## **GAME NOTES**

**CALL THE GENERAL** -- **Gabriel "General" Gonzalez** got back to his high-percentage-shooting ways with a team-best 16 points on 5-of-7 from the field, 5-of-7 at the line and 1-of-1 from deep in a career-high 36 minutes against Franciscan Saturday ... In wins this season, Gonzalez is averaging 13.2 points on 29-of-53 (54.7 percent) from the field.

**MARLO'S MAKIN' IT RAIN** -- In six career games versus Bethany, **Marlon Ellerbee** is averaging 12.7 points on 26-of-53 (49.1 percent) from the field and 19-of-23 (82.6 percent) from the charity stripe to go with 4.5 rebounds and 2.7 assists per matchup ... Ellerbee averaged 16.5 points, five boards, 3.5 assists and two steals in Thiel's contests with Westminster and Franciscan last week ... On the year, he has posted at least 10 points in 14-of-19 games.

**CONSISTENT KHAMARI** -- **Khamari Accursio-Harris** is averaging 12.7 points and 6.7 rebounds across Thiel's last three games ... He has reached double-figure points in the last three games and 4 of the last 5 contests ... He leads the team in rebounds per game (6.4) and offensive boards per game (2.6).

**BYE BYE BISON** -- Thiel topped Bethany 83-72 in their first matchup this season on Dec. 10 ... Four Tomcats scored in double figures in the win ... Gonzalez logged a career- and team-best 20 points on 8-of-12 from the field and 3-of-4 at the line ... Along with Gonzalez, **Rob Thomas** (19 points), Ellerbee (13) and **Mike Brown** (11) all reached double-digit points ... As a team, Thiel had season bests in made free throws (18-of-20), points (83) and assists (16).

GOOD BETHANY, BAD BETHANY -- Bethany scores the most points per game (85.0) in the conference ... Bethany also allows the most points per game (88.7) in the league ... The Bison attempt the most 3-pointers (665) in the league with Chatham (489) as the next closest ... The Bison also shoot the second worst (31.1 percent) from deep of any PAC team ... Bethany leads the PAC in rebounds per game (42.8) ... Bethany is also second to last in opponent rebounds per game (40.0).

**LOYOLA MARYMOUNT YOU ARE NOT** -- Bethany plays a run-and-gun style of play reminiscent of the Paul Westhead-coached Loyola Marymount teams of the late 80s and early 90s ... Deffensively, expect the Bison to pressure full-court for nearly the entire game ... Offensively, expect quick shots and a bargage of 3-pointers.

**PAC TOURNEY OUTLOOK** -- Thiel is on the outside looking in as the PAC Championship Tournament field takes shape ... Thiel is 2.5 games back of Geneva for the sixth and final seed ... Chatham (14-1) occupies the top spot while Saint Vincent (11-3), Washington and Jefferson (11-4) and Grove City (10-5) are battling for the second seed and a bye into the semifinals ... Franciscan (8-7) and Geneva (7-7) hold the final two spots ... Allegheny (5-9) is at seventh and sits a half game ahead of Thiel and Waynesburg (5-10).

**SERIES STATS** -- Bethany leads the all-time series 95-52 with current records dating back to the 1950-51 season ... The Tomcats took the first known series meeting 71-66 in Greenville, Pa. ... The Blue and Gold have won the last six meetings dating back to the 2021-22 season, which is the programs longest winning streak in the series ... In the last six matchups, Thiel is averaging 80 points and winning by an average margin of 10.7 points ... Since 2010, Thiel holds a 16-14 series edge ... Bethany is 3-0 in meetings that take place on Feb. 5.
