- The meeting is just the second between the teams, with the first coming in 1959 in Lubbock. Texas Tech won that game, 15-14.

- 6** - 100-yard rush efforts for Anthony Hankerson at Oregon State after finishing with 136 against Fresno State.
- 8** - Catches and 106 yards, on average, over the last four games for Trent Walker dating back to the 2024 season.
- 10** - Oregon State pass plays of 20 or more yards thus far, good for 13th nationally.

- 615** - Passing yards for Maalik Murphy over the first two games, including 371 versus Fresno State.

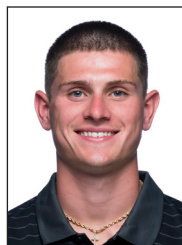

Against Texas Tech

- Oregon State and Texas Tech have met just once, in 1959 in Lubbock. Texas Tech won that matchup, 15-14.
- A full box score is not available. The Beavers were up 14-0 at halftime but the Red Raiders scored eight points in the third quarter and seven in the fourth for the come-from-behind win.
- Saturday's game is the first at an active Big 12 Conference foe for the Beavers since a 1996 visit to Baylor.
- Oregon State has played just five active Big 12 teams since 1996, going 2-3. OSU defeated Baylor in Corvallis in 1998, and Missouri in the 2006 Sun Bowl. The Beavers lost at Baylor in 1996, versus Texas in the 2012 Alamo Bowl and against Oklahoma State at home in 2019. Oregon State was supposed to play at Oklahoma State in 2020 but the game was canceled due to Covid-19.

In The Booth

- Coaches in the press box this season include offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach Ryan Gunderson and co-defensive coordinator and secondary coach Rod Chance.
- The two are joined by graduate assistants Trevon Bradford (offense), Adam Klein (offense) and Nick Pickett (defense). They are joined by special teams quality control analyst Daniel Akey.

On This Date

- Oregon State is playing on September 13 for just the seventh time in the program's history.
- The Beavers are 2-4 on the date, last defeating Hawai'i, 45-7, in 2008 in a game played in Corvallis.

Bray Adds Defensive Coordinator Title

- Oregon State head coach Trent Bray is in his second season leading the program. The former Oregon State linebacker added the defensive coordinator title in the offseason.
- Bray is in his 11th season with the program, and took over as the team's defensive coordinator over the last four games of the 2021 season. He served as DC in both 2022 and 2023.
- Rod Chance, who coaches the secondary, serves as Co-Defensive Coordinator.

Behind Center

- Maalik Murphy is the seventh different opening-day starting quarterback for the Beavers dating back to 2019. Here's a look at OSU's quarterback leader statistically over the first two games:

2024: Gevani McCoy - 25-36, 295 yds, 2 TD, 0 INT
2023: DJ Uiagalelei - 28-38, 346 yds, 5 TD, 0 INT
2022: Chance Nolan - 28-50, 470 yds, 3 TD, 2 INT
2021: Chance Nolan - 31-45, 459 yds, 2 TD, 0 INT (note Sam Noyer was the opening-game starter)
2020: Tristan Gebbia - 45-72, 414 yds, 1 TD, 1 INT
2019: Jake Luton - 38-74, 420 yds, 4 TD, 0 INT
- Murphy is the first Beaver to surpass 600 yards in the first two games of a season since Sean Mannion threw for 628 in 2014. Mannion attempted 82 passes over the first two games of 2014.

Not Since '19

- The Beavers returned both their leading rusher (Anthony Hankerson, 1,082 yards) and leading receiver (Trent Walker, 901 yards) from last season.
- It's the first time since 2019 that the Beavers have had both their leading rusher and receiver return in the same season. Jermar Jefferson and Isaiah Hodgins both returned that season.
- How rare is this? It is just the eighth time the team's leaders have returned since 2001, which also included 2016, 2015, 2012, 2010, 2007 and 2003.

Hankerson's Climb

- Anthony Hankerson tallied 136 carries on 25 carries against Fresno State, earning his sixth 100-yard effort as a member of Oregon State.
- Hankerson surpassed 1,200 yards for his OSU career and enters Friday's game with 1,260, good for 34th in the Oregon State record books.
- Hankerson is averaging 4.6 yards per carry in 14 games with the Beavers.

Walker, Too!

- Trent Walker came up just short of 100 yards receiving against Fresno State, tallying 99 on seven catches.
- Walker has 1,202 yards for his career, totaling 102 catches. The 1,202 yards puts him at 28th in the OSU record books.

More On Maalik

- Maalik Murphy's 371 passing yards were the first of over 300 yards by a Beaver quarterback since Gevani McCoy's 348 at Nevada on Oct. 12 of last season.
- Murphy's 371, meanwhile, marked just the 12th of 300 or more yards by an OSU quarterback since 2018. Six of the previous 11 were tallied by Jake Luton.
- Murphy has surpassed 300 yards three times in his career and 200 a total of 14 times. Thirteen of the 14 have come in his last 14 starts dating back to 2024 at Duke.
- Murphy ranks 11th nationally averaging 307.5 yards per game this season.

Ojeda Nailed It

- Caleb Ojeda's first career field goal attempt came in the second quarter against California and he nailed it from 53 yards out. That tied him for the 10th-longest by a Beaver, equaling Kieron Walford (1979 vs. Stanford), Jim Nielsen (1985 vs. Grambling) and Alexis Serna (2006 vs. USC).
- Ojeda's 53-yarder is one of 27 of 50 or more yards at the FBS level this season. It is tied for the 11th-longest.
- He is 2-for-3 this season after connecting on a 27-yarder against Fresno State.

On Third

- California and Fresno State have combined to go 3-for-21 on third downs this season, a 14.29 percent success rate. That ties Oregon State for fifth nationally with Minnesota, trailing only Virginia (9.52 percent), TCU (10 percent), BYU (11.54 percent) and Ohio (13.04 percent).
- Fresno State was just 1-for-8, becoming the first Oregon State opponent since San Jose State in 2015 to convert just once.
- Oregon State's 2024 defense allowed opponents to convert on 59 of 131 attempts, or 45.04 percent. That put the Beavers at 115 out of 134 teams nationally.

Big Passes

• Oregon State comes into Saturday's game with 10 passing plays of 20 or more yards, good for 13th nationally. The 2024 squad, meanwhile, recorded 32 in 12 games, good for 105th.

Walker After Two

• Trent Walker comes into Saturday's matchup with 16 catches on the year, placing him in a tie for eighth nationally. He's also 11th with 236 total yards.

• Walker is averaging 105.8 yards over his last four games dating back to last season, good for 12th nationally on average among players who have played at least two games since Nov. 22, 2024.

• His 423 total yards over that stretch rank 18th.

• Ten of Walker's 16 receptions this season have gone for a first down.

Reddicks' Big Day

• Taz Reddicks had the biggest day of his Oregon State career against Fresno State, going for 158 yards receiving on 11 catches. He is the first Beaver to top 150 since Trent Walker tallied 151 versus San Jose State on Nov. 9, 2024.

• Reddicks is one of 10 different Beavers with 100 or more yards receiving in a game since 2020. Only Walker (three) and Tre'Shaun Harrison (two) have done it more than once.

• Reddicks' receptions, meanwhile, marked the 32nd time in OSU's history a player recorded at least 11 catches. Eight of the 11 catches went for a first down or touchdown.

Away Notable

• The Beavers have rushed for at least 150 yards in 65 games away from home dating back to 1996. Oregon State is 34-31 in those games, going 10-9 since 2019.

• Conversely, the Beavers are 19-70 when being held to 149 yards or less over that stretch.

Schedule Notables

• The Beavers are slated to play five games against opponents they've never met before. Those opponents include Appalachian State and Tulsa away from home, Wake Forest, Lafayette and Sam Houston at Reser Stadium.

• Oregon State and Washington State are due to meet twice in the same season for the first time. The meetings will be the 109th and 110th matchups between the teams.

• Oregon State's trek to Appalachian State is set to be the fifth-longest by mileage in program history. It trails: 2,880 miles to Philadelphia (Villanova in 1962, Temple in 2002), 2,859 miles to Durham, N.C. (1942 Rose Bowl versus Duke) and 2,798 miles to

Syracuse, N.Y. (1963, 1965, 1974 and 1976). The trip to Appalachian State is 2,704 miles from Corvallis per Google Maps.

• The Beavers are not slated to play in California for the first time since the 2020 Covid-19 shortened season. The last time OSU did not play in California in a regularly scheduled season? Try 1966 when the Beavers played road games at Michigan, Iowa, Arizona State and Washington State.

• OSU is playing at Texas Tech for the first time since 1959.

• The Beavers' game at App State is the team's first in the Eastern Time Zone since opening the 2021 season at Purdue.

• Oregon State plays Houston for the fourth time but the Cougars are making just their second trip to Corvallis and their first since 1960.

• OSU is playing at least one game on a Friday for the fourth year in a row. The last at home was in 2023 against Utah, a 21-7 Beavers win.

• The Beavers are ending the regular season with a pair of road games for the first time since 2019 at Washington State and Oregon.

• OSU's last home game is slated for Nov. 8, the earliest end to a Beavers' home slate since the 1993 team lost to Washington, 28-21, on Nov. 6.

• Oregon State's first bye is slated for after the team's eighth game. Only Akron and Eastern Michigan have later byes, both after their ninth games.

• The Beavers are also one of 10 teams with their second bye immediately before their final regular season game (Eastern Michigan, Ole Miss, Mississippi State, Memphis, Boston College, Purdue, Indiana, Texas Tech and West Virginia).

Rush, Rush

• Oregon State is 25-6 since 2021 when rushing for at least 175 yards. Conversely, the Beavers are 5-17 when rushing for less than 175 yards.

Win The Toss

• Oregon State has won the pre-game coin toss in seven consecutive games. The Beavers deferred and kicked off in all seven.

• The odds of winning seven consecutive coin tosses? Try 1-in-128. To win eight straight would be 1-in-256.

• The Beavers kicked off to open a game in eight of the team's 12 matchups last season.

• OSU was 3-5 when winning the coin toss last season.

Steady Skyler

• Skyler Thomas led OSU with nine tackles in the opener, then recorded six against Fresno State and enters week three with a team-best 15 on the year. He's just ahead of

- Thomas led the team with 81 tackles a year ago.

And Foster

- Dexter Foster has had back-to-back seven-tackle efforts to open the season. Both tallies are tied for No. 2 among his single-game career highs, following 13 at Air Force last season.
- Foster already has 1.5 tackles for loss this season after posting two a season ago.

2025 Starts

- Oregon State has eight players who have made their first collegiate starts this season, seven of which came in the opener against California. Two others, Maalik Murphy and Josiah Timoteo, have made their first starts in the Orange and Black over the first two games.

More Firsts

- Jake Reichle, David Wells Jr. and Malachi Durant all caught their first collegiate touchdowns in the game versus Fresno State. In Durant's case, it also marked his first career reception.
- Gabarri Johnson caught a 17-yard pass against the Bulldogs, becoming the first Oregon State quarterback to catch a pass since Ben Gulbranson in 2022 against Utah.

Speaking Of Catches

- The 2025 Beavers have already had 13 different players make at least one catch. The 2024 team had a total of 11 players make a catch over 12 games.

20-Plus

- Trent Walker is tied for second nationally with five receptions of 20 or more yards thus far.

At Home

- The Beavers have rushed for 200 or more yards 18 times at home since 2020, going 16-2. The two losses both came in 2020 against Stanford (237 rush yards) and Arizona State (250). OSU has won 14 straight

at home when reaching the 200-yard rush plateau.

- OSU is also 17-1 when surpassing 30 points at home since that 2020 season. The lone loss was a 46-33 defeat to ASU in 2020. That gives Oregon State a 15-game win streak when totaling 30 or more points at home.
- How about turnovers? The Beavers are 20-7 at home since 2020 when committing two or fewer turnovers. Oregon State, meanwhile, is 14-0 over that stretch when an opponent turns the ball over at least twice.

In The Heat Of August And September

- Oregon State is 13-6 in games played in August and September since 2021, including an 8-4 mark in games played at home.

About Those Running Backs

- Anthony Hankerson headlines a deep group of running backs for the Beavers this season. Much has been made about his 1,000-yard season in 2024, so here's a look at the rest of the room.
- Salahadin Allah averaged 4.7 yards per carry last season, totaling 258 yards on 55 attempts. He also scored one touchdown in the win over Washington State.
- Marquis Crosby transferred in from Louisiana Tech and finished with 1,162 yards on 241 carries during his tenure. He rushed for 918 of those yards in 2022, scoring nine times.
- Jake Reichle has been a special teams standout while totaling 10 carries in his career, posting 55 yards and a touchdown. He's made 15 tackles in his career as well.
- Cornell Hatcher Jr. redshirted last season after rushing for 2,257 yards as a senior at Corona Centennial High School.
- Kourdey Glass and Skyler Jackson are true freshmen for OSU this season. Glass ran for 798 yards at Hanford High School. Jackson is the son of OSU great Steven Jackson and tallied 352 yards on 60 carries as a junior at Liberty High School.

Taylor On The Edge

- Nikko Taylor picked up two tackles for loss against California, pushing his career tally to 9.5. He's now played in 27 games as a Beaver, posting 54 total tackles in addition to 2.5 sacks, three pass breakups, two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

On It

- Jaheim Patterson has started the first two games of the season and is among the team's leaders with 12 tackles. He set a single-game high with eight in the opener versus California.
- He's played in 11 games as a Beaver and has 30 tackles over that stretch. Thirteen of those 26 have come against California as he previous high of five was in Berkeley last season.

On Fourth

- Oregon State went for it on fourth down a total of 42 times in 2024. That marked the second most in the nation, trailing only North Texas' 45.
- The Beavers averaged 3.5 fourth-down attempts per game, most in the nation.
- OSU was successful on 22 of the 42 attempts, a 52.38 percent success rate.

New To The Staff

- Oregon State head coach Trent Bray added five new coaches to the staff for the 2025 season. They are:
- Offensive line coach Mike Cavanaugh returns to Corvallis after serving in the same

role at OSU from 2005 to 2014. He replaced Kyle DeVan, who is the assistant offensive line coach with the Chicago Bears.

- Running backs coach Ray Pickering, who came to Corvallis from Buffalo. He replaced Thomas Ford, who left to become the head coach at Idaho.
- Wide receivers coach Pat McCann, who came to Corvallis from Fresno State. McCann replaced Kefense Hynson, who is now the passing game coordinator with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.
- Will Heck is the team's tight ends coach after serving in quality control last year. He replaced Jon Boyer, who is now coaching at Michigan State.
- Kharyee Marshall is coaching the team's edges. The Beavers did not have a dedicated edges coach last season. Marshall was in quality control last season.
- Additionally, AJ Cooper made the move to the secondary this season.

Other Staff Adds

- The Beavers also brought on a handful of other staffers who have a significant amount of experience as coaches at the FBS level.
- Robb Akey joined the program as the special assistant to the head coach. Akey came to Corvallis after serving as the defensive coordinator at Central Michigan from 2019-24. He was the head coach at Idaho from 2007-12.
- Mark Criner is defensive quality control after working with outside linebackers at Southern Miss since 2021.
- Danny Langsdorf is the offensive senior quality control analyst. He worked as the offensive coordinator for the Beavers from 2005-13, mentoring such future NFL quarterbacks as Matt Moore and Sean Mannion, among others.

Starts

- Oregon State's secondary led the team with 87 starts entering the 2025 season. The defensive backs are buoyed by Kobe Singleton, who leads the team with 34 career starts at the collegiate level. He made those 34 starts combined at Southern Utah and Liberty.
- Van Wells has made 30 of the offensive line's 49 starts, while Walker Harris made 23 combined at Sioux Falls and Southern Utah, highlighting the linebackers.

- OSU's tight ends opened the season with just five combined starts; Bryce Caufield made four last season and Jackson Bowers started once in 2023 at BYU.
- OSU's defensive line came into the season with 27 starts. The D-Line did not have one start entering 2024.
- Including Oregon State, the Beavers have made at least one start at 15 different college programs.

East-West Shrine

- Oregon State has five players on the East-West Shrine Game's 1,000 watch list. They include running back Anthony Hankerson, quarterback Maalik Murphy, defensive back Kobe Singleton, outside linebacker Nikko Taylor and wide receiver Trent Walker.

- Oregon State is playing as a member of the two-team Pac-12 Conference, which will expand to eight football playing programs starting with the 2026 season.

- Oregon State was 5-2 when entering the fourth quarter with a lead, but 0-5 when an opponent held the lead.
- OSU was 4-1 when scoring 30 or more points, and 3-0 when holding an opponent to 21 or less.
- The Beavers posted a 4-2 mark when out-gaining an opponent and 4-2 when tallying 400 or more.
- Oregon State controlled the time of possession in nine games, going 5-4. The Beavers ranked fifth nationally with an average time of possession of 33:09.

Completed Reser Stadium

- Oregon State completed Reser Stadium prior to the start of the 2023 season.
- The \$161 million project has made Reser into a national best-in-class facility.
- An anonymous donor made a historic \$50 million lead gift to transform Oregon State University's Reser Stadium into a national best-in-class football facility with year-round programs and facilities for all OSU students, faculty and staff.

- The project received approval by the OSU Board of Trustees Finance and Administration Committee on Jan. 28, 2021. The west side of the stadium was imploded nearly a year later in January 2022.
- The project involved the complete demolition and rebuilding of the west side of Reser Stadium and the construction of year-round university facilities, including a new state-of-the art interactive welcome center for new students considering attending OSU; new health center facilities for Corvallis campus students; health care facilities for OSU faculty and staff; and additional meeting space for university students, faculty and staff.
- Reser Stadium now features a 360-degree stadium concourse and includes expanded concessions and restroom facilities, enhanced sightlines, accessibility improvements and other fan amenities comparable to the east side of Reser, which was renovated prior to the 2005 season.

Reser Stadium

- The home of the Beavers has had over \$360 million in fiscal improvements completed since the 2005 season.
- The stadium was re-named on that date after a personal seven-figure gift by Al and Pat Reser of Beaverton, Ore.
- The Valley Football Center, which houses the coaching staff's offices and the team's locker room, underwent an enhancement that was completed in the summer of 2020. It included new graphics to celebrate the accomplishments of Beaver football alumni and a stronger presence highlighting bowl victories.
- A new videoboard, measuring 145 feet high by 50 feet wide, was installed before the start of the 2022 season. It measures approximately 6,750 square feet and has more than 6.3 million pixels. It is the 14th largest in the country.

Solar Power

- The most recent addition to Reser Stadium is powering the Valley Football Center.
- A total of 600 solar panels were added to the Valley Football Center roof. The panels, which are expected to last between 25 and 30 years or more, produce approximately 246 kW. This will produce 290,000 kilowatt hours per year.
- The design process for the solar panel project began last year. The VFC is an example of a building with large footprint, tall profile and one with a roof that has very little mounted equipment that enables max output for solar power planning.
