### THE FAST BREAK

- ► Towson hits the road for the first time this season as the Tigers visit Wagner tonight.
- ► The Tigers will be looking to build on the momentum of their 90-56 season opening win over UMass Lowell. It was the most points scored by a Tiger squad since the 2003-04 season.
- ▶ Raven Bankston got her senior year off to a flying start with 31 points in the season opener.
- ▶ Towson shot 50.8% from the field in that game. It was the Tigers' best field goal percentage since the 2013-14
- ► The Tigers' 34-point margin of victory in the season opener was the most by a Tiger squad since the 2006-07 season.
- ► Towson turned in a strong defensive effort in the opener, forcing 31 UMass Lowell turnovers and scoring 34 points off those turnovers.
- ▶ Bankston wasn't the only Tiger to put up points in the season opener. Sophomore Sianni Martin tallied 20 points in the contest. All told, 12 of the 14 Tigers who played in the game scored at least two points. Towson got 25 points from its bench.

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- ► Towson faces its second straight brand new opponent with tonight's contest against Wagner.
- ► The Seahawks are one of three new opponents for the Tigers this season (UMass Lowell and Colgate).
- ▶ Wagner is a member of the Northeast Conference (NEC). The Tigers are 30-22 all-time against the current members of the NEC. Towson's most wins against an NEC opponent are 11 versus Mount St.
- ► The Tigers have never faced NEC members, Bryant, Sacred Heart and Wagner.

### THE BIG 3-0

- ► Senior guard **Raven Bankston** got her final season off to a flying start with 31 points in the win over UMass Lowell.
- ▶ It was Bankston's second 30+ point performance as a Tiger and her seventh game with 30 or more points overall (five came at Delaware State).
- ▶ Bankston went 11-for-15 from the field for a 73.3 field goal percentage and tied her career-high with five three-pointers made in the game.
- ▶ She has now scored in double figures 61 times in her career and 30 of those games have seen the Detroit, Michigan native score 20 or more points.
- ▶ As of Monday afternoon, Bankston ranked sixth in the nation in points per game.
- ▶ Bankston was named the TowsonTigers.com Female Student-Athlete of the Week on Tuesday for her efforts in the opener.
- ▶ In addition to her 31 points, Bankston contributed four steals, three assists and two rebounds.

### TALK ABOUT A BIG WIN

- ▶ The Tigers beat UMass Lowell by 34 points in the season opener.
- ▶ It was the largest margin of victory for a Towson team under head coach Niki Reid Geckeler.
- ▶ It was also the largest win for the Tigers in 10 years. During the 2006-07 season, Towson beat Rider, 76-42 for a 34-point win.

### **DISHING OUT THE HELPERS**

- ► The Tigers handed out 18 assists in the season opener against UMass Lowell.
- ▶ It was the most assists in a game for the Tigers since the team had 19 last December at Minnesota.
- ► Five Towson players recorded at least two helpers in the win over the River Hawks.
- ► Sophomore guard **Sianni Martin** tied her career-high by dishing out six assists while redshirt junior guard Raine Bankston handed out five helpers.
- ▶ It was Bankston's ninth career game with five or more assists and Martin's third.

### I'LL TAKE THAT

- ► The Tigers used guick hands to their advantage in the season opener.
- ► Towson recorded 13 steals against UMass Lowell.
- ▶ Those 13 steals were part of the reason the River Hawks had 31 turnovers and Towson scored 34 points off turnovers.

- ► Eight Tigers recorded at least one steal in the game, including all five starters.
- ► Senior guard **Raven Bankston** had four steals in the opener while sophomore guard Sianni Martin and redshirt junior forward Jordyn Smith each had two swipes.
- ► Towson has now recorded double-digit steals in 28 games under head coach Niki Reid Geckeler.

### **SHARP SHOOTING TIGERS**

- ► Towson shot an impressive 50.8% from the field in the win over UMass Lowell.
- ► The Tigers hit 32-of-63 shots in the game. Six Tigers made two or more field goals in the game.
- ► That group was led by senior guard Raven Bankston, who connected on 11 field goals while sophomore guard Sianni Martin hit seven.
- ▶ It was the Tigers' best field goal percentage in a game since they shot 50.9% from the field in a loss to UNCW during the 2013-14 season.

### FROM BEHIND THE ARC

- ► Towson turned in another strong performance from behind the arc.
- ► The Tigers went 10-for-21 (47.6%) from three-point range against the River Hawks.
- ▶ It was the first time the Tigers hit 10 or more triples in a game since the team hit 12 last December at Minnesota.
- ► Senior guard **Raven Bankston** tied her career-high with five triples while sophomore guard Sianni Martin had four.
- Freshman guard Mariah Gray made her first career basket, a three-pointer.

### **EVERYONE'S WELCOME AT THIS PARTY**

- ▶ While 51 of the Tigers' 90 points came from a combination of senior guard Raven Bankston and sophomore quard **Sianni Martin**, they weren't the only Tigers to find the basket.
- Towson saw 12 of the 14 players who appeared in the game score at least one point.
- The Tigers got 25 points off their bench in the win.
- Sophomore forward **Brittany Tarr** was the Tigers' top contributor off the bench with six points in the game.

### **NEW TIGERS MAKE SOLID DEBUT**

- ► Four of the Tigers' new players made solid debuts in the season opener.
- ▶ Junior forward Mary Cuevas had four points, one rebound, one block and a steal in eight minutes.
- Freshman guard/forward Nukiya Mayo contributed three points and two rebounds in four minutes of action.
- Freshman guard Mariah Gray drained a three-pointer while fellow freshman guard Etalyia Vogt grabbed a steal.

A talented group of guards and more help and experience inside are what await head coach Niki Reid Geckeler as she enters her fourth season on the Tiger bench.

The 2015-16 season saw the Tigers continue to take steps forward under Reid Geckeler's watch. Junior guard Raven Bankston led the team and finished second in the CAA in scoring (15.5 ppg) en route to earning Third Team All-Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) honors. Freshman guard Sianni Martin got her Tiger career off to a flying start and was named the CAA Rookie of the Week three times. In addition senior guard Dominique Johnson scored the 1,000th point of her career and broke the school record for career and single-game three-pointers under Reid Geckeler's tutelage. However, the success did not just lie with the guards as freshman forward Brittany Tarr became the first Tiger rookie since the 2007-08 season to grab at least 100 rebounds in her first year. As a team, the Tigers finished second in the CAA while averaging 8.4 steals per game. Eight Tigers recorded at least 10 steals on the season.

Reid Geckeler and the Tigers continued to battle and improved throughout the 2014-15 season. During Reid Geckeler's tutelage, LaTorri Hines-Allen finished second in the CAA in scoring and rebounding while earning First Team All-CAA honors. Hines-Allen led the CAA with 14 double-doubles under Reid Geckeler's watch. In addition, Breonn Hughey earned CAA All-Rookie honors after leading the team and finishing fourth in the CAA while averaging 4.4 assists per game.

Reid Geckeler led the Tigers to their first CAA Tournament win since the 2008-09 season. She coached a Tiger squad that set the school record for three-pointers in a single-game (12) and single-season (186).

During the 2013-14 season, Reid Geckeler saw improvment from the Tigers throughout the season. She guided Tanisha McTiller, who finished her career as the second leading scorer in program history to First Team All-CAA honors and CAA All-Defensive squad honors. McTiller

led the CAA in scoring (19.4 ppg) as a senior. Reid Geckeler also guided forward Hines-Allen to Second Team All-CAA honors. Hines-Allen finished with 14.1 points and 8.4 rebounds per game.

Reid Geckeler, who led Howard University to back-to-back 20-plus-win seasons and three post-season tournament appearances, was named the ninth coach in Towson University women's

basketball history in April, 2013.

Prior to Reid Geckeler's first season with the Bison in 2008-09, Howard won just four games. In 2011-12, Reid Geckeler compiled a 24-9 mark, tying the program's all-time record for wins in a season. She amassed 85 career wins at Howard, including 44 in her final two seasons alone. Under her guidance, the Bison earned their first ever preseason WNIT berth and went to the postseason WNIT twice (2011, 2012) and the 2013 Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). Those were the first three postseason bids in program history.

She coached the 2010 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Rookie of the Year and the 2011 MEAC Player of the Year, Saadia Doyle, as well as three first team all-league honorees. In her final two seasons, two of her players ranked in the top 15 and three ranked in the top 35 in the nation statistically, in points per game, assist/turnover ratio and assists per game. Her teams were in the top 15 in the country in scoring defense in 2012 (14th - 53.0 ppg) and 2013 (sixth - 50.3 ppg).

Reid Geckeler is committed to her student-athletes' academic success as well. At Howard, she had a 100 percent graduation rate and eight student-athletes earned spots on the MEAC All-Academic team. In addition seven players graduated magna cum laude.

Prior to her tenure at Howard, Reid Geckeler served an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgetown (1996-2002; 2004-08) and as an assistant and associate head coach at Fordham (1995-96; 2002-04) where she coached a combined 11 conference all-academic team selections and one Rhodes Scholar finalist

While at Georgetown, she signed the No. 6 recruiting class in the country in 2007-08 - a group that led the Hoyas to three NCAA Tournament berths. She also signed Katrina Wheeler, the



first McDonald's All-American women's basketball player to attend Georgetown. Reid Geckeler guided Rebekkah Brunson, the Big East Rookie of the Year in 2001, who went on to play for the Minnesota Lynx, in the WNBA. Her 1999-2000 recruiting class was also ranked in the top 30. At Fordham, Reid Geckeler signed a top 50 recruiting class in 2003-04.

Reid Geckeler, a 1993 graduate of Georgetown University with a bachelor's degree in psychology, was a four-year starter at point guard for the Hoyas. She served as team captain and led Georgetown to the 1992-93 Big East Conference co-championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament Sweet Sixteen. Geckeler finished her career as a Hoya ranked in the top 10 for 3-point field goals made, 3-point field-goal percentage, assists and games played.

Reid Geckeler is married to Timothy Geckeler, a former football player at Rutgers, and they have seven-year old daughter, MaKenzie.
