## BREAKING DOWN THE TOMMIES

### LAST TIME OUT | CHICAGO STATE

The Tommies broke a 10-10 tie midway through the first half behind three straight 3-pointers, which led to the squad shooting 7-of-16 from behind the line in the first half. The bench contributed over half the points (17) of a 30-25 halftime lead. The Purple pushed the lead to eight again before the Cougars went on a run of 11-4 to climb within one, 43-42. Graduate student Brooks Allen scored 11 points during a 23-8, game-closing run over the final nine minutes, including two of the team's five 3-pointers over that span to extend its winning streak to three games.

### THE CAST | AT CHICAGO STATE

Allen and junior Ben Nau scored 17 points each to lead the Tommies, the total matching Allen's season high while Nau set a career high. The duo combined to make nine of the team's 13 3-pointers, the second most by the unit this season. Graduate student Raheem Anthony set a season high with eight assists and led the Purple with five rebounds. Senior Drake Dobbs scored seven points and dished out six assists, with only one turnover, to go along with one steal.

### JOINING ELITE COMPANY

Johnny Tauer became one of five active head coaches among all of NCAA to reach 250 career wins with a .740 winning percentage, all with one program, after the Nov. 19 win over Portland State.

Tauer is also one of 11 active head coaches to reach 250 career wins with a .740 winning percentage at any program.

Since taking over as head coach in 2011, Tauer has averaged 20.5 wins per season heading into 2023-24. He is the fastest to reach 250 career wins in program history, joining Steve Fritz (594-246) and Tom Feely (417-269). Tauer was a senior with Tommie Basketball when Fritz reached the 250-milestone in 1995 and Fritz was a senior for the program when Feely reached the milestone in 1970-71.

## THE OPPOSITION | MARQUETTE

The Marquette Golden Eagles are flying high as they prepare to host St. Thomas, riding momentum of consecutive wins against Notre Dame, 78-59, and No. 12 Texas, 86-65. With an impressive 8-2 record in 10 games, their only losses came against No. 2 Purdue and in-state rivals, Wisconsin.

Fueling Marquette's scoring drive is Kam Jones, leading the charge with an average of 15.1 points per game. Tyler Kolek, hailed as the BIG EAST Player of the Week, showcased stellar performances, averaging 22.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 6.5 assists while boasting an exceptional 70.8 percent shooting accuracy against Notre Dame and Texas. Adding to their arsenal is the imposing 6-11 forward, Oso Ig-hodaro, acclaimed as one of the nation's premier big men.

The Golden Eagles average 79.3 points, securing them the fourth ranked offense in the BIG EAST. Their defensive strength is evident, particularly noteworthy is their 3-point defense, restricting opponents to a mere 34.7 percent shooting accuracy from beyond the arc. Marquette also ranks eighth nationally with a turnover margin of 6.0, giving away 10.0 turnovers per game and totaling 8.6 steals per game.

## SERIES HISTORY

Marquette and St. Thomas are gearing up for their 12th showdown in their series, led 8-3 by MU. St. Thomas claimed victories in 1919-20, when Marquette capped the season at 9-3, again in 1921-22 following Marquette's impressive 14-3 performance in 1920-21 and a strong finish of 15-5 in 1921-22, and once more in 1956-57, all contests hosted at St. Thomas. Marquette won the most recent matchup, 80-45, on Nov. 30, 1977. The Golden Eagles came off the program's lone national championship title to open the 1977-78 season against the Tommies.

## DOCTOR DOCTOR

An NCAA Postgraduate Scholar and Academic All-American honoree, Head Coach Johnny Tauer earned master's and PhD degrees in social psychology at UW-Madison. He returned to St. Thomas as a member of the faculty in 2000 before being promoted to full professor in 2011. Tauer taught for 21 years at St. Thomas and is one of the only head college basketball coaches in the nation to be a tenured faculty member and to hold a doctorate in sport-related psychology. He has published academic work on motivation, goal setting and competition in top academic journals, in addition to a book on youth sports, parents and motivation titled "Why Less is More for WOSPs (Well-Intentioned, Overinvolved Sports Parents); How to Be the Best Sport Parent You Can Be."

## LUCKY 13

Head Coach Johnny Tauer is in his 13th season at St. Thomas as the longest tenured head coach among all Summit League programs and among the top 50 in their current role among all DI men's basketball coaches. He leads league head coaches with a .742 winning percentage and is third in career wins (253).

Tauer's winning percentage of .742 ranks 13th among active head coaches across all of NCAA with at least 10 years of experience. The only head coaches at their current NCAA DI programs for at least 10 seasons with a higher winning percentage than Tauer are John Calipari (Kentucky), Mark Few (Gonzaga), and Bill Self (Kansas).

## SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

Head Coach Johnny Tauer's excellence within the Tommie Men's Basketball program dates back to his days as an Academic All-American that led to his induction to the St. Thomas Athletics Hall of Fame in 2001. As a student-athlete from 1991-95, Tauer was an All-MIAC player, first team All-West Region, and as a senior led the 1994-95 Toms to a school-record 27-0 start, including an MIAC Championship with an unprecedented 20-0 record. He helped the Toms to NCAA DIII Tournament berths in 1992-93, 1993-94, and 1994-95, including a run to the Final Four in 1993-94. Tauer ranks 24th in career scoring (1,219 points) and 22nd in career rebounding (482) at St. Thomas, and was the school 3-point leader until 1999-2000.

After earning master's and PhD degrees at Wisconsin, Tauer joined the Tommie Men's Basketball coaching staff as an assistant coach and ran the St. Thomas defense for two seasons (2001-03) and also directed the Tommies' offensive sets that had consistently ranked among the best in NCAA basketball in overall offensive efficiency, field-goal percentage, 3-point proficiency, fewest turnovers, and assist-to-turnover ratio. With Tauer serving as an assistant, the Toms won the 2010-11 DIII National Championship title, made a run to the 2008-09 Final Four, and totaled seven DIII National Tournament runs.

With the retirement of longtime head coach Steve Fritz in 2011, Tauer took over the program and continued its storied tradition with another national title in 2015-16, a Final Four run in 2012-13, and five DIII National Tournament appearances.

As a student-athlete, assistant coach, and head coach at St. Thomas, Tauer has helped the Tommies to 586 wins in 28 seasons, averaging out to over 20 wins per season. He's been part of 19 conference titles, 15 national tournament appearances, three Final Fours, and two national championships.

## GAME #11: ST. THOMAS at NO. 7 MARQUETTE

## BACK FROM 2022-23

St. Thomas returns 10 letter winners and one redshirt freshman (Carter Bjerke, F), along with four newcomers. Among the newcomers is one transfer (Raheem Anthony, G) and three freshmen. Leading the pack is graduate student forward Parker Bjorklund who was named Preseason All-Summit League First Team. Fellow graduate student forward Brooks Allen also returns after starting all 33 games last season and playing in all 69 games for St. Thomas since joining NCAA Division I. Kendall Blue and Ahjany Lee come back for their sophomore seasons after Blue played in all 33 games, with 22 starts, and Lee played in 32 with four starts.

## POWER FIVE

St. Thomas prepares to play its second game against a Top 10 Big East opponent in as many years after opening the 2022-23 campaign at No. 9 Creighton. The Purple played in front of a crowd of 17,098 and held a 57-56 lead with 9:58 to play, overcoming a 15-point, first-half deficit to the Bluejays before eventually falling. No. 7 Marquette will be the highest ranked opponent and fourth Power Five team played by the Tommies in the Division I era.

The Tommies opened the 2023-24 season at Cal and led by as many as four points late before the Golden Bears closed the game on a 7-2 run. The first Pac-12 opponent for St. Thomas came during a loss at Utah on Nov. 26, 2022 in Salt Lake City, Utah.

## TAKE CARE OF THE BALL

Tauer's teams have historically taken care of the basketball and this season is no different. The Tommies currently rank tied for 42nd nationally in fewest turnovers per game (10.2) after ranking tied for 11th nationally in the fewest total turnovers (327) last season and leading the category in 2021-22. The Purple also tied for 12th for fewest turnovers per game (9.9) and tied for 50th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30) last year. Of the 14 teams with as few or fewer turnovers per game last season, only four (Iowa, NC State, Oral Roberts, Toledo) finished with a higher scoring offense than St. Thomas' 74.2 points per game.

## PREP CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

Five of the Tommies' 15 student-athletes have reached the ultimate pinnacle of their high school prep careers, winning state titles, while COVID brought another imminent title run to a halt. Three others also led their programs to Minnesota State Tournament appearances in Kendall Blue (2018-22) and Courtney Brown, Jr., (2015-19) at East Ridge High School and Adam Tauer (2019-23) at Cretin-Derham Hall.

## HIGH SCHOOL REUNION

Junior Ben Nau returns home to the Badger State for his second collegiate game ever played in Milwaukee, Wis., previously playing in St. Thomas' 76-72 win at UW-Milwaukee on Nov. 23, 2022. Nau will reunite with former teammate and current men's basketball student-athlete at Marquette David Joplin. Nau and Joplin helped Brookfield Central, under the guidance of head coach Dan Wandrey, to its first state championship in 2018-19.

## SUCCESS ON BOTH SIDES

The Purple were the only Summit League team to rank among the top three in both scoring offense (74.2) and scoring defense (70.2). St. Thomas joined South Dakota State as the only two teams in the league to rank among the top four in both 3-point field goal percentage and 3-point field goal percentage defense.

## ALL BUSINESS FOR BJORKLUND

Since joining the Tommies off the intramural courts, it's been all business for Parker Bjorklund as he's averaged double-digit scoring in each of his three seasons and leads the team this season with 13.9 points per game. He put in 12.6 points per game during the program's first DI season in 2021-22 on 54.4 percent shooting from the field. Bjorklund is averaging 13.8 points per game through his career on 52.5 percent shooting, one of two Tommies (Raheem Anthony, 51.8%) with a career field goal percentage above .500 (minimum 250 FGA).

He ranked second in the Summit League last season shooting 49.5 percent from the field and finished 13 games shooting above 50 percent while taking at least seven shots in all but one game. His 15.1 points per game ranked 10th in the Summit League and he's currently fourth among active Summit League student-athletes (min. 30 games) in career scoring average (13.9 PPG).

Bjorklund currently sits at 913 career points in 66 career games and has 375 career rebounds, tied with Brent Longval for 34th all-time at St. Thomas.

## THE 1,500-POINT CLUB

Newcomer Raheem Anthony, a transfer from NCAA DIII Saint Mary's University in Winona, Minn., eclipsed 1,500 career points Dec. 6, 2023 during a 75-71 win over Milwaukee. He was a two-time All-American (NABC, D3hoops.com) in 2022-23 after averaging 24.6 points, 9.2 rebounds, 4.6 assists and 1.5 steals per game, and shooting 54.5 percent from the field. Anthony started all 78 games played in at Saint Mary's and averaged 19.3 points during three games against St. Thomas during the 2019-20 season.

St. Thomas has five members of the 1,500-point club, all besides Anthony scored the entirety of their points in the Purple and Gray. Anthony is the first Tommie to reach the 1,500 mark since Karnell James (1993-97) who finished his career with 1,854. Six Tommies have transferred into the program and ended their careers with at least 1,000 points. He's also at 668 career rebounds, including 620 at Saint Mary's, which ranks 13th at St. Thomas.

Anthony is second on the Tommies with 11.0 points per game and leads with 3.2 assists per game, with at least three assists in seven games this season. He scored a season-high 23 points, a season high among all Tommies, on 7-of-9 shooting to push him over the 1,500 point mark.

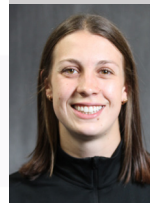

# LEE & PENNY ANDERSON ARENA



The Lee and Penny Anderson Arena will be the new home for Tommie Men's and Women's Basketball. Located on the University's South Campus in St. Paul, the arena will also include state-of-the-art practice facilities. The Lee & Penny Anderson Arena is scheduled to open in fall 2025.



A \$75-million gift from Lee and Penny Anderson surpasses a previous \$60-million donation made by the Andersons in 2007 for the construction of the Anderson Student Center, Anderson Athletic & Recreation Center, and Anderson Parking Facility. At that time, the gift was the largest-ever single donation made to any university in Minnesota. In addition to being the largest gift in St. Thomas' 138-year history, this latest donation is the ninth-largest gift to college athletics nationally.

In total, the Andersons have donated nearly \$140 million – including multiple gifts to scholarships and in support for veterans resources – to the mission-driven, Catholic university. Lee and Penny Anderson's most recent contribution to the University of St. Thomas has launched the campaign for the Lee & Penny Anderson Arena.







## The Tauer File

Johnny Tauer built a elite Division III program over his first 10 seasons, and now he's busy leading his program's historic transition into Division I basketball.

Tauer, who is on pace to coach his 350th game with the Tommies this season, is entering his 13th year as head coach of St. Thomas men's basketball team in 2023-24. That puts him first in tenure among the nine Summit League head coaches at their schools, and in the top 50 for longevity in their current role among all D-I men's basketball coaches.

An elite group welcomed Tauer into the mix following his 250th win Nov. 19, 2023 against Portland State. Not only did he become the fastest in program history to reach 250 career wins, but he also became one of five active head coaches among all of NCAA to reach the milestone with a winning percentage of at least .740, all at one school.

Tauer's basketball playing success here from 1991-95 led to his induction into the Tommie Athletics Hall of Fame. He joins Tommie women's hoops head coach Ruth Sinn to put St. Thomas on a short list of only five D-I institutions that feature alumni in both of their basketball head coaching roles.

Tauer's Tommies took a big step forward during the 2022-23 season. In moving from 10 wins in season one to 19 victories last season, the Purple had a strong finish to the season that included the program's first NCAA Division I postseason victory. After entering the 2022-23 season picked to finish eighth in the Summit League Preseason Coaches' Poll, Tauer led the Tommies to a fourth place finish and a run to the semifinals of the league's postseason tournament. The Purple nearly doubled their win total from the previous season, finishing with a 19-14 record overall and a 9-9 mark in the Summit League. Additionally, St. Thomas went 12-2 at Schoenecker Arena to rank among the top 25 percent of NCAA D-I teams in home win percentage.

The Toms' national rating by Ken Pom improved 102 spots from 305 at the end of 2021-22 to 203 at the end of 2022-23, in the top six-percent of improvement among all D-I MBB programs. Tauer's squad took 30-win Oral Roberts to the wire in the Summit League playoff semifinals, losing 70-65. The Purple beat eight of the Summit League opponents at least once. They also took a road victory at 21-win UW-Milwaukee; beat 20-win Troy; and split with 19-win South Dakota State. The Toms also beat an 18-win Merrimack team that won its conference championship. They played two Power 5 teams on the road: Against nationally-ranked Creighton, a 21-win team thus far, the Purple played the Bluejays even for 30 minutes before losing by 12. The Toms also lost to a 17-win Utah team. A quick comparison with other recent reclassifying universities provides more good signs for the Tommies. Of the 50 schools to reclassify into D-I over the last 25 years, in men's basketball, St. Thomas has the second-best improvement from year one to year two – plus-9 wins (10-20 to 19-14).

Tauer coached two 2022-23 All-Summit League honorees in Andrew Rohde and Parker Bjorklund. Rohde also was named the Freshman of the Year and made the All-Summit League Newcomer Team. From year one to year two of the NCAA Division I era, Tauer and the Tommies improved by six conference wins, had a plus-five point scoring margin, doubled its block total, and improved its 3-point field goal defense in conference play by nearly 10 percent. St. Thomas' first postseason victory of the D-I era came in a 67-60 win over Western Illinois during the quarterfinal round of the Summit League Championships.

Twice named a Division III National Coach of the Year, in 2013 by Basketball Times, and in 2016 by both the National Basketball Coaches' Association and by D3 News, Tauer has also received five West Region Coach of the Year honors and five MIAC Coach of the Year Awards. Among Division III men's coaches, he was the second fastest in history to 200 victories and is believed to have won more games in his first five seasons than any coach in Division III history. His .813 win percentage through 2021 ranked first among active Division III coaches, and in the top five among all active NCAA men's coaches. He was the first MIAC coach to sweep conference and playoff championships in each of his first two seasons as head coach. He's also the lone conference individual, and one of a small number of coaches nationally, to have played in, been an assistant coach, and been a head coach at the Division III Final Four. In addition, he is the first MIAC coach to win regular-season titles in each of his first six seasons.

Prior to being named the head coach at St. Thomas, Tauer was an assistant coach for 11 years. An All-MIAC and Academic All-America Tommie player in the 1990s, Tauer is in his 27th season with Tommie basketball. During his time as an assistant coach, he ran the St. Thomas defense for two seasons (2001-2003) and he has also directed the Tommies' offensive sets. UST's offense during that time has consistently ranked among the best in NCAA basketball in overall offensive efficiency, field-goal percentage, 3-point proficiency, fewest turnovers, and assist-to-turnover ratio.

Tauer was inducted into the St. Thomas Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001. He was an All-MIAC player, first team All-West Region, and Academic All-America, and as a senior led the 1994-95 Toms to a school-record 27-0 start, including an MIAC championship with an unprecedented 20-0 record. Tauer ranks 14th in career scoring (1,219 points) and 15th in career rebounding (482) at St. Thomas, and was the school 3-point leader until 1999-2000. He ranks sixth on the MIAC all-time list for 3-point baskets. He also helped the 1993-94 Toms to a berth in the Division III Final Four.

An NCAA Postgraduate Scholar and Academic All-America honoree, Tauer earned Master's and PhD degrees in Social Psychology at UW-Madison. Tauer returned to campus and joined the St. Thomas faculty in 2000. He is also a tenured member of the faculty, one of the only head college basketball coaches in the nation who also has a doctorate in sport-related psychology. Tauer is a Professor of Psychology where he studies factors that affect academic and athletic motivation. He published a book in 2016 on youth sports, parents, and motivation, titled "Why Less is More for WOSPs (Well-Intentioned, Overinvolved Sports Parents): How to be the best Sports Parent You Can Be," and has also published his work in top academic journals.

Prior to attending St. Thomas, Tauer graduated from Cretin-Derham Hall, where he was named all-state in both basketball and baseball, captain of both sports, and won state championships in baseball (1990) and basketball (1991).

Tauer lives in St. Paul with his sons Jack, Adam, and RQ, his daughter Issa, and his wife Chancey, who co-founded Prodeo Academy, a network of charter schools in the Twin Cities.

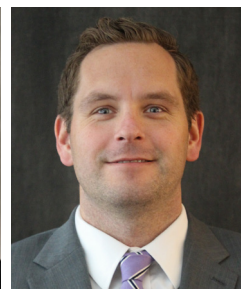
