THE CHAMPS ARE HERE -- Thiel will honor its 2005 PAC Championship and NCAA Playoffs qualifying team during Saturday's matchup ... The 2005 Tomcats produced the greatest season in team history with a program-record 11 wins and the programs first NCAA Playoffs victory.

NEED THAT '05 MAGIC -- The 2005 Cats went a perfect 6-0 in league play ... The 2005 team seeks its first PAC triumph Saturday.

PLAYOFFS! -- Thiel bested national powerhouse Johns' Hopkins 28-3 in the NCAA Playoffs opening round from Alumni Stadium ... Thiel's season came to an end in round two against Bridgewater, 24-13, in a snow bowl at Alumni Stadium.

CARDIAC CATS -- Thiel went a perfect 3-0 in OT games in 2005, with all three coming on the road ... The Tomcats took down W&J 38-35 on the Presidents' Homecoming ... The Blue and Gold bested Waynesburg 35-28 in double overtime and outlasted Carnegie Mellon 50-48 in triple overtime.

IN THE NATIONAL LANDSCAPE -- The 2005 squad finished the season ranked No. 15 by Don Hansen's Football Gazette's Top 40, No. 16 by the AFCA Coaches' Poll and No. 17 by D3football.com's Top 25.

LEGENDARY LEIP -- Jack Leipheimer led the 2005 Tomcats as head coach ... He was inducted into the Thiel Athletics Hall of Fame last year and the Allegheny Athletics Hall of Fame this year.

D-SAT -- Darrell Satterfield was the starting QB for the 2005 Tomcats ... He set Thiel single-season records in passing yards (2,804) and touchdown passes (25) ... Satterfield tied a 36-year Thiel record with six touchdown passes in the Blue and Gold's 50-48 triple-OT win at CMU on Nov. 12.

MONEY MINTON -- Steve Minton ran for a then-Thiel-record 1,066 yards on the year ... His 2005 marks in points (114) and rushing TD's (19) are still atop the Thiel record book.

B-CHAMBERS -- Brandon Chambers' 2005 marks in receiving yards (1,388) and receiving TD's (16) are still Thiel records 20 years later ... He hauled in a then-Thiel-record 90 catches ... His four TD's at CMU on Nov. 12 are the second most in a game in Thiel history ... Chambers was named the D3Football.com South Region Co-Offensive Player of the Year ... He also made the D3Football.com All-American Second Team.

BIG DAVE UP FRONT -- Dave Hendricks led the Tomcats' offensive line ... He was named the Football Gazette National Offensive Lineman of the Year in addition to being Football Gazette's South Region Offensive Lineman of the Year ... Hendricks became the first Tomcat to garner AFCA All-American First Team honors and was named an AFCA DIII All-Star.

BRINGIN' HOME THE HARDWARE -- Thiel players/coaches collected 26 individual honors following the legendary 2005 season ... 20 players also made All-PAC teams.

WAGNER WILLIS THE DEFENSE -- Jeff Wagner led the Thiel defense with 75 tackles (56 solo) ... He added 6.0 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, two interceptions and four pass breakups.

DT THE DB -- Darious Thompson record six interceptions and six pass breakups, both team bests ... He made 48 tackles (30 solo) and had a trio of TFL's.

KICKERS ARE PEOPLE TOO -- Sammy Koyl set a Thiel record with 45 successful PAT's in 2005.

Waynesburg jumped to a 21-0 lead halfway through the second quarter. The Tomcats got back into the game as Darrell Satterfield connected with Brandon Chambers for a 5-yard score with 5:35 left in the first half. After forcing a three-and-out to start the second half, Steve Minton ran in a 2-yard score to make it 21-14. With 5:23 left in the game, Satterfield and Chambers connected for a 38-yard TD to knot things at 21. Waynesburg opened OT with a score, but Satterfield found Tom McEntire to even things at 28. Minton scored his second TD in double OT and the Thiel defense stymied the Jackets to seal the comeback win.

BAD DAY TO TAKE THE OVER -- Thiel and Geneva first met in 1899, a barnburning 6-5 Tomcats victory.

REALLY BAD DAYS TO TAKE THE OVER -- Thiel and Geneva have played to three separate 0-0 ties, doing so in 1916, 1923 and 1924.

SERIES STATS -- Saturday's meeting will be the 49th all-time meeting between the two schools ... Geneva leads the series 34-11-3 ... The Golden Tornadoes have taken each of the last nine series clashes.

HOLD 'EM UNDER 15 = W -- In all 11 Thiel series victories, the Tomcats have held the Golden Tornadoes under 15 points ... 9-of-11 Thiel wins have been one-score victories.

BALLIN WITH BOVA -- **Willie Bova** threw a Thiel record 63 passes against Bethany on Oct. 11 2008 ... His 32 completions in the matchup are third most in Thiel history while his 374 passing yards were second most ... He threw four TD's, which is tied for third most in a game in Thiel history.

SMIDGE UNDER .500 ON 10/11 -- Thiel holds a 6-7 all-time record on Oct. 11 ... The Tomcats last played on Oct. 11 in 2014, a 40-28 loss at Westminster ... Thiel's last Oct. 11 win came in 2008, a 50-44 win over Bethany.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

D-LO RE-WRITES THE RECORD BOOK -- **Deon Logan** ran for an 85-yard touchdown up the left sideline against Waynesburg in week 4, breaking **Ron Leuschen's** 44-year-program-record run of 83 yards at Case Western Reserve in 1981 ... Logan totaled a season-best 146 yards on the ground on 16 carries to go with two touchdowns against Waynesburg ... He averaged 9.1 yards per carry in the matchup ... His 146 yards were 2 shy of his career best of 148, which also came against Waynesburg last season.

J-FELL BACK UNDER CENTER -- **Joey Fell** got the start at QB in week 4, his first start since 2023 ... After missing last season, Fell started the year in a super-utility role for the Tomcats ... Fell was 4-of-14 against Waynesburg for 20 yards ... He ran for 36 yards on 10 carries with a long of 15.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMIN'S -- **Jaylen Benjamin** set career highs in receptions (six) and receiving yards (77) in week 1's clash with Concordia (Wis.) ... Benjamin brought in a 28-yard pitch and catch in the fourth quarter for the longest reception of his career ... He averaged 12.8 yards per reception ... Benjamin's 77 receiving yards were the

seventh most in a Thiel season opener since 2001 ... Benjamin was named to the PAC Offensive Weekly Honor Roll for his performance.

DUNBAR FOR PRESIDENT -- **Riley Dunbar** made a career-high-tying four catches at Allegheny in the PAC opener ... He amassed a career-best 52 receiving yards in the defeat ... Dunbar made four grabs for 30 yards in week one versus Concordia (Wis.).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

AIR JORDAN -- **Matt Jordan** made a career- and game-best 13 tackles in week 1 versus Concordia (Wis.) ... Seven of his tackles were solo stops ... Jordan added one pass breakup in the defeat ... Jordan posted a game-leading eight tackles (seven solo) at Adrian in week 2 ... Jordan made six stops (three solo) at Allegheny in the PAC opener ... He added three solo tackles against Waynesburg last week.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE -- Bauman added Greg Polis (OC), Tom Keane (WR/ST), Mo De La Garza (OL), Jon Bevier (LB) and Jyair Thomas (DB) to the staff heading into last spring.

ROUNDING OUT THE STAFF -- Kevin McLane is in his fourth season on the staff and serves as recruiting coordinator and D-line coach ... Donny Pattison '23 (running backs) and Mateo Renteria (QB) are in year two on the staff.

GENEVA NOTES

HANGIN' EM UP -- Geneva Head Coach Geno DeMarco is in his 33rd and final season leading Geneva ... He is the longest active tenured NCAA coach.

NOT YOUR GRANDFATHER'S GENEVA -- Geneva has embraced a pass-first mentality in 2025, unlike prior years of the triple-option, wish-bone style offense DeMarco normally ran ... Geneva passing last season was 60-for-105 in 10 games ... In just five games this season, Geneva is 128-for-208.

SAM BAUMAN

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
