

- Texas Tech concludes its non-conference slate as the Lady Raiders host UTA on Thursday for a 2 p.m. tip.
- Thursday's game marks the 13th meeting between the two programs. The Lady Raiders hold a 12-1 alltime record over the Lady Mavericks. This is the first meeting under Head Coach Candi Whitaker.

- Former Lady Raider Krista (Kirkland) Gerlich returns to Lubbock for the first time as head coach of the Lady Mavericks. She was a member of the 1993 National Championship team. Her No. 21 jersey was retired on Dec. 4, 1993 and she was inducted into the Texas Tech Hall of Fame in 2003.
- This is the second game this season that two former Lady Raiders coached against each other. The first was when Noel Johnson and Midwestern State came to Lubbock for the exhibition game.
- ▶ In the last meeting, Texas Tech defeated UTA, 88-48, on Dec. 7, 2012 in Lubbock. The Lady Raiders are 8-0 in home meetings against the Lady Mavericks.
- Texas Tech enters the matchup on a three-game win streak. The Lady Raiders routed Alcorn State, 90-37, on Sunday. This was the third time this season the Lady Raiders have scored 90 points in a game. Texas Tech scored 90 in back-to-back games in the season opener vs. North Dakota (W, 90-80) and at #24 Texas A&M (L, 90-98).
- ► For the first time this season, six Lady Raiders scored 10+ points. Jada Terry led the team with 15 points, shooting .857 (6-7) from the field.
- UTA comes to Lubbock on a two-game win streak after defeating Texas A&M-Commerce, 80-50, on Sunday.


TEXAS TECH-UTA SERIES

- ► Thursday's game marks the 13th meeting between the Lady Raiders and Lady Mavericks and the first under both head coaches for each program.
- ► In the last meeting, Texas Tech defeated UTA, 88-48, on Dec. 7, 2012. The Lady Raiders hold a 8-0 record in home meetings against the Lady Mavericks.
- Former Lady Raider Krista (Kirkland) Gerlich returns to Texas Tech for the first time as a head coach. She was a member of the 1993 National Championship team.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Texas Tech Lady Raiders picked up their largest win of the season, routing Alcorn State, 90-37, on Sunday.
- ► Texas Tech (7-3) outscored the Lady Braves (0-9) 52-10 in the paint and scored 20+ points in three of the four quarters.
- ▶ Defensively, the Lady Raiders held Alcorn State to just 37 points. The last time the Lady Raiders held an opponent to 40 points or fewer was when TCU scored 37 on Jan. 4, 2015. The Lady Raiders also forced a season-best 11 turnovers in the first half alone.
- ► Six Lady Raiders scored double-digit points for the first time this season. Junior center Jada Terry led the team with 15 points as she went 6-for-7 from the field. Freshman Arella Guirantes followed with 13 points, marking her eighth double-digit game of the season. Junior Dayo Olabode scored a season-best 12 points against the Lady Braves while sophomore Recee' Caldwell scored 11 points and a season-best nine assists.

BREAKING RECORDS

- ► The Lady Raiders scored 29 points in the final quarter against Alcorn State, setting a new record for most points scored in a fourth quarter.
- ► Sophomore Recee' Caldwell scored 15 points in the final quarter at Arkansas, becoming the first Lady Raider to score 15+ points in a quarter.
- ► The Lady Raiders' 71 boards against New Mexico (11/20) broke a 22-year-old school record for the most rebounds in a game. The previous record was 66 rebounds coming against SMU on Jan. 18, 1994.
- ► The Lady Raiders' 49 defensive rebounds also broke a 13-year-old record. The previous record was 43 defensive rebounds coming at Oklahoma State on Feb. 22, 2003.
- ► The Lady Raiders had 21 rebounds in the third period alone, marking the most in a quarter since the start of quarter play in 2015.

- In the season opener, the Lady Raiders scored 33 points in the first quarter, the most in a quarter since the NCAA moved to quarter play last season.
- ▶ The Lady Raiders recorded six 3-pointers in the first quarter against North Dakota, marking the most made in a quarter.

RECEE' CALDWELL

- ► Sophomore Recee' Caldwell led the Lady Raiders with 29 points against Arkansas, her second-best of the season. She scored 15 points in the final quarter, becoming the first Lady Raider to score 15+ points in a quarter. Her 24 points in the second half marked the first time a Lady Raider has accomplished this feat since Jia Perkins scored 21 against Creighton on Dec. 4, 2002.
- ► Caldwell also scored 16 points against Prairie View A&M, marking her fourth double-digit game of the season. She went 4-for-7 (.571) from behind the arc, her best performance of the season.
- ▶ With the 38 points against No. 24 Texas A&M, she became the first Lady Raider to score 35+ points since Alesha Robertson scored 37 against Miami (12/6/04).
- ► Caldwell scored 11 points in the third quarter against Texas A&M to become the first Lady Raider to score 10+ points in a quarter since she last did it against North Dakota (11/13/16).
- ► She also became the first Lady Raider to make 15+ field goals since Jia Perkins made 17 against Creighton (12/4/02).
- ► Caldwell ranks second in scoring amongst the Big 12, averaging 18.4 points per game. She also leads the league in 3-PTs made (28 / 3.5). Her 38 points vs. Texas A&M is the most by any player in the conference this season.

ARELLA GUIRANTES

- Freshman Arella Guirantes led the team with a career-high 22 points against Central Arkansas on Wednesday. That was her second game with 20+ points and her seventh double-figure game.
- ► Guirantes leads all Big 12 freshmen in three categories including scoring (14.7 ppg), blocks (1.9 bpg) and free throw percent (86.2%).
- Guirantes recorded a career-high five blocks in the win over Prairie View, becoming the first Lady Raider to record 5+ blocks in a game since Haley Schnieder had six against Kansas on Feb. 1, 2014.
- ▶ In her first double-double of the season, Guirantes scored a career-high 21 points and 13 rebounds against New Mexico.
- Guirantes has scored double digit points in five of the six games played this season.
- Guard Arella Guirantes scored 17 points against #24 Texas A&M (11/17). She hit a jumper at the buzzer to tie the game 83-83 at the end of regulation and force the Aggies into overtime.

JADA TERRY

- ▶ Junior Jada Terry led the team with 15 points against the Lady Braves on Sunday.
- She recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds against the Cougars. She has scored double digits in seven games this season.
- ► Terry leads the team and the Big 12 with four double-doubles on the year.
- In her first double-double of the season, Terry scored 24 points and recorded 11 rebounds against No. 24 Texas A&M. Both were career highs for the junior.

CANDI WHITAKER

TEXAS TECH HEAD COACH



- Head coach Candi Whitaker enters her fourth season at the helm of the Lady Raider basketball program.
- Became the sixth women's basketball head coach at Tech on May 20, 2013.
- First former Lady Raider to become the women's basketball head coach.
- Won her first game as the women's basketball head coach on Nov. 10, 2013.
- Led the 2014-15 Lady Raiders to a nine-win increase overall from the 2013-14 season, and a five-win jump in conference play. Not only that, but six additional games were within reach in the final minute bringing even more confidence to the 2015-16 squad.
- Spent 2012-13 season as associate head coach at Oklahoma State under Jim Littell and helped the Cowgirls reach the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Became one of the youngest head coaches in women's basketball at 26 when she took over the program at UMKC in 2006 after two years as an assistant coach.
- Won 77 games at UMKC to become the second-winningest head coach in program history while leading the Roos to their first two postseason appearances in the 2010 WBI and 2012 WNIT.
- UMKC went 22-12 in Whitaker's last season at the helm and advanced to the Summitt League Tournament Championship for the first time since 2005.
- Had a 100 percent graduation rate from all players who completed their four-year eligibility at UMKC.
- As a player, Whitaker (then known as Candi White) helped lead Texas Tech to back-to-back Sweet 16 appearances in the NCAA Tournament from 2000-02.
- The Lady Raiders won 45 games over her two seasons as the point guard for legendary head coach Marsha Sharp and rose as high as No. 7 in the national polls.
- Started and played in all 64 games over two seasons while tallying 232 points and 249 assists with 87 steals.
- Graduated from Texas Tech in 2002 with a degree in Exercise Sports Science and earned her Masters degree in Sports Administration at Valparaiso in 2004.
- Married husband, Matt Whitaker, in April 2007. They have two sons, Westin and William.
