Conference News & Notes

- The Big I2 has four top IO matchups on the Week 2 schedule. On Monday, No. 2/4 Baylor hosts No. 9/9 UCLA while No. 8/6 Texas is on the road at No. II/IO Stanford. Baylor then travels to No. 3 Connecticut on Thursday while Texas has another road contest at No. 10 Mississippi State on Sunday. (Updated coaches rankings will be released on Tuesday.)
- The Big I2 has a total of five games against autonomy conference opponents this week. In addition to the top IO contests, Texas Tech travels to Texas A&M, which is receiving votes in the national polls.
- Four Big I2 teams are ranked in the latest Associated Press Poll. No. 2 Baylor and No. 8 Texas are joined by No. 16 Oklahoma and No. 21 West Virginia. Baylor is just four points behind No. I Notre Dame and received I2 first-place votes.
- The Big I2 compiled an 8-I record over opening-weekend games with a +30.I scoring margin over its opponents, highlighted by Baylor's 75-point win. In the eight victories, Big I2 teams upended opponents by an average of 40.5 points.
- Baylor's II8 points in the II8-43 win over Houston Baptist were the most in the NCAA through opening games.
- The Big I2 leads all conferences with its average of 84.0 points, 48.0 rebounds and .477 field goal percentage.
- Four Big I2 teams are in the top I3 nationally for fewest points allowed in season openers - 2. K-State (33.0), T4. Oklahoma State (34.0), T8. West Virginia (38.0) and TI3. TCU (40.0).

- Baylor's II8 points against Houston Baptist marked the fourth-highest single-game scoring effort in program history.
- Baylor has won I68 consecutive home games vs. non-ranked opponents, dating back to an April 4, 2003, home-court loss to Auburn in the WNIT finals. BU is I56-4 (.975) in non-league home games under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Iowa State tipped off the 2016-17 campaign with a 77-60 victory over UCSB, its 22nd-straight season-opening win. The Cyclones tallied 15 total steals in the game.
- The Cyclones extended their streak to 92-consecutive regular season non-conference wins in Hilton Coliseum.

- Kansas owns a 38-II mark in season openers and, under head coach Brandon Schneider, the Jayhawks are I-I in regular-season openers.
- In the month of November, KU is I22-44 all time and has won eight of its last I3 contests in the IIth month of the year. Kansas has a record of 4I0-I77 (.705) in Allen Fieldhouse.



- Freshman forward Peyton Williams was the first K-State player to register a double-double in her career debut since Kendra Wecker in 2001.
- Kansas State registered a school record for field goal percentage in a quarter, shooting 80.0 percent in the third quarter against Chicago State on Nov II

- Oklahoma won its season opener with an 80-48 victory over Southern Illinois. The Sooners have won I8 out of their last I9 home openers under head coach Sherri Coale. The win also marked OU's 375th all-time home win at Lloyd Noble Center.
- Junior center Vionise Pierre-Louis scored I8 points on 6-of-8 shooting and added in six rebounds. Pierre-Louis was 6-for-6 at the free throw line, helping the Sooners to an .821 free throw percentage (23-for-28).
- The Cowgirls opened the season with a victory over Arkansas State, giving them their IIth consecutive win in a home opener and running their winning streak against non-conference foes to 49.
- Kaylee Jensen logged her ninth career double-double, finishing with 22 points and I4 rebounds.

- TCU opened its season with an 88-40 win over Incarnate Word. The Frogs held the Cardinals to 19.6 percent shooting, marking the seventh time in school history that TCU had held a team under 20 percent.
- All I2 of TCU's players in uniform played at least I0 minutes, and none player more than 2I minutes. Sophomore Amy Okonkwo led the way with 2I points, I0 rebounds and four assists, all career-highs for the USC transfer in her TCU debut.
- The Longhorns are ranked among the nation's top IO teams in each of the major preseason polls. Texas faces nine teams this season in the AP Top 25, including three of the top four and seven of the top I3.
- Texas opens its season on the road with a top 25 matchup against No. II/IO Stanford.

- The Lady Raiders defeated North Dakota 90-80 in the IIth straight season opening win. TTU set its quarter record for most points with 33 in the first period.
- Recee' Caldwell led the team with 28 points, seven assists, two rebounds and a steal in her first game as a Lady Raider.
- No. 22/25 West Virginia opened the season with an 88-38 victory over Charleston Southern. The Mountaineers held CSU to II field goal makes on the evening, marking the I7th time WVU has held an opponent to II or fewer field goals.
- Lanay Montgomery registered I7 points and grabbed I8 rebounds to pace the Mountaineers. Montgomery became the first Mountaineer since Donna Abbott in 1991 to record at least I7 points and I8 rebounds in a game.
