GETTING STARTED

- Today marked the 67th consecutive season Texas Tech and Baylor have met and 81st time overall in the all-time series.
- Texas Tech wore throwback black helmets, black jerseys and black pants against Baylor.
- Today's game captains were Tyree Wilson, Jaylon Hutchings, Myles Price, and Tony Bradford Jr.
- Tech won the coin toss and elected to defer to the second half. Baylor started with the ball. Tech has won the coin toss three times in 2022.
- Today's game was televised by ESPN2. It is Tech's second appearance on the network this season (at NC State).

TEXAS TECH'S LOSS...

- Gives Texas Tech a 4-4 overall record in 2022.
- Gives Texas Tech a 4-1 record in home games in 2022.
- Gives Texas Tech a 2-1 record against unranked opponents in 2022.
- Gives Texas Tech a 2-3 record in Big 12 games in 2022.
- Gives Texas Tech a 39-41-1 all-time record against Baylor.
- Gives Texas Tech a 20-15 record in home games at Jones AT&T Stadium played against Baylor.
- Gives Texas Tech an 18-9 all-time record against Baylor in Big 12 competition.
- Gives Texas Tech an 8-1 all-time record in home games against Baylor in Big 12 competition.

TEXAS TECH'S TEAM NOTES

- Jones AT&T Stadium sold out for the second time in 2022. The last time Tech announced two sellouts in the same season was in 2018.
- Texas Tech was held from scoring in the first quarter for the third time this season. Tech lost all three of those contests (at NC State, at K-State, vs. Baylor).
- Tech drops to 1-3 this season when the opponent scores first.
- Tech was held to less the 20 minutes of possession time for the first time since 2021 against Stephen F. Austin.

NOTING THE RED RAIDERS | OFFENSE

- 7:34, 3Q: Red Raiders' tight end Henry Teeter caught his first career touchdown pass (1-yard pass from Morton).
- 2:46, 3Q: Red Raiders closed the gap to seven points. Morton's 8-yard rush on 4th and 7 from the 8-yard line.
- Tech turned the ball over five times, each an interception. Five interceptions committed by the offense was the most since Nov. 22, 2003 versus No. 1 Oklahoma.
- The last time Texas Tech committed five turnovers of any kind was in 2009 versus Texas A&M.
- Tech is 1-3 this season when committing three or more turnovers.

NOTING THE RED RAIDERS | DEFENSE

- 4:55, 3Q: The Red Raiders' had its first takeaway. Rayshad Williams recovered a fumbled pitch by the halfback on a quarterback option.
- Tech's defense had one takeaway tonight. The Red Raiders are 1-4 this season when having zero or one turnover while 3-0 when having two or more takeaways.
- Three Red Raiders recorded double-digit tackles (Kosi Eldridge-12, Krishon Merriweather-12, Tyree Wilson-10). It was the first time since Nov. 7, 2015 at West Virginia that three players (Micah Awe, D'Bonta Hinton, Jah'Shawn Johnson) posted double-digit tackles in the same game.
- Kosi Eldridge posted a career-high 12 tackles. It surpassed his previous high of seven, collected twice earlier this season.
- Merriweather's 12 tackles were not a career-high, which is 17 earlier this season vs. Oklahoma State, but it was the second this season and fourth time of his career.
- Tech's 7.0 TFLs marked a tie for the second-most in a game this season, matching at NC State (7.0) and trailed hosting Murray State (13.0).
- Tony Bradford posted a career-high 3.0 TFLs. It bested 2.5 TFLs versus Kansas in 2020.
- With six tackles, Malik Dunlap matched his career-high previously set while playing for NC State. The game was against Wake Forest in 2019 when he last had six tackles in a game.
- The last time the defense faced 50-plus rushes by its opponent was last year's game against Baylor when the Bears rushed 50 times. Tonight they carried it 59 times for 231 yards.
