OFFENSIVE NOTES

BIG HERZ MAKES HISTORY -- Freshman QB **Keller Herzberger**, in his first collegiate start, set a single-game program record with 447 passing yards against Geneva in week 6 ... Herzberger broke Ryan Radke's 2016 record of 391 passing yards against Waynesburg ... He is the first Thiel player to ever throw for more than 400 yards in a game.

RECORD-SETTING QB1 -- Herzberger's 447 passing yards were the most by any DIII freshman this season, the second most of all NCAA freshmen in 2025 and the eighth most in PAC history.

FINDING PAYDIRT -- Herzberger threw five touchdowns, the second most in Thiel history, and ran for one score ... He accounted for six TD's, which ties Darrell Satterfield's and Patsy Combine's program record for total touchdowns.

AIR-RAID OFFENSE -- Herzberger completed 31 passes, the fourth most in school history, on the sixth-most attempts (52) in program lore.

BRINGIN' HOME SOME HARDWARE -- Herzberger was recognized as the PAC Newcomer of the Week for his historic performance against Geneva... He is the first Tomcat since **Joey Fell** in 2023 to bring home the award.

DUNBAR BREAKS OUT -- **Riley Dunbar** posted a breakout performance with career-and-game highs in catches (nine), receiving yards (147) and touchdowns (two) against Geneva ... His 147 receiving yards were the most by a Tomcat since DeShawon Bracy had 218 at Grove City in 2016 ... They were also the second most by a PAC freshman this season ... Dunbar hauled in five catches for 30 yards at Westminster last week.

D-LO RE-WRITES THE RECORD BOOK -- Deon Logan ran for an 85-yard touchdown up the left sideline against Waynesburg in week 4, breaking Ron Leuschen's 44-year program-record run of 83

yards at Case Western Reserve in 1981 ... Logan totaled a season-best 146 yards on the ground on 16 carries to go with two touchdowns against Waynesburg ... He averaged 9.1 yards per carry in the matchup ... His 146 yards were 2 shy of his career best of 148, which also came against Waynesburg last season.

D-LO OUT WIDE -- Logan hauled in four grabs for 63 yards, the second most in his career, against Geneva in week 6 ... He logged his first receiving touchdown of the year on a 3-yard catch and run in the flat against the GTs.

CAREER-HIGH CK -- **CK Kershaw** posted a career-most 58 receiving yards against the Golden Tornadoes ... He had a career-long 32 yard reception in the fourth quarter of the matchup ... Kershaw made four grabs for 17 yards last week at Westminster.

GET BETWEEN THE KREAIS' -- **Adam Kreais** set career bests in catches (five) and receiving yards (37) in week 6 ... He hauled in his first career TD on an 8-yard back-shoulder strike from Herzberger in the fourth quarter against Geneva ... Kreais made three catches for a team-best 43 receiving yard in New Wilmington last Saturday.

LET JAYVEERH COOK -- **Jayveerh White** hauled in five grabs for a season-best 58 yards against the GTs ... White had a pair of grabs for 18 yards last week.

GOT THE O GOIN' -- Thiel racked up 38 points in week 6, its highest output since Nov. 12, 2016 when they logged a 47-41 win over Grove City in the Mercer County Cup.

THE MCDC AFFECT -- The Tomcats were 5-for-6 on fourth down conversions against Geneva, their best conversion percentage (83.3) of the season.

OPENING-DRIVE TD -- The Tomcats logged their lone score of last week's contest with a 13-play, 75-yard drive across 6:23 capped with a Herzberger 1-yard score.

JD: JUST DOMINATING -- Daniel made a career-best nine tackles last week and had a career-high-tying two tackles for loss ... He is tied for 12th in the PAC in tackles for loss (six) ... He totaled eight tackles (four solo), 1.0 TFL, and one forced fumble, interception and fumble recovery each against Geneva ... Daniel has at least one tackle for loss in 4-of-6 games this season.

ALL STREAKS MUST COME TO AN END -- Thiel's last series win came in 1981, a 54-13 trouncing of the Spartans in Cleveland ... CWRU has taken each of the last 11 meetings since then.

HISTORY LESSON -- Case Tech and Western Reserve federated into Case Western Reserve in 1967 ... The two student bodies competed separately, however, as Case Tech and Adelbert ... The two bodies merged and began play as one singular body in 1970.

POINT OF THE ABOVE HISTORY LESSON -- Against Case Tech, Adelbert/Western Reserve and Case Western Reserve, Thiel holds a 23-19-1 series advantage ... The Tomcats won 11 straight matchups against Case Tech and Western Reserve from 1965-69.

THIS DAY IN THIEL HISTORY

CRISIS DE OCTUBRE -- The Tomcats hold a 5-7-2 all-time mark on October 25 games.

HE'S NO PATSY ... WELL, ACTUALLY, HE KINDA IS -- *Patsy Combine* threw four touchdowns against Bethany on Oct. 25, 1969, a 34-12 Thiel win in Greenville.

TOP SERIES PERFORMANCES

RON RUNS INTO THE RECORD BOOK -- *Ron Leuschen* broke free for a program-record 83-yard rushing touchdown at CWRU in 1981 ... His record stood until **Deon Logan** logged an 85-yard rush against Waynesburg on Sept. 27 this season ... Leuschen ran for three touchdowns in the contest, which is tied for fourth most in team history.

Thiel clinched its first PAC Championship since 1972 with the 24-14 win over Thomas More in week 9. The Thiel offense smothered Thomas More as they held a 40:18-19:42 time of possession advantage. Steve Minton ran for a then-career-high 217 yards on 37 carries while scoring a pair of touchdowns. Thiel produced 266 rushing yards on 57 carries while holding Thomas More to 3 rushing yards on 24 carries. The visitors were within a score at 21-14 with less than 8 minutes left before Darious Thompson picked off Seth Ellis in Thiel territory. The interception set up an 11-play Thiel drive that shaved 5:44 off the clock and led to a Sammy Koyl dagger field goal with 54 ticks left to spell the 24-14 final.

SAM BAUMAN

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
