### GAME NOTES

**OPENING TIP:** The Tennessee State women's basketball team will open the 2024 calendar year with a two-game road trip to kick off the second week of OVC play, beginning with Southern Indiana on Thursday in Evansville.

**SERIES INFORMATION:** This will be just the third-ever matchup between the Lady Tigers and the Screaming Eagles. The two schools first met last season, playing both matchups in February, with each team winning on each other's court. TSU won the first game 59-55 in Evansville, while USI claimed a 67-61 victory in Nashville.

#### LR NUMBERS AND NOTES

**3:** The number of players that now have 100+ points or more this season. Caitlin Anderson and Zyion Shannon became the second and third Lady Tigers to reach the 100-point scoring mark this season joining Sanaa' St. Andre after the win over Little Rock. Anderson finished with 17, while Shannon scored 12 in the win.

**49 PERCENT:** The Tigers finished a season-best shooting percentage of 49.1 percent in the win over Little Rock. TSU was 28-of-57 from the field.

**SEASON BEST:** Graduate transfer point guard Caitlin Anderson posted two season-highs in the win over Little Rock. Anderson tallied a season-high 17 points, while also logging a season-high six assists. The Missouri native is averaging 9.0 ppg and has finished in double-figures six times this season.

**HOME COOKIN':** Sanaa' St. Andre logged her third straight double-digit scoring game at home in the win over Little Rock. The Kansas City transfer finished with 15 points against the Trojans while finishing with 17 two nights prior against UT Martin. St. Andre's first game dates to UT Southern before Christmas break as she tallied 10 points. She is averaging 12.0 ppg inside the Gentry Center.

# HEAD COACH TY EVANS

Ty Evans was named the 12th head coach of the Tennessee State University women's basketball program in August 2020.

"Words can't possibly convey the level of happiness, excitement, and gratitude that I feel as a result of being named the next women's Head Basketball Coach at Tennessee State University," said Evans. "This moment is a culmination of many years of preparation, hard work, sacrifice, disappointment and prayer, and it's a journey that I wouldn't change. Thanks to Dr. Allen, President Glover, and the entire selection committee for entrusting me with this opportunity and to the entire "Big Blue" family, specifically my players, it's time to ... #PressPlay."

Evans took over the reigns at TSU after spending eight years at SEC member Auburn. During his stint with the Tigers, he served as associate head coach from 2015-20 and assistant coach from 2012-2015. Evans helped guide the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances.

Prior to his tenure at Auburn, he served two years at Georgetown before accepting a position at Alabama in 2007.

Evans began his collegiate coaching career at Saint Louis University where he served as an assistant coach during the 2001-02 season. After a season coaching professionally, he returned to SLU for two more seasons.

Evans spent the last decade making a name for himself in the Southeastern Conference (SEC). In his first season with Auburn, he helped lead the Tigers to 19 wins, the most in four years, and an appearance in the Women's NIT quarterfinals. Auburn set a school record with 402 steals during the 2012-13 season while forcing 701 turnovers, a mark that ranks second all-time on The Plains.

In his fourth season, Evans helped to advance the Tigers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2009 and post a 20-13 overall record. Evans helped Auburn to its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and a 17-15 overall record in season five. Two seasons later, Auburn experienced its best season in 10 years, finishing 22-10 and earning their third trip to the NCAA tournament in four years.

At Alabama, Evans coached the post players and helped his players earn All-SEC honors in three of his five seasons. He was also instrumental in coaching the Crimson Tide to a WNIT Sweet 16 appearance in 2011, the team's first post-season trip since 2002.

Also heavily involved in recruiting, Evans brought national attention to Alabama in 2010 and 2011 after securing top-20 recruiting classes both years. Prior to Alabama, Evans served two years at Georgetown. During that stint, he was instrumental in the recruiting and re-building efforts that would eventually turn Georgetown into a perennial NCAA Tournament team.

Evans is a 1995 graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater where he was an All-American and served as team co-captain for two years. He received a bachelor's degree in secondary education.

## ABOUT TSU

- TSU is one of two NCAA Division I HBCUs that competes outside of the MEAC or SWAC
- Of the four D-1 schools in Nashville (TSU, Belmont, Lipscomb and Vanderbilt), TSU is the only public university

**37:** The number of that TSU bench scored against UTM. Sanaa' St. Andre (17) and Zyion Shannon (14) came off the bench to combine for 31 points. St. Andre's 17 points were a team-high.

**KEEPING IT 100:** Sanaa' St. Andre became the first Lady Tiger to reach 100 points this season after her 17-point performance last night. The transfer from Kansas City has 113 points on the year and leads the Tigers with 11.3 ppg. Eboni Williams (98), Caitlin Anderson (91), and Zyion Shannon (90) will all look to hit the 100-point mark soon.

**UNDER PRESSURE:** The Lady Tigers continue to pace the league in total turnovers and turnovers forced per game. TSU leads the OVC with 22.9 forced turnovers per game, while their 252 forced turnovers also sit atop the league standings. The Tigers forced 27 turnovers against UTM while just turning the ball over 13 times.

## UT SOUTHERN NUMBERS AND NOTES

**18:** The number of steals TSU finished with against UT Southern. The Lady Tigers' 18 swipes set a new season high. Saniah logged seven steals in the win, followed by Sanaa' St. Andre who finished with four.

**6:** The number of Lady Tigers that finished in double-figures against UTS. All five TSU starters finished in double-figures, along with Zyion Shannon who finished tied for a team-high 13 points with Eboni Williams and Saniah Parker. Aaniya Webb finished with 12 points, followed by Caitlin Anderson (11) and St. Andre (10).

**SEASON HIGHS:** The Lady Tigers set six different team season highs in the win over UTS. TSU set a new mark for points (86), field goals made (30), field goals attempted (70), and steals (18). TSU also set two new marks from the free throw line with 26 made free throws on 33 attempts.

## EKU SOUTHERN NUMBERS AND NOTES:

**44.3:** The percentage that TSU shot from the floor against ECU, marking a new season-high. The Lady Tigers finished 27-of-61, while also knocking down a season-high seven made threes on 19 attempts.

**BACK IN ACTION:** Saniah Parker returned to the court against ECU after missing the season's first eight games and made an immediate impact coming off the bench. The junior guard logged 26 minutes and scored nine points, with four rebounds and three assists.

**AIKENS DELIVERS:** Graduate transfer Jordan Aikens had her best outing of the season against ECU as she was named the OVC Newcomer of the Week, becoming the third Lady Tiger to earn the honor this season. The Chicago native scored a season-high 15 points while finishing 3-of-4 from behind the arc. Aikens played just 18 minutes and

**22.0:** The number of turnovers that TSU is forcing per game. The Tigers lead the OVC in this category and are the only team forcing 20+ turnovers per outing while ranking 20th in the NCAA.

**12:** The number of assists that TSU tallied against Akron. Caitlin Anderson finished with a team-high four in the loss. She leads the team with 20 helpers and is the only player on the team to have double-digit assists.

**WELCOME TO THE LEAGUE:** The Lady Tigers have now earned two straight OVC Newcomers of the Week awards after Caitlin Anderson took home the honors after TSU's two-game road trip to Ohio. The grad transfer averaged 12.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.0 steals throughout two games against Cincinnati and Akron. Sanaa' St. Andre took home the honors the week prior after a two-game trip to Florida.

**14:** The number of points that Zyion Shannon, Caitlin Anderson, and Sanaa' St. Andre all recorded against Cincinnati. Shannon and Anderson's 14-point performances marked season highs for both.

**BALLING WITH THE BIG DOGS:** The Lady Tigers showed their ability to hang with Cincinnati after ending the first quarter down by just two points at 19-17. TSU would then outscore the Bearcats in the 4th quarter 16-13, while only dropping the contest against the Big 12 opponent by 24 points.

**53x3:** TSU finished with 53 points in both of their games in the FIU Thanksgiving Tournament. Sunday's 53-point performance marked the third time the Lady Tigers have finished with 53 points, matching a season high. The Lady Tigers are averaging 45.8 ppg through six games.

**SHINING IN THE SUN:** Sanaa' St. Andre shined bright in the Florida sun last week as the senior transfer from Kansas City was named to the FIU Thanksgiving All-Tournament Team, while also being recognized as the OVC's Newcomer of the Week. She logged a season-high 19 points against William & Mary and averaged 13.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals, and 2.5 assists over two games in Florida.

**PERFECT FROM THE STRIKE:** The Lady Tigers finished a perfect 10-of-10 on free throws against Bryant. Zyion Shannon finished 6-of-6 from the strike, while Aaniya Webb and Caitlin Anderson both finished 2-of-2.

**BENCH HELP:** More than half of the Lady Tigers' points against Bryant came by way of the bench TSU had 29 of their 53 total points come from the bench, led by Zyion Shannon's season-high 14 points. Aaniya Webb tallied seven points, while Shequana Jackson logged four.

**TRIPLE THREAT:** The Lady Tigers had three players finish in double-figures against William & Mary on Friday. Sanaa' St. Andre finished with a season-high 19 points, while Eboni Williams finished with 14.

Diamond Cannon also logged a new season-high with 10 points.

**WORKING INSIDE:** TSU finished with a season-high 32 points in the paint against W&M. The Lady Tigers surpassed their previous high of 24 against Lipscomb. TSU only attempted two three-pointers in the game, with most of their points coming down low.

**ON THE BOARDS:** Four players finished with 5+ rebounds in Friday's contest. Caitlin Anderson collected a season-high eight rebounds, while Cannon finished with seven. Shequana Jackson and St. Andre both pulled down five boards.

**BACK IN THE SUNSHINE STATE:** This trip to Florida marks the first for the TSU women's basketball program since the team competed in the 34th Annual Hatter Classic in December of 2021, Ty Evan's second season. TSU took down Stetson 60-56, while their game against Virginia Commonwealth was canceled.

**FINDING HER STRIDE:** Through four games this season, Eboni Williams leads the team in points per game (8.8) and rebounds per game of those who have played more than one game (5.0). In a game that did not go TSU's way against Lipscomb, Williams finished with 13 points and a season-high seven rebounds, marking her second double-digit scoring performance after logging 15 against Wilberforce.

**PRESS ON:** The Tigers have remained true to the "Press Play" style of defense, which is something that head coach Ty Evans has built the identity of this program on. TSU remains on top of the OVC standings in turnovers forced per game with 23.3.

**A NEW Q:** After playing in just 34 minutes over the course of 11 games with no starts and scoring six points a season ago, Shequana Jackson has been off to a hot start this season. The grad student from New York has shown an improvement in her game as she started the first three games of the season while playing in all four. Jackson has tallied 10 points and 10 boards in 49 minutes of action this year.

**MUSIC CITY RHYTHM:** Head coach Ty Evans has won three straight games against teams that are from Nashville. Last season saw his squad pick up wins over Fisk, Trevecca, and Lipscomb, all inside the Gentry Center. The fourth-year head coach is 5-4 against teams from the 615, which includes a 2-0 record against Lipscomb. All four losses have come against Belmont.

**TURNOVER BATTLE:** TSU leads the OVC in forced turnovers per game with 25.0. The Lady Tigers have won the turnover battle in two of their three games played. TSU forced 36 against

Wilberforce, 16 against Charlotte, and 23 against UNC Asheville.

**FIRST ONE-UP:** Despite not having a start this season, Zyion Shannon has become the clear "6th" woman through three games as she is third on the team with 72 minutes played. Shannon is averaging 24.0 minutes per outing and 5.3 points per game. She has had back-to-back six-point games off the bench. Shannon played a season-high 28 minutes against UNC Asheville on Sunday.

**TWO GOES FOR 12:** Caitlin Anderson had her best outing of the season on Sunday as she tallied 12 points and five steals against UNC Asheville. Anderson is tied for the team lead with 7.3 ppg while leading the team in total minutes played with 76.

**TSU DEBUT:** Five Lady Tigers made their TSU debut in the win over Fisk, with three of the five getting the starting nod. Caitlin Anderson, Eboni Williams, and Diamond Cannon were all in the starting lineup for their debut, while Jordan Aikens and Aaniya Webb came off the bench.

**BACK ON THE COURT:** After having not played in a game due to injuries and transfer rules since March 4, 2021, TSU forward Eboni Williams seemingly picked up right where she left off as she made her Lady Tiger debut on Monday evening. Williams, who sat out last year got the start against Wilberforce and made the most of it as she led the team with 15 points and four steals. The Chattanooga transfer finished 7-of-11 from the floor.

**FRESH START:** Aaniya Webb finished with a career-high 14 points in her Lady Tiger debut, while also setting a new high in minutes played with 29. Webb, who transferred in from St. Bonaventure doubled her career high after finishing with seven points on three occasions as a freshman. Her 29 minutes played against Wilberforce was a team-high.

**EASTBOUND AND DOWN:** Head coach Ty Evans is 2-1 when traveling to play on the East Coast. The Lady Tigers dropped a game at Mercer in Evans's first year on November 28, 2020, and have won two games out east since. The Lady Tigers picked up wins at Georgia State (70-67) and at Stetson (60-56) in 2021. This will mark TSU's first trip to North Carolina since the team took on North Carolina State in Raleigh in November of 2014.

**THEIF IN THE NIGHT:** The TSU defense finished with 17 steals in the opener against Wilberforce, taking just one game to match their season-high of 17 steals against Omaha last season. The Lady Tiger's 17 swipes against WU are the most in a game in the OVC this season. Williams led the

team with four steals followed by Lyric Cole and Diamond Cannon who both tallied three apiece.

**YEAR FOUR:** Head coach Ty Evans returns for his fourth season after leading the Tigers to their second straight appearance in the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament, something that had not been done since the 2014-15 / 2015-16 seasons. With eight returners and six new pieces, Evans and his staff have their eyes set on more than just a third straight trip to the OVC tournament. "I have my own standards and last year for us I feel like we didn't take a step up, this year we need to take a step up and we plan on doing that", stated Evans in an interview with TSU basketball analyst Greg Pogue. "Our mindset right now to me has been the best it's been at this point in the preseason since I've been here".

**PORTAL PURSUERS:** After losing eight players from last year's team, Evans and his staff turned to the transfer portal to fill the gaps on this year's roster. The Tigers signed five DI transfers through the portal, while also finding Kamera Piggee from the Juco ranks. TSU added Jordan Aikens who previously played at fellow HBCU Southern, and Diamond Cannon who played one year in the OVC at UT Martin. Aaniya Webb joins the team after one season at St. Bonaventure, while Caitlin Anderson comes to the Music City after four years at Indiana State. Sanaa' St. Andre joins the team after spending three seasons at Kansas City.

**FROM FAR AND WIDE:** TSU's roster has players from 11 different states and one country. The Tigers only have two players from Tennessee in Lyric Cole and Zyion Shannon, with Shannon being the local product from Smyrna. Newcomer Kamera Pigge hails from California, while Corina Suarez-Tudela is from Spain. Diamond Cannon comes to TSU after originally playing her high school ball in Michigan, while Aaniya

**UPPER CLASS:** With no freshman on the roster, this year's team will mark one of Evans' more experienced squads. The Tigers have 12 upperclassmen with five graduate students, three seniors, and four juniors, while also having two sophomores on the roster.

**RETURNING BUCKETS:** The Tigers return combined points from last year's team. Saniah Parker is the returning leading scorer after averaging 9.1 ppg and finishing with 263 points. Lyric Cole finished with 181 points while scoring 6.7 ppg. Zyion Shannon returns after scoring 104 points as a true freshman.

**EYEING DOWN 1K:** Having not played since March of 2021, Eboni Williams is set to make her TSU debut after missing the 2021-22 seasons and 2022-23 season. Williams joined the team last season but was unable to play due to injury. She

played in 83 games over three years as a Moc and finished with 855 career points. Williams is just 145 points shy of 1,000 for her career and will look to hit the mark soon.

**LOTS OF BALL:** Caitlin Anderson joins the team this year as a grad student after playing four seasons at Indiana State. Anderson played 110 career games as a Sycamore, which is the most on the TSU roster. She is expected to take over the point guard role after averaging 5.72 ppg and 2.65 assists per game over four years.
