ABOUT THE MATCHUP: The Lobos will take to the road for their first away game of the season against Texas Tech on Sunday, Nov. 20 after claiming their first two wins of the season on their home court in WisePies Arena - The Pit.

The last time the Lobos faced the Lady Raiders was on Nov. 13, 2013 when UNM fell 64-56. That season, the Lobos finished 11-19 overall, 6-12 MW. Senior Kianna Keller and redshirt-junior Alex Lapeyrolerie are the only two players remaining on the Lobo squad that traveled to Lubbock for the teams' last meeting. Neither freshman saw action in the match.

The Lobos enter Sunday's matchup coming off of two nearly 30-point victories including the season opener against Fairleigh Dickinson and the first of two Rio Grande Rivalry contests against the Aggies. Lapeyrolerie once again led the Lobos with 20+ points. She netted 22 points to lead four double-digit scorers on Tuesday including Richelle van der Keijl (19), Jaisa Nunn (15) and Jayda Bovero (13).

As a team, the Lobos are entering Sunday's matchup shooting 47.7 percent from the field and 41.2 percent from behind the arc for an 83.5 ppg average.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING TEXAS TECH**

Texas Tech was tabbed to finish tied for seventh in the 2016-17 Big 12 Preseason Coaches Poll, the league announced on Oct. 12. The Lady Raiders are coming off of an overtime loss vs. No. 24 Texas A&M despite scoring 90 points for their second-straight game.

Offensively the Lady Raiders shot 55 percent from the field and three-point land. Freshman Arella Guirantes hit a jumper at the buzzer to tie the game, 83-83, and force overtime but Texas A&M went on to score 15 points in overtime to claim a 98-90 win. Two Lady Raiders scored 20+ points in the game including sophomore Reece' Caldwell (38) and junior Jada Terry (24 pts., 11 rebs).

Leading Texas Tech on the season is Reece' Caldwell who posts 33.0 points per game and is shooting 61.0 percent from the field, 57.1 percent from three. Caldwell is followed by Jada Terry who is averaging 16.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 57.7 percent from the floor. Texas Tech's final double-digit scorer is Arella Guirantes who is averaging 13.5 points while shooting 50 percent from the field.

THE LOBO BIG D

The Lobos have boasted strong defensive numbers so far this season, holding both regular-season opponents to under 30 percent shooting from the floor (28.1 percentage average). The Lobos have also posted 14 blocks and 11 steals. The match with Texas Tech will be exciting to watch as the Lady Raiders have three players scoring in double figures (Caldwell, 33.0, Terry, 16.5, Guirantes, 13.5).

VAN DER KEIJL'S BIG DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior **Richelle van der Keijl** notched 19 points and an outstanding 20 rebounds vs. NMSU. The last time a Lobo brought down 20 boards was on Dec. 13, 2008 ... vs Texas Tech.

LOBOS STARTING STRONG

The Lobos have started the season with two exhibition victories followed by head coach Mike Bradbury's first two official wins at the helm of the Lobos. The last time UNM won its first two regular-season games was during the 2012-13 season when the squad went on a five-win streak to open the season, including a 65-61 win over Texas Tech at home on Nov. 15.

LAPEY-ROLL-ERING

After averaging just 2.6 points per game last season, redshirt-junior **Alex Lapeyrolerie** has burst on the scene this year, scoring 13+ points in each of the Lobos' exhibition games and 20+ points in each of the Lobos' first two contests. She leads the Lobos with 21.5 points per game shooting 58.3 percent from the field, 55 percent from three-point range and 66.7 percent at the free throw line.

RECORD FOR BEYNON

Junior **Cherise Beynon** tied the all-time New Mexico record for assists in a single game with 15 on Tuesday against NM State. Beynon tied former Lobo player - and current Lobo administrator - Janice Ruggiero (Branch) who set the record on Jan. 23, 1987 against Adams State.

CAREER FIRST

Sophomore **Jaisa Nunn** assured the press after Tuesday's NM State victory that her first career three-point shot will not be her last this season. Last season, the center did not attempt a single three-pointer, she has attempted two in as many games in 2016-17 and is now shooting 50 percent from behind the arc in her second campaign as a Lobo.

LAST TIME IS NOW

In their first two games under head coach Mike Bradbury, the Lobos have blasted through our "Last time it happened section" (see page 28). UNM scored over 80 points, won by more than 20, made 10 three-pointers, had 50 rebounds and over 20 assists in both games. In addition, the Lobos registered two 20-point scorers in their season opener, but were just short of two more against NMSU with their top two scorers netting 22 and 19 points. In the Lobos' last game against NMSU, the team posted 11 blocks. Last time the Lobos posted over 10 blocks was on Jan. 4 2012 vs. Wyoming.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 LOBOS

The 2016-17 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is going to have a much different look as the Lobos are under new direction with new head coach Mike Bradbury. The Lobos will show off a new style of play, speeding the game up with the dribble drive and shooting those outside threes.

The Lobos return seven lettermen from last year's squad including First Team All-Mountain West selection Cherise Beynon and All-Freshman Team selection Jaisha Nunn. The Lobos will add in six new faces, including three freshmen and three transfers (only one transfer will play this season).

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome in six new faces to the program -- all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshman were rated as the top recruiting class in the Mountain West. Three transfers

come in to the program. Only one will be eligible to play this season.

PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS

Junior **Cherise Beynon** was named to the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team following her stellar sophomore campaign while freshman **Mykiel Burleson** was named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year. As a team, the Lobos were selected to finish sixth in the league.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Two years ago, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2016-17 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one from another country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington. The Lobos have one player from overseas in senior transfer Richelle van der Kiejl from The Netherlands.
