ON THE ROAD AGAIN -- Thiel has won 165 road games in program history.

WEEK 2 WOES -- Thiel is seeking its first week 2 victory since Sept. 12, 2009, a 20-10 win over Albion.

SERIES HISTORY... OR LACK THEREOF -- Saturday's clash between Thiel and Adrian will be the first in program history.

GREENVILLE VS. THE STATE OF MICHIGAN -- Thiel is 1-4 all-time in matchups in the state of Michigan ... The lone win came over Albion in 2007 (13-10) ... Thiel is 3-8 all-time in showdowns against teams from Michigan, owning a 2-4 record against Albion and a 1-4 mark versus Wayne State.

HONORING THE GREATS -- Thiel will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 2005 PAC Championship team on Oct. 11 against Geneva ... The 2005 Tomcats went a perfect 10-0 in the regular season as they qualified for the NCAA Playoffs for the first time in program history ... Thiel toppled Johns Hopkins 28-3 in round one before falling to Bridgewater 24-13 in the second round.

ON THE BIG STAGE -- Thiel's week 3 matchup at Allegheny will be broadcast on SportsNet Pittsburgh ... Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

BY THE NUMBERS -- Thiel has won three PAC Championships (1967, 1972, 2005) ... The Tomcats have produced 40 All-Americans in their 119 seasons ... The Blue and Gold have placed 469

players on All-PAC teams in their 66 seasons in the conference.

THIS DAY IN THIEL HISTORY

MORGAN MAKES HISTORY -- **Clyde Morgan** tied the Thiel record for longest kickoff return with his 97-yard house call versus Allegheny on Sept. 13, 1997.

THE STREAK BEGINS -- Thiel's program record 15-game winning streak began on Sept. 13, 1941 with a 22-0 triumph in Greenville over Lock Haven ... Thiel went on to cap an unblemished 7-0 season before World War II halted games from 1942-45 ... The Tomcats posted a second straight 7-0 campaign in 1946 ... Thiel opened the 1947 season with its 15th straight win, a 19-7 triumph over Alliance, before falling 8-7 versus Hiram to end the streak.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

MJ SHINES UNDER THE LIGHT -- **Matt Jordan** made a career- and game-best 13 tackles in week 1 ... Seven of his tackles were solo stops ... Jordan added one pass breakup in the defeat ... Jordan was named a Player to Watch for the 2025 season in addition to making the PAC Weekly Honor Roll on defense following week 1.

BLOOMIN' 'CROSS THE FIELD -- **Chris Bloomfield** set career highs in tackles (11) and tackles for loss (3.0) in week 1 versus Concordia (Wis.) ... His 3.0 TFL's resulted in a loss of 7 yards ... All 11 of Bloomfield's tackles were solo stops ... He added one pass breakup.

D-LONG MAKIN' PLAYS -- Bethany transfer **Devin Long** made a collegiate career-high 12 tackles last week ... He tallied eight solo stops and four assisted tackles.

AHEM, IT'S AHERN -- **Dylan Ahern** accounted for a career-best 1.5 tackles for loss against Concordia (Wis.) in week 1 ... He also made a career-high five tackles in the defeat.

TFL MACHINES -- Thiel racked up 6.0 tackles for loss last week to CUW's 3.0 ... Thiel's TFL resulted in 10 yards lost.

BIG BADGER ENERGY -- **Jake Badger** made eight tackles in week 1 ... He has produced six career performances with at least eight tackles ... Badger set a career high with 13 tackles in last seasons 21-7 win over Allegheny on Oct. 12 ... He tallied a career-best 3.0 tackles for loss at Bethany, a 30-23 Tomcats win, on Nov. 16 last season.

He led the team in sacks (3.5) last season and was third on the team with 5.5 tackles for loss .. Mittner made 23 tackles (12 solo) on the year to go with two QB hits ... He blocked one PAT.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMIN'S -- **Jaylen Benjamin** set career highs in receptions (six) and receiving yards (77) in week 1's clash with Concordia (Wis.) ... Benjamin brought in a 28-yard pitch and catch in the fourth quarter for the longest reception of his career ... He averaged 12.8 yards per reception ... Benjamin's 77 receiving yards were the seventh most in a Thiel season opener since 2001 ... Benjamin was named to the PAC Offensive Weekly Honor Roll for his performance.

D-LO IN THE FLESH -- **Deon Logan** returns as the leader in the Tomcats backfield in 2025 ... He was named a Player to Watch by the PAC for the upcoming year ... He was an All-PAC Honorable Mention selection in 2024 ... Last season, he finished fourth in the PAC and posted a team-leading career best in total rushing yards (628) ... He led the Tomcats in rushing attempts (154), rushing TD's (five) and yards per carry (4.1) ... Logan averaged 62.8 rushing yards per game, which was also a career best and good for fifth in the conference ... Logan's 24 points (4 TD's) at Bethany on Nov. 16 are tied for the fourth most in a game in team history.

The 2005 Tomcats continued their record-setting season with a 42-0 walloping of Bluffton in week 2. Darrell Satterfield connected with Brandon Chambers for a 22-yard TD on the opening drive while Steve Minton had a pair of first-half rushing scores from 2 and 3 yards, respectively. Thiel added one more score before the half to carry a 28-0 lead into the break. The Tomcats added 14 more points in just over a minute in the fourth quarter as Robert Hughes had a 41-yard blocked punt return TD and Minton ran in his third score of the game to spell the 42-0 final.

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
