ARIZONA NOTES & NUMBERS

- The Arizona Wildcats host the Texas Tech Red Raiders. FOX will have the broadcast with Connor Onion (Play-by-play), Mark Helfrich (Analyst), and Allison Williams (Sideline) providing the call.
- » This is the 34th all-time meeting between Arizona and Texas Tech and the first since 2019. Arizona trails the all-time series 5-26-2 dating back to 1932. The Wildcats won the last matchup 28-14 on Sept. 14. 2019 in Tucson.
- Texas Tech enters tonight's matchup with a 4-1 record and have won three in a row since dropping its second game of the season 37-16 at Washington State.
- » Arizona and Texas Tech were once members of the Border Conference that began in 1931 and existed until 1962. The conference was comprised of teams from Texas to as far was as Arizona. Member schools included Arizona, ASU, Hardin-Simmons, New Mexico, New Mexico State, Northern Arizona, Texas Tech, UTEP, and West Texas A&M.
- » Arizona defeated No. 10 Utah 23-10 last Saturday, marking the first win over an AP Top 25 opponent for Head Coach Brent Brennan. It was the first loss for Utah to an unranked team at home since falling 21-7 to Washington on Sept. 15, 2018.
- » Last week's win was the Wildcats first road win at Utah since 2014. Arizona has won back-to-back games over Utah for the first time since rattling off four straight victories from 2012-14.
- » In the season-opening win over New Mexico, Tetairoa McMillan became the first player in FBS history to have a game with 10-plus receptions, 300-plus receiving yards, 30.0-plus yards per reception, and 4-plus receiving TD (per OptaSTATS).

- The Wildcats' defense stopped Utah on fourth down four times last week, marking their first 0-for-4 performance since Oregon in 2006.
- Arizona boasts nine wins while unranked over AP Top 10 teams in the last 20 seasons, the most in the country over that span.
- The Wildcats allowed only 10 points to Utah, marking the fewest points allowed to a Top 10 team since shutting out #10 Miami 29-0 in the 1994 Fiesta Bowl.
- QB Noah Fifita threw for a pair of touchdowns in last week's win at No. 10 Utah, giving him 33 for his career. He is now tied for 12th all-time at Arizona in passing TDs.
- Arizona's defense combined for eight pass breakups against Utah, the program's most in a single game since posting nine PBU against Southern Utah in 2018.
- Saturday's win over Utah was the first AP Top 10 victory for Arizona first-year head coach Brent Brennan.

Please submit requests well in advance to allow time for an interview to be scheduled. However, some requests may not be granted based on academic schedules and other team responsibilities. All in-season player availability will be on Tuesdays.

WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCES

Head Coach Brent Brennan is available twice weekly at press conferences each Monday and Thursday of game weeks during the regular season. Press conferences begin at approximately 11:20 AM MST in the east concourse press conference room. A live web stream and archive of the press conferences are both available on the Arizona Athletics YouTube channel, accessible at YouTube.com/@ ArizonaWildcats.

PRACTICES

The first 30 minutes of in-season practices are open to media on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only. All interviews with Coach Brennan and student-athletes will take place on Monday (coach), Tuesday (offensive players), Wednesday (defensive players), and Thursday (coach) afternoons in the east concourse press conference room. Contact Jeff Bowe or Brett Gleason for more specific information on the weekly availability throughout the season.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Arizona has a closed locker room policy after games. There is no player availability on the field immediately after the game. Head coach Brent Brennan will address the assembled media only after his postgame radio show responsibilities have been completed both at home and on the road. At home games, Coach Brennan will hold a postgame press conference in the east concourse press conference room. Selected offensive and defensive players will also be available after games. For road games, each locker room situation will dictate postgame protocol. Please direct any specific requests for players to Jeff Bowe and Brett Gleason with the UA Communication Services staff.

FACILITIES ACCESS FOR MEDIA

The team locker room, practice sites, sports medicine center and strength and conditioning center are off limits to media unless special arrangements have been made through Jeff Bowe.

PHOTO/VIDEO USAGE

Usage of imagery, audio and video taken at Arizona Athletics events is restricted to editorial purposes; these guidelines are covered in materials issued to reporters, editors and photographers upon receipt of credentials and/or access. RENEWING AN OLD RIVALRY: The Arizona Wildcats (3-1, 1-0 Big 12) host the Texas Tech Red Raiders (4-1, 2-0 Big 12). FOX will have the broadcast with Connor Onion (Play-by-play), Mark Helfrich (Analyst), and Allison Williams (Sideline)providing the commentary. This is the 34th all-time meeting between Arizona and Texas Tech and the first since 2019. Arizona trails the all-time series 5-26-2 dating back to 1932. The Wildcats won the last matchup 28-14 on Sept. 14. 2019 in Tucson. In the 2019 win, Khalil Tate accounted for 314 yards and two touchdowns. Gary Brightwell capped a late 99-yard drive with his second touchdown run and Arizona grinded out a 28-14 win over Texas Tech. Tate led the Wildcats with 185 yards passing and 145 yards rushing, accounting for two touchdowns, one through the air and one on the ground in the 2019 win. Texas Tech enters tonight's matchup with a 4-1 record and have won three in a row since dropping its second game of the season 37-16 at Washington State. Arizona and Texas Tech were once members of the Border Conference that began in 1931 and existed until 1962. The conference was comprised of teams from Texas to as far was as Arizona. LAST GAME: Noah Fifita threw for 197 yards and two touchdowns and Arizona's defense stopped No. 10 Utah four times on fourth down to help the Wildcats beat the Utes 23-10 last Saturday night. Arizona (3-1, 1-0 Big 12) turned in a stellar defensive performance with two interceptions, eight pass breakups and seven tackles for loss. Utah (4-1, 1-1 Big 12) played without QB Cam Rising again. Freshman Isaac Wilson moved the ball but couldn't convert in the red zone and threw a pair of interceptions. Fifita hit Tetairoa McMillan for a 41-yard pass on third-and-11 and then threw a 35-yard touchdown to Keyan Burnett on another third-and-11 to make it 23-10 with 8:13 to play. Tao Johnson intercepted Fifita in the end zone on the first play of the fourth quarter before Wilson drove the field and found Caleb Lohner for a 20-yard TD reception to cut the lead to 16-10 with 11:54 to play. But the Wildcat defense held strong. In the third quarter after Tyler Loop's 53-yard field goal, Wilson was intercepted by Genesis Smith on the next play. Loop's ensuing 33-yard field goal gave the Wildcats a 16-3 lead. Fifita used quick passes to avoid Utah's pass rush and capped a seven-play, 75-yard drive with a 3-yard TD pass to Jeremiah Patterson to give Arizona a 10-3 lead at halftime. Fifita completed all seven passes on the Wildcats opening drive but it was Kedrick Reescano's 23-yard run that set up Loop's 47-yard field goal. The Wildcats stopped the Utes first two possessions on downs - both inside the Arizona 10-yard-line on fourth-and-2. Utah fans and the team waited to see if Rising would be able to play after hurting his throwing hand on Sept. 7. Again, it was a game-time decision, but Wilson was the one who ran out with the offense. Rising, a seventh-year senior, has only played four total quarters this season after missing all of last season. Arizona now has a 6-31-1 road record against AP Top 10 teams. Utah had its most explosive first half of the season with 219 yards but only scored three points. Then, when the pressure was on, Wilson threw two interceptions despite a career-high 280 yards. Utah should tumble from their Top 10 perch after the loss at home while Arizona looks to find its way into the rankings.

TACARIO DAVIS NAMED BIG 12 DEFENSIVE POTW: Arizona defensive back Tacario Davis has been named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week, as announced today by the Conference. Davis recorded five pass breakups which were the most by any defensive back in the Big 12 during Week 5. He also made seven solo tackles, third on the team, to help Arizona upend No. 10 Utah 23-10. Arizona as a team recorded eight pass breakups in total. Davis came up big for the Wildcats with a pass breakup in the end zone on a fourth-and-goal and turned the Utah offense away on another fourth-down attempt causing two turnovers on downs. Davis, a junior from Long Beach, Calif., entered Saturday's contest with no pass breakups and moved into second in the Big 12 in passes defended with his huge five PBU performance.

DESERT DEFENSE: The Wildcats allowed 10 points to Utah, which marked the fewest points allowed to a top 10 team since shutting out #10 Miami 29-0 in 1994 Fiesta Bowl. The Wildcats held the Utes to just 10 points, marking the fewest first half points by Utah since scoring seven against Northwestern at the 2023 Las Vegas Bowl. Ten points is Utah's lowest scoring output against a conference team since losing 6-35 to Oregon in 2023. Prior to the matchup with Arizona, Utah running back Micah Bernard rushed for more than 118 yards in each his last three games. He was held under 100 rushing yards (91 yards) for the second time this season. The Wildcats defense allowed 84 total yards on 29 rushes to Utah runners, which is an average of 2.9 yards per carry, marking the lowest in a single game this season.

LAST GAME INDIVIDUAL NOTES:

- TE Keyan Burnett recorded career-high marks in both receptions (5) and yards (76) on Saturday night. His fourth quarter touchdown was the first of his career.
- QB Noah Fifita threw for two touchdowns and moved into a tie for 12th all-time at Arizona with 33rd career TDs.
- K Tyler Loop connected on 3-for-4 field goals, tying his career high with three made attempts.
- DL Stanley Ta'ufo'ou recorded his first sack with the Wildcats late in the first half.
- Safety Genesis Smith picked off Utah QB Isaac Wilson for his third-career interception and second of the 2024 season.
- DB Tacario Davis has made five pass breakups, marking a single-game career high and giving him 21 passes defended for his career.
- Safety Gunner Maldonado also logged an interception on Saturday, giving him four career picks.
- RB Kedrick Reescano posted career-high marks in attempts (7) and yards (73) in Saturday's victory.
- LB Taye Brown led the Wildcats with 10 total tackles, marking his second double-digit tackle performance of the season.

BACK ON TRACK: Saturday was the Wildcats first road win at Utah since 2014. They have now won back-to-back games over Utah for the first time since rattling off four straight victories from 2012–14. Arizona now boasts nine wins while unranked over AP Top 10 ranked teams in the last 20 seasons, the most in the nation over that span. Arizona picked up its second road win versus a top 10 opponent in the last 10 seasons. (Won at #9 UCLA in 2022).

FIRST BIG 12 WIN: Arizona won their first Big 12 Conference game in program history and improved to 3-1 on the year. The Wildcats are now 21-26-2 all-time against Utah. Last Saturday was the first win over an AP Top 25 program for head coach Brent Brennan. The 23-10 victory for Arizona is the first loss for Utah to an unranked team at home since falling to Washington 21-7 on Sept. 15, 2018.

O-FER ON 4TH: Arizona's defense turned away Utah on fourth down four times, marking their first 0-for-4 performance since Oregon in 2006.

THE TRE WAY: Arizona defensive lineman Tre Smith is third nationally in hurries, getting after the quarterback 17 times so far through three games this season (Per PFF). Keldric Faulk (Auburn) is first nationally in hurries with 20. Smith joined the Wildcats prior to the 2024 season as a transfer from San Jose State. Smith has recorded 105 total tackles (51 solo, 54 ast) over 27 games. He has 10.5-career sacks and 18.5 tackles



for loss combined between Arizona and San Jose State.

GETTING TO THE BALL: Defensive back Tacario Davis recorded five pass breakups during last Saturday's game at Utah. He moves into a tie for second in the Big 12 with those five breakups. Trailing only Korie Black (Oklahoma State) with six. Davis is tied for first with 1.25 passes defended per game. He now has 21 passes defended in his career.

QUALI TAKES FLIGHT: RB Quali Conley recorded his first 100-plus yard rushing game with Arizona (112 vs. NAU, 9/7), and since he rushed for 155 yards against San Diego State on 11/18/23. Conley broke off a 58-yard rush on Arizona's first drive of the game, marking his longest rush with the Wildcats and the second longest of his career (Longest: 68 yards vs. New Mexico, 10/14/23). Conley matched his career-high in receptions with five against NAU (9/7) (2x; last: vs. Air Force, 9/22/23).

RUSHING OFFENSE: The Wildcats rushed for 161 total yards with Kedrick Reescano (74 yards) and Quali Conley (75 yards) combining for 149 of those yards. It was the third of four games that the Wildcats have rushed for more than 160 yards combined on offense. So far, the Wildcats are averaging 5.9 yards per carry (17th nationally) and averaging 152.5 yards per game. Arizona rushed for 5.4 yards per carry against Utah, which is the most rushing yards per carry allowed in a single game this season.

T-MAC: After making four touchdown grabs in Game 1 against New Mexico, wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan is 6th in program history in career-receiving touchdowns (22), 6th in career-receiving yards in program history (2,557). McMillan pulled in the second-most receiving yards in a single-season in program history in 2023 (1,402). He has now recorded the most receiving yards in a single game (304) and the second-most receiving yards in a single game in program history in 2023 (266; at ASU, Nov. 25, 2023). Currently, McMillan is tied for 10th in FBS with four touchdown grabs.

The Wildcats had seven players selected to the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year Award watch list including quarterback Noah Fifita, defensive lineman Keanu Mailoto, linebacker Jacob Manu, wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan, offensive lineman Jonah Savaiinaea, defensive lineman Stanley Ta'ufo'ou, and defensive lineman Ta'ita'l Uiagalelei. The seven players included in this watch list is second in the nation behind only BYU in 2024. It also marked the most for the Wildcats since the inception of the award preseason watch list. Fifita joined the college watch list for the first time. Savaiinaea makes his second straight appearance on the list. McMillan advanced to the finals of the 2023 award consideration after being named to the preseason list. Mailoto, Manu, Ta'ufo'ou, and Uiagalelei made their first appearance as Wildcats on this award watch list.

WILDCATS IN THE NFL: Arizona currently has 11 players on NFL rosters heading into the 2024 season. Former offensive lineman Jordan Morgan was selected by the Green Bay Packers in the first round (25th overall) following the 2023 season. He was the first first-round selection since Antoine Cason was picked 27th overall in 2008. He joined a list that includes Cason (2008; 27th, San Diego), Trung Canidate (2000; 31st, St. Louis), Chris McAlister (1999; 10th, Baltimore), John Fina (1992; 27th, Buffalo), Chris Singleton (1990; 8th, New England), Anthony Smith (1990; 11th, Oakland), Rickey Hunley (1984; 7th, Cincinnati), Mike Dawson (1976; 22nd, Arizona), Bill Lueck (1968; 26, Green Bay), and Walt Nelson (1939; 10th, New York Giants) to be selected in the first round of the NFL Draft. Wide receiver Jacob Cowing was picked in the fourth round (135th overall) by the San Francisco 49ers and became the highest wide receiver selected since Mike Thomas in 2009 (4th Rd, 107 overall by Jacksonville) and the first wide receiver since Juron Criner (5th Rd, 168th overall by Oakland) in 2012. Tight End Tanner McLachlan was the third Wildcat selected in the 2024 NFL Draft when the Cincinnati Bengals picked him the 6th round (194 overall). The three draft picks matched the most selected in one draft since 2014 when Ka'Deem Carey (4th Rd, 117 overall), Shaguille Richardson (5th Rd, 157th overall), and Marquis Flowers (6th Rd, 212 overall) were picked in the 2014 NFL Draft.

RECAP

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP) — Khalil Tate accounted for 314 yards and two touchdowns, Gary Brightwell capped a late 99-yard drive with his second touchdown run and Arizona grinded out a 28-14 win over Texas Tech Saturday night.

Arizona (2-1) hit a few chunk plays passing, but it was the ground game that made the difference.

The Wildcats ran for 314 yards and went 99 yards in 13 plays — all rushes — to set up Brightwell's second touchdown, a 1-yard run with four minutes left.

Tate scored on an 84-yard run and finished with 129 yards on 17 carries to help overcome three turnovers.

Arizona also bounced back from shaky defensive performances its first two games, keeping Texas Tech's vaunted passing game under control most of the night.

Alan Bowman threw for 311 yards and hit McLane Mannix on an 8-yard touchdown to put the Red Raiders (2-1) up 14-13 in the third quarter.

Arizona answered on the first play of the fourth quarter, going up 20-14 on Brightwell's 1-yard TD run. The Wildcats pounded out the victory after that with their 99-yard, all-run scoring drive.

Arizona's offense was sharp the first two games, averaging 629.5 yards and 51.5 points per game.

Texas Tech has had one of the nation's most prolific offenses since the Mike Leach days and won its first two games by a combined score of 83-13.

The expected offensive showdown never really got going.

The Red Raiders and Wildcats had four turnovers in a span of five possessions in the first quarter: Two Bowman interceptions, a fumble and interception by Tate.

T.J. Vasher seemed to get Texas Tech going with a diving 39-yard catch, setting up SaRodorick Thompson's 1-yard TD run.

Darrius Smith jumpstarted Arizona by turning a screen pass into a 46-yard gain, setting the stage for Tate's 12-yard scoring pass to Stanley Berryhill III.

Tate followed with an 84-yard touchdown run, but the offenses went dormant again for the rest of the half.

Brent Brennan became the next Head Coach of Arizona Football in January of 2024. Brennan enters his first season following seven seasons leading the San José State University football program where he steered the Spartans to three bowl game appearances and earned 2020 Mountain West Coach of the Year.

Brennan, 51, is an experienced leader in college football who enjoyed two stints coaching under legendary Arizona head coach Dick Tomey, the winningest coach in program history. The San José native first learned under Tomey with the Wildcats as a graduate assistant in 2000, and again from 2005-09 at SJSU as an assistant coach. The ties between Brennan and the University of Arizona run deep, with Brent's brother Bradley playing five years as a wide out in Tucson under Tomey, and Brent's wife Courtney being an alumna of the University.

Among a multitude of accomplishments at San José State, Brennan became the first head coach in SJSU history to lead the Spartans to three bowl games in a four-year span. He also steered SJSU to back-to-back winning seasons in 2022 and 2023, marking the first time it had been accomplished by the Spartans since the 1991-92 campaigns.

Throughout Brennan's lengthy and accomplished career, he helped develop five All-Americans and 19 Professional Football players, including six who enjoyed NFL careers of five-plus seasons.

The 2023 season at San José State saw Brennan's Spartans charge down the final stretch of the season, winning six consecutive conference games to close out the regular season and earn a bowl berth. During that six-game stretch Brennan's offense averaged over 38 points per game while the defense held opponents to a meager 17.8 points per game. SJSU's offensive efforts were fueled by ball security, turning the ball over just 10 times, the best mark in the Mountain West and the ninth best in the nation. The trend was continued from the 2022 campaign in which the Spartans led the country with only six turnovers on offense and a +12 turnover margin that led the MWC.

Across time as a coach and player, Brennan has been part of nine teams that reached bowl games including in each of the last two years at San José State. The highlight of his SJSU tenure was a remarkable 7-1 campaign in 2020 that secured the Spartans their first Mountain West Conference championship and the school's first outright conference championship since topping the Big West in 1990.

Since that impressive 2020 season under Brennan's leadership, the Spartans have posted a 20-10 record against Mountain West competition and went 26-19 overall.

Brennan twice had the opportunity to learn from Dick Tomey, first as a graduate assistant at Arizona in 2000 and again as an assistant coach at San José State from 2005-09. His crossover with Tomey at SJSU included the Spartans impressive 9-4 campaign in 2006 that concluded with a victory over the University of New Mexico in the New Mexico Bowl. That 2006 season orchestrated by Tomey and Brennan still stands as one of just 14 nine-plus win seasons in SJSU history.

A former wide receiver during his playing days, Brennan has long been regarded as an exceptional offensive mind. Players recruited and coached by Brennan litter the San José State receiving record books, while his time at Oregon State from 2001-15 included the mentorship of numerous standouts highlighted by 2013 Biletnikoff Award winner Brandin Cooks.

Prior to his second stint in San José, Brennan logged six seasons coaching wide receivers at Oregon State where he and the offensive staff fielded some of the most dangerous offenses in the country. The Beavers passing attack was explosive and relentless, ranking top 20 nationally in 2011 (19th), 2012 (20th), and 2013 (3rd).

Brennan also logged time with Cal Poly (2001-04) as an assistant coach. He opened his coaching career with Woodside High School in California before securing a trio of one-year graduate assistant positions at Hawai'i (1998), Washington (1999), and Arizona (2000).

His playing career spanned five seasons at UCLA as a wide receiver, where he lettered as part of the Bruins 1993 Rose Bowl team. Brennan earned a degree in history from UCLA in 1996

Brennan and his wife Courtney are the proud parents to two daughters, Blake and Casey, and one son, Scott.

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP) - Tetairoa McMillan had a school-record 304 yards receiving and matched another with four touchdown catches - all from Noah Fifita - and No. 21 Arizona opened coach Brent Brennan's first season with a 61-39 win over New Mexico on Saturday night.

The Wildcats (1-0) put on an offensive show in their first game as a Big 12 member, with McMillan and Fifita headlining.

Arizona's stars connected on a 69-yard touchdown on the Wildcats' opening drive and kept gouging New Mexico's defense for big chunks.

McMillan averaged 30.4 yards on 10 catches and broke the Arizona single-game record of 283 yards receiving set by Jeremy McDaniel in 1996. McMillan matched Jacob Cowing's touchdown catches record set against Southern California last season and fell 10 yards short of the Big 12 record set by Baylor's Terrance Williams in 2012.

Fifita finished with 422 yards and four touchdowns on 19-of-31 passing with an interception. Quali Conley ran for 90 yards and three touchdowns to round out an Arizona offense that racked up 627 total yards.

The Lobos (0-2) opened coach Bronco Mendenhall's first season by blowing a 17-point lead in a 35-31 loss to Montana last

New Mexico's issue for the second straight week came on defense, particularly McMillan.

Arizona's first preseason AP All-American also had touchdown catches of 17 and 78 yards in the first half, then added a 40-yarder in the third quarter to help Arizona pull away after leading 27-24 at halftime.

The chemistry between Fifita and McMillan played a huge role in the high expectations for Arizona in Brennan's first season.

RECAP

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP) — Quali Conley ran for 112 yards, Noah Fifita threw for 173 yards and a touchdown and No. 20 Arizona overcame a four-point halftime deficit to beat Northern Arizona 22-10 on Saturday night for its ninth consecutive win, tying the school record for consecutive victories.

The Wildcats (2-0) extended the longest active win streak in FBS by outscoring the Lumberjacks 16-0 in the second half after trailing 10-6 at the break. The nine straight wins matches the school record set in 1974-75 and matched in 1997-98.

Conley, a transfer from San Jose State, led the way as Arizona gained 188 yards on the ground. Receiver Tetairoa McMillan, who had a school-record 304 yards and four TDs in the 61-39 season-opening win over New Mexico, was limited to two catches for 11 yards.

Northern Arizona (1-1) finished with only 198 yards of total offense, 91 after halftime. Quarterback Ty Pennington threw for 84 yards on 14 of 24 passing and added 39 on the ground.

Arizona forced a turnover on downs in Northern Arizona territory to open the second half and converted that into points as Jeremiah Patterson scored on a 17-yard touchdown pass from Fifita for a 13-10 lead with 12:06 left in the third.

The Wildcats' Chubba Ma'ae tackled running back Darvon Hubbard in the end zone for a safety with 11:33 left in the fourth, upping the lead to 15-10. And after getting the ball back, Arizona made it 22-10 on a 56-yard scoring run by Kedrick Reescano with 9:32 remaining.

Arizona only led 3-0 after the first quarter after settling for a red zone field goal on its first drive and punting the next two. Northern Arizona took a 7-3 lead with 10:24 left in the half on a trick play, with receiver Isaiah Eastman throwing a 25-yard TD pass to tight end Xander Werner.

A Fifita interception led to more points for the Lumberjacks, with Marcus Lye converting on a 38-yard field goal to make it 10-3 with 6:20 left in the first half.

The Wildcats cut Northern Arizona's lead to 10-6 with 32 seconds left in the first half on a 48-yard field goal from Tyler Loop.

UP NEXT

The Wildcats hit the road for the first time, taking on Big 12 conference foe Kansas State on Friday, September 13 in a non-conference game scheduled before Arizona joined the Big 12.

RECAP

MANHATTAN, Kan. (AP) — Avery Johnson threw two touchdown passes, Dylan Edwards returned a punt 71 yards for a score and No. 14 Kansas State beat No. 20 Arizona 31-7 on Friday night in a rare nonconference matchup of new Big 12 rivals.

The loss ended Arizona's nine-game winning streak, the longest active streak in the Football Bowl Subdivision.

Johnson had 156 yards passing and 110 yards rushing, and D.J. Giddens added 86 yards rushing and a score, as Kansas State (3-0) rebounded from a lackluster road with over Tulane with an emphatic victory over the desert Wildcats.

Noah Fifita had 268 yards passing for Arizona (2-1) with an interception. Tetairoa McMillan had 11 catches for 138 yards, but the potential first-round NFL draft pick was unable to turn any of those grabs into a big play or touchdown.

The schools agreed to the matchup before Arizona left the Pac-12 for the Big 12. And with neither having enough time to find a replacement opponent, Kansas State and Arizona kept the game but without it counting in the conference standings.

The teams traded grinding, time-consuming touchdown drives to start the game, but otherwise the first 30 minutes was plagued by penalties, mental mistakes and dumbfounding miscues from two teams trying to make a statement.

Arizona failed to cover a poor punt that Edwards returned untouched for a touchdown. On the next drive, Fifita lazily threw over the middle into double coverage and was picked off by Kansas State's Keenan Garber in the end zone.

Johnson made perhaps the most embarrassing gaffe. He was sacked at the Arizona 19 with 24 seconds left in the first half. On the next play, the freshman needed only to step out of bounds to stop the clock and bring on the field-goal team, but he instead reversed field and ran the other way, allowing the clock to expire without the chance for an attempt.

Kansas State still led 14-7 at the half, and the mistake didn't matter in the end.

The fleet-footed Johnson began to sling it in the second half, leading his team on back-to-back TD drives. The first featured a 48-yard pass to Jayce Brown on third-and-12, setting up Johnson's scoring toss to Brayden Loftin. The next included a 21-yard throw to Loftin before Giddens plowed into the end zone to give Kansas State a 28-7 lead.

Kansas State stuffed Arizona on fourth down a few minutes later, and merely had to run out the clock in the fourth quarter.

Arizona might have fared better had it not repeatedly hurt itself with flags. It committed 30 yards worth of penalties on a single drive in the first half, and finished with nine penalties for 74 yards in the game.

Kansas State's defense had something to prove after allowing Tulane to throw for 342 yards and pile up 491 in last week's 34-27 comeback win. The Wildcats held Arizona to 324 yards of total offense.

RECAP

SALT LAKE CITY (AP) — Noah Fifita threw for 197 yards and two touchdowns and Arizona's defense stopped No. 10 Utah four times on fourth down to help the Wildcats beat the Utes 23-10 on Saturday night.

Arizona (3-1, 1-0 Big 12) turned in a stellar defensive performance with two interceptions, eight pass breakups and seven tackles for loss.

Utah (4-1, 1-1 Big 12) played without QB Cam Rising again. Freshman Isaac Wilson moved the ball but couldn't convert in the red zone and threw a pair of interceptions.

Fifita hit Tetairoa McMillan for a 41-yard pass on third-and-11 and then threw a 35-yard touchdown to Keyan Burnett on another third-and-11 to make it 23-10 with 8:13 to play.

Tao Johnson intercepted Fifita in the end zone on the first play of the fourth quarter before Wilson drove the field and found Caleb Lohner for a 20-yard TD reception to cut the lead to 16-10 with 11:54 to play. But the Wildcat defense held strong .

In the third quarter after Tyler Loop's 53-yard field goal, Wilson was intercepted by Genesis Smith on the next play. Loop's ensuing 33-yard field goal gave the Wildcats a 16-3 lead.

Fifita used quick passes to avoid Utah's pass rush and capped a seven-play, 75-yard drive with a 3-yard TD pass to Jeremiah Patterson to give Arizona a 10-3 lead at halftime.

Fifita completed all seven passes on the Wildcats opening drive but it was Kedrick Reescano's 23-yard run that set up Loop's 47-yard field goal.

The Wildcats stopped the Utes first two possessions on downs - both inside the Arizona 10-yard-line on fourth-and-2.

Utah fans and the team waited to see if Rising would be able to play after hurting his throwing hand on Sept. 7. Again, it was a game-time decision, but Wilson was the one who ran out with the offense. Rising, a seventh-year senior, has only played four total quarters this season after missing all of last season.

Arizona now has a 6-31-1 road record against AP Top 10 teams.
