2017 FOOTBALL SCHEDULE

	EASTERN WASHINGTON Saturday, Sept. 2 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech owns a 14-game winning streak in season openers, the nation's fourth-longest streak on opening day ... Red Raiders trail only Florida, Ohio State and Alabama for longest winning streak in season openers ... Texas Tech is 63-26-3 in its 92 all-time season openers ... Red Raiders are 1-0 all-time against Eastern Washington after a 49-24 victory at home to open the 2008 season.
	ARIZONA STATE Saturday, Sept. 16 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech and Arizona State will close a two-year contacted home-and-home series ... Sun Devils opened the series with a 68-55 victory this past season in Tempe ... victory improved the Sun Devils to 2-1 all-time against the Red Raiders ... this will Arizona State's first ever trip to Lubbock as the two teams previously met in 1999 in Tempe and again in 2013 at the Holiday Bowl.
	@HOUSTON Saturday, Sept. 23 TDECU Stadium Houston, Texas	This will be the first meeting between Texas Tech and Houston since the Red Raiders recorded a 35-20 victory in 2010 ... Tech last travelled to Houston early in the 2009 campaign ... Cougars control a 18-11-1 all-time advantage in the series that dates back to the Southwest Conference ... Red Raiders have won six of the last seven meetings against Houston.
	OKLAHOMA STATE* Saturday, Sept. 30 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Oklahoma State narrowly topped the Red Raiders this past season with a 45-44 victory in Stillwater ... Texas Tech has not defeated the Cowboys since a 56-20 rout in 2008, its largest win over a top-10 team in school history ... despite the losing streak, Tech still controls a 21-20-3 all-time advantage in the series, including a 12-6-2 mark in games played in Lubbock.
	@KANSAS* Saturday, Oct. 7 Memorial Stadium Lawrence, Kan.	Texas Tech has won 10-straight games against the Jayhawks dating back to the 2001 season ... Red Raiders ran away with their 2015 meeting thanks to a 55-19 victory ... Red Raiders are 17-1 all-time against Kansas, including a perfect 9-0 in games played in Lawrence ... Tech is 13-1 vs. Kansas since the two schools joined the Big 12 in 1996.
	@WEST VIRGINIA* Saturday, Oct. 14 Milan Puskar Stadium Morgantown, W. Va.	Texas Tech is 2-4 all-time against West Virginia and 1-1 vs. the Mountaineers in Morgantown ... Mountaineers have won each of the last three meetings in the series ... Red Raiders last defeated West Virginia in 2013 with a 32-27 victory on the road in what was just second meeting since the Mountaineers joined the Big 12 prior to the 2012 season ... The two schools first met in the 1938 Sun Bowl.
	IOWA STATE* Saturday, Oct. 21 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech has historically dominated the series against Iowa State with a 11-4 all-time record versus the Cyclones ... Red Raiders are 8-1 all-time in home games against Iowa State ... Iowa State snapped a four-game losing streak to Tech this past season in Ames ... Iowa State game serves as Texas Tech's lone home contest during the month of October.
	@OKLAHOMA* Saturday, Oct. 28 Gaylord Family - OU Memorial Stadium Norman, Okla.	Red Raiders will be looking for their first win over Oklahoma since 2011 ... Texas Tech and Oklahoma snapped multiple FBS records during 2016 meeting which resulted in 125 combined points ... Patrick Mahomes II tied the FBS record with 734 passing yards in 2015 meeting ... Mahomes also snapped the FBS record with 819 yards of total offense (734 passing, 85 rushing).
	KANSAS STATE* Saturday, Nov. 4 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech and Kansas State will celebrate their 18th all-time meeting in 2017 ... Red Raiders control a 9-8 advantage in the all-time series after winning six of the previous 11 meetings against the Wildcats ... Tech is 7-3 at home against K-State ... Wildcats edged the Red Raiders, 44-38, in 2016 contest held in Manhattan despite 504 passing yards from Patrick Mahomes II.
	vs. BAYLOR* Saturday, Nov. 11 AT&T Stadium Arlington, Texas	Texas Tech and Baylor will meet at AT&T Stadium in Arlington for the seventh-consecutive season ... the neutral site contest is the third of a four-game contract between the two schools ... Tech tied the all-time series at 37-37-1 in 2016 following a 54-35 victory over the Bears ... Red Raiders are 16-5 all-time against Baylor since the Big 12 formed in 1996.
	TCU* Saturday, Nov. 18 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	The Nov. 18 home finale is the latest calendar date for Tech to face a conference opponent since the Red Raiders topped Baylor on Nov. 29, 2008 ... Red Raiders own a 31-25-3 all-time record versus TCU ... each of past two contests have come down to the wire with TCU winning on tipped pass in 2015 and the Red Raiders kicking a game-winning field goal in double overtime in 2016.
	@TEXAS* Friday, Nov. 24 Darrell K Royal-Texas Memorial Stadium Austin, Texas	Red Raiders return to Austin over Thanksgiving weekend to face the Longhorns for the 67th time in series history ... Texas Tech claimed a 48-45 victory over Texas on Thanksgiving Day in 2015, its first win over the Longhorns in Austin since 1997 ... Longhorns narrowly hang on for a 45-37 victory during 2016 contest at Jones AT&T Stadium in Lubbock.
	BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP Saturday, Dec. 2 AT&T Stadium Arlington, Texas	The Big 12 Championship returns after a six-year hiatus ... game will pit the top two schools in the Big 12 standings ... AT&T Stadium in Arlington has been selected to host the championship through the 2021 season ... 2017 Championship will be broadcast nationally by FOX with 2018 contest aired on an ESPN platform.
