### ABOUT THE BULLDOGS

Drake went 23-10 last season and advanced to the WNIT, where it fell in the second round to Northern Iowa. The Bulldogs have been tabbed as the favorite in the Missouri Valley Conference's annual preseason poll, and for the second-straight year senior Lizzy Wendell is the MVC Preseason Player of the Year.

Nine returners make up the bulk of Drake's roster. Wendell led the league in scoring in each of the previous two seasons and is a three-time All-MVC First Team selection and was named the MVC Freshman of the Year in 2014. She has scored 1,859 career points to rank fifth among active NCAA players, seventh all-time at Drake and 13th all-time in the MVC.

## ABOUT THE RED RAIDERS

Texas Tech went 13-18 last season and 4-15 in the Big 12 Conference. The Lady Raiders return six letterwinners including senior Ivonne Cook-Taylor and sophomore Japreece Dean. Cook-Taylor was the Lady Raiders leading scorer, averaging 14.3 points per game. She was named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention. Dean was the Lady Raiders' top free-throw shooter, posting a .806 average as the starting point guard. She was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Texas Tech was picked to finish seventh in the Big 12 preseason poll, the highest Big 12 preseason ranking for the Lady Raiders under fourth-year head coach Candi Whitaker.

## COACHES PICK FIGHTING HAWKS SECOND

The University of North Dakota women's basketball team was picked second by the league's coaches in the Big Sky Conference Preseason Poll. UND was slotted fifth in a tight media poll that had five different schools with at least one first-place vote. Defending league champion Idaho took the coaches poll, edging out UND by just three points, while regular-season champ Montana State was the media's top selection. The UND women have been picked in the top two spots of the coaches poll in each of the past three seasons and have a conference title (2014) and a runner-up finish (2016) while qualifying for a postseason tournament in each of the past three seasons as well (NCAA in 2014, WBI in 2015 and 2016).

**SENIOR CAPTAINS NAMED**

Leah Szabla, Samantha Roscoe, Makailah Dyer and transfer Holly Johnson have been chosen by their teammates to represent the leadership group for the Fighting Hawks as they eye another postseason run. The trio of Szabla, Roscoe and Dyer have been part of one of UND's most successful runs. This class was the catalyst for North Dakota's 11-game turnaround in their freshmen season, a memorable Big Sky Conference championship and subsequent NCAA Tournament appearance. Since, UND has appeared in the postseason in each of the next two seasons as well, hosting and winning its first Division I postseason game last year against Grand Canyon in the Women's Basketball Invitational. Johnson, a transfer from North Dakota State, will be on the other side of an in-state rivalry that stands at 4-0 in favor of UND in the Division I era.

**FIND UND ON THE TUBE... NATIONALLY**

UND will enjoy the national spotlight a total of nine times this season with eight home games televised and an additional road contest available on a national platform.

Midco Sports Network (MidcoSN) will produce five home women's basketball games, including the big showdown against Big Ten Conference opponent Iowa on Nov. 16. Alex Heinert returns as the play-by-play voice while former UND women's basketball player and assistant coach Val Sussex will serve as the analyst for the women's tilts on MidcoSN.

FSN or FSN Plus will air three women's basketball games, including the women's game against Montana State on Jan. 12 in a game that features two of the top three teams in the Preseason Big Sky Conference coaches poll. These contests will be produced by UND Athletics staff, professional freelancers and UND students. UND Athletics' Video Production Coordinator David Folske will produce the broadcasts while Assistant Athletics Director for New Media and Video Production Matt Schill will serve as a key crew member. Assistant Media Relations Director Mitch Wigness will provide the play-by-play for women's contests with Sussex.

**LEAGUE TOURNEYS AGAIN HEAD TO RENO**

The Big Sky Conference is in year two of a three-year agreement that sees its basketball championships held in Reno, Nev.

As in 2015-16, the Big Sky Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be played downtown at the Reno Events Center. The REC was constructed in 2005 and can accommodate roughly 5,000 fans in a basketball configuration.

All 12 men's and women's teams from the conference will participate in the championship. The tournament starts Mar. 6 and runs through Mar. 11.

**2015-16 RECAP****HISTORIC WIN**

UND's come-from-behind win over Grand Canyon in the opening round of the WBI marked the school's first-ever Division I postseason win. It is the first postseason victory by a non-hockey program at UND since the school transitioned to NCAA Division I in 2008-09.

**ALL-LEAGUE ACCOLADES**

Senior Mia Loyd (first team) and junior Makailah Dyer (second team) were each named to the All-Big Sky Conference Teams. Loyd picked up her second first-team nod and her third all-league accolade while Dyer was recognized for the first time in her career.

**TWIN TOWERS**

The interior duo of Stephanie Smith and Samantha Roscoe piled up blocked shots to rival recent UND posts. Smith's 60 blocks were just one away from cracking the top 10 all-time at UND while Smith and Roscoe combined for 94 blocks, just two away from the formidable tandem of Alyssa Wall (52) and Emily Evers (44) back in 2013-14.

**"GRAND" CANYON**

Junior Makailah Dyer became the 34th UND player to notch 1,000 career points with her seven points in the WBI win over Grand Canyon. She joined eammate Mia Loyd (1,384) in the 1,000-point club.

**GRIZ FIZZLE THREE TIMES**

North Dakota notched a rare feat, defeating Montana three times in a single season. UND's 65-62 quarterfinal win at the Big Sky Tournament gave North Dakota the first 3-0 mark against UM since 2009-10 when Portland State turned the trick. Only four teams have ever beat long-time legendary head coach Robin Selvig three times in a season.

**RATINGS BONANZA**

North Dakota's final Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), topped the Big Sky Conference. Heading into the postseason, UND was at 94 in the RPI, way ahead of its closest Big Sky foe (Idaho-123). UND's strength of schedule is at 94, also tops in the league and one of just five in the conference under 200.

**LEXI FLEXIN'**

Freshman Lexi Klabo came on like gang-busters in the final 12 games. In the first 21 games, Klabo scored a combined 49 points (2.3 ppg). But, in the last 12 games, she scored 103 (8.6 ppg), scoring in double figures five times. She poured in a career-best 18 to go along with seven rebounds, three blocks, two steals and an assist, without a turnover in the win at Sac State.

**BIG BOOK-END ROAD WINS TO END REGULAR SEASON**

UND's 61-59 win on Jan. 16 at Montana was its first-ever at Dahlberg Arena. It started a six-game road winning streak this season and the final win in that stretch was a 86-79 victory in the Hornets' Nest, also UND's first in that building.

**SIX STRAIGHT**

North Dakota ended the regular season with six straight road wins. That is the longest road winning streak since the 2011-12 season when UND ended the regular season with six straight road wins en route to a Great West Conference regular season title.

**CARDIAC KIDS**

North Dakota had a flair for the dramatic during the last 19 games. UND posted a 15-4 record in that stretch but has overcome late deficits in several of those. Nine of those games were decided by a single possession with UND on the winning end in eight of those:

North Dakota gained its first-ever win in Sacramento with its 86-79 victory at the Hornets' Nest. UND out-scored the Hornets, 27-14, in the final quarter to win its sixth straight road game.

**REBOUND RAMPAGE**

North Dakota easily led the Big Sky Conference in rebounding margin, averaging 8.8 more rebounds per game than its opponent. That's nearly double the closest team (Idaho State, +4.5). UND's +8.8 margin ranked 17th in the NCAA.

**U-N-DEE EVENTS CENTER?**

North Dakota has made itself quite cozy in Weber State's home gym, the Dee Events Center. UND has now won all four meetings there since joining the Big Sky Conference, despite three of the games being decided by seven points or fewer.

**SOME PEOPLE JUST CAN'T HANDLE LIFE ON THE ROAD**

North Dakota has handled it quite well-- thank you-- in recent times, winning each of its six true road games.

**LOYD WITH 37 DOUBLE-DOUBLES**

Mia Loyd produced another double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds in the WBI first round win over Grand Canyon. She finished her career with 37 career double-doubles and 12 this season. She had a league-high 16 last season.

## TRAVIS BREWSTER HEAD COACH

**Year at UND:** 13th year/4th as head coach

**Collegiate experience:** 15th year

**Hometown:** Cedar Rapids, Iowa

J. Travis Brewster enters his fifth season at the helm at the University of North Dakota and his 14th year with the women's basketball program. Brewster has led UND to three straight postseason appearances and 69 wins in his four seasons as head coach with a myriad of program firsts along the way.

Brewster, who spent nine years as an assistant under former head coach Gene Roebuck, guided the team into the first season in the Big Sky Conference in 2012-13. Once acclimated, his teams have ascended back to their normal perch at or near the top of the league standings and qualifying for national postseason tournaments with regularity.

Last season, UND rattled off 14 wins in its final 17 games to reach the postseason for a third consecutive season. North Dakota would host its first-ever postseason game in its NCAA Division I era and subsequently etched its first win in the opening round of the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). That resilient team had rallied from a 4-10 start and a 1-3 record in Big Sky play to finish 19-14 overall and 13-5 in league play, just a game back for second place in the regular season standings. In that mix was a rare six-game road winning streak that North Dakota will carry into the 2016-17 campaign.

His 2014-15 team was the first (in the Division I era) to win a national tournament game with a pair of wins at the 2014 Preseason Women's National Invitational (at Towson University). That was part of a 7-1 start to the campaign, the best start on record in UND's Division I era. UND would qualify for the Women's Basketball Invitational at season's end for its third postseason appearance in four seasons.

Brewster was named the Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year in 2013-14, guiding his team to a host of firsts and milestones in a season that will long be remembered. His second team went 22-10, 15-5 in league play and not only won a share of the Big Sky's regular season title, but earned the opportunity to host the league tournament. It did so and cruised to the tourney title and the NCAA Division I Tournament-- all of those accomplishments becoming program firsts.

Accolades rained down on the club as he mentored the league's Player of the Year (Madi Buck), Sixth Person of the Year (Emily Evers) and Newcomer of the Year (Kelsey Knox) along with a Big Sky Second Team accolade for Mia Loyd. Buck was also the school's first Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) All-Region player and was an honorable mention All-America selection after a standout senior season.

His first season (11-18 overall) was highlighted by several monumental wins as well. The team entered its first season in the Big Sky Conference and promptly knocked off preseason favorite Idaho State on Jan. 3 for its first league win. A non-conference triumph over arch-rival North Dakota State provided the first victory in Brewster's regime, a Nov. 30 win that helped UND retain bragging rights in the first game of the series since 2004. Nearly a month later, North Dakota defeated WNIIT runner-up Utah 62-56 for the school's first win over a power-5 conference (PAC-12) since joining Division I. Junior Megan Lauck poured in 29 points after halftime en route to a career-high 36 points in the season finale at Southern Utah, an effort that helped UND erase a 21-point second-half deficit.

The success has also come in the classroom as 26 players have earned All-Big Sky Academic honors in his four seasons. His teams are consistently among the best in the nation in combined grad point average, finishing with a 3.546 GPA in 2012-13, good for fifth-best among all NCAA Division I women's basketball teams.

University of North Dakota athletics director Brian Faison announced Brewster as the sixth head coach of the North Dakota women's basketball program in Feb. 2012. Brewster's appointment came just weeks after former head coach Gene Roebuck announced that he would retire following his 25th season at the helm.

"Coach Brewster is one of the up-and-coming coaches in the game," Faison said at the time of the hiring. "He brings a special combination of coaching, recruiting, administrative and communication skills to the position. In observing Coach Brewster over the past few years, he clearly knows how to effectively lead and motivate our student-athletes. He has a passion to continue the excellent competitive and academic traditions that have been built for women's basketball at the University of North Dakota."

"Travis has earned the right to move into the head coaching position," Roebuck said. "He's been instrumental in all phases of our program."

During his nine years on Gene Roebuck's staff, UND won over 71 percent of its games, three regular season conference titles, five conference postseason tournament titles and helped lead the program to three winning seasons during the four-year transition to NCAA Division I status. Two players earned conference player of the year accolades, three earned All-America status and nine earned first team all-conference honors.

"I learned so much from Coach Roebuck," Brewster admits. "He taught me that it's okay to keep things simple and be the best at it. It's about what our program does, not about what other programs do. He gave me things and let me take it and make my own strides. It started with recruiting, then working with player development and then strategy. He always gave me great input."

Brewster began his career at North Dakota as a graduate assistant coach for the men's program during the 2001-02 season, then joined the women's staff as a full-time assistant in 2002. From 2002-06, he served as recruiting coordinator and assistant coach. During those four years, the Sioux won four North Central Conference Tournament titles and consecutive NCC regular season titles in 2005 and 2006. In 2006, the team finished had a perfect regular season, won the NCC regular season and conference tournament titles and finished 34-1.

Brewster spent the 2007-08 season as an assistant coach and team travel coordinator at South Dakota State and helped guide the Jackrabbits to a 23-7 record, a Summit League regular season championship and an appearance in the Women's NIT postseason tournament. He spent the 2006-07 season as an assistant coach and strength and conditioning liaison at Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

Brewster returned to Coach Roebuck's staff to start the transition from NCAA Division II to Division I status in 2008-09. In that first season UND went 18-11, posted a perfect 13-0 home record and won the season ending UND Spring Thaw Tournament. The next season UND won the 2010 Great West Conference regular season title and in 2012 won both the conference regular season and tournament titles en route to its first Division I postseason berth, the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI).

In the summer of 2010, Brewster was one of just a handful of coaches selected nationally to attend the Black Coaches & Administrators Achieving Coaching Excellence program, where he underwent training in on- and off-camera interviews, on-court teaching, conducting home visits, budgets, leadership, networking, contract negotiations, and maintaining a quality of life.

As a player at the collegiate level, Brewster played two seasons at Iowa Lakes Community College ('90, '91), before moving on to Division I Charleston Southern ('92, '93). At ILCC, Brewster played on teams that went 49-12; at CSU, he was a two-time defensive MVP and team captain in 1993.

After graduating Charleston Southern in 1994, he played three years of professional basketball in Europe. In 1994-95, he played for Grand Saconnex in Geneva, Switzerland. In 1995-96, he moved up to Olympia Basketball Regensdorf in Zurich, Switzerland. In his third and final year, 1996-97, Brewster played for Dungannon in Ireland and Villar in Switzerland. He was a two-time member of the Swiss all-star team.

After his professional career, Brewster returned to Iowa Lakes in 1998 as an assistant coach. In three seasons he helped guide the Lakes to an aggregate record of 68-27.

Brewster is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Black Coaches & Administrators (BCA). His family includes his wife, Rebecca, daughter, Reganne, and sons, Drake and Kaid.
