962. He and his wife, Susan, have two children and two grandchildren. Pierce's daughter, Chelsea, graduated from The University of Texas in 2012 and is married to husband Bryan Caffey, and the couple have two daughters, Beckett and Lochlan. David and Susan's son, Shea, played for his father at both Sam Houston (2012-15) and Tulane (2016) and is married to the former Madison Olivarez, who is a 2018 graduate of The University of Texas.
