

## **SEASON NOTES**



▲ Texas Tech debuted a new footwear, uniform, apparel and accessory partner in 2024 after signing a 10-year agreement with adidas. The collaboration comes as part of adidas' evolving work with brand partner and Texas Tech alumnus Patrick Mahomes II.

### WELCOME TO THE THREE STRIPE LIFE

- Texas Tech had a new footwear, uniform, apparel and accessory partner beginning with the 2024 season after signing a 10-year agreement with adidas. The collaboration comes as part of adidas' evolving work with brand partner and Texas Tech alumnus Patrick Mahomes II, who will be the first adidas athlete to have his logo featured on official collegiate apparel. Texas Tech and adidas have already launched co-branded apparel featuring Mahomes' signature Gladiator logo.
- On a busy day in college athletics, the Texas Tech and adidas announcement reached 17 million users across social media platforms as part of a large-scale unveiling that incorporated "ripping the tape" off the partnership, a reference to the shirt Mahomes infamously wore at the 2019 Men's Final Four.
- As part of the partnership, all eligible student-athletes at Texas Tech will have the opportunity to join the brand's historic NIL Ambassador Network, which gives all student-athletes at adidas-partnered Division 1 schools the chance to benefit from their Name, Image and Likeness. Since its inception, over 12,000 student-athletes nationwide across a variety of sports have participated in the network, earning a percentage of the sales they drive for key products and campaigns.
- adidas and Patrick Mahomes unveiled a new Texas Tech football uniform that features Mahomes' signature "Gladiator" logo — one of the first times in history that an athlete's personal brand has been included in official on-field apparel. The Red Raiders utilized the Mahomes Strategy uniform at home against Colorado.

### FAN EXCITEMENT AT AN ALL-TIME HIGH

- Texas Tech sold out of season tickets for the second consecutive season in early May as Red Raider fans purchased more than 32,000 season passes for the 2024 campaign. Texas Tech also sold out of its entire premium seating inventory in all areas of Jones AT&T Stadium, including the new south end zone addition.
- Over his three seasons as head coach, Texas Tech has added more than 13,000 season tickets since McGuire's hiring in November 2021. Texas Tech previously sold 28,000 season tickets for McGuire's debut season in 2022, which, like this year's total, ranks among the top-10 highest season ticket counts in program history.
- Texas Tech had a capacity crowd of 60,229 fans on hand four times this season with sellouts against Abilene Christian, Cincinnati, Baylor and Colorado.

the Big 12 Conference behind only BYU. It ranked as the second-highest singleseason average in school history, slightly trailing the 2014 average of 58,934 over six games.

### SOUTH END ZONE OFFICIALLY OPEN

- Texas Tech officially opened the South End Zone and Dustin R. Womble Football Center project in 2024, featuring more than 340,000 combined square feet of space with a blend of world-class modern design and technology elements with Spanish Renaissance architecture well known to Texas Tech supporters. The \$242 million project marks the largest contiguous football facility in the country, connecting the south end zone building to the Womble Football Center and the Sports Performance Center, which opened in 2017 as Texas Tech's indoor football practice facility and indoor track and field venue.
- The opening of the South End Zone Building to Jones AT⊕T Stadium officially closed The Campaign for Fearless Champions, one of the most-successful fundraising initiatives in university history that raised more than \$500 million to transform Texas Tech's athletic facilities across every sport, while also pouring resources into the student-athlete experience through scholarship endowments and the creation of the J.T. and Margaret Talkington Office of Student-Athlete Development.

## **600-WIN MILESTONE**

■ The Red Raiders secured their 600th all-time win against Arizona State on Sept. 21. Texas Tech finished its 2024 campaign, its 100th year of football, with 605-485-32. Among power conference schools founded since 1900, it is the third-most wins nationally, trailing only Miami (661) and UCLA (631).

#### WHERE THE REGULAR SEASON RANKED...

- Texas Tech secured its third season with six or more Big 12 victories with its win over West Virginia in the regular-season finale, marking the third-consecutive season under Joey McGuire that the Red Raiders have won five or more conference games. In its history, Texas Tech had won five or more league games over three consecutive seasons only once previously, from 1995-97, when the Red Raiders were transitioning from the Southwest Conference to the Big 12.
- The victory over the Mountaineers placed the Red Raiders in a special category as only the third team to win six Big 12 wins since Texas Tech joined the Big 12 in 1996. The Red Raiders were 6-2 in league play in 2005 and then 7-1 in 2008, with both seasons resulting in trips to the Cotton Bowl.
- Texas Tech's win over West Virginia also punched its first eight-win regular season since 2009. A victory over Arkansas in the bowl game would also mark Texas Tech's first nine-win season since that same 2009 campaign.
- Texas Tech's win at Oklahoma State a week earlier solidified a 3-2 road record this season, with all three wins coming in Big 12 play, The Red Raiders had not won three or more true road games in a season previously since 2008.

## SEASON NOTES

## BROOKS SNAPS HANSPARD'S CAREER RECORD

- Tahj Brooks became Texas Tech's all-time career rushing leader against Colorado with a 25-yard run to start the Red Raiders' fourth-quarter drive against Colorado. The rush attempt pushed him past Byron Hanspard's previous career record of 4,219 yards, which was set during his 1996 Doak Walker Award season. Brooks closed his Red Raider career with 4,557 rushing yards as he announced he will not participate in the AutoZone Liberty Bowl.
- Brooks combined for 321 rushing yards and six touchdowns over Texas Tech's final two games against Oklahoma State and West Virginia en route to moving into fourth place all-time in the Big 12 record book. The only three Big 12 running backs with more career rushing yards than Brooks are Cedric Benson (Texas), Ricky Williams (Texas) and Darren Sproles (K-State).
- Brooks rushed for at least 100 yards in 23 different games during his career, which snapped the Texas Tech all-time record of 21 that was previously set by Byron Hanspard. Brooks ended his career ranked fourth for career 100-yard games in the Big 12 record book, trailing only Ricky Williams (Texas) with 25 as well, as Cedric Benson (Texas) and Darren Sproles (K-State), who both had 24 during their respective tenures.
- Brooks' 11 different 100-yard games, in 11 games played in 2024, snapped the Texas Tech single-season record of 10 that was previously set by both Byron Hanspard (1996) and Byron Morris (1993). Brooks entered bowl season as one of only two FBS players to have rushed for at least 100 yards in every game in 2024 (min. 7 games), joining Boise State's Ashton Jeanty.
- Brooks registered 19 different 100-yard games over his last 22 outings dating back to the 2023 season. In the three games he did not eclipse 100 yards during that span, he recorded at least 95 yards in each contest, which is the longest streak for an FBS player since 1996.
- Brooks ended 2024 as the only Red Raider all-time and only the third player in Big 12 history to rush for 1,500 yards twice in a career, joining the likes of Kendall Hunter of Oklahoma State (2008, 2010) and Ricky Williams of Texas (1997-98). Brooks is the fifth Red Raider in program history with consecutive 1,000-yard seasons, joining the likes of James Hadnot (1978-79), Byron "Bam" Morris (1992-93), Byron Hanspard (1995-96) and DeAndre Washington (2015-16).
- Brooks was a semifinalist for the Earl Campbell and Doak Walker Awards as well as a finalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy presented by the National Fnotball Foundation.

### THE 1,500, 1,000-YARD CLUB

- For the first time in its history, Texas Tech boasted both a 1,500-yard rusher and a 1,000-yard receiver behind running back Tahj Brooks and wide receiver Josh Kelly in 2024. Both went over their respective marks in the regular-season finale against West Virginia, with Brooks rushing 23 times for a career-high 188 yards, while Kelly finished with nine receptions for 150 yards.
- Texas Tech was joined by Arizona State as the only two schools in the country with a 1,500-yard rusher and a 1,000-yard receiver entering bowl season.



▲ After rushing for 1,538 yards in 2023, the fourth-most in the FBS, **TAHJ BROOKS** ranked third in the FBS in 2024 in rushing yards per game (136.8) en route to setting the Texas Tech program record for career rushing yards. After 1,505 rushing yards in 11 games in 2024, Brooks finished with 4,557 career rushing yards.

### 3,000/1,000/1,000

- Texas Tech had its second season in program history with a 3,000-yard passer (Behren Morton-3,335), a 1,000-yard rusher (Tah) Brooks-1,505) and a 1,000-yard receiver (Josh Kelly-1,023). It was the first occurrence since the 2015 season when it was first accomplished by Patrick Mahomes II (4,653 passing), DeAndre Washington (1,492 rushing) and Jakeem Grant (1,269 receiving).
- More offense: Texas Tech topped 6,000 yards of total offense for the first time since the 2017 season (6,170), having posted 6,015 total yards in 2024.
- The Red Raiders manufactured 37.6 points per game in 2024, the most since 2016 when Patrick Mahomes II guided Tech to an average of 43.7 points per game.

### **BROOKS, RODRIGUEZ HEADLINE ALL-BIG 12 AWARDS**

■ The Texas Tech football team had five players named to the first and second All-Big 12 teams on Dec. 7, as announced by the league office. All Big 12 postseason awards are based on votes of the conference's 16 head coaches, who are not permitted to vote for their own players. Eight Red Raiders overall were honored as three more were given honorable mention nods.

### MORTON OPTS IN

- Texas Tech junior quarterback Behren Morton announced he would miss the AutoZone Liberty Bowl in preparation for his senior season in 2025 after undergoing shoulder surgery on Dec. 10 in Los Angeles. True freshman quarterback Will Hammond was slotted to make his first career start in Morton's place for the Red Raiders' AutoZone Liberty Bowl contest on Dec. 27.
- The elective surgery was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, a leading orthopedic surgeon specializing in shoulder injuries. Dr. ElAttrache, who was recommended by Texas Tech medical director and orthopedic surgeon Dr. Kevin Crawford and its sports medicine staff, is also the head team physician for the Los Angeles Dodgers and Los Angeles Rams and has significant experience with professional athletes across the NFL and Major League Baseball.
- "After hearing from several leading NFL medical experts, my family and I felt it was best to get this procedure done now so that I can fully rehab this spring and be ready for the start of summer workouts," Morton said. "As I've said all year, this injury did not impact me at all this past season. I elected to undergo this surgery now for my long-term success, which will allow me to invest more time in offseason strength and conditioning and my development as a quarterback. I love this team and will be there every step of the way as a captain and leader entering the howl name."
- Morton's 3,335 passing yards over 12 games in 2024 were the most by a Red Raider since Nic Shimonek's 3,963 in 2017. Morton's 277.9 yards per game ranked 8th-best in the FBS. He was the first Red Raider quarterback to start all 12 games in the regular season since Patrick Mahomes II in 2016.

## **2025 TEAM CAPTAINS**

- In what was a unique move, Joey McGuire announced back in January of 2024 the naming of five team captains for the following season. The five who were appointed to that role were senior running back Tahj Brooks, senior offensive lineman Caleb Rogers, junior quarterback Behren Morton, junior linebacker Jacob Rodriguez and senior linebacker Bryce Ramirez. The five captains, all previous members of McGuire's leadership committee during the 2023 season, were tasked with identifying and developing new leaders for the football program throughout spring practices as well as enhancing Texas Tech's player-led culture. This was the first time during McGuire's tenure that he had named set captains that early, as he previously relied on a leadership committee of upperclassmen from each position group. Furthermore, the five wore the letter "C" on their respective jerseys, also a first under McGuire.
- The custom of selecting game day captains continued during the season, those selected to serve that role, in addition to the five afforementioned individuals included: C.J. Baskerville, Ty Buchanan, De'Braylon Carroll, Davion Carter, Jalin Conyers, Coy Eakin, Charles Esters III, Gino Garcia, Josh Kelly, Jackson Knotts, Quincy Ledet Jr., Bralyn Lux, Drae McCray, Johncarlos Miller II, Joseph Plunk, Ben Roberts, Issae Smith and Mason Tharo.

- The Red Raiders allowed Washington State quarterback John Mateer to rush for 197 yards. The last time Texas Tech allowed a quarterback to rush for more than 100 yards was TCU's Max Duggan, 184 yards, in 2020, on the road.
- Texas Tech is the first Big 12 team to visit Pullman since Colorado traveled to Washington State in 2004. The Buffs won 20-12.
- The Red Raider defense held Mateer to 115 passing yards and one touchdown, and forced an INT, after he passed for 352 yards, five touchdowns and zero interceptions last week versus Portland State.
- It marked the first time Texas Tech traveled to Pullman after playing the first two games in the series versus the Cougars in Lubbock (1963-64).
- Behren Morton surpassed 3,500 career yards in the game; he entered the game needing 248 yards to reach the milestone.
- Wide receiver Coy Eakin delivered a 20-yard touchdown pass to tight end Johncarlos Miller II late in the second quarter. He was the first wide receiver to throw a touchdown pass since Jakeem Grant's 72-yard connection with Reginald Davis versus Arkansas in 2015.
- Josh Kelly finished with a team-high nine receptions for 95 yards, giving him 19 receptions and 251 receiving yards over his first two career games as a Red Raider.
- Jacob Rodriguez shared the team lead in tackles with seven alongside Ben Roberts on Saturday. Rodriguez has led Texas Tech in tackles in each of the first two games.
- Chapman Lewis recorded his first career interception in the first quarter. It gave Tech the ball at its own 7-yard line with 14:43 left in the first quarter.

- The win marked the 600th all-time victory for Texas Tech, which is now in its 100th season of football on campus. Among power conference schools founded after 1900, it ranked as the third-most wins nationally at the time, trailing only Miami (657) and UCLA (631).
- The win marked Texas Tech starting 1-0 in Big 12 play two of the first three seasons with Joey McGuire at the helm.
- With the win, Joey McGuire improved to 18-12 overall, the best record for a Texas Tech head coach through 30 games since Steve Sloan, who was 21-9 at the same point in his tenure over the 1975-77 seasons.
- Led by Tahj Brooks, the Red Raiders rushed for 133 yards as a team. Arizona State entered the game allowing only 65.3 rushing yards per game.
- Brooks moved to No. 5 all-time in career rushing yards (3,431) in program history. He surpassed DeAndre Washington (3,411).
- Jalin Conyers scored his second career rushing touchdown out of the wildcat formation in the third quarter, giving Tech a 24-10 lead (8:14). It was his first career rushing touchdown since 2023 while a member of the Arizona State football team, scoring against Arizona.
- After setting a career-high with 10 receptions versus Abilene Christian, Josh Kelly matched that record on Saturday with his second 10-reception game in his fourth game this season.
- Ben Roberts led Texas Tech with 11 tackles in the win. He had eight tackles at halftime.

- Texas Tech fell behind 14-3 in the first quarter before coming back to win. The game was tied 24-24 after Cincinnati missed a 42-yarder to close the half. It marked the Red Raiders' 27th double-digit come-from-behind win since 2000, and improved the 2024 Red Raiders to 2-0 in Big 12 play.
- The game marked the first matchup against the Bearcats since Sept. 21, 1968, and was the first Big 12 game between the two programs since UC joined the league in the summer of 2023.
- A.J. McCarty returned an interception 51 yards for a touchdown, marking the second pick-six of the season for the Red Raiders, joining the Bralyn Lux pick-six versus North Texas. It was the second pick-six of Lux's career, as he previously picked off former Red Raider quarterback Tyler Shough for a touchdown while with Baylor in 2022. - The win marked Texas Tech's fourth consecutive victory, and the Red Raiders' second four-game winning streak under Joey McGuire; the team finished the 2022 season with four straight wins.
- The victory improved the Red Raiders to 3-0 in Big 12 play for the first time since 2013.
- Texas Tech improved to a 27-5-2 all-time record against Arizona. It was the first matchup against the Wildcats since Sept. 14, 2019, but the first conference matchup between the two programs since Nov. 7, 1959, when Texas Tech and Arizona were both members of the Border Conference.
- The Red Raiders are off to their first 5-1 start since the 2013 season.
- Texas Tech's red zone defense held Arizona to 13 points on four trips. The Wildcats kicked two field goals and turned the ball over on downs while allowing one touchdown.
- Texas Tech flipped three Arizona turnovers into 18 points. They turned two turnovers in the first half into 11 points, turning its first interception into a touchdown (and a 2-point conversion) and the next into a field goal as time expired in the first half. Texas Tech converted its fumble recovery in the fourth quarter to seven more points.
- Behren Morton continues to take care of the football with his fourth straight zero-interception game. Tech is 4-0 in those games. He's had 134 consecutive attempts without an interception through Saturday's game at Arizona.
- Tahi Brooks had three rushing touchdowns, matching a career-high.

- The loss snapped Texas Tech's four-game winning streak, dating back to the Red Raiders' Sept. 7, 2024, loss at Washington State.
- The game marked the third sellout crowd this season, as well as back-to-back home sellouts.
- The 24-point loss (59-35) was the most lopsided loss at home suffered by Texas Tech since falling to Baylor by 28 points (45-17) in the Bears' last visit to Jones AT&T Stadium on Oct. 29, 2022.
- Tech dropped to 8-2 in Behren Morton's career in games he started and finished at Jones AT&T Stadium. Both losses are against Baylor, dating back to his third career start while a redshirt freshman.
- Jalin Conyers tossed a 20-yard touchdown pass; it marked the first career TD throw as a college player for the former high school gunslinger.
- Drae McCray surpassed 1,000 career kick return yards at Texas Tech in just his second season; finished with four returns for 30 yards, totaling 1,026, becoming the seventh player in program history to accumulate 1,000 or more kick return yards.

- Texas Tech lost consecutive games for the first time in 2024, marking the Red Raiders' first string of back-to-back losses since falling to both Kansas State and BYU midway through the 2023 season. Despite the loss, the Red Raiders' 5-3 start after eight games remained their best start over the last 10 years.
- It was the Red Raiders' third-straight loss to TCU in games played in Fort Worth ('20, '22, '24). It narrowed the Red Raiders' all-time series advantage against TCU to 33-31-3 after the 67th meeting in the series.
- Tech lost its first game under Joey McGuire when forcing three or more takeaways. The Red Raiders were previously 6-0 in those games.
- Texas Tech was in its fifth one-possession game versus TCU, after only eight games in 2024. Previously undefeated, the Red Raiders dropped to 4-1 in one-possession games in 2024, while McGuire dropped to 11-4 in his career in one-possession games.
- The Texas Tech defense allowed two of its three most explosive plays through its first eight games. It surrendered a 75-yard strike in the first quarter, matching the longest play allowed in 2024 (75-yd play to UNT), followed by a fourth-quarter 84-yard pass that put the Horned Frogs in front (35-34), setting a new high.
- True freshman quarterback Will Hammond saw the first significant action of his career playing the entirety of the second half due to an injury to starter Behren Morton at the close of the first half. Hammond led the offense to points on his first three drives the third being a field goal.

- Texas Tech secured its first win against a top-10 team on the road since 2011, dating back to shocking No. 1 Oklahoma on Oct. 22, 2011. Furthermore, it was the first win, at home or on the road, against an opponent ranked in the Top 10 since defeating No. 4 West Virginia in Lubbock on Oct. 13, 2012.
- By earning its sixth win, Texas Tech clinched its fourth-consecutive bowl appearance and the 42nd bowl appearance in program history.
- The Cyclones have provided bowl eligibility (Tech earning its sixth win) twice in the last three years under Joey McGuire ('22, '24), and bowl eligibility three times over the last four seasons overall dating back to 2021 when Jonathan Garibay connected on a dramatic 62-yard game-winning field goal to lift the Red Raiders past lowa State for its sixth win at Jones AT&T Stadium that year.
- Texas Tech snapped Iowa State's 25-game winning streak when owning a lead at halftime.
- Texas Tech was in its sixth one-possession game on Saturday after only nine games this season. The Red Raiders improved to 5-1 in one-possession games this season while McGuire improved to 12-4 in his career in those games.
- Texas Tech passed for 237 yards against an lowa State defense entering the game, allowing 133.7 passing yards per game the second-lowest average in the FBS.
- Tahj Brooks eclipsed 4,000 career rushing yards during the lowa State contest. He became one of three Texas Tech running backs in school history to reach the 4,000-yard career milestone, joining Byron Hanspard (4,219) and James Gray (4,066).
- Jacob Rodriguez recorded a career-high 2.0 sacks and a career-high 2.5 tackles for a loss while leading the Red Raiders with 13 tackles to match a career-high. It was his fifth double-digit tackle performance in 2024.

- Texas Tech debuted its "Mahomes Strategy uniform" in the contest versus Colorado, which was a metallic gray helmet, jersey and pants with power red accents. adidas and Patrick Mahomes unveiled the new Texas Tech football uniform that also featured Mahomes' signature "Gladiator" logo one of the first times in history that an athlete's personal brand has been included in official on-field apparel.
- Texas Tech's loss represented just the fifth loss at Jones AT&T Stadium in the Joey McGuire era (14-5) and the first time in his career suffering back-to-back home losses (lost to Baylor, Oct. 19).
- Texas Tech trailed the turnover margin with three giveaways versus zero takeaways.
- Tahj Brooks surpassed Byron Hanspard (1994-96) as Texas Tech's all-time leading rusher; with 137 rushing yards versus the Buffs, Brooks moved past Hanspard's 4,219 career yards, upping his total to 4,236 career rushing yards.
- Josh Kelly finished with eight receptions and 106 yards; he surpassed 3,000 career receiving yards in the contest.
- Jacob Rodriguez set a new career-high for tackles with 17. His 17-tackle performance was the first 15-plus tackle game by a Red Raider since 2022, when Krishon Merriweather's 17 versus Oklahoma State.
- It was the first meeting against Colorado since Oct. 23, 2010, a 27-24 win for the Red Raiders in Boulder, which marked the Buffaloes' final season of their first stint as Big 12 Conference members.

- Texas Tech scored its most points (56) in a Big 12 road game since defeating Kansas, 65-19, on Oct. 7, 2017.
- The win tied the all-time series with Oklahoma State, 24-24-3, after its 51st all-time meeting.
- The win was just the Red Raiders' third in Stillwater since the turn of the century (with wins coming in 2001, 2018 and 2024).
- Texas Tech finished with 543 yards of total offense. It was its highest total versus a Big 12 team through 11 games and the second 500-yard game overall dating back to the Red Raiders' 586 yards total offense versus North Texas.
- The Red Raiders forced multiple turnovers in a game for the sixth time this season and the fifth time in the last seven games.
- Behren Morton finished with a career-high 404 passing yards his first 400-yard game and the first 400-yard game by a Red Raider since Tyler Shough's 436 yards in 2022 versus Oklahoma.
- Tahj Brooks set the school record for most career 100-yard games with his 22nd 100-yard game; he surpassed Byron Hanspard's school record of 21 held since 1996.

- Texas Tech earned its eighth win, marking the Red Raiders' first eight-win regular season since 2009.
- Texas Tech earned its sixth Big 12 win, marking the third time in program history that Tech earned six Big 12 wins in a season (2005, 2008, 2024).
- Texas Tech finished with a winning Big 12 record for the third-straight season. Before Joey McGuire arrived in 2022, the Red Raiders' last season with a Big 12 record above .500 was in 2009.
- Texas Tech eclipsed 50 points for the second-straight game. The last time the Red Raiders scored 50 or more in back-to-back Big 12 games was in 2003 (Oct. 4, Texas A&M; W, 59-28/Oct. 11, lowa State; W, 52-21).
- Tahj Brooks eclipsed 1,500 rushing yards on the season in the win, while Josh Kelly topped 1,000 receiving yards. It marked the first time in program history that a Tech running back surpassed 1,500 rushing yards and a wide receiver surpassed 1,000 receiving yards in the same season.
- Tahj Brooks set a single-game career-high for rushing yards with 188 in what would be his final game as a Red Raider. He extended his streak of 95 rushing yards or better to 22 straight games. It's the most consecutive games with at least 95 rushing yards by any FBS player dating back to 1996.
- Tahj Brooks eclipsed 5,000 career all-purpose yards, finishing with a single-game career-high 233 all-purpose yards.

- The Red Raiders' loss marked their first in a bowl game to an unranked opponent since falling to lowa, 19-16, in the 2001 Alamo Bowl. It was also the first bowl game loss suffered by Joey McGuire after victories in bowl games in 2022 and 2023.
- Despite the loss, Texas Tech finished the season with eight wins, its second eight-win season under Joey McGuire in three years, and the 28th eight-win season all-time in school history.
- As senior Tahj Brooks opted out of the bowl game in preparation for the NFL Draft, the true freshmen running back tandem of Cameron Dickey (74) and J'Koby Williams (123) helped the Red Raiders rush for 217 yards against Arkansas. The 217 team rushing yards marked the third-most accumulated by the Red Raiders in 2024 and was the fourth time to eclipse 200 yards rushing in a game.
- Will Hammond was the eighth true freshman in school history to start at quarterback and the second to do so in a bowl game, joining Davis Webb, who was the Offensive MVP of the 2013 Holiday Bowl victory over Arizona State.
- The defense allowed the longest explosive rushing play (70 yards) and the longest explosive pass play (94 yards), both in the first quarter, of the 2024 season, as Arkansas built a 21-3 lead after the first quarter.
