- The Red Raiders also lead the Big 12 and rank among the NCAA's Top 30 in steals per game (10.5 • 22nd) and turnovers forced per game (20.5 • 24th).

EVANS AND SMITH NAMED ALL-BIG 12 PRESEASON

- Keenan Evans and Zach Smith became the third pair of Texas Tech teammates to capture All-Big 12 Preseason honors announced on Oct. 12 by the conference office.

- Evans and Smith join Jarrius Jackson and Martin Zeno in 2005-06 along with John Roberson and Mike Singletary in 2010-11 as the only pair of Texas Tech teammates to garner All-Big 12 Preseason awards.

- Smith, a two-time All-Big 12 Honorable Mention pick, is the fourth player and first since Jackson in 2006-07 to secure an All-Big 12 Preseason Team nod.

SMITH LANDS ON KARL MALONE WATCH LIST

- Zach Smith made program history on Oct. 19 when he was named as one of 20 players on the prestigious Karl Malone Award Watch List.

- Smith is the first Texas Tech player to be recognized by either of the five preseason watch lists for honors presented by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame. The list includes the Bob Cousy, Jerry West, Julius Erving, Karl Malone and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar awards.

- By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2018 Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award will be narrowed to just 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to Mr. Malone and the Hall of Fame's selection committee.

- Previous winners of the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award have come from the Big 12 Conference in each of the last two seasons by Baylor's Johnathan Motley and Iowa State's Georges Niang. The initial award went to Montrezl Harrell of Louisville in 2015.

RED RAIDERS HOST 'THROWBACK GAME'; RETURN TO THE COLISEUM

- The Texas Tech men's basketball program will turn back the clock and play host to former Southwest Conference rival Rice in a 'Throwback Game' on Saturday, Dec. 16 at the Lubbock Municipal Coliseum.

- Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. from The Bubble which served as Texas Tech's home court from 1956-57 to 1998-99 highlighted by a 35-game winning streak and two undefeated marks during the 1994-95 and 1995-96 seasons.

- The Red Raiders will honor their past by wearing commemorative jerseys and by hosting an Alumni Game prior to the event.

\$10 MILLION GIFT FOR BASKETBALL PRACTICE FACILITY

- Texas Tech Director of Athletics Kirby Hocutt announced on November 8th a \$10 million gift to The Campaign for Fearless Champions that will be used to construct The Dustin R. Womble Basketball Practice Facility.

- Hocutt recognized the Dusty and Leisha Womble family for their generous lead gift to the project while also presenting renderings for the proposed \$23 million facility.

- The Dustin R. Womble Basketball Practice Facility will be located directly across Indiana Avenue, providing student-athletes and coaches quick access to nearby United Supermarkets Arena.

- The Red Raiders will move their day-to-day operations to the facility once completed, giving both teams 24-hour access throughout the year for student-athletes to practice and train.

- The Dustin R. Womble Basketball Practice Facility will feature two practice courts, a strength and conditioning weight room, men's and women's basketball coaches' offices as well as sports medicine and nutrition areas.

- The facility will be made possible by gifts to The Campaign for Fearless Champions, which has already funded 22 facility projects since its launch in August 2014.

- Over the past year, Texas Tech has made significant renovations to United Supermarkets Arena with upgrades to the locker room, film areas and sports medicine facilities. In addition, Texas Tech also installed a new center-hung video board prior to the 2016-17 season that drastically improved the gameday environment.

WHAT'S NEXT - 2018-19 EARLY SIGNEES

• Texas Tech has signed Deshawn Corprew and Kyler Edwards to National Letter of Intent (NLI) and Athletic Scholarship Agreement (ASA) as part of the NCAA fall signing period.

• Corprew and Edwards are the fifth and sixth Top 100 high school players to sign with Texas Tech under second-year head coach Chris Beard. The list also includes Jarrett Culver, Hyron Edwards, Brandone Francis and Tommy Hamilton IV.

• Corprew, a 6-6 forward from Norfolk, Virginia, is a freshman at South Plains College playing for Steve Green, the reigning National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) National Coach of the Year.

• Corprew has posted 13.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game for the No. 3 ranked Texans during his first two games of the 2017-18 season. He has hit on 55.6 percent of his field goal attempts.

• Corprew was a Top 100 player and four-star recruit out of high school where he played at Quality Education Academy. He was ranked No. 7 overall player in the state of Virginia per 247Sports in the class of 2016.

• Edwards, a 6-4 guard from Arlington, Texas, is playing his final season of prep basketball at the prestigious Findlay Prep in Nevada.

• Edwards received close to 30 scholarship offers and chose the Red Raiders over Butler, Georgia Tech, Kansas State, Oklahoma State and Virginia Tech.

• Edwards amassed 22.4 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game during his junior season at Arlington Bowie High School. He was tabbed the District 4-6A Offensive Player of the Year.

MEN'S BASKETBALL ROUTS MAINE, 83-44, MOVES TO 2-0 ON THE SEASON

- Texas Tech used a balanced scoring attack as seven players scored seven or more points during an 83-44 wire-to-wire victory over Maine to conclude the regional round of the Naim-Smith Memorial Hall of Fame Tournament on Tuesday at the United Supermarkets Arena.
- The Red Raiders (2-0) have won their first two games for the fifth time in the last seven seasons and extended its non-conference home winning streak to 31 games dating back to the 2013-14 campaign.
- Four players hit for double figures headed by Keenan Evans' 12 points and four assists. He pushed his streak to 22 straight games with 10 or more points, and the senior guard moved to within 38 points of reaching 1,000 for his career.
- Evans' 22-game streak is the longest for a Texas Tech player since Rayford Young pieced together 23 consecutive games in double figures during the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 seasons.
- Jarrett Culver and Zhaire Smith registered 11 points each on a combined 8-of-13 shooting effort. For Smith, he has reached double figures in back-to-back games to start his career and also grabbed seven rebounds.
- Norense Odiase and Brandone Francis secured eight points apiece as Texas Tech racked up a healthy 48-19 advantage in bench points.

• Niem Stevenson tacked on 10 points and a team-high eight rebounds in an active 19 minutes of court time, while Zach Smith chipped in three points, six rebounds, three blocks and three assists. The three rejections enabled Smith to move within 24 blocks of former All-American Tony Battie's program record.

• Tommy Hamilton IV garnered seven points, three rebounds and a block followed by Davide Moretti's five points, three assists and two steals.

• The Red Raiders also received four points and four assists versus zero turnovers courtesy of Josh Webster, and Malik Ondigo also scored his first career points in a Texas Tech uniform.

• The Red Raiders sank 29-of-57 from the field and drained eight of their 10 three-pointers during the opening 20 minutes. Texas Tech also connected on 15-of-19 at the free throw line. The Red Raiders forced Maine into 17 turnovers and came away with 24 of the game's 29 points off turnovers.

• Maine was limited to a 14-for-57 shooting clip and misfired on 18 of its 21 three-point attempts. The Black Bears were 13-for-15 at the charity stripe. Andrew Fleming and Ilija Stojiljkovic tallied eight points apiece to lead Maine.

MOMENTS THAT MATTERED

• Texas Tech snatched the momentum early and often en route to an 11-0 lead during the opening 3:11 of the contest sparked by a barrage of three-pointers from Stevenson, Evans and Culver.

• The Red Raiders ballooned the advantage out to 24-3 with 10:48 remaining. Zhaire Smith got rolling with a two-handed slam, a layup and a pair of free throws. Moretti rattled home a triple, and Justin Gray capped the flurry with a 10-floater off glass.

• Texas Tech stretched the lead to 30 points when Stevenson scored off an inbounds play out of a media timeout with 3:26 to go. The Red Raiders took a 49-13 edge into the locker room. The 13 points were the fewest points allowed in a half under Beard.

• Texas Tech went up by as much as 48 points after Stevenson finished a traditional three-point play at the 6:24 mark of the second half. The Red Raiders held Maine to 44 points, the second-lowest total for an opponent, in 34 games under Beard.

FROM THE BENCH WITH COACH BEARD

"I thought we did a good job of trying to defend the three-point line. Every team has an identity. In competition, you try to stop what the other guy wants to do. It's a lot easier said than done especially at our level. Maine is a very good three-point shooting team. They are a team that is going to win a lot of games this year because of their ability to shoot three's. They have five guys out there at one time on the floor that can all shoot the ball. I liked our urgency, I liked our game plan and I liked our players buying into the game plan especially early. From their point of view, we did miss some shots so we were fortunate tonight. I think you have to give our guys credit because we had an urgency to defend the three for most of the game."

"We take away a lot of things anytime we play. We will study our offense and our defense. We will try to get individual players better, and we will try to get our team better at the same time. I have a lot of respect for Maine. I thought the way they played in the second half – basically they outplayed us. That is a direct reflection of their coaching and their guy's discipline and heart. I thought it was a well-coached team. We played great early, and we made shots that made the deficit large at halftime. I thought Maine played great down the stretch."

TEXAS TECH VS. THE ACC

• Texas Tech has posted a 7-21 overall record against the 15 current members of the ACC. The Red Raiders have yet to face Duke, Florida State, Louisville or Virginia. Texas Tech has notched three of its seven wins over Georgia Tech along with victories over Boston College, North Carolina, North Carolina State and Syracuse.

• Texas Tech's last win over an ACC opponent was an 80-72 victory over Georgia Tech on March 26, 2003 during the NIT Quarterfinals. Andre Emmett poured in 29 points followed by Robert Tomaszek's 19 points and Kasib Powell's 15 points. The Yellow Jackets were fueled by 21 points each courtesy of Chris Bosh and B.J. Elder.

• Texas Tech's most notable win over an ACC team was a 92-73 victory over North Carolina on March 17, 1996 during the NCAA Tournament 2nd Round. Jason Sasser was one of five players in double figures with 27 points on 10-of-13 shooting. Cory Carr (19 PTS), Tony Battie (16 PTS, 14 REB), Darvin Ham (14 PTS) and Koy Smith (13 PTS) also surpassed 10-plus points. Ham provided the game's signature moment breaking the backboard on a dunk with 12 minutes left in the 1st half.

CAREER AND TEXAS TECH

Chris Beard enters his second season as head coach and his 12th season overall with the Texas Tech men's basketball program. He was named the program's 17th head coach on April 15, 2016 by Director of Athletics Kirby Hocutt and Interim University President Dr. John Opperman.

Beard's 18 victories were third in program history for a coach during his first season only behind Bob Knight (23 – 2001-02) and Gene Gibson (19 – 1961-62). The Red Raiders also collected two wins versus Associated Press Top 10 opponents in No. 4 Baylor and No. 7 West Virginia for the first time since the 2007-08 season when Texas Tech knocked off No. 5 Texas and No. 10 Texas A&M.

Beard has either coached and/or recruited 14 of Texas Tech's 19 All-Big 12 selections highlighted by seven of the 10 honorees on the first, second and third teams in program history.

Keenan Evans was an All-Big 12 Third-Team pick after he nearly doubled scoring average with 15.4 points per game last season. Evans was joined by Zach Smith as All-Big 12 Preseason in 2017-18, the third time in program history and the first going back to 2010-11 that Texas Tech has had two players on the list.

Texas Tech connected for a 46.9 team field percentage, the program's highest mark since a 47.6 clip during the 2004-05 season. The Red Raiders also limited their opponents to 67.1 points per game last season which was good enough for third place in the Big 12 rankings. It marked the Red Raiders best finish in that category since the 2013-14 season.

Texas Tech has had five seasons with a winning record in Big 12 conference play, four of which came when Beard was an assistant coach. The Red Raiders also recorded four of their five top half finishes in the Big 12 during Beard's time as an assistant coach.

Beard's six wins in Big 12 play during the 2016-17 season matched TCU's Jamie Dixon and West Virginia's Bob Huggins and were more than Baylor's Scott Drew and Oklahoma's Lon Kruger during their first seasons as Big 12 head coaches at their respective schools.

Beard guided Little Rock to a historic turnaround in 2015-16 fueled by 30 victories, which was a program single season record and Sun Belt single season mark. The Trojans claimed the Sun Belt regular season and tournament titles en route to the program's fifth NCAA Tournament bid.

Little Rock overcame a 14-point deficit during the final five minutes of the second half and won an 85-83 double overtime thriller over No. 12-ranked and fifth-seeded Purdue in the NCAA Tournament. The Trojans also registered road victories over San Diego State, Tulsa and DePaul to spark a 10-0 regular season start. The 10-game winning streak to start the season matched a Little Rock program record.

Beard's 30-5 record in his only season at Little Rock was a 15-game improvement from a 13-18 campaign prior to his arrival. The 15-game improvement was tied for the NCAA's top spot in 2015-16, while his 30 victories was tied for sixth by a first-year Division I head coach. Little Rock's 27 wins and .871 winning percentage led the nation during the regular season. For his efforts, Beard collected National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 24 and Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Beard has amassed a 189-64 record, a .747 winning percentage and 23.6 victories per season over his eight seasons as a head coach. His previous head coaching stops include Fort Scott Community College, Seminole State College, McMurry University, Angelo State, Little Rock and UNLV.

Beard's roots in Lubbock and West Texas run deep. He spent 10 years at Texas Tech which included seven seasons as an assistant coach under Hall of Fame Coach Bob Knight and three seasons as an associate head coach under Pat Knight. The Red Raiders racked up 188 victories -- the best 10-year stretch in program history -- while Tech piled up four NCAA Tournament bids and three NIT appearances. His tenure with the Red Raiders was highlighted by Tech's run to the 2005 NCAA Sweet 16 where the Red Raiders defeated UCLA and No. 11-ranked and three-seeded Gonzaga in the first two rounds.

Beard spent two seasons at Angelo State from 2013-15 where he secured NABC South Central Region and Lone Star Conference Coach of the Year after he guided the Rams to a program record-setting 28 wins and the program's first NCAA Division II Sweet 16 appearance in 2014-15. Angelo State began the season with a 17-0 record and finished with a No. 19 national ranking. Prior to Beard's arrival, the Rams suffered three consecutive losing seasons which included a 71-9 mark in 2012-13.

Before Angelo State, Beard was the head coach at McMurry University and for the American Basketball Association's (ABA) South Carolina Warriors. McMurry went 19-10 with Beard at the helm during the program's first season as a Division II member in 2012-13. The Warriors won the 2012 Mid Atlantic Championship, advanced to the ABA finals and notched a 31-2 mark as a first-year franchise.

Raised in Irving, Texas, Beard's coaching career began in the Lone Star State as a graduate assistant at Incarnate Ward followed by a pair of assistant coaching stints at Abilene Christian and North Texas.

Leading into his time with Texas Tech, Beard's first two head coaching opportunities came at Fort Scott Community College in Kansas and Seminole State College in Oklahoma. He led Seminole State College to a 25-6 record and a No. 14 national ranking in 2000-01 after Fort Scott came away with 19 victories and a NJCAA Regional appearance in 1999-2000.

Beard earned his bachelor's degree in kinesiology from the University of Texas in 1995. He has three daughters: Avery, Ella and Margo.
