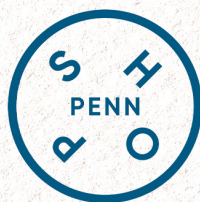

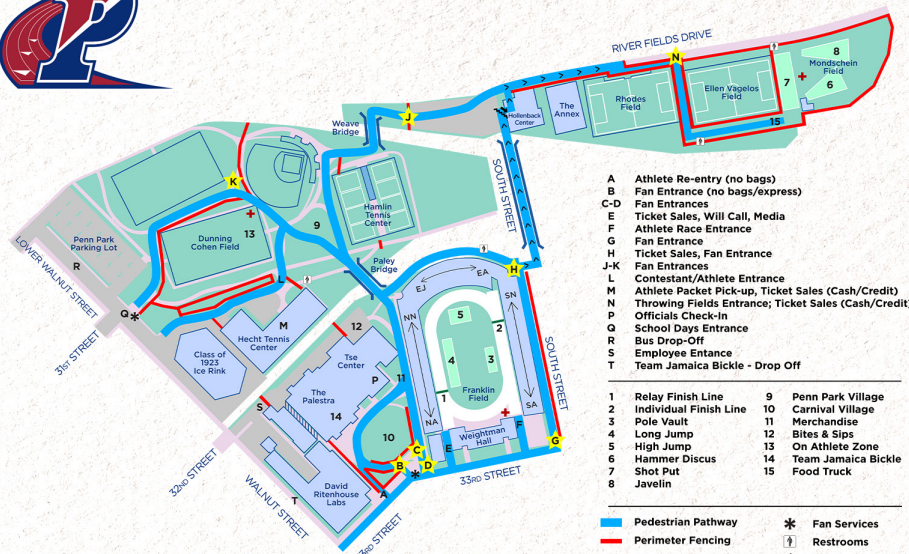

» Franklin Field

235 S. 33rd Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104. Please be advised that Franklin Field has a No Re-entry policy.

» Getting to the Throwing Fields

Exit Franklin Field at the Big East Gate (H). Cross South Street at the light and walk east towards the Hollenback Center. Head down the stairs, bear right and continue straight on River Fields Drive to the entrance of Rhodes Field. Follow the pathway until you reach the Mondschein Throwing Fields.

» On Campus Parking

Limited parking is available on Penn's campus for \$25 (credit card only) and on a first-come, first-serve basis. Visit upenn.edu/parking for additional information. Parking garages are located at:

PERMITTED ITEMS

- » Bags up to 16" x 16" x 8"
- » Drawstring bags
- » Diaper bags
- » Soft-sided seat backs and bench cushions that do not impede seat access
- » Sealed plastic water bottles & juice boxes/pouches
- » Medically necessary items after proper inspection at Gate E
- » Blankets, opened & carried in
- » Hand-held camera for personal use
- » Service animals with paperwork that aid guests with disabilities
- » Food carried in a one-gallon freezer bag. Limit one bag per guest

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- » Bags including duffel or equipment bags, larger than 16" x 16" x 8"
- » Metal, wooden or hard plastic seats with or without backs
- » Umbrellas
- » Coolers, glass bottles & cans
- » Animals (except service dogs)
- » Firearms, weapons and other items deemed dangerous and/or inappropriate
- » All poles/sticks, including tripods & selfie sticks
- » Smoking & all open flames
- » Video cameras & the use of video capable cell phones for commercial or mass distribution purposes
- » Strollers
- » Ticket scalping, trespassing, soliciting, peddling & loitering
- » Food not carried in a one-gallon freezer bag or more than one food bag per guest
- » Large quantities of food in packaging such as pizza boxes, catering trays or large plastic containers
- » Binocular or camera cases
- » Laser pointers
- » Fireworks
