GAME NOTES

RECAPPING DAY ONE -- Allegheny secured a 3-2 win over **Bethany** in Game A ... **Thiel** collected a 3-2 victory over Geneva in Game B ... Grove City blanked Allegheny 7-0 in Game C ... Westminster rolled to a five-inning 11-0 win over **Thiel** in Game D.

WHAT'S ON TAP TODAY -- Geneva battles Allegheny at 10 a.m. in an elimination game ... **Thiel** and **Bethany** clash in another elimination game at noon ... Westminster and Grove City go head to head in the winners bracket championship at 2 p.m. ... The winners of Geneva vs. Allegheny and **Thiel** vs. **Bethany** will collide in Game H with a spot in the losers bracket championship up for grabs.

STEHLIK SAVES THE DAY -- With the tying run on first with two outs in the seventh of yesterdays battle with Geneva, Molly Shelley came to the dish and roped a deep drive into left center where **Jensen Stehlik** made a diving over-the-shoulder grab to secure the final out and seal the 3-2 win.

WHAT A WIN -- **Dani Ficeti** clubbed her first homer of the year in the first inning of the win over Geneva to put Thiel ahead 2-0 ... The Blue and Gold plated an insurance run on a **Makenna Oswalt** sac fly in the sixth to make it 3-0 ... Geneva plated two in the bottom of the sixth to make it 3-2 before Stehlik saved the day in the seventh to clinch the win.

LANDIS VS. WISE PT. 2 -- Thiel's **Becca Landis** and Bethany's **Josie Wise** will almost certainly take the circle for their respective clubs in this do-or-die game ... The two battled exactly one month ago and Landis emerged victorious as she K'd a then-career-high 13 Bison in the 4-1 win ... **Mackenzie Herman** provided all the offense Thiel needed in the win as she mashed a pair of long balls.

LANDIS AND WISE: CREME DE LA CREME OF THE PAC -- Landis is the PAC leader with 150 strikeouts while Wise is second with 142 ... Landis is sixth in ERA at 2.06 while Wise is eighth at 2.68 ... Landis has twirled a conference-high-tying six shutouts and Wise has tossed one ... Wise is first in the PAC in innings (146.1) while Landis is second (136.0) ... The Tomcats' righty is second in batting average against (.211) as the Bison hurler is eighth (.255) ... Landis has a league-best 16 complete games and Wise has 15 ... Wise leads the PAC in wins (17) while Landis is tied for fifth (12).

FINDING WAYS TO WIN -- Thiel's 17 wins are the programs most since 2019 when they collected 19 victories ... The 2019 cadre of Cats reached the PAC Championship but were bested by top seed Saint Vincent 7-0 and 7-4 in the if necessary game.

STOP THE STAMPEDE -- Bethany leads the PAC with 136 stolen bases, which is 41 higher than Geneva (95), who is second ... The Bison are tied for the conference lead with 17 roundtrippers.

HEY HEID WHERE'S KELSO? -- **Kylie Heid** is eighth in the PAC with a .639 slugging percentage ... She is tied for the league lead with six triples ... She sits in the top 20 in doubles (10) and is tied for sixth with five long balls.

TAKE THE UNDER -- Landis has worked at least six innings 14 times this season ... Opponents have scored 4 or more runs just five times in that stretch ... Landis has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in each of her last six appearances, three of which have been shutouts ... In those last six appearances, she has K'd 52 in 44 innings.
