#### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

- Gonzaga is 1-4 all-time against Texas Tech, most recently dropping a pair of narrow 5-4 decisions in a two-game swing in Lubbock in 2021. Before that, the two programs hadn't squared off since 2010, when GU split a pair of games in Lubbock.
- In the Zags' lone win against Tech in 2010, they hit the most home runs in a single game in program history (8), with four Zags homering twice each.
- Four of the five games between the two teams have been in Lubbock, with one matchup in 2009 taking place in Palm Springs, Calif.
- This is the 67th time since 2016 GU has played a team that made the NCAA Tournament the year prior. The Zags are 33-33 in last 66.

#### **SEASON-OPENING NOTES / EARLY RETURNS**

- -Gonzaga was picked to win its third straight WCC Crown in the 2023 Coaches' Poll, receiving 6 of 10 first-place votes. San Diego, which won the 2023 WCC Tournament to get an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, earned the other four.
- -A league-leading four Zags were named to the WCC Preseason Team, with Grayson Sterling, Savier Pinales, Cade McGee and Owen Wild all earning nods.
- For the first season since 2016, the Bulldogs will be opening their season outside of Arizona after appearing in the Sanderson Ford Collegiate Baseball Classic in Surprise, Ariz. the last six seasons.
- GU is coming off a program-best No. 10 ranking and its second straight year with a win in the NCAA Tournament in 2022 — the first time in program history the Zags have done so since 1984 — after appearing as a #2 seed in the 2022 Blacksburg Regional.
- Owen Wild was named a Preseason Second Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball News. GU was ranked No. 38 nationally in Collegiate Baseball's Preseason Poll.

#### 'MADE-FOR-RPI' SCHEDULE

- 13 of GU's 19 opponents in 2023 finished last season in the Top 150 in the NCAA's final RPI ranking, with two of those opponents Tennessee and Oregon State finishing No. 1 and No. 2 in those final rankings before hosting NCAA Regionals. Other highlights include a three-game series with 2022 College World Series Runner-Up Oklahoma in Spokane and a two-game midweek matchup with Oregon in Eugene.
- Zags will have a pair of crucial home series back-to-back with BYU (March 30-April 1) and 2022 WCC Tournament Champions and NCAA Regional qualifiers San Diego (April 6-8) coming to Patterson.
- A road trip to Corvallis, Ore. for two midweek games with Oregon State is up next on April 10-11, marking the 13th and 14th time they've squared off in the last five years. The Zags went 1-3 against the Beavs in 2022, dropping a pair of neutral site games in Surprise to start the year but splitting a pair on the road, with GU's 13-6 win becoming their highest-ranked win in history.

#### OWEN WILD NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

- Gonzaga RHP Owen Wild was named a Preseason Second Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, the outlet announced.
- -The honor makes it back-to-back years that a GU pitcher picks up preseason All-America honors from the outlet after Gabriel Hughes did the same in 2022.

Initially appearing as a reliever last spring before taking over as a starter in the absence of William Kempner due to injury, Wild gained momentum as the season went on, accumulating a 9-1 record to go with a team-best 3.03 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 16 appearances. Wild's breakout year culminated in an All-Blacksburg Regional Team nod after pitching six shutout innings of relief to help cue a Bulldogs rally in an NCAA Tournament game against Wright State, as well as All-WCC Tournament and All-WCC Honorable Mention honors.

-Wild's .900 career winning percentage is the highest of any GU pitcher with at least 10 games of record, and the fourth-highest in a single season.

#### PITCHING ROUNDUP

-The Zags lost three starters (Gabriel Hughes, William Kempner and Trystan Vrieling) and a crucial reliever (Brody Jessee) to the MLB Draft as well as two more (Michael Spellacy and Nico Zeglin) to graduation, but return RHP

- Owen Wild (9-1 in 2022, 3.03 ERA), who will move into the Friday starting role after a strong finish to 2022 that saw him pick up All-WCC Tournament and All-Blacksburg Regional honors.
- GU brings in some experienced newcomers in RHP Ty Buckner (Missouri St transfer, ) and RHP Jeff Nelson, who was the NWAC Pitcher of the Year in 2022 at Mt. Hood CC (Ore.).
- Jacob Rutherford, who held opposing batters to a .169 average in 2022, the third-best in a single season in program history.
- Blue-chip freshmen Payton Graham (No. 8 overall recruit in WA on Perfect Game, No. 5 RHP) and Matthew Mueller (No. 1 LHP in WI, No. 12 overall) also look to make an impact in their first year at GU.

#### RETURNER-FILLED LINEUP

- DH Brian Kalmer, the 2022 NJCAA Player of the Year out of Wabash Valley, brings some power to the lineup to help replace the loss of 2022 All-WCC C/DH Tyler Rando to graduation. Kalmer batted .421 to go with 20 homers and 109 RBI against JuCo opponents in 2022.
- GU returns 5 of its top 6 hitters by average from last spring, led by 2022 Freshman All-American Cade McGee , Savier Pinales, Grayson Sterling, Enzo Apodaca and Ezra Samperi.
- The Zags get back starters at every position except first base, including WCC Defensive Player of the Year Connor Coballes at shortstop, who finished the season ranked among the Top 50 in the nation's toughest to strike out and 130 assists to just 7 errors.

#### 2022 HIGHLIGHTS

- The Zags' 37 wins match the fifth-most in program history and are the most under Head Coach Mark Machtolf. The 37 victories are also the most in 32 years when GU won 37 games in 1990.
- The Bulldogs appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the 12th time in program history, and for the fourth time in the last six tournaments (2022, 2021, 2018, 2016).
- The Zags clinched their second straight regular season conference title and the sixth in program history. GU has won either the WCC's regular season or tournament title in five of the last six seasons.
- The Bulldogs appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the 12th time in program history, and for the fourth

time in the last six tournaments (2022, 2021, 2018, 2016).

- Mark Machtolf was named the WCC Coach of the Year, while Connor Coballes and Cade McGee were named the league's Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year. Machtolf earned the honor for the fifth time, and second straight season, and for the third time since 2017.
- Gonzaga won all nine of its West Coast Conference series in 2022, finishing 20-7 in conference play. It marked the first time the Bulldogs have ever won every WCC series in a season since joining the league in 1996. The Zags lost only one weekend series this season, dropping a pair of games to Long Beach State on the road in March.
- GU matched its record for most West Coast Conference wins in a season at 20. The Bulldogs were 20-7 in WCC play in 2017, 2021, and 2022.
- The Bulldogs were 10th in the country with six shutouts and seventh with 10.7 strikeouts per nine innings. They led the WCC in both of those stat categories. GU was 15th in the nation in Earned Run Average (3.95) and 19th in Fielding Percentage (.979).
- The Bulldogs' No. 10 ranking was the highest under Mark Machtolf's 19 seasons at the helm.
- GU boasted three wins over Top-5 teams, going 4-1 versus Top-10 competition, including a 13-6 victory at No. 2 Oregon State on April 18, the highest-ranked foe the Zags have ever beat.

#### HISTORY IN CORVALLIS

- On April 18, Gonzaga traded blows early with No. 2 Oregon State, but cruised to an 11-6 lead after a seven-run third frame and didn't look back en route to a 13-6 win the highest-ranked opponent they've beaten in program history.
- Jacob Rutherford put together the best performance of his career over four frames on the mound, striking out a career-high six while holding the Beavers to just one run in that span

for his second win of the season. Zeglin earned the save with three frames of scoreless relief, striking out five more in the process.

#### **SWEEPING IN STILLWATER**

- In its first-ever sweep over a Top-10 team, GU knocked off No. 4 Oklahoma State 4-3 on March 4, 2-1 in the tenth inning on March 5 and 2-1 on March 6 in Stillwater, Okla.
- Thanks largely to dominant starts from starting pitchers Gabriel Hughes (7 IP, 3 ER, 1 BB, 11 K), William Kempner (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 3 BB, 5 K) and Tyrstan Vrieling (5 IP, 0 ER, 4 BB, 13 K) and shutdown infield defense that held the Cowboys to just five runs on 17 hits over the series.
- -The Bulldogs never trailed in any game of the three-game road series.

#### **BLACKSBURG REGIONAL**

- GU's #2 seed matched a program-best set in 2021.
- After falling to #3-seed Columbia 8-2 in game one, Gonzaga came away with an NCAA Tournament win in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history after rallying to eliminate #4-seed Wright State in game two, 11-9.
- The Bulldogs were eliminated by the Lions in their third game, falling 15-6.

#### 30 WINS AGAIN IN 2022

Gonzaga surpassed 30 wins for the sixth straight full season and ninth time in the last 11 seasons in 2022, finishing the season with a 37-19 overall record. During head coach Mark Machtolf's now 20 years at the helm, GU has won at least 30 games 12 times.

# **QUICK FACTS ON THE PROGRAM**

- The Bulldogs have made three of the last four NCAA tournaments that have been held, and were nationally ranked in multiple polls for the third season in a row in 2022.
- Since 2016, GU boasts a 231-144 record, with five WCC titles (2016, 2017, 2018, 2021, 2022) and four NCAA Tournament appearances (2016, 2018, 2021, 2022). 23 former Zags have been selected in the MLB Draft since then, with four making their major league debuts during the 2020 and 2021 seasons. The Zags have a 123-85 record against WCC opponents in that span.
- Since 2019, Gonzaga scored 651 total runs against WCC opponents, which leads the conference. The Bulldogs have led the WCC four separate times in strikeouts since 2016, including Brandon Bailey's 125 strikeouts in 2016, which was tied for seventh in the nation.
- In the past decade, 49 Zags have been selected All-WCC, with 13 earning WCC First-Team honors, 11 making the WCC Second Team, and 25 honorable Mentions.
- Coach Machtolf has earned WCC Coach of the Year five times during his tenure at GU, including three times since 2017. In addition, Gonzaga has had two WCC Players of the Year, three Defensive Players of the Year, two Freshmen of the Year, and three Pitchers of the Year in the past decade.
- GU has had five Collegiate Baseball All-American selections in the past decade, including two second-team and three third-team selections. Gonzaga has also had two Academic All-Americans and four Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American selections since 2011 to go with eight total All-West team selections, including Marco Gonzales' 2012 All-West Coast Player of the Year season.

# **MARK MACHTOLF**

# GONZAGA HEAD COACH - 20TH YEAR



Mark Machtolf enters his 20th season as the Gonzaga University baseball head coach and 31st on staff in 2023. Machtolf, a five-time WCC Coach of the Year (2009, 2013, 2017, 2021, 2022), sits as the second-winningest coach in program history with a career 558-435-2 record entering 2023. His .562 career winning percentage is also third-best all-time in Gonzaga history.

During his tenure as head coach of the Bulldogs, Machtolf has produced 124 All-WCC selections, including 17 First Team All-Conference selections, 17 Freshman All-WCC selections, six WCC Pitchers of the Year, four WCC Players of the Year, three WCC Defensive Players of the Year and two WCC Freshmen of the Year. In addition, Machtolf has coached 17 All-American selections, eight Freshman All-Americans, five Academic All-Americans, 10 All-West Region selections, two United States Baseball National Team members, an ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove recipient and the 2013 College Baseball Hall of Fame's John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year winner.

There have been 51 players under Machtolf who have been selected in the Major League Baseball draft, including three first-round selections. Of those 44 draftees, 17 were picked in the first 10 rounds of their respective drafts. Ten of Machtolf's former players have reached the big leagues — Clayton Mortensen, Steve Ames, Cody Martin, Tyler Olson, Marco Gonzales, Taylor Jones, Brandon Bailey, Eli Morgan,

Wyatt Mills and Ryan Carpenter. Since 2016, Machtolf-coached Gonzaga teams have gone 210-137 overall and 112-50 in WCC regular-season play, winning 5 WCC championships, 8 WCC Yearly Awards, making 4 NCAA Regionals and producing 23 MLB Draft picks in that span.

The Bulldogs have made the NCAA Tournament on

five occasions under Machtolf, most recently in 2022. After first qualifying with an autobid in 2009, the Zags earned their first-ever at-large bid to the tournament in 2016, finishing with a 36-21 record and a share of the WCC regular season title. Gonzaga opened the Fort Worth Regional with a 5-1 win over Arizona State. Just a week earlier, the Zags reached the title game of the WCC Tournament for the first time in the competition's four-year history. 2016's run began a streak of league dominance for the Zags, who lead the league in conference wins, titles, WCC Tournament appearances and Regionals in that span.

The Zags also earned the automatic bid to the tournament in 2018 after defeating No. 1 seed Pepperdine 17-2 in the title game of the WCC Baseball Championship. Gonzaga advanced to the Minneapolis Regional and faced elimination following a loss to No. 2 UCLA, but kept their season alive with an 8-2 win over No. 4 Canisius. Gonzaga closed the season with a loss to the Bruins, finishing the 2018 campaign with a 33-24 overall record for its ninth 30-win season under Machtolf.

GU earned its highest-ever seeding in a Regional in 2021, when the Zags were the No. 2 seed in the Eugene Regional after winning the WCC regular season title. The Zags defeated No. 3 LSU 3-0 before falling 7-3 to No. 1 Oregon and being eliminated by the Tigers in a rematch. That year, Machtolf was named WCC Coach of the Year, while Zags Alek Jacob and Brett Harris earned Pitcher of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year, respectively. Both earned Collegiate Baseball All-American honors in addition. With a 20-7 record in conference play, the Zags won the WCC Pennant in lieu of a tournament to punch their tickets to the NCAA Tourney.

After winning the WCC Regular Season title for the second consecutive year in 2022, the Bulldogs then matched that feat with a No. 2 seed in the Blacksburg Regional, winning a game in an NCAA Regional in consecutive years for the first time in program history after defeating Wright State 11-9. That season, the Bulldogs reached a program-best national ranking of No. 10 in Baseball America's poll -- the highest GU has ever been ranked under Machtolf. First-year Zags Connor Coballes and Cade McGee took home DPOY and Freshman of the Year honors, respectively.

In addition to guiding the Zags to the postseason and to league titles, Machtolf was also instrumental in the construction of Gonzaga's new state-of-the-art facility: Patterson Baseball Complex and Washington Trust Field. Machtolf assisted with shaping the new home of Bulldog baseball, which opened in 2007.

In the summer of 2006, Machtolf was named one of the assistant coaches for the USA Baseball Team. Under Machtolf's guidance, the National Team posted a 28-2-1 record, including going a perfect 8-0 at the Federation Internationale du Sport Universitaire (FISU) World Championships in Havana, Cuba. The .919 win percentage for the season was the best posted by a USA Baseball collegiate team and the tournament win was another first for a USA Baseball National Team in Cuba.

Prior to being named head coach on Aug. 7, 2003, the Spokane native served 13 years as an assistant coach for the Zags. Machtolf entered the coaching ranks as the hitting coach at Gonzaga for the 1988 season and worked with the Zags until the completion of the 1990 campaign. Following one season as an assistant coach at Spokane's Whitworth College (now University), Machtolf accepted the head coaching position at Gonzaga Prep and coached through the 1995 season. While at Prep, he volunteered with Gonzaga for two seasons before returning to the Zag dugout fulltime in 1996. He was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 1998 campaign and earned the head job six years later.

A 1987 graduate of Stanford University, Machtolf was a member of the Cardinal 1987 College World Series championship team and was an All-CWS selection. A four-year baseball letterman and two-year football letterman, Machtolf received his B.A. in history in 1987. He received a Masters of Education degree in 1990 from Whitworth.

Machtolf has three sons - David, Steven and Jack.

**BRANDON HARMON** 

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH - 11TH YEAR

Brandon Harmon will begin his first season as Associate Head Coach and 11th season overall on the baseball staff in 2023. He was elevated from volunteer assistant in September 2015, and elevated from pitching coach to associate head coach in July 2022.

Harmon has helped guide the Zags to five West Coast Conference titles in his seven years coaching GU's pitchers -2013, 2016, 2017, 2021 and 2022 – his pitching staff played a large role in the Zags' first-ever at-large bid to an NCAA Regional in 2016 as well as their highest-ever seeding in a Regional in 2021 and 2022.

In 2022, Harmon's staff shattered the previous record for strikeouts with 596 and finished Top-50 in ERA (4.32, 35th), hits allowed per nine innings (8.35, 28th) and top-10 in shutouts (6, 10th) and strikeouts per game (10.6, 9th) led by First Team All-American Gabriel Hughes, who finished ninth in the nation with 138 strikeouts. Hughes was one of four of Harmon's pitchers to be drafted in the 2022 MLB Draft, becoming the highest draft pick in GU history with his 10th overall selection by the Rockies. Following him were Trystan Vrieling (Round 3, Pick 100) to the Yankees, Will Kempner (Round 3,

Pick 106) to the Giants and Brody Jesse (Round 10, Pick 303) to the Reds.

In 2021, Harmon-coached pitchers took home a bevy of honors, led by WCC Pitcher of the Year and Second Team All-American Alek Jacob and Freshman All-American Gabriel Hughes. In the 2021 season, Zag pitchers combined for a WCC-leading nine shutouts.

Also in 2016, Harmon's pitching staff broke the program record with 501 strikeouts, and they eclipsed the old mark once again a year later. He tutored three of the pitchers among the top five on Gonzaga's single season strikeouts list (No. 2 Eli Morgan, No. 4 Brandon Bailey and No. 5 Daniel Bies), along with one of the top closers in school history in Wyatt Mills.

Under Harmon's tutelage, 11 pitchers have been selected in the MLB Draft: Mills (3rd Rd.; 2017), Bailey (6th; 2016), Bies (7th, 2018), Morgan (8th; 2017), Hunter Wells (23rd; 2016), Casey Legumina (8th, 2019), Alek Jacob (16th, 2021), Hughes (1st, 2022), Vrieling (3rd, 2022), Kempner (3rd, 2022) and Jessee (10th, 2022). Four signed with major league organizations (Justin Vernia, Diamondbacks; Sam Hellinger, Rangers; Mac Lardner and Nick Trogrlic-Iverson, Cardinals) and Bailey, Mills and Morgan have all earned the call-up to the big leagues for their respective organizations.

Harmon is a former player and graduate of Gonzaga. He completed his undergraduate work in 2007 with a degree in sports management and followed that up with a master's degree from Gonzaga in 2009 in Sport and Athletic Administration. During his days as a pitcher for the Bulldogs (2005-08), he etched himself into the program's record book. Harmon is one of two atop the all-time career appearances category with 88 and owns the most innings in a season, pitching 123.1 frames in 2007. He was named All-WCC Honorable Mention in 2006 and 2007 and finished his career with a 13-17 overall record with 10 saves.

# SEAN WINSTON ASSISTANT COACH -8TH YEAR

Sean Winston enters his first season as a full-time assistant and eighth on the staff in 2023. Winston directly coaches the squad on baserunning and serves as the third base coach while assisting with the hitters, infielders, and defensive positioning.

With Winston on the staff, Gonzaga has won two West Coast Conference regular-season titles and one WCC Baseball Championship title. With titles in both 2016 and 2017, they earned their first back-to-back conference titles since 1973-74 and first ever as members of the WCC. Winston has helped the Zags to four NCAA tournament berths (2016, 2018, 2021, 2022) including their first-ever at-large bid in 2016. The Zags finished Top-20 in the nation in fielding percentage in 2021 and 2022, posting the second-best fielding percentage in program history (.981, 7th in the nation) in 2021 and the third-best (.979, 18th in the nation) in 2022.

Winston has helped coach some of the best fielding teams in recent program history. In 2018, Gonzaga set the program record for fielding percentage, fielding at a .984 clip. In his first season in 2016, Gonzaga equaled its previously highest fielding percentage since the 2008 season, finishing with

a .975 fielding percentage. 2017's mark of .973 is the fourth-best since 2008.

Winston came to Spokane with five years of coaching experience. Most recently, he was an assistant coach at Paradise Valley Community College in Phoenix where he helped lead the Pumas to the ACCAC Championship in 2015. At Paradise Valley, Winston was in charge of coaching third base and running the offense, served as the recruiting coordinator, and also coached individual skill positions in the infield and at the plate. The 2015 season was actually his second stint at the school; he also helped coach the Pumas from August 2010 until December 2012. Over his three seasons at Paradise Valley, Winston coached one NJCAA National Gold Glove Award winner and three finalists.

Before coaching, Winston played for two years at Hawaii Pacific in Honolulu, where he was a two-time First Team All-Conference second basemen and helped the Sea Warriors to a Pac-West Conference Championship and a second-place finish at the 2010 Western Regional. Before heading to the Islands, Winston spent two years at Lower Columbia College in Longview, Wash., where he led the Red Devils to two division titles and a second-place finish in the NWAC Championship in 2008.

# REMEMBERING AS GREAT ZAG SAME AND ASSESSED AS A SAME AND AS A SAME AND ASSESSED AS A SAME AS A SAME AND ASSESSED AS A SAME A

There are a plethora of words that have been used to describe Danny Evans, Gonzaga baseball's associate head coach who passed away in April at age 41 after a yearlong battle with melanoma. But "Zag" is always a common refrain, one that seems to sum up so many aspects of what makes the fallen coach irreplaceable.

Not everyone who's been a part of GU Athletics gets that distinction by default, and it certainly doesn't just pertain to winning – even if Evans has been a cornerstone of one of the most successful periods in program history. There's something intangible and intricate about what makes someone a great Zag, but there was always a universal understanding that he had it.

"For one, he was an inherently incredibly positive person," said Zags pitching coach Brandon Harmon, who played for Evans before coaching alongside him for a decade. "That energy just rubbed off on every aspect of the program, whether it's behind closed doors or on the field."

In over two decades at GU, Evans was offered plenty of chances to jump ship for opportunities other coaches would dream of. But Gonzaga was his home; a place where he met the love of his life, found his dream job and raised his family. Spokane was where he was given a shot at building something special, and he valued that more than anything. He never left – and the program, the school, and hundreds of lives he became a part of are better for it.

Put simply, Evans wanted to make GU baseball a program that everyone was as proud to be a part of as he was.

"Danny loved his job, he loved the Zags," said his wife Kellie, who he met during his time at GU. "There has been one constant since we met, every connection, every memory, every triumph and every heartbreaking moment of this last year ... Gonzaga means more to our family than anything."

And in that regard, his fingerprints are everywhere. An alumni network that now spans hundreds of former players and friends of the program was an undertaking spearheaded by him, and the Zags' transformation into perennial contenders and now, national powers — in a warmweather WCC came largely because of a bevy of premium players that continued to flow through Spokane and an airtight culture that only begot more success. He even led the effort in creating an LLC for the program's summer camps, finding nev Zag baseball fans wherever they wen throughout the northwest and establishin a constant presence amongst the northwest baseball community.

But all of that almost didn't happen. The summer before Evans' freshman year of college, he told then-assistant coach Mark Machtolf that he was going to junior college in Arizona instead of GU, feeling it was in his best interest as a player.

Machtolf would have nothing of the sort. He told Evans that he was going to come play at GU, or at least he'd have to come to Spokane and tell him to his face. That was how strongly he and head coach Steve Hertz felt about him.

"Not only is he our kind of guy, we absolutely have to have him," Machtolf remembers telling Hertz.

Five years later, when Hertz retired and Machtolf assumed head coaching duties, Evans was just as important of a target, this



time as an assistant coach. And just the same, it took some mulling over. Evans was freshly graduated, finding himself in an interstitial period where he wasn't sure where his path would lead next.


But after sleeping on it, he was in. Machtolf remembers his words that next day, at all of 21 years old: "You know what – I think I'm going to give this coaching thing a try."

"There's not a day that goes by that I don't thank God that he made that decision," Machtolf said. "There was an intervention that somehow led me to think that he was a guy that I needed by my side, and man, did I need him."

From that point on, he was indispensable. He was eventually promoted to lead assistant and recruiting coordinator, becoming an ardent ambassador of the "Zag Way" and one of the premier recruiters on the West Coast.

Maybe it's because the pitch was relatively simple, and Evans himself was a testament to its legitimacy: "Come to this amazing school, this amazing community, and your life will never be the same," as Kellie remembers.



Evans was nothing if not consistent. He wasn't the type to treat two different people two different ways, and it didn't matter who you were when you spoke with him. He had time, and as Harmon said, "A gift for making you feel good when you talked to him."

"While the rest of us vacillate between the best version of ourselves and the worst version of ourselves and everywhere in between, he just managed to be the very best version of himself, all the time," said Jared Hertz, GU's Associate AD for Major Gifts who was Evans' teammate in undergrad. "And that was his baseline."

The vigor with which he promoted his program endeared him to everyone who he ran into in baseball spaces — The dozens of scouts and coaches who poured out condolences and memories of their interactions with him after his passing is evidence enough.

At a Celebration of Life held in honor of Evans on May 12, Machtolf made a promise

- there wouldn't be a team that he coached that wouldn't know the kind of man, the kind of father, the kind of coach Evans was.

Because ultimately, the standard he set remains foundational to the program's culture; a sort of gritty servant leadership that lifted up those around him in ways they couldn't have imagined. Someone who saw every day as a great day to be a Zag.

His former player and fellow assistant coach Cory Lebrun had a promise as well, echoing the sentiments of the dozens of former players and friends who came back to Spokane to remember him.

"If I could tell Danny one last thing, it'd be that we've got your back," he said. "Everything here is taken care of. "You've taught us the right way. We're going to continue that legacy every day."

The truest of Zags – and an unreservedly great man, above all else – deserves nothing less.
