STORY LINES

- After starting the year 2-0 for the first time since 2018 with wins over South Alabama and SFA, UNT heads to Lubbock to take on Texas Tech in the second year of the **Eric Morris** era.
- North Texas will be looking for its first win over a Big 12 opponent since taking down Baylor on Sept. 6, 2003 in Denton and its first road win over a Big 12 team since defeating the Red Raiders on Sept. 18, 1999.
- The contest will be a homecoming for Coach Morris, who played WR at Texas Tech from 2005-08 and was the Offensive Coordinator for the Red Raiders from 2013-17. In addition, Assistant HC/S&C Coach **Bryan Kegans** and Offensive Coordinator **Jordan Davis** also played collegiately for Texas Tech.
- Led by junior QB **Chandler Morris**, the UNT offense is 14th in FBS in total offense and third in passing. Morris is the nation's leader in points responsible (54) for while sitting second in the country in passing yards (737).
- Defensively, senior CB **Ridge Texada** is coming off a historic performance against SFA with an INT and two PBUs to become the program's career leader in both PBUs (27) and passes defended (32).
- The Mean Green have a host of new faces on the 2024 squad, leading all of FBS with 77 newcomers on the roster including 41 freshmen and 36 transfers.
- Even with the large turnover, UNT returns a number of key contributors with 14 total returners who started at multiple games last season, nine of which play on the defensive side of the ball.
- WRs **Damon Ward Jr.** and **DT Sheffield** have teamed up to become a strong 1-2 punch for the UNT offense, combining for 26 catches for 394 yards and five TDs through two games. Both rank inside the top-six in the AAC in receiving yards and receptions.
- Along with Texada, UNT returned 9 of their top 15 tacklers and two of the top three from 2023 in LBs
 Jordan Brown and Ethan Wesloski.
- Since 1966 when Mean Joe Greene was a freshman, UNT has had just nine seasons start 2-0 and three of those nine were when Greene played from 1966-68. The Mean Green finished with a winning record in eight of those nine seasons.
- Dating back to the final two games of 2023, North Texas comes into the contest having won four straight games, tied for the sixth-longest active streak in the country.

MORE QUICK HITTERS

- · Led by special teams coordinator Drew Svoboda, UNT had one of the best special teams units in the country in 2023 and continued the trend UNT blocked a punt and returned it for a touchdown in week one for the first time since 2019 in the opener against South Alabama.
- North Texas scored 28 points in the third quarter against South Alabama which ties for the fifth-best mark in any quarter and second-highest mark in any third quarter (28 in the 3rd at UTEP on Sept. 10, 1977)
- UNT named LB Jordan Brown, DL Roderick Brown, CB Ridge Texada, QB Chandler Morris, WR Damon Ward Jr., OL Landon Peterson and LB Jaylen Smith team captains prior to the season.
- Eric Morris' winning percentage in 2023 was the best win percentage by a first-year head coach at UNT since Matt Simon (7-4-1, .625) in 1994.
- Despite the massive turnover, UNT is tied for 16th the country and second in the AAC for the most seniors (24) on its roster heading into the 2024 season.
- North Texas had a 3,000 yard passer, a 1,000-yard rusher and a 1,000-yard receiver in the same season for the first time in program history last season, one of only four FBS programs to accomplish the feat.
- The Mean Green had one of the best offenses in FBS in 2023, as one of only five FBS teams (LSU, Georgia, Texas and UNC) ranked inside the top 25 in scoring (15th), rushing (22nd), passing (12th) and total offense (6th).
- At just 32 years old, offensive coordinator **Jordan Davis** is the sixth-youngest FBS OC in the nation.

TEXAS TECH SERIES HISTORY

- Dating back to 1952, Saturday's meeting between UNT and Texas Tech will be the ninth all-time with the series currently knotted at 4-4.
- Texas Tech has won each of the last two contests in 2000 and 2001, but UNT has won in Lubbock in three of its last four opportunities at Jones AT&T Stadium and owns a 3-2 record on the road in the series.
- The Mean Green defeated TTU 21-14 in 1999 and 30-27 in 1997 for back-to-back road wins in the series.
- Ja'Quay Wilburn led UNT in its last win over the Red Raiders in 1999 with 151 rushing yards while the UNT defense held the Red Raiders scoreless in the first half and forced a pair of turnovers to grab the victory.

OFFENSIVE MASTERMIND

- UNT head coach Eric Morris is one of the top offensive minds in the country, proven by a stellar track record in his 12 seasons as an offensive coordinator and head coach.
- Since becoming the offensive coordinator at Texas Tech in 2013 Morris has led an offense that finished inside the top 25 (FBS or FCS) in scoring eight times in 11 years.
- · In addition, Morris has led offenses that finished in the top-10 in total offense eight times, including the top FBS offense (Texas Tech) in 2016 and the top FCS offense (UIW) in the nation in 2020.
- Morris-led offenses have been dominant through the air as seven of Morris' first 11 years as an OC or HC have resulted in a top-five passing offense in the country.
- UNT currently has the third ranked passing offense in FBS in 2024 while QB Chandler Morris is second in the country in passing yards.
- Morris is the voungest head coach UNT has hired since Llovd Russell in 1942 after Jack Sisco was called up for service in World War II. He is also the 10th-youngest active head coach in Division I.
- At UIW, Morris was twice named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year (2018, 2021). He led the Cardinals to two conference titles, twice FCS playoff appearances, and left UIW as the program record holder for wins with 24.

WEST TEXAS HOMECOMING

- The North Texas coaching staff is littered with Texas Tech ties as Head Coach Eric Morris, Assistant Head Coach/Strength Coach Bryan Kegans and Offensive Coordinator Jordan Davis all played collegiately for the Red Raiders.
- Morris, who was also the offensive coordinator at TTU from 2013-17, was an explosive receiver under Mike Leach from 2005-08. He caught 184 passes for 1,965 yards and 19 TDs while also rushing for three scores in his four years in Lubbock.
- Kegans played with the Red Raiders from 2002-05 and was a stalwart on the offensive line appearing 46 games across four years in his career.
- Davis, meanwhile, played WR for Tech while Morris was the offensive coordinator from 2012-14 and caught 43 passes for 398 yards and a pair of touchdowns in his career.

C4 – HIGHLY EXPLOSIVE

- Junior QB **Chandler Morris** has had a stellar start to his UNT career. In two games, Morris is 58 for 85 with 737 passing yards and seven passing TDs.
- As shown by the chart, Morris ranks inside the top four in all of FBS in points responsible for, completions per game, passing TDs, total passing yards, passing yards

- Morris was extremely efficient in the season opener, completing 32 of his 41 pass attempts, good for a 78.0 percent completion percentage to be named AAC Offensive Player of the Week and earn the Davey O'Brein Great 8 Award as one of the top QBs in the nation.
- Morris, a transfer from TCU, started the season opener in both 2022 and 2023 for the Horned Frogs but ultimately lost the job both years due to injury.
- An underrated runner, Morris has rushed for 410 yards on 91 carries with eight touchdowns in his career.
- Morris' father, Chad, is a longtime college football coach having previously served as the head coach at SMU and Arkansas. He is currently the pass game coordinator at Texas State.

TEXADA ISLAND

- Senior DB Ridge Texada has established himself as one of the top defensive backs in program history.
- After a stellar performance with two PBUs and an INT in the win over SFA, Texada now owns the program record for both career PBUs and passes defended (INT + PBU).
- With 32 career PDF, Texada surpassed Jonas Buckles (2001-04) who previously held the record with 30.
- Texada currently ranks fifth among active FBS players in career passes defended.
- The senior out of Frisco, Texas, was a preseason All-AAC selection by Athlon and Phil Steele. He has recorded 10 total tackles in his career and has appeared in 41 games with 27 starts with the Mean Green.

DT SPELLED BACKWARDS IS TD

- Junior WR **DT Sheffield** has been a star performer in his first two contests with 13 catches for 148 yards and three touchdowns to earn Honorable Mention Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Player of the Week honors.
- Sheffield had a breakout performance against SFA, catching six passes for 74 yards and three touchdowns, all of which came in the first half.
- The Washington State transfer became just the 14th player in program history to score three touchdowns in a game and just the eighth player to do it in a single half.
- Sheffield now ranks fourth in FBS and leads the American in touchdown receptions while sitting sixth in the AAC in receiving yards and third in receptions.

NEW FACES EVERYWHERE

- UNT has 77 new players on the roster for the 2024 season, the most of any FBS program heading into the year.
- Among the 77 newcomers, 36 are transfers, tied with New Mexico St. for the most transfers among in the FBS.
- Newcomers are littered throughout the two-deep including projected offensive starters TE Oscar Hammond, OL Ma'Kyi Lee, QB Chandler Morris, OL Landon Peterson, and WR DT Sheffield.
- Defensively, expected production will come from a number of new faces including DL Terrell Dawkins, S Jayden Hill, LB JJ Jean-Louis, DL Jake Shipley, and LB Shane Whitter.
- The 35 transfer prospects bring a wealth of experience with 17 players who have appeared in at least 15 games in their careers, led by Price (39 GP), Whitter (39 GP), Hill (38 GP), Peterson (35 GP) and Dawkins (35 GP).

THE WARDEN

- Senior WR **Damon Ward Jr.** started his season in a big way with 12 catches for 230 yards and two touchdowns in the win over South Alabama to be named an Honorable Mention AAC Offensive Player of the Week selection.
- Ward Jr. now has 13 catches for 246 yards this season and ranks 12th in FBS in receiving yards, is tied for 25th in receptions.
- Last season, Ward caught 39 passes for 487 yards and five touchdowns. His 246 yards through two weeks is over half of his total from 2023.
- In his career, Ward has 99 catches for 1,422 yards and 12 touchdowns. He ranks 20th in program history in receiving yards and 21st in career receptions. His first reception Saturday will make him the 21st player in program history to have 100 career catches.

"DO YOU BELIEVE IN THE MEAN GREEN?!"

- On Sept. 20, 1997, North Texas resumed its series against regional foe Texas Tech, traveling to Jones Stadium in Lubbock. The Red Raiders of the Big 12 were heavily favored over the Mean Green, who were still playing in Division I-AA's Southland Conference.
- What ensued was a stunning upset and one of former North Texas play-by-play man **George Dunham's** most memorable calls and one of the most memorable moments in UNT history.
- After falling behind 10-0, UNT rallied back to take 24-13 lead in the fourth quarter before Tech came back for a 27-24 advantage.
- UNT, however, rallied again. Quarterback Jason Mills hit Jay Young with a 36-yard completion on fourth and 14, setting up a 15-yard touchdown pass to Bo Harrison with 1:04 to play for a 30-27 lead.
- But Tech responded by returning the ensuing kickoff to the North Texas 30-yard line, and with 25 seconds
 to play, the Red Raiders lined up for a 45-yard field-goal attempt, leading to Dunham's unforgettable call
 "Do you believe in the Mean Green?!" when the kick was no good, giving North Texas its third win over
 the Red Raiders in four meetings.
- A year later, Texas Tech beat North Texas at Texas Stadium, but Red Raiders still wanted to avenge the 1997 loss when the series returned to Lubbock in 1999.
- The Red Raiders entered the 1999 game as a 30-point favorite, prepared for the game with the 1997 score plastered on the wall of its locker room. North Texas won in Lubbock again, 21-14.

"SPECIAL" TEAMS

- UNT had one of the best special teams units in the country in 2023 and started 2024 with a bang, blocking a punt in the season opener and returning it for a touchdown for the first time since 2019.
- Junior P **Sawyer Evans** is one of the best returning punters in the AAC. His kicking style allows for little return options helping UNT rank 12th in the nation in punt return defense through two weeks.
- The UNT kickoff return unit is averaging 24.33 yards per return, good for 26th in the country led by **Juwaun Price** who is second in the nation with 185 kickoff return yards.
- Unfortunately, Price went down with a leg injury against SFA, but the Mean Green will now turn to senior Lamar transfer **Damashja Harris** who comes to UNT after being named Dave Campbell's Texas Football FCS Special Teams Player of the Year in 2023. Harris has over 1,600 all-purpose yards in his carer.
- Because of this success, Associate HC/Special Teams Coordinator **Drew Svoboda** was named one of 57 nominees for the Broyles Award given to the top assistant coach in FBS last season.

LINEBACKER CORE

- UNT returns all three starting LBs from a season ago in senior **Jordan Brown**, senior **Jaylen Smith** and sophomore **Ethan Wesloski**.
- Through two games, the trio of veterans combined to play 388 of the 459 (84.5 percent) total linebacker snaps against South Alabama and are three of the top five tacklers on the team.
- Last season, Brown led UNT with 83.0 tackles and 3.5 sacks while registering 5.0 TFLs and five QB hurries.
- Wesloski had a breakout season as a redshirt freshman in 2023, finishing third on the team with 63 tackles while racking up 7.5 TFLs and 3.0 sacks. Wesloski led all AAC freshmen in tackles a season ago.
- The Mean Green also welcomed Oklahoma transfer **Shane Whitter** this offseason. He has played the fourth-most defensive snaps of any LB and has a wealth of experience with 41 games played in his career.

No. 44 LADIES THAT'S ME!

- Senior RB **Damashja Harris** arrived on the scene against SFA in week two, rushing the ball 10 times for 142 yards and a touchdown.
- The highlight of the night for Harris, who wears #44, was an 80-yard touchdown run that pushed the game out of reach for the Mean Green early in the fourth quarter.
- The 142 yards was a new career-high for Harris who ran for 100+ yards for the first time in his career.
- In addition, the 80-yard scamper was the longest run by a UNT player since Ayo Adeyi's 92-yard run against LA Tech on Oct. 15, 2022, and it was 17th time in program history UNT has had a rush of 80+.
- In his career, Harris has rushed 143 times for 672 yards and four touchdowns.

STABLE OF PASS CATCHERS

- In addition to Sheffield and Ward Jr., UNT has a stable of receivers who are all capable of making a big play, highlighted by 2023 breakout star WR **Landon Sides** and the steady presence of WR **Blair Conwright**.
- After missing week one, Sides returned to action and caught three passes for 43 yards against SFA. Sides finished 2023 with 30 catches for 363 yards and four TDs. He was the first freshman since Johnny Quinn (2003) to catch a pass in every game he appeared in and has continued that streak in 2024.
- Conwright, meanwhile, caught a touchdown in the opener and has four catches for 64 yards this season.
- The talent does not stop there, however, as 11 different players have caught a pass for UNT..
- Currently, the No. 3 pass catcher on the team is TE **Oscar Hammond** with six catches for 84 yards and a touchdown. The Oklahoma Christian transfer caught his first TD with the Mean Green against SFA.
- UNT also has the ability to turn to WRs Jeremiah Aaron (4-82), Wyatt Young (5-44) and Dalton Carnes (4-25) who all have at least four catches in two games.

FRESHMAN TALENT ON DISPLAY

- The opening two games of the season Mean Green have featured a ton of young talent as 11 redshirt and 12 true freshman have already appeared in a game for UNT this season.
- The young players have littered the stat sheet as well as WRs **Kyle Koch** and **Wyatt Young** have both recorded a catch.
- Defensively, CB **Taylor Starling**, CB **Kerry Williams II**, DL **Jayden Williams**, CB **Brian Nelson II**, DL **Jayden Williams**, CB **Kollin Lewis**, S **Quinton Hammonds**, DL **Nathan Laperi** and DL **Zhaiylen Scott** all have at least one tackle for UNT. Nelson II, meanwhile, is second on the team with a pair of PBUs.
- On special teams, redshirt freshman K Kali Nguma is a perfect 12 for 12 on PATs and hit his first career field goal from 30 yards out in the fourth quarter to put the game away against South Alabama.

IN THE SECONDARY

- Led by Texada, North Texas has a wealth of talent littered throughout the secondary defensively. Senior S **Jayden Hill** leads the Mean Green and ranks fourth in the AAC with 17.0 tackles through two games.
- Sophomore S **Evan Jackson** is third on the team with 13.0 tackles this season, 11 of which are solo stops, a total that ranks second in the AAC and 23rd in the country.
- Redshirt freshman CB **Brian Nelson II** is seemingly on track to chase down Texada's PBU record. In his last three career games, Nelson has five PBUs.
- UNT gave up just 181 yards through the air in week two against SFA and finished the contest with five PBUs plus and interception.
- In addition, freshman DBs **Taylor Starling**, **Kollin Lewis**, **Kamdon McFarland**, **Kerry Williams II** and **Quinton Hammonds** have all seen action this season.


STONE COLD CELEBRATION

- In honor of WWE Superstar Steve Austin, who played linebacker and defensive end at North Texas in the 1980s, players bang together two bottles of water while holding a wrestling belt to mimic the famous celebration of "Stone Cold" Steve Austin.
- In the win over SFA, a video of Ridge Texada's interception celebration generated over 7.2 million views on social media over the first 24 hours after posting.

- UNT junior guarterback Chandler Morris finished 32-for-41 with 415 yards, three passing touchdowns and two rushing touchdowns in his first start with the Mean Green en route to a 52-38 season-opening victory over South Alabama at Hancock Whitney Stadium on Saturday.
- Down 19-14 at halftime, UNT surged back with a 28-point third quarter capped with a blocked punt recovery in the end zone by C.J. Garnett to give the Mean Green a 42-26 lead over the Jaguars (0-1) entering the fourth quarter.
- UNT's 28-point third guarter matched the fifth-best in any guarter in program history and the second-highest total in the third quarter.
- The Mean Green added 10 points in the final guarter to finish with 52 for the day, the most in a season opener against an FBS opponent in program history.
- · Senior wide receiver Damon Ward Jr. recorded 12 catches for 230 yards and two touchdowns for his first 200-yard performance and ranks fifth in singlegame UNT history.

- UNT improved to 2-0 for the season and extended its winning streak four games after a 35-20 home victory over Stephen F. Austin at DATCU Stadium on Saturday.
- Down 17-14 in the second quarter, the Mean Green gained the lead with 0:15 left in the first half on a 28-yard passing touchdown from junior quarterback Chandler Morris to junior wide receiver DT Sheffield for a 21-17 halftime lead.
- UNT posted 504 yards of total offense including 322 passing yards from Morris who became the ninth player in program history to throw for 300-plus yards in consecutive games.
- · Sheffield finished with six catches for 74 yards and three touchdowns to become the seventh player in program history with three receiving TDs in a half and the first since Jyaire Shorter on Oct. 1, 2022.
- The Mean Green held the Lumberjacks to 248 yards of total offense and 3-of-17 on third-down conversions for the game. This marked the first game in the Eric Morris era in which an opponent was held shy of 250 yards and first overall since Nov. 20, 2021 at FIU.
