TEAM NOTES

120 YEARS STRONG -- Thiel is in its 120th season of Football in 2025 ... The Tomcats own a 365-582-35 all-time record.

IN GREENVILLE -- Thiel holds a 200-266-18 all-time record in Greenville ... The Tomcats have won 35 games at Alumni Stadium all time.

HONORING THE GREATS -- Thiel will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 2005 PAC Championship team on Oct. 11 against Geneva ... The 2005 Tomcats went a perfect 10-0 in the regular season as they qualified for the NCAA Playoffs for the first time in program history ... Thiel toppled Johns Hopkins 28-3 in round one before falling to Bridgewater 24-13 in the second round.

BY THE NUMBERS -- Thiel has won three PAC Championships (1967, 1972, 2005) ... The Tomcats have produced 40 All-Americans in their 119 seasons ... The Blue and Gold have placed 469 players on All-PAC teams in their 66 seasons in the conference.

SERIES NOTES

1913 ... NOT SO GREAT -- Thiel and Waynesburg first met in 1913 during the presidency of Woodrow Wilson , the 28th U.S. President ... The 16th Amendment, which established federal income tax, was ratified in 1913 ... The 17th Amendment, which allowed for the direct election of U.S. Senators, replacing the previous system of appointment by state legislatures, was also ratified ... Raja Harishchandra, the first full-length feature film in India, a silent movie, was released.

TOP SERIES PERFORMANCES -- **Ryan Radke** produced the greatest passing performance in team history with a program-record 391 yards on 17-of-27 with three TD's in a 50-42 win in 2016 ... **Willie Bova** and **Brendan Taylor** set program records for completions (37) and receptions (17), respectively, against the Yellow Jackets in 2009 ... Taylor hauled in 216 receiving yards in the battle, the fourth most in school history.

SERIES STATS -- Saturday's meeting will be the 46th all-time meeting between the two schools ... Waynesburg leads the series 34-10-1 ... The Jackets hold a slight 14-8-1 edge in contests coming in Greenville.

NICE -- Thiel scored a 69-0 win over Waynesburg on Nov. 11, 1916 ... The 69 points are the second most in a game in Thiel history.

COMING HOME HAPPY -- Saturday's matchup is Homecoming ... The Tomcats bested the Yellow Jackets 15-14 in their last Homecoming meeting in 2023.

RECAPING THE LAST DUB -- The Tomcats posted a come-from-behind victory over the Jackets in 2023 ... **Joey Fell** capped a 19-play, 80-yard drive that took 8:48 off the clock with a 6-yard TD run with 2:08 left to put Thiel ahead ... The Tomcats defense forced a fumble on the ensuing Waynesburg drive to seal the win ... Waynesburg mustered just 209 yards of total offense in the loss.

TAKIN' THE STING OUTTA THE JACKETS -- Thiel has limited Waynesburg to 14 or less points in 7-of-10 all-time series wins.

DO YOU REMEMBER SEPTEMBER? -- Saturday's meeting will be the 10th all-time September meeting between the two schools ... Thiel's lone September dub came in 2023.

THIS DAY IN THIEL HISTORY

FALL OF '69 -- **John Gibson** set Thiel records for points (30) and receiving touchdowns (five) in Thiel's 46-22 win at Carnegie Mellon on Sept. 27, 1969 ... Gibson made 14 grabs for 201 yards in the win ... **Patsy Combine** threw a school-record six touchdowns in the victory over the Tartans.

WE WENT STREAKING -- Thiel notched the last victory of its program-record 15-game winning streak over Alliance (19-7) in 1947.

7-7 ON 9-27 -- Thiel holds a 7-7 record in games played on Sept. 27 ... Thiel has dropped its last four Sept. 27 affairs ... The Tomcats last 9/27 win came in 1986 over John Carroll (12-7).

TAKE IT TO THE HAASE -- **William Haase** made 4.0 tackles for loss against Geneva on Sept. 27, 2008 at Alumni Stadium.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

AIR JORDAN -- **Matt Jordan** made a career- and game-best 13 tackles in week 1 versus Concordia (Wis.) ... Seven of his tackles were solo stops ... Jordan added one pass breakup in the defeat ... Jordan posted a game-leading eight tackles (seven solo) at Adrian in week 2 ... Jordan made six stops (three solo) at Allegheny last week ... He leads Thiel with 27 tackles.

D-LONG, D-TERMINATOR -- **Devin Long** made a career-best 1.5 tackles for loss at Adrian in week 2 ... He posted 12 tackles (eight solo) in week 1 against Concordia (Wis.) while making five tackles (three solo) at Allegheny last week.

DIXIELAND DELIGHT -- **Robert Dixie** made a career-best 11 tackles (eight solo) at Allegheny last week ... He added 1.0 TFL and one fumble recovery against the Gators.

BIG BADGER ENERGY -- **Jake Badger** made eight tackles in week 1 ... He followed that up with seven tackles (five solo) and 0.5 TFL's at Adrian ... Badger made nine tackles (five solo) against Allegheny last week ... He has produced seven career performances with at least eight tackles ... Badger set a career high with 13 tackles in last seasons 21-7 win over Allegheny on Oct. 12 ... He tallied a career-best 3.0 tackles for loss at Bethany, a 30-23 Tomcats win, on Nov. 16 last season.

JD MAKIN' AN IMPACT -- **Joshua Daniel** made a career-pacing 2.0 tackles for loss, totaling 5 yards, at Adrian in week 2 ... Daniel totaled six tackles (two solo) in the non-conference affair ... He logged three solo stops, 1.0 TFL and one forced fumble last week.

TFL MACHINES -- Thiel made a season-best 8.0 tackles for loss last week ... **Alexander Miltner**

had a game-best 2.0 with a sack ... **Mekhi Carroll** had a sack as well ... **Adrian Bohinski**, **Dixie**, **Daniel**, **Jordan** and **Brian White** each had 1.0 TFL in the clash.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMIN'S -- **Jaylen Benjamin** set career highs in receptions (six) and receiving yards (77) in week 1's clash with Concordia (Wis.) ... Benjamin brought in a 28-yard pitch and catch in the fourth quarter for the longest reception of his career ... He averaged 12.8 yards per reception ... Benjamin's 77 receiving yards were the seventh most in a Thiel season opener since 2001 ... Benjamin was named to the PAC Offensive Weekly Honor Roll for his performance.

D-LO VS. THE WU -- **Deon Logan's** top two career rushing performances in terms of yards both came against Waynesburg ... He totaled 113 yards in 2021 and 148 yards last season ... In three career appearances against the Yellow Jackets, Logan is averaging 100.3 rushing yards per game and 7.3 yards per carry.

DUNBAR FOR PRESIDENT -- **Riley Dunbar** made a career-high-tying four catches at Allegheny last week ... He amassed a career-best 52 receiving yards in the defeat.

SCORING DROUGHT -- Thiel has not put points on the board in 125:09 of game action, with their last score coming with 2:10 remaining in week 1 ... The streak is the longest since the 2023-24 campaigns when Thiel did not score in 173:08 from week 10 in 2023 til the third quarter in week 2 of the following season.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

RUNNIN' WILD -- **Jayveerh White** recorded a 95-yard kickoff return TD in week 11 at Bethany last season ... The return is tied for the fifth longest in program history ... It was the longest kickoff return in Thiel history since 2017 when **Darien Mosley** housed a 96-yarder against Case Western Reserve ... White was named a Player to Watch by the PAC for the 2025 year ... White had four kickoff returns last week for 101 yards with a long of 38.

Thiel overcame a 14-point first-quarter deficit with a 21-point second quarter to lead by 7 at the break. W&J carried a 27-21 lead into the fourth quarter before the Tomcats took the lead on a Steve Minton 21-yard TD and Sammy Koyl PAT. Thiel added to the lead on a Zjaque Douglas pick-6 to make it 35-27. The Presidents knotted things at 35 with a score and 2-point conversion in the final five minutes to send the game to overtime. W&J got the ball first in OT and was promptly picked off by Darius Thompson on their second play, setting up the game-winning 22-yard field goal from Koyl to push the Cardiac Cats to 4-0 on the year.

HEAD COACH

Sam Bauman is entering his fourth season as head football coach at Thiel College in 2025.

Under his leadership, the Tomcats snapped a 41-game losing streak and have posted seven wins in the past three seasons, the same amount the program won in the prior six seasons combined.

Bauman led the Tomcats to three wins in 2023 and 2024, the most since the 2016 team won four games.

Through his guidance, 17 Tomcats have garnered All-PAC honors, 47 have made the PAC Academic Honor Roll and 16 have been named to the CSC Academic All-District team.

Bauman was the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster from 2013-21. He served as the team's defensive coordinator from 2015-21 and was the special teams coordinator in 2013 and 2014.

Bauman was part of a new coaching staff at the College of Wooster in 2013 that took a two-win team in 2012 to seven wins in 2013. The 2013 team ranked fifth in the nation in Division III in turnover margin (+16).

In 2015 and 2021, Bauman's defense ranked in the top 20 in forced fumbles. In 2019, the team ranked third in the country in red zone defense and 24th in scoring defense.

Bauman began his coaching career in 2010 as the assistant defensive backs coach at the University of Chicago, a position he held for two seasons. He also spent two seasons at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology as the team's linebackers coach. He also served as the head junior varsity coach and video coordinator at Rose-Hulman.

Bauman received a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in coaching from Indiana State University. He earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Beloit College.
