TEXAS TECH POSTGAME NOTES

GETTING STARTED

- This was the 18th meeting all-time between Texas Tech & New Mexico and the second under Head Coach Candi Whitaker.
- The starting lineup was: Larryn Brooks (G), Recee' Caldwell (G), Ivonne CookTaylor (G), Arella Guirantes (G), and Jada Terry (C).

TEXAS TECH'S WIN...

- Moves the Lady Raiders to 2-1 this season.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 2-0 all-time vs. New Mexico
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 36-59 at Texas Tech.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 113-152 in her head coaching career.
- Moves the Lady Raiders to 15-3 all-time vs. New Mexico.

OFFENSE

- The Lady Raiders trailed 34-32 at the half, marking the first time Texas Tech has trailed at the half this season.
- Three Lady Raiders scored 10+ points against the Lobos, Arella Guirantes (21), Jada Terry (16), and Recee' Caldwell (12).

DEFENSE

- The Lady Raiders' 71 boards against the Lobos broke a 22-year-old school record for the most rebounds in a game. The previous record was 66 rebounds coming against SMU on Jan. 18, 1994.
- The 49 defensive rebounds also broke a 13-year-old record. The previous record was 43 defensive rebounds coming at Oklahoma State on Feb. 22, 2003.
- The Lady Raiders had 21 rebounds in the third period alone, marking the most in a quarter since the start of quarter play in 2015.

JADA TERRY

- Junior Jada Terry recorded her second double-double in as many games with 16 points and 10 rebounds.

ARELLA GUIRANTES

- Freshman Arella Guirantes scored a career-high 21 points and recorded a career-high 13 boards.
- The 21 points and 13 rebounds marked her first double-double as a Lady Raider.

LARRYN BROOKS

- Junior guard Larryn Brooks earned her first start as a Lady Raider.
- Brooks scored five points, recorded four rebounds and two assists in her first start.

REECE' CALDWELL

- Sophomore Guard Recee' Caldwell scored 12 points, marking her third consecutive game with double figures. She also tallied a career-high eight rebounds.

WHO'S GOT NEXT?

- The Lady Raiders travel to Coral Gables, Fla., for the Miami Thanksgiving Tournament. Texas Tech opens the tournament on Friday against Fordham at 1 p.m. The final game of the tournament is set for Sunday against Grambling State or Miami.
