TEXAS TECH POSTGAME NOTES

GETTING STARTED

- This was the third meeting all-time between Texas Tech and Houston and the first under Head Coach Candi Whitaker.
- The starting lineup was: Larryn Brooks (G), Reece' Caldwell (G), Ivonne CookTaylor (G), Arella Guirantes (G) and Jada Terry (C). The Lady Raiders have a 5-2 record when starting this group of five.

TEXAS TECH'S WIN...

- Moves the Lady Raiders to 7-3 this season.
- Moves the Lady Raiders to 3-0 all-time vs. Alcorn State.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 1-0 all-time vs. Alcorn State.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 41-61 at Texas Tech.
- Moves Candi Whitaker to 118-154 in her head coaching career.

OFFENSE

- Six Lady Raiders scored 10+ points against Alcorn State, Jada Terry (15), Arella Guirantes (13), Dayo Olabode (12), Reece' Caldwell (11), Larryn Brooks (10) and Grayson Bright (10).
- This is the first game that six players have scored double-digit points. The Lady Raiders have had two or more players score double figures in all 10 games played.
- The Lady Raiders scored 20+ points in the three of the four quarters tonight. Texas Tech has scored 20+ points in two or more quarters in five games this season.
- The Lady Raiders have scored 20+ points in 19 of the 39 quarters played this season.
- Texas Tech has scored 20+ points in at least one quarter in all 10 games played this season.
- The Lady Raiders shot 57.6 percent from the field, the second best of the season.
- The Lady Raiders' 28 points in the fourth quarter was the most in a fourth quarter since the new rule last season.
- The 53-point deficit was the largest win for the Lady Raiders this season.

DEFENSE

- The Lady Raiders held Alcorn State to less than 10 points in the second quarter.
- The Lady Raiders held Alcorn State to just 37 points. The last time Texas Tech held a team to 40 points or fewer was when TCU scored 37 on Jan. 4, 2015.
- The Lady Raiders forced a season-best 12 turnovers in the first half.

JADA TERRY

- Junior center Jada Terry led the team with 15 points and three rebounds. She went 6-for-7 from the field and 3-for-6 from the free throw line.

ARELLA GUIRANTES

- Freshman guard Arella Guirantes scored 13 points for the Lady Raiders. She has scored in double figures in eight of the 10 games this season.

DAYO OLABODE

- Junior Dayo Olabode scored a season-high 12 points against the Lady Braves. She went 3-for-6 from the field and 5-for-5 from the free throw line.

REECE' CALDWELL

- Reece' Caldwell scored 11 points for her eighth double-digit game of the season.
- The sophomore also had a career-high nine assists and a steal.

LARRYN BROOKS

- Junior guard Larryn Brooks scored 10 points, recorded three rebounds and three assists in Sunday's win.

GRAYSON BRIGHT

- Freshman Grayson Bright tied her career-high 10 points and tallied a career-high five rebounds, career-tying three assists and career-tying two steals.

BRIELLE BLAIRE

- Junior forward Brielle Blaire saw a season-best nine minutes of play time. She scored six points as she went 2-for-3 from the field and 2-for-2 from the line.

- The Lady Raiders host UT-Arlington for the final non-conference home game of the season on Thursday, Dec. 22. Tip is set for 2 p.m. at the United Supermarkets Arena.
