Conference News & Notes

2:41 Fifty percent of Big I2 teams enter the 2016 season ranked or receiving votes, including Oklahoma who is rated third in both national polls and begins the year versus No. 13/15 Houston in NRG Stadium in Houston.

The Big I2 opens the season as the only autonomy conference with three 2:41 week I non-conference games against top 15 opponents. Two of the three will be played away from home.

The Big I2 is one of two peer leagues in which at least 30 percent of its 2:41[openers will be against ranked non-conference teams.

Half of the non-conference slate (I5 games) features teams that played in 2:41 bowl games last season. The Big I2 will play five teams that competed in CFP New Year's Bowls (Stanford, Iowa, Ohio State, Notre Dame and Houston), the second-most of the peer leagues.

2:11 Thirty percent of this season's non-conference games are against autonomy conference opponents. Only one other league plays a higher percentage.

2:11 The Big I2 is one of two leagues to enter the season with at least 60 percent of teams in ESPN's Power Index top 30 - 3. Oklahoma, 8. Oklahoma State, 22. Baylor, 23. Texas, 26. West Virginia and 29. TCU.

The only three active FBS head coaches with I43-plus wins at their 2:11 current school reside in the Big I2 - Bill Snyder (K-State) 193, Bob Stoops (Oklahoma) 179 and Gary Patterson (TCU) 143.

The Big I2 will have a medical observer stationed in the press box for all of 2:41 its home games this season. Non-conference opponents playing at Big I2 host sites will have the opportunity to utilize the medical observer.


