GAME NOTES

HISTORY MADE -- **Marlon Ellerbee** became the 12th player in program history to score 1,000 career points with a turnaround layup at the 4:49 mark of the second half in the Tomcats' wire-to-wire 77-52 victory over Waynesburg Saturday ... He joins A.H. Davis (1,683 points), Victor Harp (1,607), Joe Herrmann (1,520), Devon Adams (1,409), Mark Fleischer (1,345), Blair Rozenblad (1,302), Eric Vanderveen (1,177), Jim Mondok (1,172), Bob Anderson (1,149), Ahmad Tejumola (1,108) and Khari Bess (1,066) as members of the exclusive 1,000-point club.

BACK-TO-BACK -- Ellerbee logged his best week of the season with a pair of solid performances last week ... Against Allegheny Wednesday, he posted 12 points and game bests in rebounds (12) and assists (six) ... His 12-point, 12-board showing marked his fourth career double-double and first since 2023 ... He went a perfect 4-for-4 at the free-throw line as he logged his most minutes in a game (37) since the 2022-23 season ... Against Waynesburg Saturday, Ellerbee joined the 1,000 point club ... He finished with a game- and season-best 19 points on 6-of-13 shooting, 6-of-8 at the line and 1-of-2 from deep ... The graduate student grabbed a team-leading nine boards and posted game highs in assists (four) and steals (three).

¡GABE SE ESTÁ VOLVIENDO LOCO! -- **Gabriel Gonzalez** has shot better than 45 percent from the field in 4-of-5 games and 10-of-13 contests on the season ... Gonzalez is second on the team with a 49.6 field-goal percentage ... He has contributed at least 11 points in three straight games and 4 of his last 5 contests ... Gonzalez is averaging 11.1 points per game, a near 7.0 points better than last season (4.2).

DAT'S DAS DOWN LOW -- **Das Sanders** made his first start in nearly two months Saturday versus Waynesburg ... He pitched in 6 points on 3-of-6, grabbed six rebounds and swiped two steals in the victory.

NO FREE-THROW WOES HERE -- Geneva is second in the PAC from the free-throw line (74.2 percent) while Thiel is fifth (70.9) ... **Ryan Rachic** is second in the conference at 88.5 percent (54-of-61) for the Golden Tornadoes ... Ellerbee is eighth in the league at 75.4 percent (46-of-61).

BOX OUT HARD -- Thiel and Geneva sit tied for fourth in the PAC in rebounding margin per game (+1.1) ... The Tomcats are sixth in the league in offensive boards per game (12.7) while the Golden Tornadoes are ninth (9.8) ... The reigning PAC champs are third in defensive rebounds per contest (26.4) while the Blue and Gold are 10th (24.7).

SERIES HISTORY -- Thiel and Geneva's first known meeting was in Dec. 1972, a 69-65 Thiel victory ... The Tomcats took six straight in the series from 2015-17 ... At home, the Blue and Gold are 13-10 ... When the two sides have met as conference foes, the Golden Tornadoes hold a slight 15-13 edge ... The GT's have taken 9 of the last 10 matchups ... Thiel's last win in the series came on the road in Feb. 2023 (99-84) ... Two games in the series have reached overtime, both of which were Blue-and-Gold winners.

PAC OUTLOOK -- Chatham (10-1), Grove City (9-2), Saint Vincent (8-3) and Washington and Jefferson (8-3) occupy the top four spots in the conference ... Franciscan and **Thiel** both sit at 5-6 and hold the fifth- and sixth-place spots ... The top six teams qualify for the PAC Championship Tournament ... **Geneva** (4-6) is a half-game back of the Barons and Tomcats while Allegheny and Waynesburg are both one game back (4-7).
