



# TROY GAME NOTES

**TROY 40 (9-2, 6-1 SBC)**  
**TEXAS STATE 7 (2-9, 0-7 SBC)**



## SERIES NOTES

- Troy improves to 6-1 all-time against Texas State and have now won five straight games in the series.

## GENERAL NOTES

- Troy's captains QB Brandon Silvers, WR Emanuel Thompson, LB William Lloyd, LB Justin Lucas
- Troy lost the toss (3-8) and Texas State elected to defer to the second half. Troy received the opening kickoff.
- Neal Brown has never been shut out as a head coach or as an offensive coordinator -- a span of 111 games.

## OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Brandon Silvers moved into ninth place in Troy history with 2,707 passing yards in a single season after throwing for 218 yards on Saturday.
- Jordan Chunn moved into a tie for third place on the Troy career rushing touchdown list after rushing for one touchdown against Texas State; he now has 32 in his career.
- Jordan Chunn moved into a tie for seventh place on the Troy single-season rushing touchdown list with 11.
- Josh Anderson recorded his second rushing touchdown of the season on a 29-yard run in the second quarter
- Josh Anderson recorded his second rushing touchdown of the game on Troy's opening drive of the second half for the first multi-rushing touchdown game of his career.
- Gabe Hill recorded his first career reception with a 4-yard reception in the second quarter; it was the first reception by a Troy tight end this season.
- Brandon Silvers moved into a tie for sixth place with 21 touchdown passes on the season after throwing two against Texas State.
- Brandon Silvers moved into third place in Troy history with 63 touchdowns responsible for after throwing for two against Texas State.
- Tevaris McCormick caught his fourth touchdown pass of the season with a 39-yard grab in the second quarter; his touchdown receptions have averaged 42.5 yards in length.
- Deondre Douglas' 46-yard touchdown reception was the longest catch of his career and his sixth touchdown reception of the season.
- Brandon Silvers finished with two passing touchdowns in the game; it marked the eighth time this season and the 16th time in his career with multiple touchdown passes in a game.

## DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Junior nose tackle Seth Calloway made the first start of his career, while sophomore defensive tackle Trevon Sanders made his second career start.
- Troy held Texas State scoreless in the first half which marked the third time this season that the Trojans have pitched a shutout in the first half.
- Jalen Rountree recorded his third interception of the season to end Texas State's opening drive.
- Jalen Rountree intercepted his second pass of the game in the second quarter; it marked the third time this season that a Troy player has recorded multiple interceptions in a game -- Blace Brown had two picks against New Mexico State and Idaho.
- Troy has recorded an interception in nine of its 11 games this season and now have 18 on the season, which ranks as the third most in a single-season in Troy's FBS history.
- Troy intercepted two Texas State passes in the game; Troy has intercepted multiple passes in a game six times this season.
- Redshirt freshman Tron Folsom recorded a career-high eight tackles as he saw extended time at linebacker in the absence of Terris Lewis ... his eight tackles were a team high.

## SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Ryan Kay moved into a tie for third place in a single-season in Troy history with 17 field goals this season after making two against Texas State.
- Ryan Kay moved into a tie for sixth place on the Troy career field goals made list with 28; he also moved into fifth place on the career field goal percentage list (.757).
- Ryan Kay's streak of consecutive extra points ended at 69 after his third attempt was blocked against Texas State; Kay is now 71-of-72 in his career.
