OFFENSIVE NOTES

BIG HERZ MAKES HISTORY -- Freshman QB **Keller Herzberger**, in his first collegiate start, set a single-game program record with 447 passing yards against Geneva in week 6 ... Herzberger broke Ryan Radke's 2016 record of 391 passing yards against Waynesburg ... He is the first Thiel player to ever throw for more than 400 yards in a game.

RECORD-SETTING QB1 -- Herzberger's 447 passing yards were the most by any DIII freshman this season, the second most of all NCAA freshmen in 2025 and the eighth most in PAC history.

FINDING PAYDIRT -- Herzberger threw five touchdowns, the second most in Thiel history, and ran for one score ... He accounted for six TD's, which ties Darrell Satterfield's and Patsy Combine's program record for total touchdowns.

AIR-RAID OFFENSE -- Herzberger completed 31 passes, the fourth most in school history, on the sixth-most attempts (51) in program lore in the clash with the Golden Tornadoes.

BRINGIN' HOME SOME HARDWARE -- Herzberger was recognized as the PAC Newcomer of the week for his historic performance against Geneva ... He is the first Tomcat since **Joey Fell** in 2023 to bring home the award.

DUNBAR BREAKS OUT -- **Riley Dunbar** posted a breakout performance with career-and-game highs in catches (nine), receiving yards (147) and touchdowns (two) against Geneva ... His 147 receiving yards were the most by a Tomcat since DeShawon Bracy had 218 at Grove City in 2016 ... They were also the second most by a PAC freshman this season ... Dunbar hauled in three grabs for a team-best 37 yards last week.

D-LO FOR A HUNDO -- **Deon Logan** produced his second 100-yard rushing effort of the season and fourth of his career last week against CWRU with 110 yards on 24 carries ... He broke free up the Thiel sideline for a game-long run of 47 yards.

RON'S RECORD REPLACED -- Logan ran for an 85-yard touchdown up the left sideline against Waynesburg in week 4, breaking **Ron Leuschen's** 44-year program-record run of 83 yards at CWRU in 1981 ... Logan totaled a season-best 146 yards on the ground on 16 carries to go with two touchdowns against Waynesburg ... He averaged 9.1 yards per carry in the matchup ... His 146 yards were 2 shy of his career best of 148, which also came against Waynesburg last season.

CAREER-HIGH CK -- **CK Kershaw** posted a career-most 58 receiving yards against Geneva on Oct. 11 ... He had a career-long 32 yard reception in the fourth quarter of the matchup ... Kershaw made a career-best five catches last week for 26 yards.

GET BETWEEN THE KREAIS' -- **Adam Kreais** set career bests in catches (five) and receiving yards (37) against Geneva in week 6 ... He hauled in his first career TD on an 8-yard back-shoulder strike from Herzberger in the fourth quarter against the GTs ... Kreais made three catches for a team-best 43 receiving yards against Westminster in week 7 ... He made four grabs for 21 yards last week.

GOT THE O GOIN' -- Thiel racked up 38 points in week 6, its highest output since Nov. 12, 2016 when they logged a 47-41 win over Grove City in the Mercer County Cup.

THE MCDC AFFECT -- The Tomcats were 5-for-6 on fourth down conversions against Geneva, their best conversion percentage (83.3) of the season.

FF's FOR DAYS -- **Joshua Daniel** enters play tied for the PAC lead in forced fumbles (four) ... Daniel forced a fumble in four-straight contests from Sept. 20 - Nov. 18 ... His mark in forced fumbles are the most by a Tomcat since *Tim Taylor* forced four in 2009.

JD: JUST DOMINATING -- Daniel made a career-best nine tackles and had a career-high-tying two tackles for loss at Westminster in week 7 ... He is tied for 11th in the PAC in tackles for loss (7.0) ... He totaled eight tackles (four solo), 1.0 TFL, and one forced fumble, interception and fumble recovery each against Geneva ... Daniel has at least one tackle for loss in 5-of-7 games this season.

The Tomcats put on a defensive clinic as they logged seven sacks, which is tied for second most in team history, and made 14 tackles for loss, the third most in program history, en route to a 21-3 win over Buffalo State. The visitors capitalized on an opening-drive interception with a field goal to lead 3-0. Thiel carried a 7-3 lead into the break thanks to a Brandon Chambers 24-yard score from Darrell Satterfield. Dan Hess capped a five-play, 80-yard drive with a 1-yard score to make it 14-3 with 1:38 left in the third quarter. The Chambers-Satterfield duo delivered the dagger with a 67-yard strike early in the fourth quarter to spell the 21-3 final and move the Tomcats to 9-0.

SAM BAUMAN

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
