

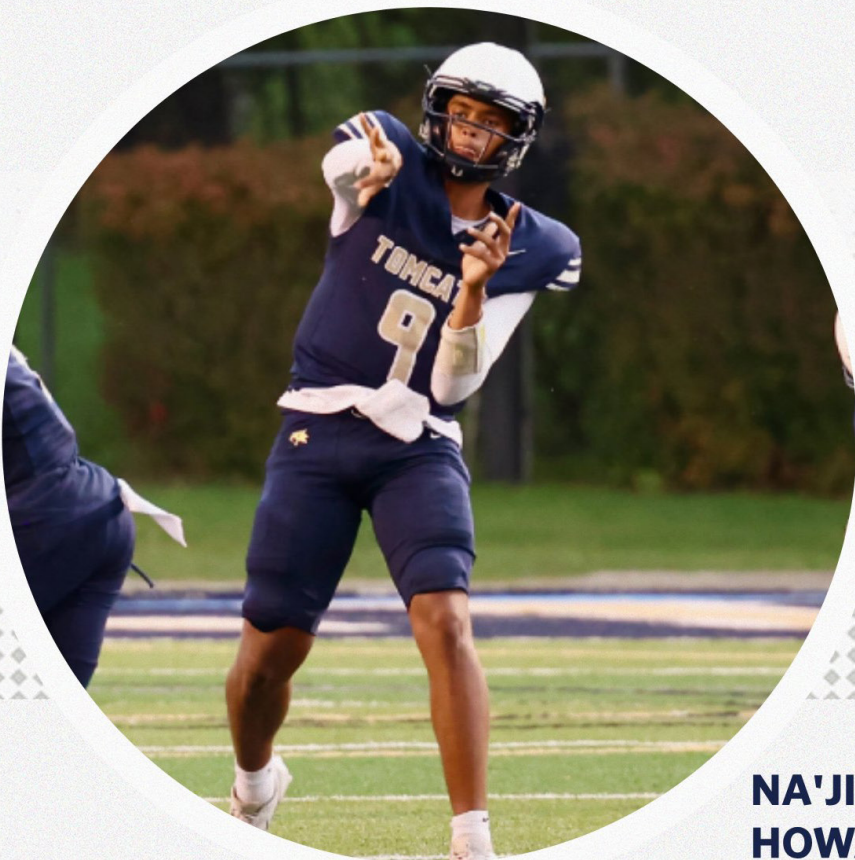

TEAM NOTES

120 YEARS STRONG -- Thiel is in its 120th season of Football in 2025 ... The Tomcats own a 365-581-35 all-time record.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN -- Thiel has won 165 road games in program history.

HONORING THE GREATS -- Thiel will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 2005 PAC Championship team on Oct. 11 against Geneva ... The 2005 Tomcats went a perfect 10-0 in the regular season as they qualified for the NCAA Playoffs for the first time in program history ... Thiel toppled Johns Hopkins 28-3 in round one before falling to Bridgewater 24-13 in the second round.

BY THE NUMBERS -- Thiel has won three PAC Championships (1967, 1972, 2005) ... The Tomcats have produced 40 All-Americans in their 119 seasons ... The Blue and Gold have placed 469 players on All-PAC teams in their 66 seasons in the conference.

PAC OPENERS -- Thiel is seeking its first PAC opener win since 2017 when they rolled past Bethany 28-13 on the road.

SERIES NOTES

TAKIN' A TRIP IN THE WAY BACK MACHINE -- Thiel and Allegheny first met in 1893 during the second, non-consecutive term of President Grover Cleveland ... A dozen Grade A eggs cost approximately 21 cents at the time, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics ... The first meeting came during the papacy of Leo XIII ... At the time of the first meeting, American sugar planters in Hawaii overthrew the Hawaiian monarch, Queen Liliuokalani, with the support of American business interests.

TOP SERIES PERFORMANCES -- Clyde Morgan had a 97-yard kickoff return TD against the Gators in 1997, which is tied for the longest in team lore ... Dennis Scott logged a program-long 97-yard fumble return TD versus Allegheny in 1974 ... Daniel Rennie connected with Blake Joseph for a 95-yard score, the second longest receiving play in Thiel history, in last seasons 21-7 victory.

SERIES STATS -- Allegheny holds a slight 35-43-6 edge in the series ... Thiel won the first eight meetings, outscoring Allegheny 102-6 while posting seven shutouts ... The Tomcats took three straight in the series from 2014-16 and snapped a four-game series skid with last seasons 21-7 triumph at Alumni Stadium.

THIS DAY IN THIEL HISTORY

CHAMBERS THE GOAT -- Brandon Chambers hauled in a program-record 283 receiving yards on eight grabs in Thiel's 35-7 thrashing of Bluffton in 2003 ... Chambers had three touchdown grabs in the win, which is tied for the third most in a game in program history.

GAME NOTES

ETCHED INTO ETERNITY -- In the same victory over Bluffton, Thiel's defense made a single-game program-record 19 tackles for loss ... **Ken Peterson** had a game-best 4.0 while **Jonathon Howson** and **Kyle Brown** each had 3.0.

KICKERS ARE PEOPLE TOO -- **John Madeline** drilled a 43-yard field goal, the third longest in team history, in the Tomcats' clash with W&J at Alumni Stadium.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

MJ MAKIN' MOVES -- **Matt Jordan** made a career- and game-best 13 tackles in week 1 versus Concordia (Wis.) ... Seven of his tackles were solo stops ... Jordan added one pass breakup in the defeat ... Jordan posted a game-leading eight tackles (seven solo) at Adrian last week ... Jordan leads Thiel with 21 tackles on the young season.

D-LONG, D-TERMINATOR -- **Devin Long** made a career-best 1.5 tackles for loss at Adrian last week ... He posted 12 tackles (eight solo) in week 1 against Concordia (Wis.).

BIG BADGER ENERGY -- **Jake Badger** made eight tackles in week 1 ... He followed that up with seven tackles (five solo) and 0.5 TFL's last week ... He has produced six career performances with at least eight tackles ... Badger set a career high with 13 tackles in last seasons 21-7 win over Allegheny on Oct. 12 ... He tallied a career-best 3.0 tackles for loss at Bethany, a 30-23 Tomcats win, on Nov. 16 last season.

TFL'S FOR DAYS -- **Joshua Daniel** made a career-pacing 2.0 tackles for loss, totaling 5 yards, at Adrian in week 2 ... Daniel totaled six tackles (two solo) in the non-conference affair.

TAKIN' A CHOMP OUT OF THE GATORS -- In all 35 Thiel wins over Allegheny, the Thiel defense has held the Gators to 22 or fewer points ... Allegheny has mustered no more than two touchdowns in 5 of the last 7 Thiel series wins ... Of Thiel's 35 wins, nearly half (17) have been shutouts ... From 1897-1941, all 11 Thiel series wins were shutouts ... 15

of the first 17 Thiel series wins were also shutouts.

GATOR HUNTIN' SZN -- The Thiel D held Allegheny to 46 passing yards on 5-of-20 in last seasons win ... The Gators mustered just over 200 yards of total offense (208) in the two-touchdown defeat ... Allegheny was held to a 21.4 percent clip (3-of-14) on third downs in the defeat.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMIN'S -- **Jaylen Benjamin** set career highs in receptions (six) and receiving yards (77) in week 1's clash with Concordia (Wis.) ... Benjamin brought in a 28-yard pitch and catch in the fourth quarter for the longest reception of his career ... He averaged 12.8 yards per reception ... Benjamin's 77 receiving yards were the seventh most in a Thiel season opener since 2001 ... Benjamin was named to the PAC Offensive Weekly Honor Roll for his performance.

D-LO -- **Deon Logan** is the leader in the Tomcats backfield in 2025 ... He was named a Player to Watch by the PAC for the 2025 season ... He was an All-PAC Honorable Mention selection in 2024 ... Last season, he finished fourth in the PAC and posted a team-leading career best in total rushing yards (628) ... He led the Tomcats in rushing attempts (154), rushing TD's (five) and yards per carry (4.1) ... Logan averaged 62.8 rushing yards per game, which was also a career best and good for fifth in the conference ... Logan's 24 points (4 TD's) at Bethany on Nov. 16 are tied for the fourth most in a game in team history ... He rushed for 93 yards on 24 carries in last seasons matchup with the Gators.

RUNNIN' WILD -- **Jayveerh White** recorded a 95-yard kickoff return TD in week 11 at Bethany last season ... The return is tied for the fifth longest in program history ... It was the longest kickoff return in Thiel history since 2017 when Darian Mosley housed a 96-yarder against Case Western Reserve ... White was named a Player to Watch by the PAC for the 2025 year ... White had four kickoff returns last week for 101 yards with a long of 38.

Thiel climbed to 3-0 on an overcast and humid 80-degree Saturday afternoon at Alumni Stadium with a stymying defensive performance that featured nine sacks, a program single-game record that still stands 20 years later. Kevin Strouse accounted for four of the sacks while Chris Lorber added a pair. Steve Minton paced the run game with 91 yards on 16 carries and two TD's while Dan Hess added 66 yards on 15 touches and a TD. Marc LaScoloa made six catches for 104 yards, with 53 coming on a touchdown grab from Darrell Satterfield in the third quarter.

SAM BAUMAN

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
