

WHAT THEY ARE SAYING ABOUT TOWSON BASKETBALL

Pat Skerry knows this team has a lot of promise. They're big and bruising, and probably will be the least-fun team to play in the CAA. I might have the Tigers ranked too low.

Pat Skerry may have his best team since arriving in Maryland, as Arnaud William Adala Moto, Mike Morsell and John Davis are all capable of carrying the team on a given night. All three could end up being all-CAA performers. They'll have to replace point guard Byron Hawkins, but Eddie Keith II and Brian Starr should be able to fill the void. The issue with the Tigers last season was consistency and perimeter shooting.

College Sports Madness

Towson is ready for a better season in part due to the return of leading scorer and leading rebounder Arnaud William Adala Moto. The 6-7 senior forward averaged 13.9 points and 8.3 rebounds last season. He is a great interior scorer and the offense will work through Adala Moto again this year. But he can also stretch the defense with his shooting ability. The Tigers need to find a floor leader and a shooter or two. If Starr can handle the point and emerge as a leader, Towson will be in very good shape. The shooting may be a bigger issue, but there are a handful of players who can knock down some outside shots for this team. They just need to be more consistent than last season in order to compete for a CAA title and an NCAA Tournament spot.



SKERRY

Head Coach 6th Season • Tufts, '92

When Pat Skerry was announced as the 13th men's basketball head coach at Towson University on April 5, 2011, he took over a program that had endured 15-straight losing seasons.

The gritty Medford, Massachusetts native has turned Towson into one of the top programs in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). Towson has won at least 20 games in two of the last three years under Skerry.

Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Towson leads the CAA with most conference victories at 42. The Tigers have participated in a postseason tournament in two of the last three years, including the Vegas 16 in 2016.

Skerry needed only two seasons to make everyone know he was the right man for the job.

After winning just one game during his first season, Skerry led the Tigers to an 18-13 record in 2012-13. Not only was it the first winning season since 1995-96, it was also the largest single-season turnaround in NCAA Division I history.

The achievement did not go unrecognized by his peers as Skerry was selected as the CAA Coach of the Year. He became the first coach to receive that honor since Terry Truax earned back-to-back Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1992-93 and 1993-94.

The success continued during the 2013-14 season as the Tigers won a Division I record 25 games. This includes winning their first two postseason games as a Division I program in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

The 2013-14 season saw the Tigers end the year ranked 84th in the RPI, marking the first time Towson finished the season in the Top 100. The Tigers also received their first votes in the national polls when they were receiving votes in the Associated Press Top 25 poll.

The successful season was made even more special with the opening of SECU Arena. The Tigers opened the building with a 72-45 victory over Navy on Nov. 8 in front an arenarecord crowd of 4,262. Less than one week later, Towson defeated Temple, 75-69, on their new home floor.

The Tigers finished their first season in SECU Arena with a 15-1 record.

The staple of success during the Skerry era has been defense and rebounding. In each of the past three seasons, the Tigers have led



the CAA in field goal percentage defense and rebounding. Individually, Towson has also had the conference double-double leader over that span.

Skerry has done an outstanding job of mixing in transfers to his recruiting classes. In his first season, Skerry landed Georgetown transfer Jerrelle Benimon. In his two seasons at Towson, Benimon led the conference in scoring and rebounding. He was twice named the CAA Player of the Year, while also earning All-America honors following his junior season.

Skerry's first recruiting class at Towson was ranked as the best in the CAA and sixth among all non-BCS schools, according to CBS Sports.

Hard work is not just limited to the court under Skerry. Since taking over as head coach, the team GPA raised to 2.881. Since the Fall of 1999, five of the top seven semester GPA's have occurred under Skerry's watch. During the 2014-15 academic year, the men's basketball team had five players with at least a 3.0 GPA during the fall semester, and six players with a 3.0 during the spring semester.

Skerry has a perfect graduation rate since he became Towson's head coach with 18 players earning degrees.

Skerry has used his platform as a head coach and teamed up with TCU staffer Tom Herrion to start Autism Awareness in college basketball.

What started as two guys with an idea five years ago, has turned into a national event where hundreds of coaches where the prominent blue puzzle piece pin. The effort put forth by both Skerry and Herrion were recognized as the duo was honored with the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Guardians of the Game Service Award.

Since taking over as head coach, Skerry has mentored 16 players that were honored as all-conference, all-rookie, all-defense or all-academic by the CAA.

Benimon is the most recognizable name in the group. The two-time CAA Player of the Year was also twice named to the all-defensive team. He also became the third Tiger to earn All-America honors when he

was selected honorable mention by the Associated Press.

Senior John Davis joined the list following the 2014-15 season after earning third-team honors, while sophomore Mike Morsell was selected to the freshman team.

Senior William Adala-Moto was a second team all-conference selection and Morsell earned third team honors following the 2015-16 season. Timajh Parker-Rivera was named to the All-Defensive and All-Academic teams.

Under Skerry, the Tigers have had at least one player on the all-academic team, including having two players each following the 2012-13 and 2014-15 seasons.

Tonight's Game

Towson finishes its four-game road trip by playing Boston College for the first time in program history.

Busy Tigers

Towson will play four games this week. After playing Maryland Sunday, the Tigers will play at Boston College on tonight and host Stony Brook on Friday as well as Hampton or Robert Morris on Saturday. By the time the lights are turned off in SECU on Saturday, the Tigers will have played six games during a two-week stretch.

A Look At Boston College

Boston College sophomore Jerome Robinson recorded career highs with 22 points and eight rebounds to lead the Eagles to an 82-75 win over Stony Brook. He also added five assists. Freshman Nik Popovic scored 13 points off the bench and grabbed five boards in 13 minutes. He was 6-for-7 from the field. Sophomore A.J. Turner (12) and graduate student Mo Jeffers (10) also scored in double figures. Jeffers added eight rebounds. Boston College shot 65.4 percent (17-26) from the field in the first half and 54 percent (27-50) for the game. The Eagles have won the rebounding battle in two of their last three games.

CAA Tournament Changing Locations

After spending the last three years hosting the tournament at Royal Farms Arena in downtown Baltimore, The Colonial Athletic Association has reached an Agreement with the Charleston Area Sports Commission, North Charleston Coliseum and the College of Charleston to conduct the 2017, 2018 and 2019 CAA Men's Basketball Championships at the Coliseum. The first CAA Men's Basketball Championship in Charleston will be held March 3-6, 2017. Future tournament dates are March 2-5, 2018 and March 8-11, 2019.

Captains Named

Seniors Arnuad William Adala Moto and senior John Davis were named team captains for the 2016-17 season. "I am excited in naming John and Wiliam as our captains for the season," Towson head men's coach Pat Skerry said. "This is the first time we have done this. We try to emphasize that captain is just a title and what we need are leaders. At this time, I felt that both these guys have led extremely well and that we need their continued efforts in doing so in our quest to be as consistent as we possibly can be this season."

Tournament Time

Towson will compete in a pair of tournaments this season. The Tigers will visit Maryland (Nov. 20) and Boston College (Nov. 22) as part of the Barclays Classic. The tournament concludes on Nov. 25 and 26 when Towson hosts Stony Brook, Hampton and Robert Morris. The Tigers open with Stony Brook on Nov. 25 while Robert Morris and Hampton tangle in the second game. The consolation and championship game will be held on Nov. 26. Towson will also compete in the Southpointe Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 21-22. Towson will meet Nevada and Iona.

Chairmen of the Boards

Towson has outrebounded 22 consecutive opponents dating back to last season.

SECU Success

Towson is 33-13 all-time at SECU Arena. The Tigers enter the season with a three-game home winning streak. The Tigers will begin play in their four-year playpen on November 25 when it hosts Stony Brook in the Barclays Classic.

Senior Arnaud William Adala Moto and junior Mike Morsell earned preseason recognition from the CAA. Adala-Moto was named a preseason first-team all-CAA selection, while Morsell was named to the second team.

Morsell sets SECU Scoring Record

Mike Morsell set a SECU Arena scoring record when he poured in 34 points in the Tigers' 99-82 victory over William & Mary on Feb. 13, 2016. It was the first 30-point effort by a Tigers' player since Jerrell Benimon in 2013. Morsell finished 11-of-17 from the floor, including 4-of-7 from 3-point range.

Davis Can Stand Alone

John Davis has been part of 59 victories for the Tigers during his career. If the Tigers win 18 games this season, Davis will be Towson's winningest player in Division I history. Currently the mark is 75 held by Timajh Parker-Rivera.

Savage Schedule Stats

- Towson will face five teams that participated in the 2016 NCAA Tournament in the first two months of the season (Maryland, FDU, UNCW, Iona & Stony Brook). That total could increase to six if the Tigers play Hampton.
- The Tigers will also play two postseason tournament champions in ODU (Vegas 16) and Nevada (CBI).
- In non-conference, the Tigers will face six teams that won at least 20 games.
- Towson opens its CAA schedule by playing three of its first four games on the road.
- Towson will play non-conference contests against schools from 10 different leagues.
- Towson will play four opponents for the first time in program history (Boston College, Stony Brook, Iona and Nevada).

Awesome Adala Moto

Arnaud William Adala-Moto opened the season with 22 points against George Mason and then a double-double agianst Morgan State. In two games, Adala Moto has scored 34 of his 52 points in the second half. He scored all 16 of his second half points in the final 10:42 against George Mason. Adala Moto has opened the season by making two 3-pointers in each game. He did that twice all of last season. Now, he has made at least two 3-pointers in a game four times in his career.

Battle for Greater Baltimore

Towson finished the 2015-16 season with a perfect 4-0 record in the Battle For Greater Baltimore after a 69-61 victory over Morgan State, an 81-77 overtime victory over Coppin State, a 65-54 win over Loyola and a 91-65 win over UMBC.
