



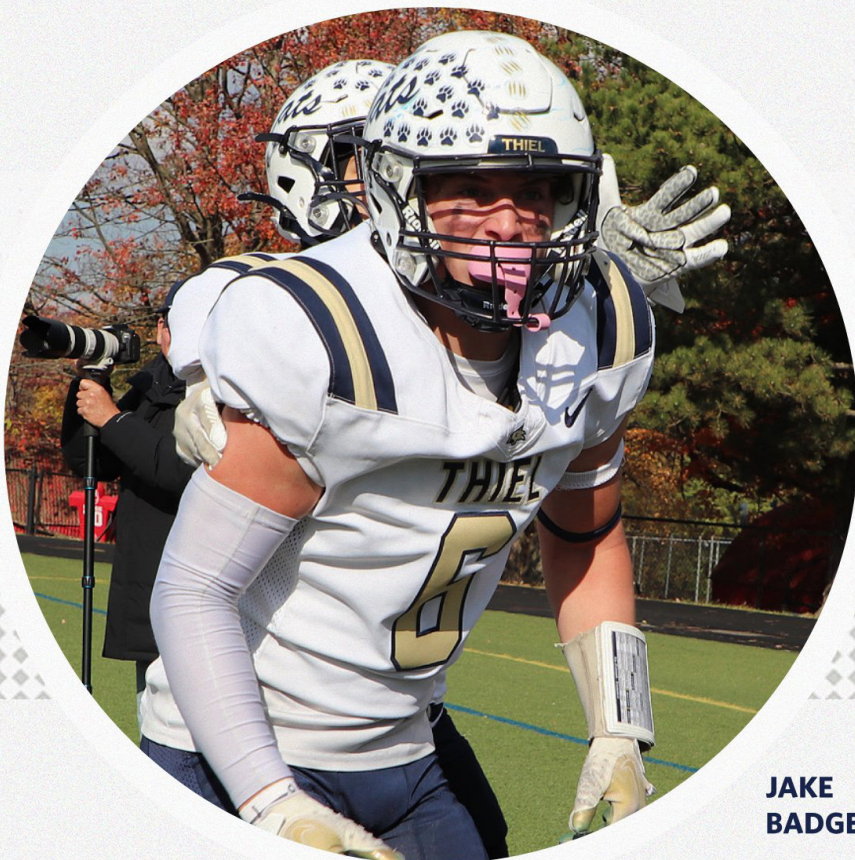

GAME NOTES

OFFENSIVE NOTES

BIG-TIME NUMBERS -- Thiel walloped Hiram 48-20 last week for its first victory of 2025 ... Thiel's 48 points marked its highest offensive output since Oct. 29, 2016, when the Tomcats defeated Waynesburg 50-42 ... It was also their most points in a road game and highest margin of victory since Nov. 10, 2007, when they topped Saint Vincent 62-14.

THE 403 -- Thiel totaled 403 yards of total offense last week ... The Blue and Gold had 227 in the air and 176 on the ground.

RUN JAY, RUN -- **Jayveerh White** posted a career-best rushing performance with 111 yards on the ground in the win ... White did so on just eight carries ... He had a career-long 62-yard rushing touchdown through the heart of the Hiram defense in the third quarter to extend Thiel's lead to 41-20 ... White ran in one more score from 16 yards out in the fourth to spell Saturday's 48-20 final ... The junior posted a career-most 143 all-purpose yards in the victory.

BIG HERZ -- **Keller Herzberger** is in line to make his fifth straight under center ... Herzberger threw for 199 yards last week with a pair of touchdown passes and a rushing score ... In his first collegiate start against Geneva in week 6, Herzberger set a single-game program record with 447 passing yards ... Herzberger broke **Ryan Radke's** 2016 record of 391 passing yards against Waynesburg ... He is the first Thiel player to ever throw for more than 400 yards in a game.

RECORD-SETTING QB1 -- Herzberger's 447 passing yards are the second most by any DIII freshman this season, the fourth most of all NCAA freshmen in 2025 and the eighth most in PAC history.

FINDING PAYDIRT -- Herzberger threw five touchdowns, the second most in Thiel history, and ran for one score in his record-setting performance against Geneva ... He accounted for six TD's, which ties **Darrell Satterfield's** and **Patsy Combine's** program record for total touchdowns.

AIR-RAID OFFENSE -- Herzberger completed 31 passes, the fourth most in school history, on the sixth-most attempts (51) in program lore in the clash with the Golden Tornadoes.

BRINGIN' HOME SOME 'HERZ'WARE -- Herzberger was recognized as the PAC Newcomer of the week for his historic performance against Geneva ... He is the first Tomcat since **Joey Fell** in 2023 to bring home the award.

THE LAST D-LO DANCE -- Senior **Deon Logan** will play his final game at Alumni Stadium Saturday ... Logan has produced a pair of 100-yard rushing efforts this season at home ... He broke **Ron Leuschen's** 44-year program-record run of 83 yards with an 85-yard house call against Waynesburg on Homecoming this season.

D-LO IN THE END ZONE -- Logan's 1-yard score on the ground last week was his fifth of the season, tying his career high ... He added a receiving touchdown in the win to run his season total TD mark to seven, setting a new season high ... Logan had a career-most four touchdowns in Thiel's win over Bethany last season ... His 24 points in the win are tied for the fourth most in Tomcat history

ONE MORE FOR ETERNITY -- With one more touchdown this season, Logan will move into 10th on the all-time Thiel points list ... He is currently 2 points shy of **Joseph Scafuri** (98) for 10th ... With one more rushing TD, he will tie **Justin Napotnik** and **Chuck Scafuri** for 10th in Thiel history with 13 on-the-ground scores.

THE BIG GUY DUNBAR -- **Riley Dunbar** posted career-and-game highs in catches (nine), receiving yards (147) and touchdowns (two) against Geneva ... His 147 receiving yards were the most by a Tomcat since **DeShawn Bracy** had 218 at Grove City in 2016 ... Dunbar made four grabs last week for a game-most 76 receiving yards, his second highest career total ... He hauled in a 33-yard score from Herzberger in the first quarter of the matchup with Hiram.

AK-41 -- Adam Krais made a career-most six catches in last Saturday's win at Hiram ... He logged 41 receiving yards ... Krais has posted five consecutive multi-catch games ... He had a career-most 43 receiving yards at Westminster on Oct. 18 ... Krais scored his first career touchdown against Geneva in week 6.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

BIG BADG: THE DPOTW -- Jake Badger was named the PAC Defensive Player of the Week following his dominant defensive effort at Hiram last week ... Badger totaled a team-best eight tackles (five solo), scored his first career touchdown and had a hand in two turnovers in Saturday's victory.

DEEP DIVE ON THE DPOTW -- One of Badger's tackles stopped a Hiram receiver on the 1-yard line on the final play of the first half and kept Thiel in front 21-14 at halftime ... Badger's 49-yard scoop-and-score in the third quarter increased the Tomcats' lead to 28-14 ... His first interception of the season late in the third stopped a Hiram drive in Thiel territory.

FF's FOR DAYS -- Joshua Daniel enters play leading the PAC and tied for second in DIII in forced fumbles (five) ... Daniel recorded his fifth of the season last week, leading to Badger's scoop-and-score TD ... Daniel forced a fumble in four-straight contests from Sept. 20 - Nov. 18 ... His mark in forced fumbles are the most by a Tomcat since at least the 1997 season.

JD: JUST DOMINATING -- Daniel made a career-best nine tackles and had a career-high-tying two tackles for loss at Westminster in week 7 ...

He is 12th in the PAC in tackles for loss (8.0) ... He totaled eight tackles (four solo), 1.0 TFL, and one forced fumble, interception and fumble recovery each against Geneva ... Daniel has at least one tackle for loss in 6-of-8 games this season.

MJ AT THE TOP OF THE PAC -- Matt Jordan enters play second in the PAC in solo tackles (43) ... He is 11th in the conference and first on the Tomcats in total tackles (62) ... Jordan made five solo stops at Hiram last week and had a tackle for loss ... He's logged at least seven tackles in four games this season.

MJ ON STOEBER -- In home games this season, Jordan is averaging 9.8 tackles ... He's racked up three double-digit tackle efforts on the season, all of which have come at home.

SACK TO MY LOU -- Thiel had a season-most three sacks last week ... **Brian White** made a career-high two sacks in the victory while **Alexander Miltner** had one ... Miltner added a career-best four QB hurries.

WATCH ME WHIP, WATCH ME NAY NAY -- **Nayshaun Davis** posted a career- and game-best-tying three pass breakups against Geneva in week 6 ... He also made three solo tackles ... Davis recorded five tackles (three solo) at Westminster in week 7 and at Hiram last week ... He added a pair of PBU's in the win over the Terriers.

OH, HOW THE TIMES HAVE CHANGED -- Thiel and Bethany first met in 1917 ... The average price of a home in the U.S. was a measly \$5,000 at the time ... The Chicago White Sox won the World Series in 1917.

AUTUMN BOOMER BEATDOWN -- The Tomcats are 4-1 all-time in home November matchups with Bethany ... Thiel has taken 3 of the last 5 November series meetings, including last season's 30-23 win.

TOP SERIES PERFORMANCES

KD -- Kennard Davis set a Thiel record with two

interceptions returned for touchdown's in Thiel's 42-14 curbstomping of Bethany in 2003 ... One of the pick-6's was for 99 yards, the longest pick-6 in program history.

CURRENT CATS -- **Deon Logan** had four touchdowns for 24 points in last season's win at Bethany ... His 24 points are tied for fourth most in team history ... **Jayveerh White** ran home a 95-yard kickoff return TD in that same win.

4 TIMES THE MADNESS -- Thiel defeated Bethany 50-44 in quadruple overtime in 2008, the longest game in Thiel history ... **Willie Bova** had the eventual game-winning score on a 10-yard rush ... **Matt Joy** sealed the win with an interception on the final play of the fourth OT.

STEADY IMPROVEMENT -- Under **Sam Bauman**, Thiel has posted three victories in each of the past two seasons ... Those six wins match the amount of Tomcat victories from 2016-22 combined.

Carnegie Mellon held a 28-14 lead with 14 minutes left in the game. The Tomcats capped a seven-play, 69-yard drive with a Dan Hess 1-yard touchdown run to make it a one-score game. The Blue and Gold knotted things at 28 with 2:32 left as Darrell Satterfield found Mark LaScolaa for a 7-yard TD to force overtime. CMU opened OT with a score before Satterfield found Brandon Chambers to force double overtime. After exchanging scores in the second overtime, the Tartans opened the third overtime with a score but failed on the 2-point try, making it 48-42. Satterfield threw his program-record-tying sixth touchdown of the game to Chambers for his fourth receiving score to even things at 48. The Satterfield-Chambers duo clinched the win with a successful 2-point attempt, capping a perfect 10-0 regular season for the Blue and Gold.

SAM BAUMAN

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
