The Previous Series

Game One

-The Air Force bats eventually found a spark, but their ignition was too little too late, as the Falcons were on the wrong end of Friday's 5-3 score versus Navy.
-Making his second start of the spring, Doyle Gehring was a bit erratic over his first couple of innings, but later settled into a rhythm. In spite of a high pitch-count early on, Gehring eventually completed 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits to go with six strikeouts.
-Chase Spencer launched his third home run of the season in just his fifth game, a majestic blast to straightaway center field in the 7th. Jake Greiving narrowly missed a home run of his own in the 4th, but in the 6th, he settled for an RBI triple to score the first Falcons run of the game.
-Charlie Jones, pinch-hitting in the 7th, manufactured his first collegiate knock to score a run, as the freshman dumped a base-hit into left center field to put Air Force within a run.
-Matt Thompson made his first start of 2023 on Friday, and was the lone Falcon with multiple hits.

Game Two

-The Air Force bats were unable to create much traffic on Saturday, as the Falcons offense stalled in the 5-2 loss to Navy.
-After going hitless in his last eight plate appearances, Sam Kulasingam found the barrel throughout the afternoon. Kulasingam was 3-4 with a double while scoring both Air Force runs, and was robbed of potential extra-bases in the 8th following a tremendous diving catch by the Navy left fielder.
-Jay Thomason drove home the first Falcons run in the 1st, lining a double over the head of the Navy centerfielder to bring home Kulasingam. Thomason finished the day 1-3 with a walk.
-Kulasingam and Thomason each added a stolen base as well.
-Chase Spencer singled through the left side to bring home a run in the 7th, bringing his hit-streak to a team-best four-consecutive games.
-Dylan Rogers gave Air Force the definition of a quality start, as the sophomore pitched 6.0 innings while allowing three runs on five hits, three walks, and three strikeouts. Nine of Rogers' 18 outs came via the ground ball.

Game Three

-Seungmin Shim provided six innings of one-run ball in the final game of the Freedom Classic, as Air Force ended the weekend with a 4-1 win over Navy.

-Shim was terrific while recording a career-best seven strikeouts. The junior southpaw scattered three hits and three walks while having not allowed a hit through his first five innings.

-Sam Kulasingam was 1-3, though his lone hit was a big one. After Matt Thompson led off the game with a single to right field, Kulasingam tripled into right-center to give the Falcons a 1-0 lead two batters into the afternoon.

-Following Kulasingam, Jake Greiving lined a double over the head of the Navy centerfielder to score Kulasingam and extend the lead to 2-0. Later in the inning, Chase Spencer singled up the middle to score Greiving, extending his hit-streak to five games in the process.

-The Falcons immediately led 3-0 after the first half inning.

-Thompson finished with his second multi-hit game of the weekend, going 2-4 with a double.

-Sawyer Hawks picked up his second save of the season, overwhelming the Midshipmen. The sophomore closed the final three innings, striking out five of the 11 batters he faced.

Picking Up Where He Left Off

-In his first seven games, Sam Kulasingam is 14-26 (4 2B's, 1 3B) with 4 RBI.

-To go with four BB's and two HBP's, Kulasingam has reached base in 20 of his first 32 plate appearances (.625 OBP).

-The reigning Mountain West Player of the Year is currently one of only 16 players in Division I with a batting average of .538 or higher.

-Kulasingam's 1.394 OPS is second among players in the Mountain West.

-The junior's four multi-hit games lead the team.

-Kulasingam owns a .700 BABIP (batting average on balls in play), 9th-highest in DI.

No Sophomore Slump

-Following Air Force's opening seven games, Chase Spencer leads the Falcons in slugging (.833), the highest figure of any player in the Mountain West.

-His three home runs are tied for the team lead.

-The C3C's 1.247 OPS is third among Mountain West players.

-Spencer is the only Falcon to have reached base in all seven games this season.

-Spencer's current five-game hitting streak is also a team best.

A Strong Start for the Rotation

-Air Force's weekend rotation has been solid in its first two turns, as Doyle Gehring, Dylan Rogers, and Seungmin Shim have pitched to a 2.53 ERA in 32.0 IP.

-The trio have held opponents to a .202 BA, while striking out opposing hitters at rate of 10.1 K/9.

-The Falcons starters also posted a KK/B ratio of 3.6 (36 K's/10 BB's).

#BOMBason is Back

-After leading Air Force with 16 home runs a season ago, Jay Thomason looks to again be a consistent power threat.

-Thomason is tied with Chase Spencer for the team lead in home runs (3), having hit one long ball against each of Air Force's first three opponents.

-Thomason is the first Falcon to reach double-digit RBI (10), and is second in total bases (19).

-He is one of three Falcons with an OPS north of 1.000 (1.098).

-Thomason is the only Air Force player thus far with two multi-RBI games.

Missed Opportunities

-In Air Force's first 271 plate appearances, the Falcons have struck out 71 times (26.9%).

-That figure is the highest among teams in the Mountain West.

-As well, the Falcons are currently hitless with the bases loaded this season, going 0-10 in said opportunities.

Kulasingam named to Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List

USA Baseball today revealed the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, kicking off the process of identifying the nation's top amateur baseball player for the 2023 season.

The 2023 preseason list includes 55 athletes from the ranks of high school and college baseball. Moving forward, the Golden Spikes Award Advisory Board will maintain the award's watch list on a rolling basis, allowing athletes to play themselves into consideration for the award based on their performances throughout the season.

"We are thrilled to begin the amateur baseball season with the announcement of the fifty-five-player Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List," said USA Baseball Executive Director/CEO Paul Seiler.

A Falcon was selected for the second-consecutive year, as junior first baseman Sam Kulasingam was added to the award's initial 55-player list. Former Air Force player and current LSU Tiger, Paul Skenes, was selected to the Golden Spikes Watch List a season ago and again heading into the 2023 campaign.

Kulasingam, the reigning Mountain West Player of the Year, was the first Air Force player to receive the honor in program history. Kulasingam's 109 hits in 2022 were the most-ever by an Air Force player in a single season, as were his games played (61) and at-bats (265). Kulasingam also produced the second-most doubles (26) in a single season in the history of Air Force baseball. His .411 batting average led the Mountain West Conference, and was second in Division I only to Georgia Tech's Chandler Simpson. The C2C's 181 total bases were also a program record, and seventh-most in Division I. Kulasingam recorded a .797 slugging percentage in 30 Mountain West games, the highest mark by a Falcon since Air Force joined the conference in 2000.

Trio of Falcons earn Preseason All-Mountain West recognition

On February 9, the Mountain West Conference released its preseason All-Conference team, as Doyle Gehring, Sam Kulasingam, and Jay Thomason were among the players chosen following superlative 2022 campaigns.

Gehring, who began his sophomore season as the Falcons closer before transitioning to a starting role, was vital to Air Force's postseason run a season ago. Having recorded six saves prior to his insertion into the Falcons starting rotation, Gehring finished his sophomore season with a 4.36 ERA over 64.0 IP while producing 9.3 K/9. When his team needed him most, the Oklahoman allowed just one earned run in 14.1 post-season innings (0.62 ERA) to go with 20 strikeouts in those two starts. Gehring will slide into the Friday ace role for Air Force. The Falcons managed a record of 14-9 in games in which Gehring appeared a season ago.

Kulasingam, the reigning Mountain West Player of the Year, was the first Air Force player to receive the honor in program history. Kulasingam's 109 hits in 2022 were the most-ever by an Air Force player in a single season, as were his games played (61) and at-bats (265). Kulasingam also produced the second-most doubles (26) in a single season in the history of Air Force baseball. His .411 batting average led the Mountain West Conference, and was second in Division I only to Georgia Tech's Chandler Simpson. The C2C's 181 total bases were also a program record, and seventh-most in Division I. Kulasingam recorded a .797 slugging percentage in 30

Thomason broke out as the Falcons starting third baseman a season ago, and was one of four players to appear in at least 60 games in 2022. The Alabamian led the Falcons with 16 home runs last season, second only to New Mexico slugger Lenny Junior Ashby (17). Thomason's 12 home runs within Mountain West play tied him with Nic Ready for the most in program history. Thomason was one of only 12 players in the Mountain West with an OPS north of 1.000 (1.028), while also having tied for the team lead with 10 stolen bases. Thomason became one of only nine players in program history to manage at least 85 hits in a single season, while his 149 total bases in 2022 were the eighth-most by a player in the history of Air Force baseball.

Air Force, San José State and UNLV each had three preseason All-Mountain West Selections, tying for the most in the league.

In addition, UNLV was selected by the coaches of the conference as the preseason favorite to win the league, receiving four first-place votes. Air Force was selected to finish fifth while not receiving a first-place vote.

Kulasingam selected as Preseason All-American by NCBWA

Having been named a Third Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper earlier this offseason, junior first baseman Sam Kulasingam has added yet another preseason accolade to his list of accomplishments.

On Thursday, Kulasingam was named a Third Team Preseason All-American by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. The North Carolina native certainly made an impression a season ago, as he was among the nation's most prolific hitters as a sophomore.

Kulasingam, who enters 2023 as the reigning Mountain West Player of the Year, was the first Air Force player to receive the honor in program history. Kulasingam's 109 hits in 2022 were the most-ever by an Air Force player in a single season, as were his games played (61) and at-bats (265). Kulasingam also produced the second-most doubles (26) in a single season in the history of Air Force baseball. His .411 batting average led the Mountain West Conference, and was second in the Division I only to Georgia Tech's Chandler Simpson. The C2C's 181 total bases were also a program record, and seventh-most in Division I.

Kulasingam named Preseason All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper

On December 19, Sam Kulasingam, the reigning Mountain West Player of the Year, received further honors as the junior prepares for the 2023 season. Kulasingam was named a preseason

Third Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, the result of a historic sophomore season.

Kulasingam produced one of the most potent of offensive campaigns in Air Force history in 2022. Kulasingam's .411 average led Air Force, as did his 109 hits. He became the all-time single season leader in hits in program history on May 20, breaking Bradley Haslam's record of 96 hits set in 2016.

His .411 BA was second in the country, trailing only Georgia Tech's Chandler Simpson (.433). His 109 hits were tied for most in Division I with Kennesaw State's Josh Hatcher. Kulasingam was one of only four players in the country with at least 26 doubles, while his 181 total bases were the most-ever by a Falcon. His total bases mark was seventh-best in the nation.

UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY FACT SHEET

Nominations

Nominations to the academy may be obtained through a congressional sponsor or by meeting eligibility criteria in other categories of competition established by law.

Freshmen

- All new cadets begin with six weeks of basic cadet training (BCT) in their first summer prior to classes.

Summer Training

- Summer training for cadets is divided into three, three-week training periods. There are a variety of programs available, and each cadet is required to complete two training periods each summer with leave during the other period.

- Combat survival training (CST) is a required three-week program during cadets' second summer. For other second-summer training periods, cadets have options such as working with young airmen in an operational unit at an Air Force installation, airborne parachute training, soaring or basic free-fall parachute training.

- During their last two summers, all cadets are offered leadership training as supervisors or instructors in summer programs, such as basic cadet training, survival training, freefall parachuting and soaring.

Graduation

- Each cadet graduates with a bachelor of science degree and a commission as a second lieutenant in the Air Force.

History

In 1948 a board of leading civilian and military educators was appointed to plan the curriculum for an academy that would meet the needs of the newly established Air Force. The board determined that Air Force requirements could not be met by expanding the other service academies and recommended an Air Force academy be established without delay.

In 1949, then Secretary of the Air Force W. Stuart Symington appointed a commission to assist in selecting a site and on April 1, 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower authorized creation of the United States Air Force Academy. After considering 580 sites in 45 states, the commission narrowed the choice to three locations. The summer of 1954, Secretary of the Air Force Harold Talbott selected a site near Colorado Springs, Colo. Colorado contributed \$1 million toward purchase of the property.

In July 1955, the first academy class entered interim facilities at Lowry Air Force Base, Denver, while construction began. It was sufficiently completed for occupancy by the cadet wing in late August 1958. Initial construction cost was \$142 million.

Women entered the academy on June 28, 1976, as members of the class of 1980.



The Honor Code

"We Will Not Lie, Steal Or Cheat, Nor Tolerate Among Us Anyone Who Does"

The Air Force Academy Honor Code was formally adopted in 1956 by the first graduating class, the Class of 1959. It was then, and continues to be today, a minimum standard of conduct which cadets expect of themselves and their fellow cadets.

Cadet Pay

U.S. Air Force Academy cadets earn \$846 a month in basic pay that covers the costs of uniforms, books and supplies, with a modest amount left for personal spending and a savings account.

After Graduation

Base Pay

The typical base pay per month after graduation is more than \$3,100. The salary increases as rank increases.

- * All health care is provided, so there is no pay-check deduction for medical or dental care.
- * Specialty career fields (aviation, medical, etc.) receive bonus pay on top of their annual salary.

Military Commitment

- Although it depends on your job, basic service requirement is five years after graduation.
- All graduates begin their military career as 2nd Lieutenants.

Flying

- Basic pilot and UAV Pilot (Drones) service requirement is 10 years.
- Pilots must undergo undergraduate pilot training (UPT) prior to actual service time.
- Pilots will undergo 1-4 years of UPT depending on aircraft (transport, fighter, etc.).

Mike Kazlauskas enters his 13th year as Air Force baseball head coach in 2022. Kazlauskas was named head baseball coach on June 2, 2011. Kazlauskas retired from active duty, effective June 1, 2011, and his interim tag was lifted to official head coach status. A former player and Academy graduate, Kazlauskas epitomizes what it means to don the Falcon baseball Blue and White. Kazlauskas, known as "Coach Kaz" is a 1991 Academy graduate and has also logged six years as an assistant coach at the Academy. He is the first Academy graduate to become head baseball coach at Air Force and was the program's first military coach since 1988.

Kazlauskas retired with the rank of major after 20 years of meritorious service with the U.S. Air Force. As the interim head coach in 2011, Kazlauskas led the Falcons to a 19-36 overall record, leading the program to the most wins since 2002. The 19 wins were also the second-most in school history against Division I opponents and the most Division I wins by a first-year head coach at the Academy.

In an abbreviated 2020 season, which was canceled after 19 games due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Kazlauskas still had plenty of highlights. It started with his 200th win as Air Force's head man after a 7-3 win over rival Army West Point, Feb. 29. Kaz became just the second AF baseball coach to reach the 200 win milestone. As a team, Air Force finished the season second in the country in stolen bases, eighth in doubles, ninth in double plays, and 43rd in hits. Three players were named All-MW Conference, including senior Ashton Easley, who went on to be signed by the Miami Marlins organization. Easley is the seventh former Falcon to go on to play professional baseball under Kaz's tutelage.

The 2019 season saw the Falcons conclude the season with a 26-26 record, as well as a 12-14 record in MW play. It is the third time in the last four seasons Air Force has finished .500 or above, as well as the fourth season in a row with 12 conference wins. Four players were named All-Conference in catcher Rob Dau on the first team, and Nic Ready, Ashton Easley, and Jake Gilbert on the second team. With four players honored, it marked the third time in the last four seasons Air Force has had four players earn all-conference accolades, joining the 2016 and 2017 teams. It is also the fourth straight season the Falcons have had at least one player named to the first team, the first time that has happened in school history. Kaz also saw the final chapter of one of his finest recruiting classes at the Academy, as the Class of 2019 finished with 107 wins, making them the winningest senior class in Academy history. In addition, 2019 graduate Nic Ready set new program career-best marks in games played (217), at bats (917), hits (300), home runs (50), RBIs (224), and total bases (544). He also finished second in career doubles (76) and third in career runs scored (190). This parlayed Ready into a 23rd round selection in the 2019 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins. In addition, Gilbert was also signed as an undrafted free agent by the Cincinnati Reds organization.

In 2018, Kaz continued the momentum of the Air Force program, posting a 24-30 record to record the fourth 20-win season in a row. It is the first time that has happened at Air Force since recording eight straight from 1988-1995. He surpassed his mentor Paul Mainieri for second on the all-time wins list at the Academy, with 171. The Falcon offense remain near the top of the national leaders in most offensive categories, ranking in the top 15 in batting average, doubles, scoring, slugging, and triples. They were also one of the most efficient fielding teams, ranking ninth in double plays and 41st in fielding percentage. He guided Nic Ready to one of the best single offensive seasons in program history, as he was named third team All-American, the 13th in program history and fifth under his leadership. In addition, he had four All-MW Conference honors in Ready and Rob Dau, who were both also named All-Region.

The 2017 season had many highlights for Air Force. The Falcons posted a 27-26 season, marking back-to-back seasons over .500 for the first time since 1994-95. Air Force also produced two All-Americans in seniors Adam Groesbeck (3rd team OF) and Bradley Haslam (3rd team 3B), an Academic All-American in senior OF Russell Williams and a MLB Draft Pick in Groesbeck (38th round - Atlanta Braves). Air Force produced four all-conference players, including two first team. The Falcons had a banner year offensively, leading the nation in six offensive categories, including batting average (.344), doubles (153) and slugging (.545). Air Force put together one of its best teams in program history in 2016. The Falcons posted a 30-27 record and made a deep run through the Mountain West Championship, finishing third. Falcons had the second most wins in a season in program history and for the second-straight season, set a program record for most Div. I game wins. Air Force had four all-Mountain West honorees, including the conference co-pitcher of the year in junior righthander Griffin Jax and the conference co-freshman of the year in 3B/DH Nic Ready. Jax and junior left fielder Tyler Jones earned All-America honors, while Ready earned freshman All-American honors. Air Force had two junior pitchers picked in the MLB draft, as Jax was a third-round selection of the Minnesota Twins and junior LHP Jacob DeVries went in the 38th round to the Cleveland Indians. The Falcons also got it done in the classroom as well, garnering eight MW all-academic honors including junior first baseman Russell Williams, who earned Academic All-America honors.

The 2015 season showed Air Force's continued upswing as an emerging program. The Falcons went 23-29 for its winningest season since 2002. The 22 wins over Div. I opponents set a new program record. Kazlauskas guided the Falcons to its second-ever win over an SEC school with their win over Missouri. Coach Kaz also had his second-ever MLB draft pick, when senior RHP Ben Yokley was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 29th round. In 2015, Kazlauskas also became Air Force's winningest coach in the Mountain West era. The 2015 team set 25 school records (individual, team, conference), including best fielding percentage (.966), lowest team ERA in conference play (5.06) and lowest ERA in MW play by a pitcher (Trent Monaghan - 3.65). Kazlauskas had three all-conference performers in outfielders Adam Groesbeck, Spencer Draws and pitcher Griffin Jax. In addition, the Falcons excelled in the classroom, with seven MW all-academic selection and an academic all-district honoree in outfielder Russell Williams. The Falcons also sent a player to the

prestigious Cape Cod wood bat summer league as pitcher Jacob DeVries played for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox.

In 2014, Kazlauskas guided the Falcons to its best season in over a decade, posting a 20-34 record. The Falcons reached the 20 win mark for the first time since 2002 and its 19 wins over Div. I opponents tied for the third-most ever in school history. Kazlauskas produced his first Freshman All-American in outfielder Tyler Jones, who earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors. Jones also earned All-Mountain West honors, becoming the first Air Force freshman to earn all-conference honors in 23 years, dating back to 1991. Air Force was 4-2 against ranked teams in 2014, earning its first-ever series sweep of a ranked team, when it swept #20 UNLV in a three-game series.

The Falcons posted a 15-39 record in 2013. The Falcons had their winningest conference season since 2002. Kazlauskas had his first player drafted in senior catcher Garrett Custons, who was a 10th round draft pick of the Toronto Blue Jays. Custons was also one of 15 semifinalists for the Johnny Bench Award. Falcon baseball also continued to excel in the classroom, producing a school-record eight Academic All-Conference players.

In 2012, Air Force went 14-39 with a young team that often times started as many as five freshmen in the field. The Falcons posted a 6.10 team ERA that was the second-lowest in the past 30 years. The Falcons featured two All-Mountain West selections in junior catcher Garrett Custons and sophomore designated hitter Seth Kline. The Falcons also posted their first winning season at home since 2002 and defeated a Big 12 school (Kansas) for the first time since 2001. In addition, Air Force set a school record with 46 sacrifice bunts.

In his first year, Kazlauskas led Air Force to its first win over a Pac 10 school in 21 years and its first four-game sweep since 2003.

The team fielded .960 to set a new school record. Sophomore Garrett Custons earned First-Team All-Mountain West honors by ranking in the conference top 10 in 11 categories. Sophomore right-hander Sean Carley posted one of the best seasons ever by a Falcon pitcher, earning second-team All-MW honors, the first Falcon pitcher to earn all-conference honors since 2002. Carley posted a 3.94 earned run average, the lowest at the Academy in 28 years. His 4.10 ERA in conference games set a school record in the Mountain West era. Air Force lowered its team ERA by over five runs a game from the 2010 season (11.31 to 6.09). The 6.09 team ERA was the lowest at Air Force in 29 years, dating back to 1982.

"This is my school and no one is more proud than I to have gone through the Academy and to have served for 20 years in the Air Force," Kazlauskas said. "I look forward to having the opportunity to continue to represent our United States Air Force Academy! It is a tremendous honor and a privilege to be associated with the Academy and the Air Force as the Head Baseball Coach. I have a great understanding of all the pillars at the Academy, and I truly understand the mission of the Academy and the Air Force. Our job, as a staff, is to ensure success not only on the baseball field but in all facets of the Academy and that each young man is ready to lead our great country upon graduation!"

As one of the most inspirational and emotional players to ever wear the Air Force baseball uniform, Kazlauskas came to USAFA baseball as a walk-on and started all four years. At the time of his graduation, he held eight career records and still ranks among the top 10 in seven all-time offensive categories. A two-time All-Western Athletic Conference (WAC) selection, Kazlauskas led the Falcons in batting in 1989 and 1991.

After a standout baseball career with the Falcons, "Kaz" spent three seasons from 1993 to 1995 as an assistant coach to former Falcon head coach Paul Mainieri, now the head skipper at LSU. During this time, the Falcons posted three consecutive winning seasons. The 1994 team led the nation in batting average, slugging percentage and triples. The 1995 team won 29 games, the second most in school history. After leaving the Academy in the summer of 1995, Kaz spent four years at Charleston Air Force Base, S.C., as a pilot in the C-17 aircraft.

He later returned to the Academy in the fall of 2000 as a TG4 and T-41/C-150 evaluator pilot in the 94th Flying Training Squadron. In addition to his flight duties, he also served as the volunteer baseball coach for the Falcons as well as the Preparatory School head baseball coach. During his tenure, the 2002 Falcon team set the school record for most Div. I victories and two Falcon players were drafted into the minor leagues. Kazlauskas then returned back to Charleston Air Force Base in 2004. He spent the next two and a half years as a C-17 pilot actively serving in the War on Terror, before returning to the Academy from 2006-2008 for this third tour as an assistant baseball coach. Kazlauskas spent 2010 as an Air Officer Commanding (AOC) for cadet squadron 12 at the Academy.

In 2007, Kazlauskas was inducted to the Lake County Hall of Fame in Lake County, Ill., for outstanding achievement. In 2008, he was inducted into the 14th Airlift Squadron Hall of Fame in Charleston, S.C.

Coach Kaz and his wife, Kris, live in Monument with their daughter, Sammy and son, Mick.
