The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff had two studentathletes selected to the 2025 SWAC Preseason All-Conference Team, showcasing both offensive firepower and special teams excellence.

BJ Curry (RB) – A versatile playmaker from Magnolia, Arkansas, Curry brings consistency and explosiveness to the Golden Lions' ground attack.

Trey Glymph (K) – A reliable leg out of Alpharetta, Georgia, Glymph adds stability to UAPB's kicking game and provides a key scoring weapon in tight contests.

Winning in the Classroom

The Golden Lions continue to excel academically, making just as much noise in the classroom as on the field.

Highest Team GPA in School History: Football recorded a 3.21 GPA in the 2024–25 academic year, the highest ever for the program.

Sustained Excellence: This marks five consecutive semesters where the team has finished with a 3.0 GPA or higher. UAPB football remains a leader in balancing academics and athletics, with multiple players earning SWAC All-Academic

honors.

Recruiting Footprint

UAPB Football continues to pull from a broad recruiting base, building a diverse roster that represents multiple regions across the country.

Total States/Countries Represented: 19 (including one international player from Cameroon and one from Canada – Saskatchewan).

Top Pipeline States:

Arkansas – 27 players Louisiana – 10 players Mississippi – 9 players Texas – 8 players New Jersey – 8 players Tennessee – 6 players California – 6 players

Additional Representation:

Ohio (3), Florida (3), North Carolina (2), Georgia (2), Wisconsin (2), New York, Arizona, Oklahoma, Missouri, Alabama, Colorado, Saskatchewan (Canada), and Yaoundé, Cameroon.

Season Openers

Since 2010, UAPB is 6-9 in season-opening games. The Golden Lions picked up season-opening victories at Langston (2012), against Morehouse (2017, 2018), at Southern (2020), and against Lane (2021, 2022). This marks the third consecutive season the team has opened the year on the road. In 2023, the team played at Tulsa. A season ago, the Golden Lions opened the 2024 campaign at Arkansas.

Another Top-Tier Opponent

This marks the first-ever meeting between Texas Tech and UAPB. However, it's not the first time the program has squared off against a Power 4 program for a season opener. In addition to opening up last year at Arkansas, the Golden Lions began the 2019 campaign at TCU.

Productivity Returns

The Golden Lions return an abundance of talent on both sides of the ball and special teams from a season ago. Offensively, BJ Curry headlines the backfield. The leading rusher in 2024 gained 509 yards and scored four times while averaging 4.1 yards per carry. Za'Marion Webber's 334 total yards were second on the team in 2024. He accounted for 5.1 yards per carry and found the endzone once. Kristian Gammage is the team's leading receiver. Last year, he hauled in 16 passes for 223 yards and a score.

Defensively, Quintin Sterling headlines the team. He had 70 total tackles, which was second on the team. Additionally, Sterling had six pass break-ups. Ja'marlin Green returns to a solid defense. He was third on the squad with 53 total tackles. Sophomore Amyrion Mingo had a team-high three interceptions in 2024.

Special teams standout Trey Glymph converted seven field goals and scored a team-best 55 points. Glymph nailed all 34 extrapoint attempts.

Playing Openers In Texas

Since 2010, the Golden Lions have opened the football season in Texas a handful of times. The team started the 2010 campaign at UTEP. The squad played at Texas State in the opener in 2014 and 2016. UAPB last opened a season in Texas when it played at TCU in 2019. The Golden Lions are still looking for their first win in a season-opening game played in Texas since before the 2010 season.

Preseason Rankings

Arkansas-Pine Bluff was picked to finish sixth in the SWAC West, which was announced July 16 at SWAC Football Media Day. The Golden Lions secured 28 total points in the poll. The squad recorded one first-place nod.

SWAC Against The Power 4

This year, four SWAC institutions compete at Power 4 programs. In addition to UAPB's season-opener at Texas Tech, Alabama A&M, Grambling and Texas Southern all have games against Power 4 schools. Alabama A&M plays at Arkansas (Aug. 30) while Grambling plays at The Ohio State (Sept. 6) and Texas Southern plays at California (Sept. 6).

About the SWAC

The Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) is considered one of the premier HBCU conferences in the country and currently ranks among the elite in the nation in terms of HBCU alumni playing with professional sports teams.

Current championship competition offered by the league includes competition for men in Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, Football, Golf, Indoor Track and Field, Outdoor Track and Field, and Tennis.

Women's competition is offered in the sports of Basketball, Bowling, Cross Country, Golf, Indoor Track and Field, Outdoor Track and Field, Soccer, Softball, Tennis, and Volleyball.

Dr. Anthony Graham Chancellor



Before coming to UAPB, Graham was a tenured professor of education and former provost and vice chancellor for academic affairs at Winston-Salem State University in North Carolina. He also served as interim chancellor at the institution from 2023-24. He was previously a

tenured full professor and dean of the College of Education at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University.

He attended the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where he earned a bachelor's degree

in English with a minor in mathematics in 1997. He obtained a master's degree in Secondary English Education in 1999 and a doctorate in curriculum and teaching with a cognate in multicultural education in 2003 from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro.

Prior to his work in higher education, Dr. Graham was a high school English teacher. He has served as the managing editor of the historic peer-review academic journal The Negro Educational Review, and has collaborated with educators and scholars to create initiatives that increase the number of classroom teachers, especially ethnic and racial minority teachers, who enter the teaching profession in under-resourced and hard-to-staff rural and urban schools.



Vice Chancellor For Intercollegiate Athletics



One of the all-time greats in Golden Lion football history, Chris Robinson was named UAPB's Vice Chancellor for Intercollegiate Athletics in June 2021 after serving as the Executive Senior Associate Athletic Director.

Robinson moves over to athletics from the Office of

Recruitment, where he had spent the previous eight years in serving the university.

Multiple stints at UAPB is a common theme for Robinson, who came to Pine Bluff after a standout career at Mattie T. Blount High in Pritchard, Ala. After playing for the legendary Archie "The Gunslinger" Cooley at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, Robinson transferred to Southern University, playing quarterback for one season under College Football Hall of Fame Coach Marino Casem.

As the Golden Lion football program returned to play in 1993, Robinson returned and led the revival of the program under UAPB alum and the coach with the most wins in school history, Coach Lee Hardman. UAPB went 6-5 before forfeiting a game in '93 before Robinson led the Golden Lions to the 1994 NAIA National Championship Game, highlighted by a seventouchdown (six passing / one rushing) performance in a come-from-behind overtime semifinal win.

After one year away from playing working in management, Robinson returned to the sidelines at Mid-American Nazarene University. He coached quarterbacks and running backs while also serving as assistant softball coach, and as the school's Director of Minority Affairs.

Robinson then returned to UAPB, teaching marketing while also coaching the offensive skill players and special teams, football operations and was the program's NFL liaison. He then returned to the corporate sector for a decade before returning to The Pride in 2012.

A 2014 UAPB Sports Hall of Fame inductee, Robinson earned his bachelor's degree in management from UAPB, and a Master's degree in business administration from Mid-America Nazarene University.

In Robinson's first year as Vice Chancellor and Director of Athletics, the Golden Lions football program captured their first Western Division title since 2012 and advanced to the spring 2021 SWAC Championship.

In July of 2022, Robinson was named to the FCS ADA Executive Committee. He currently serves on the Executive Board for the Jefferson County Habitat for Humanity and the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame.

The Golden Lions have since gone to the SWAC Championship Game with the women's basketball team for the first time in school history while the UAPB Men's Golf Team secured the SWAC Golf Title in 2023.

Robinson's administration made a monumental announcement in January and formally launched several campaign and renovation projects. The campaign will impact several key facilities throughout the athletics department, including the groundbreaking of the Track and Soccer Complex, renovation of the Thomas May Fieldhouse Fuel Station, football locker room, and UAPB Softball Complex.

Robinson married two-time All American track runner and Golden Lion Alum Kim George and the couple has two sons – Christopher (UAPB Graduate), Kylan (UAPB Graduate), and one daughter, a freshman in high school, Kaylen (The BOSS).

Head Coach



coaching stops, having been with the Golden Lions from 2006 to 2010.

A name highly recognized throughout Arkansas and across the nation in college football, Hampton comes to UAPB after serving as the Assistant Head Coach and Special Teams Coordinator under Terry Bowden at the University of Louisiana Monroe (ULM).

Hampton, a four-year letterman as a defensive back at ULM (1993-96), returned to his alma mater to serve as assistant head coach on Bowden's staff. After working with the safeties in 2021, he assumed the responsibilities as special teams coordinator.

In his second year as UAPB head coach, Hampton offense was ranked in the top-5 in the SWAC Conference and had three student-athletes named SWAC All-Conference: Jaden Kelly, Javonnie Gibson, and Christon Love. Gibson led the conference in receiving and was named SWAC First Team All-Conference and FCS All-American. Love and Kelly were named to the SWAC All-Conference Second Team.

In his first year with UAPB, Hampton's linebacker unit was one of the best in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC), led by Rico Dozier, who topped the conference in tackles and earned First-Team All-Conference honors.

At ULM in 2022, Hampton's special teams unit (punting) ranked 29th in the NCAA FBS and second in the Sun Belt Conference, averaging 43.9 yards per punt (Devyn McCormick). In 2021, three of his safeties ranked among ULM's Top 10 in tackles, including Jabari Johnson, who recorded 58 tackles.

Hampton worked as a defensive analyst for Chad Morris at Arkansas in 2019 and as special teams coordinator under Willie Taggart at Florida State in 2018. That year, FSU's D.J. Matthews ranked sixth nationally in punt return average (13.5 yards) and recorded a 74-yard punt return touchdown against Miami, the longest return in the ACC that season.

In 2017, Hampton served as a defensive analyst at Oregon. Prior to that, he spent two years (2015-16) at South Florida as defensive backs coach and special teams coordinator, helping the Bulls to a schoolrecord 11 wins and a No. 19 AP ranking in 2016. Under his leadership, the defense forced 26 turnovers and scored three touchdowns. He coached All-AAC cornerback Deatrick Nichols and return specialist D'Ernest Johnson.

Hampton has a 19-year coaching career that includes high school coaching in Arkansas and Georgia. Before joining South Florida, he coached at Tift County High School (GA), leading the team to the Class 6A playoffs. He began his college coaching career at Western Kentucky under Willie Taggart (2011-12), where his secondary anchored a top Sun Belt defense.

Hampton previously coached at UAPB (2006-10), contributing to the 2006 SWAC Western Division title. His 2008 defense ranked among FCS leaders in pass efficiency, pass defense, and interceptions. He began coaching at the high school level in Arkansas, leading Warren High School to two state titles and later serving as head coach at Dumas High School.

A former standout cornerback at ULM, Hampton earned All-Louisiana honors and finished his career with 201 tackles and three interceptions. He also competed in track and field. He holds a bachelor's degree from ULM and a master's from the University of Arkansas at Monticello.

Hampton played professionally for the Seattle Seahawks, Jacksonville Jaguars, and Frankfurt Galaxy of NFL Europe, winning the 1999 World Bowl.

He and his wife Yolanda have five children: Aaron, Rashad, A.J. (a defensive back at Northwestern), Ashton, and Kenya.

Glymph's unit led the conference in PAT efficiency, converting 36-of-36 extra point attempts, and consistently delivered in special teams situations. He recorded a season-high two field goals against Texas Southern, further highlighting his dependability under pressure and his crucial role in the Golden Lions' scoring success.

Jeremiah Rodgers, known for his excellent hand technique and agile footwork, was a key anchor on the offensive line for the Golden Lions in 2024. His dominance in the trenches earned him recognition as one of UAPB's top offensive linemen.

Rodgers played a pivotal role in the offensive front that helped propel UAPB to a top-five scoring offense in the SWAC, averaging 23.5 points per game, and ranking sixth in total offense with 335.3 yards per game. His combination of strength, technique, and football intelligence consistently set the tone up front and was instrumental in the team's overall offensive success.
