INSIDE THE MATCHUP

- HELLO, OLD FRIEND: UT Martin and Troy will meet for the first time since the 1991-92 season. Troy has a three-game winning streak against former Gulf South Conference member. The Trojans are 6-10 against the Skyhawks all-time but just 1-7 when playing outside of Troy, Alabama.
- WHAT'S POPULAR IN 1992: The Trojans and Skyhawks have not met in 30 years. Noteworthy events that happened in 1992 include the founding of Cartoon Network, the establishment of the Mall of America, France hosted the Winter Olympics, the first McDonalds in China was established, and Bill Clinton took office as the President of the United States.
- LAST TIME WE MET: No one on the Troy roster was alive the last time the Trojans and Skyhawks met in a women's basketball contest. On February 8, 1992, the Troy bested UT-Martin 99-89 to improve to 6-10 all-time against the GSC foe. The win was the first time the Trojans were able to capture a victory on the road in Martin, Tennessee. Troy, a few weeks earlier, defeated the Skyhawks again, this time scoring 101 points on their way to victory. The first meeting between these two teams came on January 23, 1982, an 84-49 victory for UT-Martin.

FAST BREAK POINTS

- PRESEASON CHAMPIONS ONCE AGAIN: For the third time in five seasons, the Troy women's basketball team has been picked to repeat as regular-season champions in 2022-23. Troy captured 12 of the available 14 first-place votes from the coaches, while 28 points separated Troy from the second-place finishers, Old Dominion.
- MORE HONORS FOR KORANGA: The highly decorated and one of the best Trojans in the storied program's history, Felmas Koranga, was named the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Player of The Year for 2022-23. Her first-team selection and Player of The Year honor come on the heels of a stellar 2021-22 campaign that saw Troy advance to the WNIT tournament against SEC foe Alabama. Koranga led the Trojans in scoring last year, averaging 12.6 points per contest and averaged a doubledouble with 10.7 boards per game.
- **NEWCOMER GETS CONFERENCE-WIDE ATTENTION:** Incoming sophomore Jashanti Simmons was recognized in the preseason release from the Sun Belt as well. The newcomer earned third-team honors as an incoming player from junior college Georgia Highlands. She captured two all-American honors and recorded over 1,000 points for her school prior to coming to Troy. She was also a standout in high school, netting over 1,500 points in three years.
- TROY RANKED IN MID MAJOR PRESEASON POLL: After ending the season outside the mid-major top 25, the Trojans will enter the season as the highest-ranked mid-major school in the Sun Belt and the second-highest school in the south, only behind FGCU, which captured the No. 2 ranking. Troy is the only SBC school to appear in the top 25.

TROY SURVIVES A ROAD SCARE

Despite scoring just six points in the second quarter, the T rojans were able to hang on late to winning an opening-day thriller against in-state rival Samford. Troy would go on to put the game away in the dying moments thanks to some clutch free throws from Felmas Koranga and Sharonica Hartsfield. The Trojans won their fourth-straight season opener.

RIGBY INCHES CLOSER

With another season-opening win under her belt, head coach Chanda Rigby stands just seven wins shy of 200 for her career. If she is able to reach this milestone, she will become just the second head coach to reach 200 wins at Troy in program history. She will attempt to join Joyce Sorrell (1975-95) who recorded an all-time record of 274-278 at Troy.

HALLMON STANDS OUT

Junior transfer Makayia Hallmon was a standout offensively for the Trojans as she was the only player to net double-digit points. The guard from Louisiana totaled 15 points and grabbed five rebounds in her Troy debut. Against the Samford Bulldogs, Hallmon would add a block and a steal while going 6-15 from the floor in game one.

TROJANS ARE ALREADY CLUTCH

Troy proved during its season-opener to be a clutch team already in 2022-23. After letting a third-quarter lead slip away late, the Trojans captured clutch free throws with under a minute remaining in the game. Koranga nailed two free throws to give Troy a one-point lead with 17 seconds left in the game. The Trojans were able to force a turnover on the ensuring inbounds play and Sharonica Hartsfield would put the game away moments later on the line.

IT'S A LOADED SCHEDULE

If the Trojans make their way back into the NCAA tournament this season, they will have earned it, as the 2022-23 slate for Troy is tough from day one. Eight of Troy's 11 non-conference opponents reached either the NCAA tournament last season or the WNIT tournament. Troy plays four teams from Power 5 schools, while a total of five teams were at least receiving votes in the national polls in the preseason.

HEAD COACH CHANDA RIGBY



Troy & NCAA Record: 193-118 (11th Season)

Career Collegiate Record: 421-216 (19th season)

Entering her 11th season at Troy in 2022-23, Chanda Rigby has built the Trojans into the premier program in the Sun Belt Conference, winning FIVE c hampionships in seven years.

Since taking over the program in 2012, Rigby has made Troy a perennial championship, and NCAA Tournament, contender.

Rigby's impressive resume includes seven 20+ win seasons, three Sun Belt Tournament Championships, two Sun Belt Regular Season Title, three trips to the NCAA Tournament, six postseason appearances, 20 all-conference selections, five Sun Belt Post Season Award winners, a Sun Belt Player of the Year honoree and a Sun Belt Coach of the Year honor.

Over the last three seasons, the Troy Women's Basketball team has tallied the most wins of any Sun Belt men's or women's basketball team. Over the last three seasons, the Troy Women's Basketball team has tallied the most wins of any Sun Belt men's or women's basketball team.

Rigby and the Trojans returned from the heartbreaking loss at Texas A&M in the 2021 NCAA Tournament looking for vengence. Troy capped off non conference action by sweeping the Mississippi State MTE. The Trojans downed host Mississippi State, the eventual SWAC champions Jackson State and South Carolina State to start off conference play with momentum.

That momentum carried Rigby's Trojans to three short-handed wins to open conference play. Due to COVID-19 protocols, Troy had to battle through three games with as few as eight players to start conference play a perfect 3-0.

The Troy Women's Basketball squad took claim to the Sun Belt Regular Season Championship after downing Appalachian State in convincing fashion, 89-56, in the final weekend of the regular season.

Felmas Koranga and Amber Leggett both earned All-Sun Belt honors after Koranga was selected to the first team and Leggett to the third team. The Nakuru, Kenya native picked up her second straight First Team All-Sun Belt honor after leading the league in rebounding. The junior also ranked 10th nationally with 354 boards on the season. Leggett earned her first nod from the Sun Belt Conference, being tabbed a Third Team All-Sun Belt selection in her first season with the Trojans. The Navarre, Fla., native ranked second on the team and 15th in the league, averaging 11.8 points per game. Leggett also backed up Koranga on the glass, ranking second on the team and 10th in the league with 7.1 boards per game.

The Trojans punched their second straight trip to the Sun Belt Tournament Championship. Despite the loss to UT Arlington, Troy earned an automatic bid to the WNIT, where the Trojans played host to Alabama.

The squad finished the season ranked first nationally in defensive rebounds, free throws made, offensive rebounds and rebounds per game. The team also ranked second in rebounds and sixth in scoring.

The 2020-21 season was another one for the record books for Rigby. She led her program to its third NCAA Tournament appearance, the program's third Sun Belt Tournament Championship and sixth 20+ win season. She was honored by the League's head coaches and media members for the first time as she was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year.

The individual awards didn't stop with Rigby though. She guided Alexus Dye to the Sun Belt Player of the Year award, the first player of the year honoree in program history, and Felmas Koranga to Newcomer of the Year honors. Under the leadership of Rigby, Dye was named a First Team All-Sun Belt performer, Koranga and Jasmine Robinson were second team honorees and Tiyah Johnson was a third team member. Troy's four All-Sun Belt performers were the most in a single season in program history and the most in the Sun Belt since 1998.

Statistically, the 2020-21 season was one of the best in Rigby's career. Troy ranked third in the NCAA in scoring offense at 86.0 ppg (the highest total of her career), first in rebounds (52.1) and defensive rebounds per game (32.8), first in both free throws made (477) and attempted (653), second in total rebounds (1,458) and offensive rebounds per game (19.3), fifth in total steals (291) and 12th in total assists (471). Troy made national headlines in the NCAA Tournament against No. 2 seed Texas A&M when the Trojans almost earned the first win for a 15 seed in NCAA Tournament history, erasing a 16-point deficit to lead the Aggies late in the fourth quarter before narrowly falling by just four points. Troy's 80-points scored was the third-most points scored by a 15 seed in tournament history.

Troy put together its most successful season in program history during the 2019-20 campaign. Rigby led Troy to a program-record 25 victories and the program's first-ever Sun Belt Regular Season Championship after posting a 16-2 conference record. Although the season was cut short due to COVID-19, the Trojans earned the No. 1 seed in the SBC Tournament. Rigby guided three players to all-conference honors, the most honorees in a single season in program history. In December Troy earned its highest RPI rating in program history (36) before ending the season with an RPI of 44, the highest in the SBC. Under Rigby's leadership, the Trojans led the NCAA in total rebounds (1,595), rebounding

margin (+15.4), rebounds per game (55.0), offensive rebounds per game (22.2) and defensive boards per game (32.8).

In 2018-19, the Trojans earned their first-ever invitation to the WNIT. Rigby guided Sky'Lynn Holmes to the SBC Defensive Player of the Year, the first such award as SBC members. Holmes was also named to the All-Sun Belt Second Team. Once again, Rigby's squad was one of the best offensive teams in the country, averaging 82.3 points per game average and a +10.3 rebound margin, finishing fifth-best in the NCAA in both stats. The Trojans finished first nationally in offensive rebounds and first in the country in rebounds per game at 50.48.

In 2017-18 Rigby's Trojans finished 18-13 overall after the departure of seven seniors from the previous season. The Trojans led the Sun Belt in scoring (81.9) and the NCAA in rebounding (49.5) joining Baylor as the only schools in the nation to lead its conference in both categories in each of the last six seasons. Sophomores Amber Rivers and Kayla Robinson earned Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors while junior Sky'Lynn Holmes was named Sun Belt Newcomer of the Year.

Troy won its second consecutive Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship in 2016-17 earning a second straight bid to the NCAA Tournament. Forward Caitlyn Ramirez was named first team All-Sun Belt Conference and SBC Tournament MVP. For the fifth straight season, the Trojans led the league in scoring and finished top 10 in the nation with 82.5 points per game. Troy was second in the NCAA with 50.15 rebounds per game including an 86-rebound performance against Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament quarterfinals, the second-most in NCAA history.

In 2015-16, the Trojans finished 20-13, won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament and qualified for the NCAA Tournament for just the second time in program history. Ashley Beverly Kelley was named First Team All-Sun Belt Conference and SBC Tournament MVP. Caitlyn Ramirez took home third team All-Sun Belt honors as well. Rigby's squad led the conference in scoring for the fourth consecutive season.

Troy's 2014-15 team won 20 games for just the fourth time in program history and made the second postseason appearance in program history and making a WBI Tournament appearance, their first postseason tournament since 1997. Ashley Beverly Kelley and Ronita Garrett were both named to the All-Sun Belt First Team, giving Troy two first team selections for the first time in over a decade.

In 2013-14, Rigby coached her first, First Team All-Sun Belt performer when Joanna Harden became the first All-Sun Belt First Team member under Rigby when she led the Sun Belt in scoring at 25.1 points per game. Harden finished seventh in the NCAA in scoring, was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award given to the nation's top point guard. During the year Troy averaged 80.4 points per game and became just the second Sun Belt team since 2000 to average over 80.0 points per game.

In Rigby's first season at the helm in 2012-13, Troy won seven games, a five-win improvement from the year before and tying the total number of wins Troy won over the previous two seasons combined. It was also Troy's first season playing its home games in the newly constructed Trojan Arena.

Before taking over the Trojan program in 2012-13, Rigby spent 12 years at the junior college level. She spent seven seasons at Pensacola State where she coached three WBCA All-Americans as well as one McDonald's All-American and four NJCAA All-Americans. She guided the Pirates to a combined 64-6 record over the last two seasons with two trips to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Final Four and earned two third-place finishes. Before Pensacola State, Rigby led Holmes Community College to four straight winning seasons and spent one season at NAIA Tabor College where she transformed a last-place team into one of the top teams in the conference. Rigby began her head coaching career at Northwest Rankin High School in Mississippi in 1992 before returning to her home state of Louisiana to coach at Loranger High School from 1996-2000.

Rigby graduated from Southeastern Louisiana University with a bachelor's degree in English education in 1990 and a master's degree in secondary education in 1998. She earned her doctorate in higher education leadership from Nova Southeastern University in July of 2017.

She is married to Ed Rigby, a high school football head coach and Athletic Director. The couple has two sons, Ramsey and Randon.

NEW COACH ON THE BLOCK



Head coach Chanda Rigby and the Troy Women's Basketball program announced the hiring of former Dallas Wings guard Chelsea Dungee to the squad's coaching staff.

"It's been almost eight years since I've had an opening on my staff to fill," Rigby said. "When this position came open, I knew I wanted to hire someone who would make a strong impact on current players and carry deep influence with recruits. Chelsea will be all of this and much more. She worked her way up into being a top scorer in NCAA and a high draft pick in the WNBA. The passion that she possesses, and her desire to be great, will be infectious. With her presence, Chelsea will help us continue to elevate the brand of Troy Women's Basketball in the recruiting world. Hiring Chelsea puts a big 'W' in our win column already!"

Dungee was drafted by the Dallas Wings with the fifth overall pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft. The 5'11" guard saw action in 14 games for the Wings during her rookie season.

Prior to being drafted by the Wings, Dungee was a four-year standout at Arkansas, where she was named an AP Third Team All-American her senior season.

"I am excited about the opportunity to pursue my lifelong goal of becoming a Division I women's basketball coach," Dungee said. "My collegiate and professional experiences have provided me with vast knowledge of the game and the ability to create and maintain healthy relationships through shared experiences. The feeling of giving back and contributing to the growth of young women is unmatched. I look forward to being a part of the Trojan Family!"

In addition to earning AP Third Team All-American honors her senior season, Dungee was also dubbed a WBCA All-American, USBWA Third Team All-American and an All-SEC First Team selection. She found her name listed on the Wooden Award Nation Ballot and was an Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Finalist.

The guard averaged 22.3 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 1.5 steals, 32.3 minutes per game during her final season as a Razorback, and scored in double figures in all 27 games that season. The former professional player had 18 games with 20+ points and four games with 30+ points.

The senior poured in 27 in Arkansas' NCAA Tournament game against Wright State and tallied 37 points in a historic performance in Arkansas' win over UConn.

Dungee is the only player in SEC history to hit 17+ free throws more than once in a career.

The Sapulpa, Okla., native also holds the Razorbacks' single-season scoring record after tallying 759 points during the 2018-19 campaign. Her 22.3 points per game during the 2020-21 season ranks second in Razorback history.

During her four-year career, Dungee scored the most collegiate points of any Razorback Women's Basketball player ever (2,147), and she also holds the program record for most career free throws after making 552 of her attempts.

Prior to her collegiate playing days, Duggen led USA Basketball's U16 squad to a gold medal at the 2013 FIBA Americas Championships.
