SPECTATOR POLICIES – HOME COMPETITIONS Updated 4/27/2021

General

The new conference-wide policy regarding attendance of spectators is left to the discretion of each host institution. Each institution has also agreed to honor any visiting institution's stated desire to compete in an arena without spectators.

At this time, we are not permitting any visiting spectators for non-conference or conference competitions and will follow the policy below.

We are currently allowing only student-athletes' families of the Transy Team and the Transy Community (students, staff, and faculty) to attend games with a limited capacity. Those on the pass list for each student-athlete will need to have a photo identification. Transy Community will need to have their Crimson Cards for entry.

Those who are not permitted to attend competitions at Transylvania University:

- Tested positive or defined as a close contact and not yet cleared by the health department to exit quarantine;
- Were tested and have not received the results;
- Informed that they may have been exposed;
- · Experiencing any symptoms; and
- Anyone who has a fever over 100.4

Outdoor Sports (updated 4.27.21)

At our outdoor competitions, spectators who are two weeks from their completed vaccination will receive a wrist band which allows them to forego the Transy health pass and opt not to wear a mask as long as they physically distance. Temperature checks will still be in place. They must have completed vaccination (both shots if Pfizer or Moderna or one shot if Johnson & Johnson) and be 2 weeks from the last shot. They must show their vaccination card or a copy of their card upon entry. This information will not be recorded and will require the spectator to show at each competition to receive the wrist band.

Athletic staff and workers, as well as student-athletes, regardless of vaccination status, will be required to wear a mask in accordance to NCAA guidelines. At this time there have been no changes from the NCAA on testing requirements or mask usage for those who have been vaccinated.

This change will be in effect beginning on games on April 28, 2021.

Special Note

The conference return to play standards at no time permit spectators (including those in a familial relationship) to be in close contact with student-athletes. When games are over, we will ask all spectators to clear the facilities. Please help us with this policy so that we can continue to have spectators at our events.

At this time we will not be able to have meals with parents/families/friends and student-athletes at the facilities. We would ask that food not be brought at this time.

Food

Unfortunately during COVID, we are not going to be allowed to have our normal family gatherings with the team due to gathering restrictions coupled with trying to keep our team in a bubble. If you would like to provide any food for the team, we would ask that it be purchased pre-packaged.

Upon Arrival

- The doors/gates will be open 45 minutes prior to game time and will be closed for further admission after 10 minutes from the start time to allow personnel to assist with other COVID requirements.
- Please do not come to the game if you are experiencing any symptoms or a fever that might indicate that you have COVID. Prior to arrival, we would ask that you download our Transylvania App (available from iTunes or Google Play Stores, instructions are included at the bottom of this page). You should complete the questions for the Health Pass. This will provide you with a Green Pass that will expedite your entry into the facility. With the green pass, we will take your temperature then allow you to enter. Without a green pass, you will need to answer each of our COVID questions asked on the app and have your temperature taken.
- You will be required to take a temperature check upon entry. Those who temperature
 reads above the CDC recommendation will not be permitted entry to protect the health
 and safety of everyone.
- Face coverings, over the nose and mouth, are required for all fans as they enter, exit and move around a Transylvania Athletic facility. Children 2 and younger are not required to wear a mask.
- Physical distancing measures have been put in place at each athletic facility, including
 physically distance lines for bathrooms and other spots where lines generally form.
- A significant number of sanitizing opportunities, including hand sanitizers have been added.
- If you are seated or standing, we would ask that you remain only with those in your household and be at least 6 feet apart from others.
- No gathering in a group is permitted.
- Family members are not permitted to enter any other building or athletic venue except the one for which they are approved.

CLIVE M. BECK CENTER

Seating and Restrooms

Once at the Beck Center, the only available door to enter is the front doors.

Once in the building, you will be directed to where you will be able to sit. Please understand that we need you to remain in those seats and not change.

The restroom on the main level will be open and we would ask that you follow the physical distancing procedures that are in place.

The water fountains are closed off due to COVID-19. We also will not be serving concessions at this time, so please bring with you bottled water if necessary.

End of Competition

At the end of competition, we would ask that you gather your belongings and make your way to the main doors to leave to leave the facility.

PAT DEACON STADIUM

Seating and Restrooms

Once at Pat Deacon Stadium, the only available entry will be through the walk-through gate next to the ticket office window.

Once you check-in to the stadium, you will be directed to where you will be able to sit. Please understand that we need you to remain in those seats and not change.

You can stand and there will be locations that will allow you to stand and remained distance. In these sections we would ask that it only be those from the same households and please abide by the limited number on those sections.

The restroom will be open and is located inside the main building and can be accessed through the doors next to the concession stand window. We would ask that you follow the physical distancing procedures that are in place.

The water fountains are closed off due to COVID-19. We also will not be serving concessions at this time, so please bring with you bottled water if necessary. A bottle fill is located between the restrooms inside.

At the end of competition, we would ask that you gather your belongings and make your way out of the facility through the gate you entered the facility.

DONNA & JOHN HALL FIELD

Seating and Restrooms

Once at Donna & John Hall Field, the only available entry will be through the walk-through gate near the corner of Third Street and Upper Street.

Once you check-in, you will be directed to where you will be able to sit. Please understand that we need you to remain in those seats and not change.

You can bring your own chair (or stand) and there will be locations that will allow you to use your chair and remained distance. In these sections we would ask that it only be those from the same households and please abide by the limited number on those sections.

The restroom will be open. We would ask that you follow the physical distancing procedures that are in place.

We will not be serving concessions at this time, so please bring with you bottled water if necessary.

Due to the social distancing, the two teams will be utilizing the space right outside their dugout where there are bleachers. Please do not go into this area.

At the end of competition, we would ask that you gather your belongings and make your way out of the facility through the gate you entered the facility.

LEGENDS STADIUM

Seating and Restrooms

Once at Legends Field, the only available entry will be through the main gate.

Once you check-in, you will be directed to where you will be able to sit. Please understand that we need you to remain in those seats and not change. .

The restrooms will be open on the first base side. We would ask that you follow the physical distancing procedures that are in place.

Legends will be serving concessions for weekend games.

Due to the social distancing, the two teams will be utilizing the space right outside their dugout where there are bleachers. Please do not go into this area.

At the end of competition, we would ask that you gather your belongings and make your way out of the facility through the gate you entered the facility.

Top Seed Tennis Club (Outdoors only)

Viewing and Restrooms

Between the outside and inside fences, only four spectators will be permitted behind each court. We ask that you follow physical distancing procedures in this area.

Fourteen people will be permitted to watch on the viewing area above Court 1. We ask that you follow physical distancing procedures in this area.

Restrooms will be available inside the Top Seed Tennis Club building.

Bottled water will be available for purchase in the Top Seed Tennis Club building.

End of Competition

At the end of competition we ask that you gather your belongings and exit the outdoor facility through the gate by court 5.

Transy App Registration for Guests

The setting up of the Transy App for guests will take 10-15 minutes with a wifi connection. We strongly suggest you do this prior to getting to campus. Here are some helpful tips when locating and downloading the Transy App:

Go to your App store (Apple/Google/etc) and search and select Transylvania University (it is a red square with the Old Morrison logo on it) to download.

Once downloaded, select the app to open and select next at the bottom. Choose "guest" as your role. You will then need to enter your first name, last name, email and create/confirm password.

A verification code will be sent to the email you used. The code will need to be entered on the app where it asks for it. This will send you to a welcome screen once the code is accepted.

You will be asked to set up their profile (some of the options are optional or allow you to skip). Once you save the information, there is a guick survey.

After the survey, the app will ask you to define your primary relationship. Some of the options are student, faculty and staff – alumni – parent –prospective student – etc. For the purpose of you being on campus, you can select Primary Relationship. Then hit submit. It may ask if you want to connect your calendar with the app; if it does you can select finish later.

At this point the main screen will appear with the Health Pass button below the header that has "Good morning/afternoon (Name) and the weather.

You will answer 10 questions in regards to COVID-19. When you submit all of your questions you will be granted a colored pass. Anyone with a red pass, we ask you not to come to campus and contact your Transy contact immediately. The pass will also be sent to your email. We will ask for this upon arrival.
