

TROY GAME NOTES

TROY 24 (9-3, 6-2 SBC) GEORGIA SOUTHERN 28 (5-7, 4-4 SBC)



SERIES NOTES

• Troy leads the overall series with Georgia Southern, 10-6, but the Eagles have won four straight in the series

GENERAL NOTES

- Troy's captains QB Brandon Silvers, LB Terris Lewis, OL Antonio Garcia, LB Justin Lucas
- Troy lost the toss (3-9) and Georgia Southern elected to defer to the second half. Troy received the opening kickoff.
- Neal Brown has never been shut out as a head coach or as an offensive coordinator -- a span of 112 games.
- Troy fell to 11-1 when leading at halftime under Neal Brown.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Right tackle Tyler Lassiter made his offense leading 21st straight start.
- Jordan Chunn tied the Troy career rushing touchdown record with 34 as he rushed for two touchdowns against Georgia Southern.
- Jordan Chunn moved into a tie for fifth place on the Troy single-season rushing touchdown list with 13 on the year.
- Jordan Chunn has now rushed for a touchdown in 10-of-12 games this season and 27-of-38 career games.
- Jordan Chunn moved into third place on the Troy single-season rushing yardage list 1,232; he is 105 yards shy of the single-season record.
- Jordan Chunn set the Troy single-season record for carries after rushing 19 times at Georgia Southern; he now has 259 on the year.
- Emanuel Thompson moved into a tie for third place in a season in Troy history with 72 catches after pulling down seven receptions on Saturday.
- Tevaris McCormick caught his fifth touchdown pass of the season to pull Troy within four, 21-17, late in the third quarter.
- Brandon Silvers moved into second place all-time in Troy history with 7,519 yards of total offense in his career.
- Brandon Silvers finished the game with one touchdown pass; he has thrown a touchdown pass in 11-of-12 games on the season.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Linebacker William Lloyd made his defense leading 24th straight start.
- Junior defensive tackle Seth Calloway forced the first fumble of his career on Georgia Southern's opening drive, which was recovered by Rashad Dillard, his second career fumble recovery.
- Troy has now forced 25 turnovers this season -- 18 fumble and seven interceptions. Troy entered the weekend ranked 14th nationally with 24 turnovers forced.
- Rashad Dillard increased his sack total to 7.5 on the season after picking up one against Georgia Southern; he now has 14.5 in his career.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Kicker / punter Ryan Kay and long snapper Justin Fuller extended their team leading consecutive starts streak to 36 games.
- Ryan Kay moved into second place on Troy's single-season list with 18 field goals this season; he is two behind Sam Glusman's school record of 20.
- Ryan Kay was a perfect 3-for-3 on extra-point attempts and has now made all 74 in his career.
