### CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Thanksgiving weekend will be highlighted by four games on the Week 13 schedule with two each on Friday and Saturday. League leader Oklahoma and second-place Oklahoma State have a bye.
- The Big 12 title will be decided on "Championship Saturday" for the fifth time out of the last six years when Oklahoma State travels to Oklahoma on December 3. The same two teams also played for the championship last season with OU winning in Stillwater over Thanksgiving weekend. Both teams had a bye on the final Saturday.
- Since round-robin play began in 2011, no team has gone undefeated in conference play.
- Three Big 12 teams are ranked in the CFP Poll with No. 8 Oklahoma and No. 10 Oklahoma State in the top 10. West Virginia is ranked at No. 18.
- Oklahoma has rolled off eight straight wins while Oklahoma State has won its last seven games. OU's win streak is ranked third nationally behind Alabama and Western Michigan while OSU's streak is tied for fourth.
- The Big 12 leads the autonomy conferences with 45 percent of league games decided by a touchdown-or-less and is second in lowest scoring margin (16.42) within conference games behind the SEC (14.78). Every Big 12 team has a conference win.
- Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, West Virginia, Baylor and K-State have all reached bowl eligibility. TCU and Texas are a victory away. Texas concludes the season by hosting TCU next Friday. TCU has two games left to play.
- The Big 12 leads all FBS conferences in scoring (34.6), total offense (476.02), yards per play (6.19), passing yards (286.38), passing efficiency (142.61) and completions per game (22.50).
- The Big 12 has seven of the nation's top 20 offenses - 2. Texas Tech (555.3), 3. Oklahoma (550.8), 6. Baylor (520.6), 14. West Virginia (504.8), 16. Oklahoma State (500.2) 17. Texas (498.9) and 20. TCU (493.3).
- Kansas has been chosen as the FWA National Team of the Week after its overtime win over Texas. This is KU's third honor and first since 2008.
- TCU football student-athlete Caylin Moore was one of 32 students chosen to receive a Rhodes Scholarship, with the opportunity to study at Oxford University next fall.
