



2023 SEASON REVIEW

SEASON NOTES



▲ The first two seasons of the **JOEY MCGUIRE** era has brought a 15-11 (.577) record and back-to-back bowl wins after a decisive 34-14 victory over Cal in the Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl. The win made McGuire the first Texas Tech head coach in program history to win two bowls in his first two years.

2023 SEASON NOTES

- Tech's bowl win gave the Red Raiders a 7-6 finish in the 2023 regular season. Tech had another strong end to a season under McGuire by winning four of their final five games after a 3-5 start. The Red Raiders finished above .500 for the third-straight season, marking the first time since the 2008-10 seasons.
- In the months of November and December, Joey McGuire has led the Red Raiders to a 7-2 record in games played during those two months.
- Tech improved under McGuire to 12-5 versus unranked opponents with its win against Cal in the Independence Bowl.
- Tech held Cal to 14 points and shut the Golden Bears out over the second, third and fourth quarters. It was the Red Raiders' second, second-half shutout of the 2023 season dating back to playing Houston on Sept. 30.
- Tech was 5-1 in 2023 when holding opponents under 25 points. The Red Raiders' defense held opponents to a 26.0 scoring average in 2023, its lowest average since a 22.6 average in 2009. It also marks back-to-back seasons holding opponents to under 30.0 points per game, the first such stretch since the 2008-09 seasons.
- The Red Raiders were 6-2 last season when either leading the turnover margin or with it tied. McGuire's career record when either leading the turnover margin or with it tied is 10-2 over two seasons.
- Texas Tech's 24-point first half versus Cal was its second-highest scoring first half in 2023, trailing its' 35-point first half versus Houston on Sept. 30.

BOWL GAME HEADLINES

- The Red Raiders improved their all-time bowl record to 17-23-1 with their 34-14 Independence Bowl win against California on Dec. 16, 2023. It was the Red Raiders' third-straight bowl win starting with the Liberty Bowl (def. Mississippi State) in 2022 followed by the Texas Bowl (def. Ole Miss) in 2023.
- The bowl win marked the second time in program history and the first time since the 2002-04 seasons that Tech boasted bowl wins in three consecutive seasons.
- Head coach Joey McGuire improved to 2-0 in bowl games; he is the first Texas Tech head coach to advance and win bowl games in the first two seasons of a tenure as the Red Raiders' head coach.
- Texas Tech owns bowl victories in 12 of its last 16 bowl appearances.
- After suffering losses in its previous two appearances at the Independence Bowl, 1986 & 1998, Texas Tech improved to 1-2 at the Independence Bowl with its convincing win to close the 2023 season.
- The Independence Bowl honored a pair of players as its game MVP's who returned to the 2024 team as quarterback Behren Morton was named the Independence Bowl Offensive MVP while linebacker Jacob Rodriguez was the Independence Bowl Defensive MVP. Morton is set to enter his junior season at

Texas Tech in 2024 while Rodriguez will begin his redshirt junior season.

- Texas Tech has made 41 postseason bowl appearances in its 99-year history, which ranks among the top-25 programs all-time in bowl games played. In addition, the Red Raiders enter 2024 as the Big 12 leader in all-time bowl appearances among the new 16-team league.

MORE HEADLINES

- Texas Tech will return nine starters to the 2024 team from the 2023 team.
- The Red Raiders return nine of 10 assistant coaches from the previous season while welcoming Clay McGuire who will coach the offensive line in 2024.
- Of those that earned 2023 All-Big 12 honors, Texas Tech will welcome back the Defensive Freshman of the Year in LB Ben Roberts, First Team selection RB Tahj Brooks, as well as honorable mention honorees C.J. Baskerville (DB), Gino Garcia (K), Bralyn Lux (DB), Drae McCray (KR), Behren Morton (QB) and Caleb Rogers (OL).
- The program had 25 named to the First Team 2023 Big 12 All-Academic team while eight were named to the second team. Of those 33, 16 return in 2024.
- Benefiting from the four-game redshirt rule the NCAA established, the following 13 players participated in 2023 but did not lose a year of eligibility — LB Jacob Rodriguez (R.Jr.), WR Brady Boyd (R.Jr.), QB Jake Strong (R.Fr.), DB A.J. McCarty (R.Jr.), DB Miquel Dingle (R.Fr.), LB Justin Horne (R.Fr.), LB Wesley Smith (R.So.), LB John Curry (R.Fr.), DL Jayden Cofield (R.Fr.), OL Kaden Carr (R.Fr.), WR D.J. Crest (R.Fr.), DL Braylon Rigbsy (R.Fr.) and DL Amier Washington (R.Fr.).
- Texas Tech had four invited to the 2024 NFL Scouting Combine — P Austin McNamara, DB Dadrion Taylor-Demerson, DB Tyler Owens and DL Myles Cole.
- Texas Tech had a pair of players selected in the 2024 NFL Draft in DB Dadrion Taylor-Demerson (4th Rd, Arizona Cardinals) and DL Myles Cole (7th Rd., Jacksonville Jaguars).

NEWS & NOTES ON MCGUIRE...

- With Texas Tech's win over Cal in the Independence Bowl, McGuire improved to 15-11 overall (.577), marking the fourth-highest winning percentage for a Texas Tech head coach through two seasons and the highest since Steve Sloan was 16-7 overall (.696) following the 1976 campaign. His 15 wins, meanwhile, are the most through two seasons.
- McGuire is now only the second head coach in program history to lead the Red Raiders to bowl games in each of his first two seasons and is the first head coach in school history to win a bowl game in each of his first two seasons with wins at the Texas Bowl and most recently the Independence Bowl. He joins the late Mike Leach, as one of two coaches who pushed Texas Tech to a bowl game in each of his two seasons. McGuire previously became the eighth head coach in program history to lead the Red Raiders to a bowl game in his debut season a year ago and the 12th head coach to lead Texas Tech to a winning record in his first year.

SEASON NOTES

RUSHING RECORDS SET

- Single-game: On Sept. 30, 2023, Cam/Ron Valdez (111) and Tahj Brooks (101) became the third duo in program history to gain more than 100 yards rushing in a single game. Valdez and Brooks joined the 1998 contest versus Baylor when Ricky Williams (159) and Rob Peters (106) did so as well as the 2012 New Mexico game when Eric Stephens (118) and Kenny Williams (105) both eclipsed 100 yards rushing.
- Top Rushing games: Tahj Brooks owned eight 100-yard rushing performances in 2023, three of those joined the ranks of the Red Raiders' best single-game performances in program history. When he set his career-high of 182 rushing yards versus UCF on Nov. 18, 2023, it ranked as the No. 33-best rushing performance in school history. Meanwhile, his 170 yards at Baylor on Oct. 7, 2023, ranked No. T-48 and his 158 versus Tarleton State on Sept. 16, 2023 ranked No. T-58.
- Single-season marks: Tahj Brooks' 1,538 yards rushing in 2023 ranked as the fourth-best single-season all-time by a Red Raider. Brooks' 290 rushing attempts also ranked No. 4 all-time, just short of Byron Morris' 298 attempts in 1993.
- Career marks: Brooks' climbed to No. 7 all-time for career yardage at Texas Tech with 3,052 yards. He became the seventh Red Raider to eclipse 3,000 yards rushing in the season finale versus Cal in the Independence Bowl. Brooks will need 948 yards in 2024 to become the third Red Raiders to ever reach 4,000 yards rushing; he will need 1,167 yards rushing to reach Texas Tech's all-time rushing leader, Byron Hanspard (1994-96) and his 4,219 career rushing yards.
- Career marks: Brooks' rose to No. 6 all-time in career attempts as he owns 593 in his career. Ricky Williams is the all-time leader with 789 career carries from 1997-2001. Brooks would need to tote the rock 196 times in 2024 to reach that mark.

SCORING RECORDS SET

- Single-game: Kicker Gino Garcia imprinted his name in the all-time Top 10 for longest field goals twice in 2023. His 55-yarder versus TCU on Nov. 2 ranked as the third-longest field goal in program history matching four additional 55-yard field goals throughout program history. Bill Adams hit a 57-yard field goal in 1977 versus Texas A&M, the second-longest field goal, while Johnathan Garibay's epic 62-yard game-winner versus Iowa State in 2022 remains the all-time longest kick made in program history.
- Single-season: Gino Garcia also joined a list of Red Raiders who enjoyed perfect PAT seasons as he went 40-for-40 in 2023. Garcia now owns one of 17 single-season perfect PAT seasons by an individual.
- Single-season: Gino Garcia made 16 field goals in 2023, ranking as tied for the ninth-most made field goals in a single season. The Red Raiders' Trey Wolff set the record for the second-most made field goals just a year before in 2022 during Joey McGuire's first season as head coach with 21 made field goals.

DEFENSIVE RECORDS SET

- Career marks: Dadrion Taylor-Demerson logged four interceptions in 2023, growing his career total to 10, which placed him tied for the 10th most interceptions in a career by a Red Raider.
- Malik Dunlap joined a long list of Red Raiders that have returned an interception for a touchdown on Sept. 16, 2023, versus Tarleton State when he had a 54-yard interception return for a touchdown. It was the first return for a touchdown since Marquis Waters did so versus FIU on Sept. 18, 2021.

KICK RETURN RECORDS SET

- Single-game: Drae McCray matched the record for most kick returns in a game with seven in the Red Raiders' game at Texas on Nov. 24, 2023. It matched Ben McRoy's seven returns versus Nevada in 2011.
- Single-game: Drae McCray registered the seventh 100-yard kick return in program history with his electric return versus Houston on Sept. 30, 2023. The six other times it happened in Texas Tech history were by Jakeem Grant (2015), Ivory McCann (2001), Keith Henderson (1984), Donny Anderson (1965) and Jack Kirkpatrick did so twice in the same season in 1953.
- Single-season: Drae McCray's 717 kick return yards in 2023 ranked as the sixth-most in a single season in program history while the 717 were the most in program history by a player in their junior season. His 26 returns ranked as the seventh-most by an individual in a single season.

PUNTING RECORDS SET

- Single season: Austin McNamara's 46.3 yards per punt in 2023 ranked as the third-best mark in program history. Coincidentally, it trails his all-time program-best mark of 48.2 yards per punt set in 2021.
- Career marks: Austin McNamara departs Texas Tech as the all-time leader for career punting average with a 45.9 average over five seasons. It best the No. 2 mark by a full two yards as Taylor Symmank's 43.7 career punting average ranks No. 2 in Texas Tech history.
- Career Big 12 record: Not only did Austin McNamara depart as the all-time Texas Tech leader for career punting average, but topped Oklahoma State's Quinn Sharp (2009-12) for the best average in league history.

TEAM RECORDS SET

- Penalties: The Red Raiders had just one penalty versus Houston on Sept. 30, 2023. It was the seventh time a Red Raider team had just one flag, matching a school record.
- Turnovers: Texas Tech had just five fumbles lost during the 2023 season. It matched a program-best mark set during two other seasons (2000, 2001). The Red Raiders fumbled the ball only 11 times, which set a new program record for the fewest times to fumble the ball in a season.
- Comebacks: Texas Tech had a 14-point come-from-behind victory against UCF after falling behind 14-0 in the first quarter. The Red Raiders went on to win 24-23, which ranked T-No. 12 as the largest comeback victory (records since 1960).
- Honors: Austin McNamara, became the first Red Raider to become a three-time first-team All-Big 12 player. He was named to the first team in 2019, 2020 and again in 2023.

CAREER RECORD BOOK ON NOTICE IN 2024

- Brooks opted for a super-senior season after his more than impressive 2023 campaign, which put No. 1 clearly in Brooks' sights for the program's most career rushing yards and most career rushing attempts.
- Brooks climbed to seventh all-time in program history with 3,052 career rushing yards, sparked by his 1,538 rushing yards in 2023 that ranked as the fourth-most in a single season.
- Brooks became the sixth Red Raider to rush 3,000 yards in a career by eclipsing the mark during the Independence Bowl.
- He is one of 16 Red Raiders all-time to record 2,000 rushing yards in a career.
- Brooks' 12 career 100-yard games, eight coming in 2023, places him in fifth place for the most in school history behind the likes of Byron Hanspard (21), James Gray (18), Byron Morris (16) and James Hadnot (13).

WYOMING 35, TEXAS TECH 33

LARAMIE, Wyo. (AP) — Andrew Peasley through an 11-yard touchdown pass to tight end John Michael Gyllenberg on a fourth-and-7, and running back Sam Scott punched in the 2-point conversion as Wyoming stunned Texas Tech 35-33 in double-overtime on Saturday night at War Memorial Stadium in the season opener for both teams.

Tyler Shough, who finished with 338 yards passing and three touchdowns, had given the Red Raiders a 33-27 lead after finding Jerand Bradley for a 15-yard score, but the senior quarterback's conversion pass failed.

Scott's walk-off score sent the crowd of 26,450 pouring onto the field late Saturday following a game that was delayed for 78 minutes due to a lightning storm that moved through Laramie.

Peasley, who limped off the field at the end of regulation after absorbing a big hit by nose tackle Jaylon Hutchings, ran for a 5-yard touchdown on the first possession of overtime.

Tahj Brooks answered for Texas Tech with a 6-yard touchdown run on third-and-2 to force a second overtime. The Red Raiders stormed out to a quick 17-0 lead with the help of fumbles by Wyoming running backs Jamari Ferrell and D.Q. James. John Hoyland, who was voted to the preseason AP All-American second team, booted a career-long 56-yard field goal to stop the bleeding for the Cowboys and start a 20-0 run.

#13 OREGON 38, TEXAS TECH 30

LUBBOCK, TEXAS (AP) — Bo Nix threw for 359 yards and two touchdowns. Jeffrey Bassa had a 45-yard interception return for a score in the final minute and No. 13 Oregon rallied for a 38-30 victory over Texas Tech on Saturday night.

Tyler Shough threw for three TDs and ran for 101 yards and another score against his former team, but it wasn't enough to extend the Red Raiders' school-record 23-game winning streak in home openers.

The Ducks (2-0) had twice rallied in the fourth quarter behind Nix, who led a pair of drives to go-ahead field goals, capped by Cameron Lewis' 34-yarder for a 31-30 lead with 1:10 remaining.

Shough was trying to answer for a second time with a drive to a field goal when Brandon Dorlus hit Shough as he was throwing. The ball went straight to Bassa, who stepped over Shough and ran free to the end zone with 35 seconds left.

Shough, who lost for just the second time in 10 games he started and finished in two-plus injury-plagued seasons since leaving Oregon, got Texas Tech to the Oregon 33 with 8 seconds to go. His desperation throw the end zone came up 2 yards short, and was intercepted by Bryan Addison.

The Red Raiders are 0-2 for the first time since 1990 after losing in double overtime at Wyoming in their opener. Gino Garcia was 2 of 6 for the season when he made a 45-yard field goal to give Texas Tech a 30-28 lead with 5:13 remaining. Shough rallied from a 22-yard loss on a strip sack and lost fumble and an interception to direct a three-play, 83-yard drive for a 27-18 lead after Nix was stuffed on fourth-and-1.

Nix answered with four third-down conversions on a touchdown drive before the Ducks went ahead 28-27 on Lewis' 23-yard field goal after Malik Dunlap almost pulled off a toe-tapping interception in the end zone.

Shough kick-started the Texas Tech offense by running 58 yards on a designed draw to set up the game's first touchdown, and Nix answered with a 72-yard scoring toss to Troy Franklin. Shough ended up with four turnovers while completing 24 of 40 passes for 282 yards. Nix was 32 of 44 without an interception, and Franklin finished with 103 yards receiving on six catches.

TEXAS TECH 41, TARLETON STATE 3

LUBBOCK, TEXAS (AP) – Malik Dunlap returned the first of his two interceptions for a touchdown. Tahj Brooks set a career high with 158 yards rushing and Texas Tech got its first win of the season, beating lower-division Tarleton State 41-3 on Saturday night.

The Red Raiders (1-2) led for good when Dunlap had a 54-yard interception return only 2 1/2 minutes into the game.

Tarleton State (2-1) trailed 41-0 until Adrian Guzman's 21-yard field goal with 5:04 left in the game. That came at the end of the same drive when Texans junior receiver Jaden Smith was taken off the field on a stretcher after being down near the goal line for several minutes while being treated by trainers from both teams.

ESPN's game broadcast said Smith had a neck injury and was being taken to a local hospital. It wasn't immediately known the extent of the injury though he gave thumbs-up with both hands as the motorized cart was driving off the field. He had an incredible one-handed catch for a 33-yard gain earlier in the fourth quarter.

Tech quarterback Tyler Shough was 10-of-20 passing for 123 yards with a touchdown and ran for another score before coming out of the game after only one series in the second half. Behren Morton, a four-game starter as a redshirt freshman last year when Shough was hurt, completed 8 of 13 passes for 72 yards with two touchdowns and an interception after that.

Tarleton State, in the fourth and final season of its transition to the Football Championship Subdivision from NCAA Division II, entered the game averaging 518 total yards per game and leading the FCS with 52 points a game. The Texans were held to 342 total yards but avoided being held scoreless for the first time since midway through the 2015 season.

Texans quarterback Victor Gabalis completed 21 of 40 passes for 182 yards with three interceptions. Benjamin Omayebu had 12 catches for 76 yards. Brooks had 140 yards on 15 carries at halftime, already surpassing his previous career high of 134 yards set against Houston in the 2021 opener. He had only four carries in the first two drives of the second half before coming out of the game.

After a double-OT loss at Wyoming to open the season and a 38-30 loss at home last week to 13th-ranked Oregon, Shough's former team, the Red Raiders, did what they needed to do against an overmatched opponent. They avoided their first 0-3 start since 1971. They have won their last 21 games against FCS opponents since losing to North Texas in 1988 but missed out on their first shutout in five years.

WEST VIRGINIA 20, TEXAS TECH 13

MORGANTOWN, W.Va. (AP)

— Nicco Marchiol threw a touchdown pass in his first start, CJ Donaldson added a short TD run and West Virginia held off Texas Tech 20-13 in their Big 12 opener on Saturday.

Texas Tech backup quarterback Behren Morton came on for the injured Tyler Shough in the first quarter and put together a pair of scoring drives. But Morton, who had thrown for 325 yards and two touchdowns against the Mountaineers a year ago in Texas Tech's 48-10 win, couldn't bring the Red Raiders back from a 13-3 deficit this time. Morton drove the Red Raiders from their 28 to the West Virginia 11, but he threw four straight incompletions, the last one with 11 seconds left.

On a day that saw former standout defensive end Bruce Irvin inducted into West Virginia's Sports Hall of Fame, the Mountaineers (3-1, 1-0 Big 12) limited Texas Tech (1-3, 0-1) to 56 total yards in the first half and 321 overall in a steady drizzle from the outer bands of Tropical Storm Ophelia.

Shough, who had sat out the two previous games against West Virginia with injuries, took hard hits on consecutive plays late in the first quarter and was driven off the field on a cart with an injury to his lower left leg.

The teams traded 79-yard scoring drives early in the fourth quarter. Morton found Jerand Bradley with a 6-yard scoring pass. Marchiol answered with a 9-yard TD toss to Kole Taylor to put West Virginia ahead 20-10.

Morton then threw a 16-yard pass to Bradley on third down to set up Texas Tech at the West Virginia 16. But Morton threw three straight incompletions and the Red Raiders settled for Gino Garcia's second field goal, a 34-yarder with 4:45 left. Morton finished 13 of 37 for 158 yards.

Marchiol, a redshirt freshman, got his first career start in place of Garrett Greene, who was held out with an ankle sprain sustained a week ago in a 17-6 win over Pittsburgh. Marchiol threw two interceptions — one that went off the hands of wide receiver Devin Carter. But Texas Tech managed only three points off those mistakes.

Marchiol put together enough sustained drives to make a difference. Donaldson ran for 34 yards on a 75-yard drive that ended with his 2-yard run late in the first quarter. Marchiol later ran 19 yards on third down to set up one of two field goals by Michael Hayes.

Marchiol led West Virginia with 72 rushing yards. But he didn't see several open receivers and was held to 12 of 21 passing for 78 yards. Brooks ran for 131 of his 149 yards in the second half for Texas Tech.

TEXAS TECH 49, HOUSTON 28

LUBBOCK, Texas (AP) — Drae McCray returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown, Loic Fouonji blocked a punt for one of his two scores and the Texas Tech offense did the rest in a 49-28 victory over Houston on Saturday.

The Red Raiders (2-3, 1-1 Big 12) won the first Big 12 meeting of former Southwest Conference foes despite 335 yards passing and four first-half touchdowns from Houston's Donovan Smith, their former quarterback. Behren Morton threw for two TDs in his first start after Tyler Shough sustained a long-term injury for the third consecutive season with a broken leg in Texas Tech's league-opening loss at West Virginia last week.

Tahj Brooks and Cam'Ron Valdez rushed for 106 yards apiece, with Brooks scoring twice and Valdez getting a clinching 41-yard TD run in the fourth quarter. The teams combined for just 14 points after halftime — all by Texas Tech — after scoring 63 in the first half, which ended with the Red Raiders leading 35-28.

Texas Tech has its longest winning streak in the series at six games and has won 11 of the past 12 meetings going back to the SWC days, which ended in 1995. Smith's first TD toss gave the Cougars (2-3, 0-2) the first points on an opening possession against the Red Raiders this season before McCray tied it on the ensuing kickoff.

The Austin Peay transfer fielded the ball 2 yards deep in the end zone and almost stopped before the 15-yard line to avoid tacklers, then found an opening along the Houston sideline and got a final clearing block near midfield from Drew Hocutt, the son of Texas Tech athletic director Kirby Hocutt. Houston went 75 yards for touchdowns on each its first three possessions before finally stalling at its 33.

A little more than a minute after a 25-yard touchdown catch, Fouonji easily reached punter Laine Wilkins on a rush from the right side, kept running after the block and grabbed the ball chest-high on a bounce at the 5 for the easy score and Texas Tech's first lead at 28-21.

Samuel Brown had 113 yards receiving and a touchdown for the Cougars, who have lost their first two conference games for just the second time in 20 years, a span that started with Conference USA before a switch to the American Athletic.

The 239 yards rushing for Texas Tech were a season high, and they had 37 running plays against 22 pass attempts. The 59 plays were well below the average for an offense that ranks among the national leaders.

PROVO, Utah (AP) — Kedon Slovis threw for 127 yards and two touchdown passes, and BYU forced five turnovers to power a 27-14 victory over Texas Tech on Saturday night.

LJ Martin piled up 93 yards rushing on 10 carries. The Cougars (5-2, 2-2 Big 12) never trailed despite totaling only 277 yards on offense.

Jake Strong threw for 236 yards and a touchdown pass but also had three interceptions in his first start for Texas Tech. Tahj Brooks added 105 yards and a score on the ground. The Red Raiders (3-5, 2-3) lost in their first game in Utah.

BYU tallied three turnovers in the first half alone and scored 13 points off its four takeaways. The Cougars also made big plays on offense before halftime to jump on Texas Tech early.

Martin's 55-yard run on BYU's second play from scrimmage set up a 3-yard touchdown catch by Chase Roberts. Eddie Heckard then pounced on a fumbled ball in the end zone to put the Cougars up 14-0.

The Red Raiders finally got on the board in the second quarter when Xavier White caught a wide-open pass along the sideline and raced 72 yards for the score. BYU countered on a 4-yard touchdown catch by Darius Lassiter and a 35-yard field goal from Will Ferrin, extending its lead to 24-7 before halftime.

Moving the ball wasn't a problem for the Red Raiders early. They outgained BYU in total yardage over the first three quarters. Turnovers ultimately hindered their ability to turn drives into points.

TEXAS TECH 35, TCU 28

LUBBOCK, Texas (AP) — Behren Morton threw for 282 yards and two touchdowns, with the go-ahead 44-yard score to Drae McCray with 10 1/2 minutes left, and Dadrion Taylor-Demerson's second interception was a game-clincher in the final minute as Texas Tech beat TCU 35-28 on Thursday night.

"So two things we did, we didn't turn the ball over and we caused turnovers. You know, if you do those two things, you got a great opportunity," Texas Tech coach Joey McGuire said. "It puts us in great situations."

Tahj Brooks ran for 146 yards on 31 carries, his sixth 100-yard game this season to become the first Texas Tech running back to surpass 1,000 yards in a single season since DeAndre Washington in 2015.

"Tahj Brooks, I was really proud of what he did. I thought Tahj was timely," McGuire said. "He could have gotten frustrated (but) he didn't. He stayed behind his pads and very few times did he ever cause a negative play." The Red Raiders (4-5, 3-5 Big 12) won for the first time in nearly a month. They had lost two games in a row before last weekend's open date.

Josh Hoover, in his third start for TCU filling in for injured Chandler Morris, completed 32 of 52 passes for 353 yards and a touchdown. But his second interception with 55 seconds left ended a potential game-tying drive when Taylor-Demerson picked it off at the Tech 19.

"It's kind of been the same story all year, honestly. We just make so many mistakes that we just can't have any kind of level of consistency, and we made some critical mistakes in the first half. We did some things that you just can't do," TCU coach Sonny Dykes said. "Our guys came back and played hard in the second half, took a lead, answered back. I knew we could. I knew we would."

Emani Bailey ran for two touchdowns in third quarter for the Horned Frogs, his 2-yard TD putting TCU up 21-20. But he finished with only 57 yards rushing, after coming in averaging 106 per game.

Taylor-Demerson's first interception, in the final minute of the third quarter, gave the Red Raiders possession at the TCU 16 and set up Brooks' 9-yard TD run before Morton's 2-point conversion throw to wide-open Jerand Bradley for a 28-21 lead.

LAWRENCE, Kan. (AP) — Gino Garcia hit a game-winning 30-yard field goal with 3 seconds to play and Texas Tech upset No. 19 Kansas 16-13 on Saturday as the Jayhawks struggled after losing quarterback Jason Bean in the first half.

Tahj Brooks ran for 133 yards and a touchdown as the Red Raiders (5-5, 4-3 Big 12) came back after Kansas (7-3, 4-3) tied the game on a 22-yard field goal by Seth Keller with :26 seconds left in regulation. Texas Tech opened as 10-0 lead in the first quarter as Brooks scored early in a 5-yard TD run. Garcia added a 32-yard field goal late in the quarter.

The Red Raiders extended their lead to 13-0 early in the third quarter on Garcia's second field goal before Kansas got back in the game on a Devin Neal 60-yard touchdown run early in the fourth quarter.

The Jayhawks marched 71 yards later in the fourth quarter and got within three points on a 24-yard field goal by Keller. He tied the game late but Texas Tech found a way to win as Behren Morton was 19 of 25 for 176 yards. Bean went down with an injury in the second quarter and returned for just one drive the rest of the game. Cole Ballard finished up and was 9 of 20 for 124 yards and an interception.

Tech's run game was too much for the Jayhawk defense to handle in the first half. The win leaves Texas Tech a win away from being bowl eligible.

TEXAS TECH 24, UCF 23

LUBBOCK, Texas (AP) — Tahj Brooks ran for a career-high 182 yards while powering a game-clinching drive after E'Maurion Banks blocked a potential tying extra-point kick, and Texas Tech rallied for a 24-23 victory over UCF on Saturday night.

Behren Morton threw for two touchdowns in the home finale as the Red Raiders (6-5, 5-3 Big 12) won their third consecutive game in a battle for bowl eligibility. In coach Joey McGuire's debut last season, Texas Tech won its final four games, including a Texas Bowl victory over Mississippi. The Knights (5-6, 2-6), making their Big 12 debut, will have to win at home against Houston next weekend to secure an eighth consecutive season of bowl eligibility.

UCF couldn't hold a 14-0 lead, didn't get any points from inside the Texas Tech 5-yard line by letting time run out before halftime and settled for a short field goal on fourth-and-3 when trailing by a touchdown early in the fourth quarter. Despite all that, the Knights were a PAT away from a tie after John Rhys Plumlee's 71-yard touchdown pass to Javon Baker with 5:30 remaining.

Colton Boomer had made 85 consecutive PATs when a leaping Banks in the middle of the line got a hand on the kick to keep the Red Raiders in front 24-23. The Red Raiders then ran off the final 5 1/2 minutes behind Brooks, who carried eight times for 34 yards in the nine plays before Morton kneeled down twice. Morton had a first-down pass during the drive, and the clincher was a 4-yard run from Brooks on second-and-3 with 1:16 remaining. Brooks scored the go-ahead touchdown on a 13-yard run late in the third quarter.

UCF led 14-0 after the kicker Boomer ran 24 yards on a fake field goal to set up Harvey's second TD run of the first quarter, a 1-yarder. The Red Raiders, who will finish with a winning record in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2008-09 under the late Mike Leach, got even with Morton's scoring tosses of 15 yards to Drae McCray and 19 yards to Mason Tharp.

The Knights were in position to score before the end of the half. Out of timeouts with the clock running inside 15 seconds, Plumlee threw a shuffle pass to Harvey, who was stopped at the 2. UCF didn't come close to getting off a play to stop the clock.

Brooks won the battle of two of the nation's top 10 running backs by beating his previous career best of 170 against Baylor last month. Brooks has at least 100 yards in eight of the past nine games. Harvey finished with 78 yards, ending a five-game run of at least 100 yards that was the longest at UCF since 2007.

Leaving with Oklahoma for the Southeastern Conference after this season, Texas (11-1, 8-1), has won six straight since a loss to Oklahoma. The Longhorns will face an opponent to be determined Saturday in the championship game Dec. 2 in Arlington.						
Texas Tech (6-6, 5-4) was outgained 528 yards to 198. Quarterback Behren Morton was 5-0 in games he started and finished this season before Friday. But hounded by a fierce Texas pass rush, he completed 19 of 36 for only 88 yards with three interceptions. His Texas counterpart, Quinn Ewers, threw for 196 yards and one touchdown against one interception. Ewers was 17 of 26.						
Texas Tech's Tahj Brooks, ranked third nationally in rushing yards per game with 122.5 coming in, gained 95 on 19 carries. Texas Tech briefly looked like it might be competitive. Trailing 10-0, the Red Raiders used a 55-yard kickoff return by Drae McCray, a 25-yard run by Brooks, and a pass interference penalty against Texas to set up a 2-yard touchdown run by Morton late in the first quarter.

TEXAS TECH 34, CALIFORNIA 14

SHREVEPORT, La. (AP) — Behren Morton completed 27 of 43 passes for 256 yards and three first-half touchdowns, leading Texas Tech to a 34-14 victory over California in the Independence Bowl on Saturday night.

Tahj Brooks ran for 98 yards and a score as the Red Raiders (7-6) shook off a terrible start. They shut out the Golden Bears (6-7) for the final three quarters to win the 47th edition of college football's 11th-oldest bowl game.

"The was the best, most complete game we've had all year," Texas Tech coach Joey McGuire said. "I really thought we played extremely hard, very physical." Texas Tech led 24-14 at halftime and Brooks, the nation's fourth-leading rusher, scored the only touchdown of the second half on a 7-yard run in the third quarter.

It was the third straight bowl win for the Red Raiders, who fumbled the opening kickoff. Cal freshman Fernando Mendoza then rifled a 25-yard touchdown pass to Monroe Young to give the Bears the lead 15 seconds into the game. California had a golden opportunity to extend it, but Mendoza was injured on a third-down scramble to the Texas Tech 5. Cal passed on the field goal and was stuffed after Jaydn Ott took a direct snap.

Texas Tech capped the ensuing 93-yard drive with a 27-yard touchdown pass from Morton to Coy Eakin before Mendoza returned on the next possession. "No way I can't go back into the game when we have everyone else fighting injuries," Mendoza said. He needed just 94 seconds to help the Bears regain the lead. Ott's 1-yard touchdown run was preceded by a 51-yard pass from Mendoza to Trond Grizzell.

"Everything after that didn't go very well," Cal coach Justin Wilcox said. Texas Tech had another immediate answer and tied the game at 14 with a 15-yard TD pass from Morton to Mason Tharp.

The Red Raiders' defense forced a three-and-out early in the second quarter and the offense continued to chew up yards — and points. A 14-yard strike from Morton to Loic Fouonji gave Texas Tech its first lead, 21-14. A short field goal by Gino Garcia just before halftime made it 24-14. Garcia added a 37-yarder in the fourth quarter. Ott finished with just 45 yards rushing on 16 carries.

"We were able to limit what he did, so we made them more one-dimensional," McGuire said. "Made (Mendoza) throw into coverages we wanted him to throw into." Texas Tech lost its previous two trips to the Independence Bowl, both to Ole Miss in 1986 and 1998.
