St. Thomas Women's Hockey to face Lindenwood for first time in program history

The Tommies play their first true two-game road series since Oct. 29-30 at RIT in Rochester, N.Y.

Inaugural Campaign

- St. Thomas enters its first season of competition at the NCAA Division I level
- The team previously played at the division iii level before making the jump to Division I
- The Tommies are being led by a new coaching staff, with head coach Joel Johnson being hired in early June
- Johnson brings more than 20 years of coach experience to st. thomas
- Johnson has coached at the collegiate level as well as with usa women's hockey

Breaking Down the Roster

- St. Thomas has 12 newcomers on its roster
- Three of the 12 newcomers are transfers and nine are incoming freshmen
- The Tommies return 11 student-athletes from the previous season

Tommies Schedule Talk

- the Tommies play a 32-game schedule in 2021-22
- 28 of the 32 contests will come against WCHA opponents
- St. Thomas will also play non-conference games at RIT and at Lindenwood

Promersberger Breaks the Ice

- Abby Promersberger scored the inaugural goal in team NCAA DI-era history in a 4-1 loss at Ohio State on Sept. 25
- Anna Solheim and Megan Cornell added the first two assists in St. Thomas Division I history on Promersberger's goal

Did you Know?

- The team has played six games that have been decided by two points or less this season. The Tommies are 4-1-1 in such games.
- 11 different skaters have now scored a goal for St. Thomas.

The Tommies in NCAA Stats

- The Women rank 13th in the nation for Penalty Kill Percentage (.894)
- Fifth for team saves with 575 (35.9 per game)

Shooters Shoot

- When finishing with 30 or more shots as a team, the Tommies are 2-1-0
- The team's season-high shot output of 38 came in a 3-1 win at RIT on Oct. 29

Last Time Out

- The Tommies were swept by Minnesota State, losing 3-1 in the first game, and 3-0 in the second.
- After trailing 2-1 for a majority of the third period in game one, the Mavs tacked on a late empty-net goal to seal the win
- Junior forward Jenna Hartung scored the lone goal of the series for St. Thomas. The assist on Hartung's goal came from freshman defenseman Alli Pahl.

- Freshman goaltender Saskia Maurer made 28 saves in game one and senior goalie Alexa Dobchuk followed up with 37 saves in game two for the Tommies.
- Maurer has made 28 or more saves in all but one contest this season.

Matching Up with the Lions

- This weekend marks the first meeting between the two opponents
- Last time out, the Lions earned a two-game sweep of RIT
- The Tommies also have swept RIT this season
- Sierra Burt tallied a goal and an assist in the 4-1 game one win over the Tigers
- In the second game, a 3-1 win for Lindenwood, the lions received two goals from Maddison Stitt and two assists from Megan Wagner
- Lindenwood's only other victory in 2021-22 came at home against Syracuse on Oct. 23

Did You Know?

In fall 2021 St. Thomas became the first institution to make a direct move in all sports in one season from NCAA Division III into D-I athletics. The Tommies have 18 sports that compete in The Summit League; football in the Pioneer Football League; the WCHA for women's hockey; and the Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) for men's hockey.

The Toms were a charter member of the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (MIAC) in 1920. In May 2019 they were involuntarily removed from the conference, as league presidents cited "competitive athletic parity." The y ended their D-II era last June.

St. Thomas won 16 national team championships in eight different sports, all in a 40-year span since 1981. Purple teams posted 30 national top-two team finishes in 11 different sports.

New Staff

The Tommies' new coaching staff starts with head coach Joel Johnson, who was hired last June. Johnson brings more than 20 years of coaching experience, both at the collegiate level as well as with USA Women's Hockey. A Minnesota native and former student-athlete and later a men's hockey head coach at Bethel University, Johnson spent the last 11 seasons at the University of Minnesota as the Associate Head Coach for the women's program. He helped guide the Gophers to six national titles and 11 Frozen Fours. Johnson is also currently serving as the head coach for the U.S. Women's Hockey National team for the 2022 Winter Games set for Beijing, China.

Johnson's staff consists of two full-time assistant coaches: Bethany Brausen and Marty Sertich. Brausen, a Little Canada, Minn., native and two-time captain at the University of Minnesota, coached with Johnson the last five seasons at Minnesota as assistants on the staff of head coach Brad Frost. Sertich, a Roseville, Minn., native and former Hobey Baker award winner at Colorado College, served as an assistant coach at St. Thomas for the last four years.

Also joining the staff is Alli Borgstrom as the Direct of Operations. Borgstrom played for the Tommies from 2014 to 2018, in which she was a three-time All-MIAC honoree, MIAC Player of the Year, and a second team All-American.
