CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Just 10 games are on the Week 6 schedule as many teams are in the midst of finals.
- West Virginia (10-0) and Oklahoma State (8-0) are among the 13 teams nationally to remain undefeated. OSU holds a 51-game home win streak in non-conference games while WVU has won its last 31 home non-conference contests.
- The Big 12 has a 69-21 (.767) non-conference record. Eleven of the 21 losses have been to ranked teams with eight of those teams rated in the top 10. Baylor, K-State and Texas losses have all come to top 10 opponents.
- The Big 12 has played 24 games thus far against teams from the other autonomy conferences, in addition to three games against current No. 1-ranked Connecticut. Notre Dame was rated No. 1 at the time of its game against TCU.
- The Big 12's 16 games against teams ranked in at least one of the two national polls is tied for the most among any league.
- The Big 12 is one of four leagues in which at least 80 percent of teams have a .625 or better winning percentage.
- Among conference stat leaders, the Big 12 is second in scoring (76.0), first in rebounding (43.0) and 3-point percentage (.360), and second in field goal percentage (.449).
- The Big 12 has four of the top nine teams in field goal percentage defense - 1. West Virginia (.287), 2. Baylor (.309), 5. Oklahoma State (.324) and 9. K-State (.324).

**BAYLOR (10-1, 0-0)**

XFL Baylor leads NCAA Division I women's basketball teams in eight categories, including assists (254), assists per game (23.1), blocked shots (86), free throws made (175), rebound margin (+24.0), rebounds (565), rebounds per game (51.36) and scoring margin (+39.8).

XFL The Lady Bears lead the Big 12 Conference in 16 categories.

**IOWA STATE (7-2, 0-0)**

XFL Iowa State's game vs. Northern Illinois marked the first time in school history that two players (Seanna Johnson - 33, Bridget Carleton - 31) scored 31 or more points in the same game.

XFL ISU has shot 80 percent or better at the free-throw line in eight of its nine games (91.3 percent vs. NIU).

**KANSAS (4-5, 0-0)**

XFL Kansas' defense held Rhode Island to just 36 points, marking the first time the program has held an opponent to under 40 points since upsetting nationally-ranked Cal (62-39) in 2014.

XFL The Jayhawks netted 26 second chance points against the Rams (12/11), the most this season. The previous season high was 16 at Alabama (12/4).

**KANSAS STATE (9-1, 0-0)**

XFL Over the last five games, Naismith Trophy candidate Breanna Lewis is averaging 17.8 points, 9.4 rebounds and 2.6 blocks.

XFL K-State hosted UConn on Sunday in front of 12,528 fans, which is the first sell-out in Bramlage Coliseum since Feb. 4, 2012.

**OKLAHOMA (7-2, 0-0)**

XFL Oklahoma's depth was on display in both wins last week as the Sooners' bench averaged 51.5 points. Reserves scored 48 points against UTRGV before recording 55 against Tulsa. The 103 points from OU's bench were the most in back-to-back games since combining for 108 in a two-game stretch versus Bradley and Lamar during the 2014-15 season.

XFL Maddie Manning averaged 18.0 points off the bench last week, including a career-high 24 points against Tulsa. The redshirt senior also led the Sooners with eight rebounds and four steals.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (8-0, 0-0)**

XFL Oklahoma State improved to 8-0 with a win over UTRGV, marking its sixth consecutive undefeated non-conference home slate and running the Cowgirls' non-conference home winning streak to 55 in a row.

XFL In the win, sophomore Karli Wheeler logged career highs with 29 points and eight rebounds. She drilled 6 3-pointers in the contest, which was one shy of matching the school's single-game record.

**TCU (6-3, 0-0)**

XFL The Frogs split their games last week, dropping a 75-67 contest to Texas A&M before beating McNeese, 74-70. The win over McNeese gave TCU head coach Raegan Pebley her 198th career win. She is looking to become the sixth of the 10 Big 12 coaches to reach 200 career victories, despite being the second-youngest of the 10.

XFL As TCU enters finals week, the Frogs will not play again until next Sunday when Texas Southern visits Schollmaier Arena.

**TEXAS (3-4, 0-0)**

XFL Texas has now won three consecutive meetings against Tennessee in the longstanding rivalry between the two programs. The game concluded a stretch of five of the first seven games for the Longhorns against teams that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 or further last season.

XFL The Longhorns are one win away from achieving 500 all-time victories within the friendly confines of the Frank Erwin Center. Texas is 499-96 (.839) all-time in the Erwin Center.

**TEXAS TECH (5-3, 0-0)**

XFL Lady Raiders defeated Houston, 84-60, on the program's third annual Education Day. Texas Tech welcomed 5,242 elementary school students from the South Plains area for the game.

XFL Five Lady Raiders scored 10+ points against the Cougars, Jada Terry (16), Ivonne CookTaylor (12), Arella Guirantes (12), Reece Caldwell (10) and Grayson Bright (10). Texas Tech has had two or more players score double figures in all eight games played.

**WEST VIRGINIA (10-0, 0-0)**

XFL With a 91-33 win over USC Upstate on Dec. 10, West Virginia (10-0) tied the 2002-03 team for the second-best start in program history. WVU opened the 2010-11 season with a school-record 16-0 mark.

XFL West Virginia has won 31 consecutive games against non-conference opponents at the WVU Coliseum, which is a program record. WVU's 12-game win streak at the Coliseum ranks seventh all-time and the 10 consecutive wins to open the season is tied for 10th all-time.
