TEXAS TECH POSTGAME NOTES

GETTING STARTED

- This was the fifth meeting all-time between Texas Tech and Prairie View A&M and the first under Head Coach Candi Whitaker.
- The starting lineup was: Larryn Brooks (G), Reece' Caldwell (G), Ivonne CookTaylor (G), Arella Guirantes (G) and Jada Terry (C). The Lady Raiders have a 3-1 record when starting this group of five.

TEXAS TECH'S WIN...

- Moves the Lady Raiders to 4-2 this season.
- Moves the Lady Raiders to 5-0 all-time vs. Prairie View A&M.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 1-0 all-time vs. Prairie View A&M.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 38-60 at Texas Tech.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 115-153 in her head coaching career.

OFFENSE

- Five Lady Raiders scored 10+ points against the Panthers, Reece' Caldwell (16), Brittany Brewer (16), Larryn Brooks (15), Jada Terry (10), and Ivonne CookTaylor (10).
- The Lady Raiders have had two or more players score double figures in all six games played.
- Four of the five starters scored double figures against the Panthers.
- Lady Raiders scored 30 points in the first quarter marking the most since Texas Tech scored 33 in the first quarter against North Dakota (11/13).
- Texas Tech scored 43 points in the first quarter. The last time the Lady Raiders scored 40+ points in a half was on Nov. 13, 2016 when Tech scored 50 against North Dakota.

DEFENSE

- The Lady Raiders held Prairie View A&M to just five points in the first quarter, the lowest points allowed this season. The last time the Lady Raiders held a team to five or fewer points was on Nov. 13, 2015 when Texas Tech held Niagara to four points.
- Texas Tech allowed only 43 points, the lowest of the season.
- The Lady Raiders' defense boarded 47 rebounds, the most since Texas Tech recorded 71 against New Mexico on Nov. 20, 2016.

REECE' CALDWELL

- Reece' Caldwell scored 11 of her 16 points in the first quarter alone.

BRITTANY BREWER

- Freshman Brittany Brewer scored a career-high 16 points, eight rebounds and two blocks in tonight's win over Prairie View.
- Her eight rebounds tonight was also a career high.

LARRYN BROOKS

- Junior Larryn Brooks scored a career-high 15 points, three rebounds, five assists and a steal. She went 5-for-9 from behind the arc, the most three-points made for the junior transfer.

WHO'S GOT NEXT

- The Lady Raiders return to action on Saturday as they travel to Fayetteville, Ark., to face Arkansas for a 3 p.m. tip. The game will be broadcasted on SEC Network.
